SURVEY METHOD


This survey was conducted online within the United States from March 27-29 among **1,340 registered voters** by The Harris Poll.

Results were weighted for age within gender, region, race/ethnicity, marital status, household size, income, employment, education, political party, and political ideology where necessary to align them with their actual proportions in the population. Propensity score weighting was also used to adjust for respondents' propensity to be online.

Pollsters Mark Penn, Prof. Stephen Ansolabehere, and Dritan Nesho supervised the poll.














Would you say that your personal financial situation is improving or getting worse?









If the 2018 midterm elections were today, would you want to see the Republican Party or the Democratic Party win control of the United States <u>House of Representatives</u>?



























Do you think that the murder rates are typically higher in rural areas or in urban areas?




Do you think most school violence occurs in urban, rural or suburban schools?






Do you think murder by gun is up or down in the last decade?














March 2018: Do you think the independent counsel has found actual evidence of Trump campaign officials colluding with the Russians or has he not found any evidence of such collusion?
















































































Do you believe that the president should put America first in his decision making or balance the interests of the United States with those of the world in making decisions?







Do you think free trade results mainly in lower prices for American consumers or mainly in the loss of American jobs?

















Do you think the tariffs and levies will impact mainly our allies, our enemies, both equally, or just the United States?
























If diplomacy is unsuccessful, would you favor or oppose air strikes on the nuclear facilities of North Korea?






Do you think Iran is a working democracy or is it run by a group of religious leaders who claim absolute power based on religion?


































