SURVEY METHOD


This survey was conducted online within the United States from Field Dates: November 17-19, 2020 among **2,205 registered voters** by The Harris Poll.

Results were weighted for age within gender, region, race/ethnicity, marital status, household size, income, employment, education, political party, and political ideology where necessary to align them with their actual proportions in the population. Propensity score weighting was also used to adjust for respondents' propensity to be online.

Pollsters Mark Penn (Chairman, The Harris Poll), Dritan Nesho (CEO, HarrisX) and Prof. Stephen Ansolabehere (CAPS Director, Harvard) supervised the poll.











How strong do you think the U.S. economy is today?









What would you say are the most important issues facing the country today? Please select three.








FAUCI, OBAMA, BIDEN AND PENCE HAVE THE HIGHEST FAVORABILITY




MILITARY, POLICE AND CDC AMONG THE MOST FAVORABLE GROUPS








RESULTING IN A 4 POINT SPREAD NATIONALLY AMONG THE CANDIDATES

Confidentially and for statistical purposes only, who did you vote for in the 2020 presidential election?




AND A SPLIT ELECTORATE WHEN VIEWED FROM THE PERSPECTIVE OF THE CONGRESSIONAL VOTE

Confidentially and for statistical purposes only, which party's Congressional candidate did you vote for in the 2020 presidential election?



Do you think Donald Trump won or Joe Biden won?









Do you think the system of mail in ballots was fair or unfair?



Did anyone solicit your ballot and ask you to fill it out and or offer to turn it in?



Do you think that there was significant fraud in the counting of the mail ballots or no significant fraud in the counting of such ballots?













Do you think the election rules were changed in key states at the last minute by courts favoring the democrats or were there no such changes in favor of the democrats?





Do you think media organizations should be calling who won the election before results are certified or should they wait for the states to certify the results before doing so?





Based on what you know today, has Joe Biden only been projected to have won the election by the media or have the states legally certified the results?





Are you generally satisfied with the outcome of the election or generally unsatisfied?





Which issue do you want the Biden administration to tackle first?




What is the next issue the Biden administration should tackle?



Do you think that Joe Biden, once in office, should rejoin the Iran nuclear deal or should he not rejoin the Iran nuclear deal?




Do you think that Joe Biden should reach out to China and adopt a more conciliatory policy or should he continue to press China on trade and human rights vigorously?





Do you think that Joe Biden should rejoin the Paris accords on climate change or should he not rejoin those accords?













Would you favor a plan to raise taxes by 4 trillion dollars a year or do you think that is too high a tax hike and oppose it?










Do you think that tech companies today have too much power, too little power or have the right amount of power?





Do you think that some of the tech companies should be broken up to create more competition or should they be kept as is to foster innovation?




Do you think that tech companies are fairly or unfairly using their power to censor or stop content from being posted?




MOST APPROVE OF CENSORING POLITICAL ADS SPONSORED BY FOREIGN GOVERNMENTS

Do you approve or disapprove of tech companies censoring and removing political and issue ads sponsored by foreign governments?




Do you approve or disapprove of tech companies censoring and removing political and issue ads sponsored by American political candidates and the democratic and republican parties?





Do you think the tech companies are primarily censoring content from Democrats, primarily Republicans or both equally?



Do you think that the tech companies have acted fairly during the election or did the tech companies favor one side over the other in their policies and actions?




Which side did the tech companies favor?


Do you think tech companies have standards they are using to determine which users might be posting misinformation or are they targeting high profile users and politicians arbitrarily?












Do you think that the rate of coronavirus infections in the US is growing faster or slowing down?




