SURVEY METHOD

This survey was conducted online within the United States from **Field Dates: February 23-24, 2022** among **2,026 registered voters** by The Harris Poll.

Results were weighted for age within gender, region, race/ethnicity, marital status, household size, income, employment, education, political party, and political ideology where necessary to align them with their actual proportions in the population. Propensity score weighting was also used to adjust for respondents' propensity to be online.

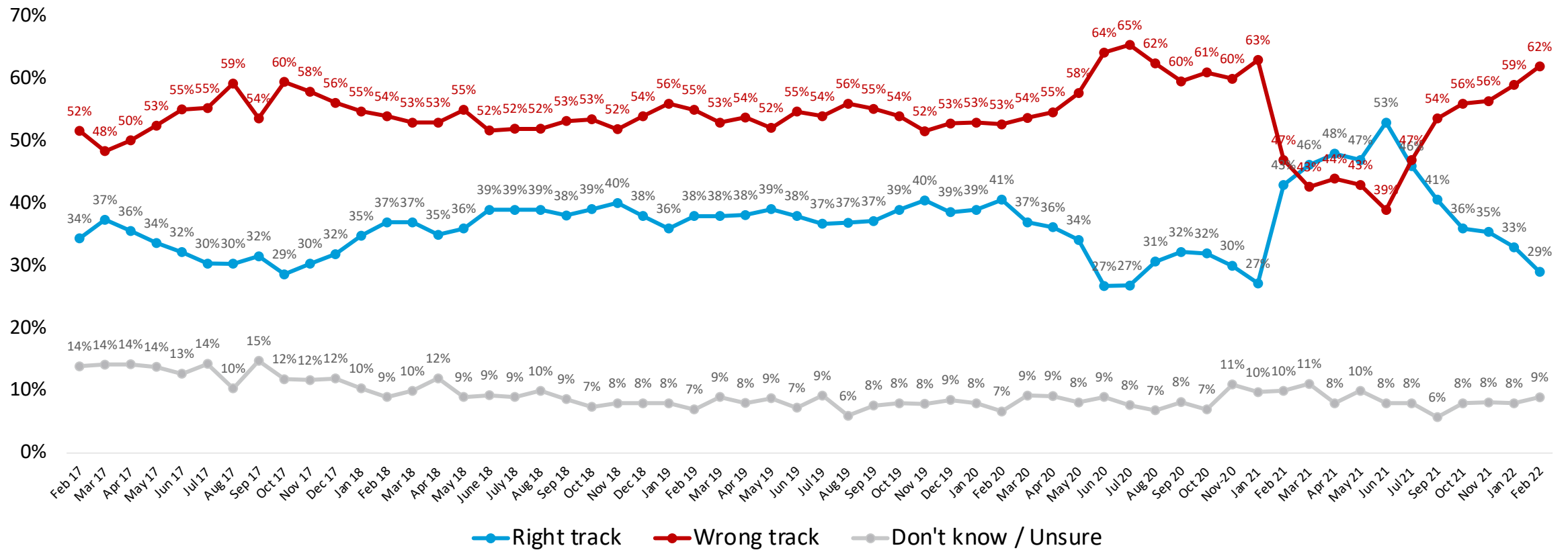

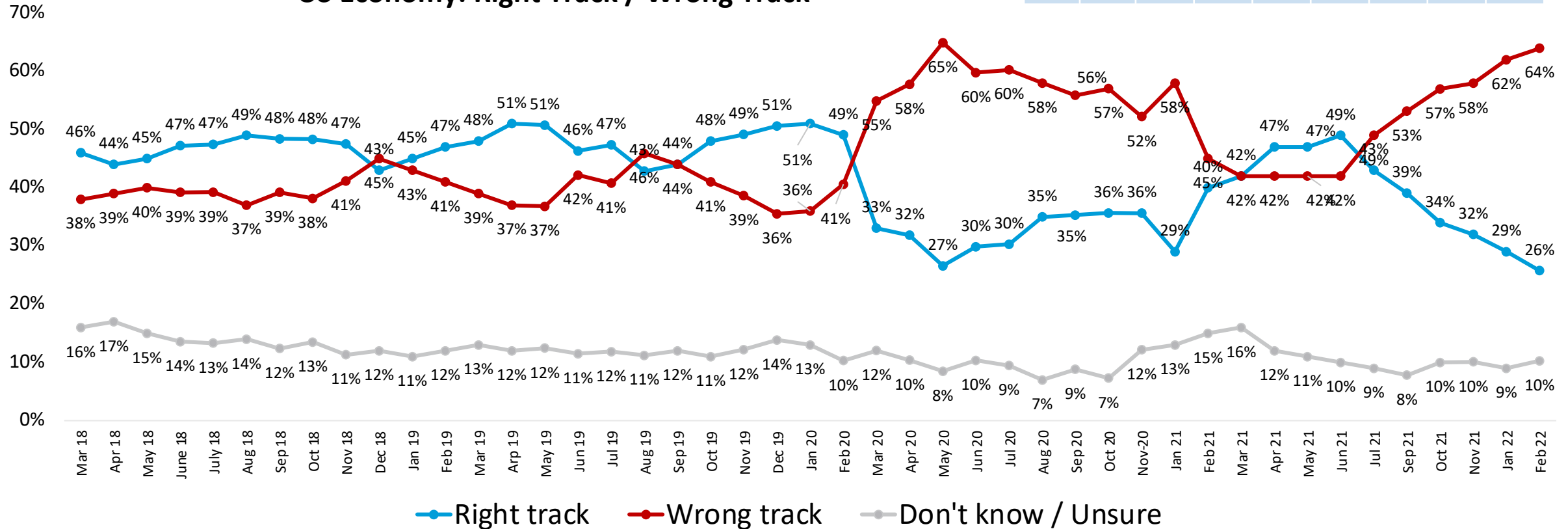

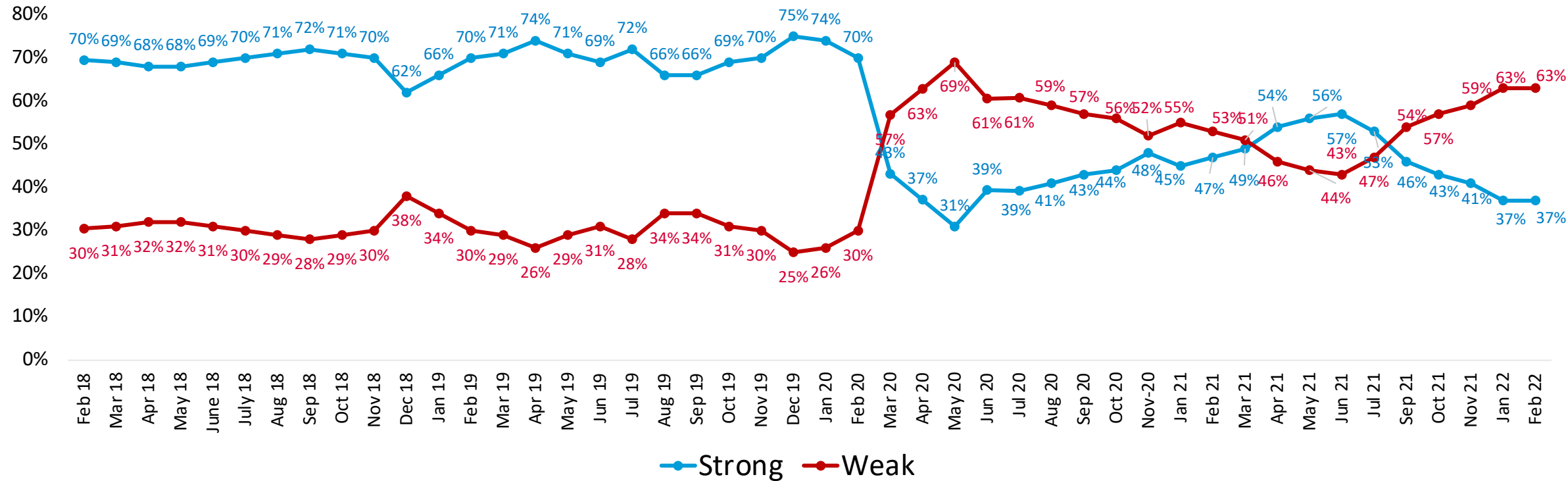

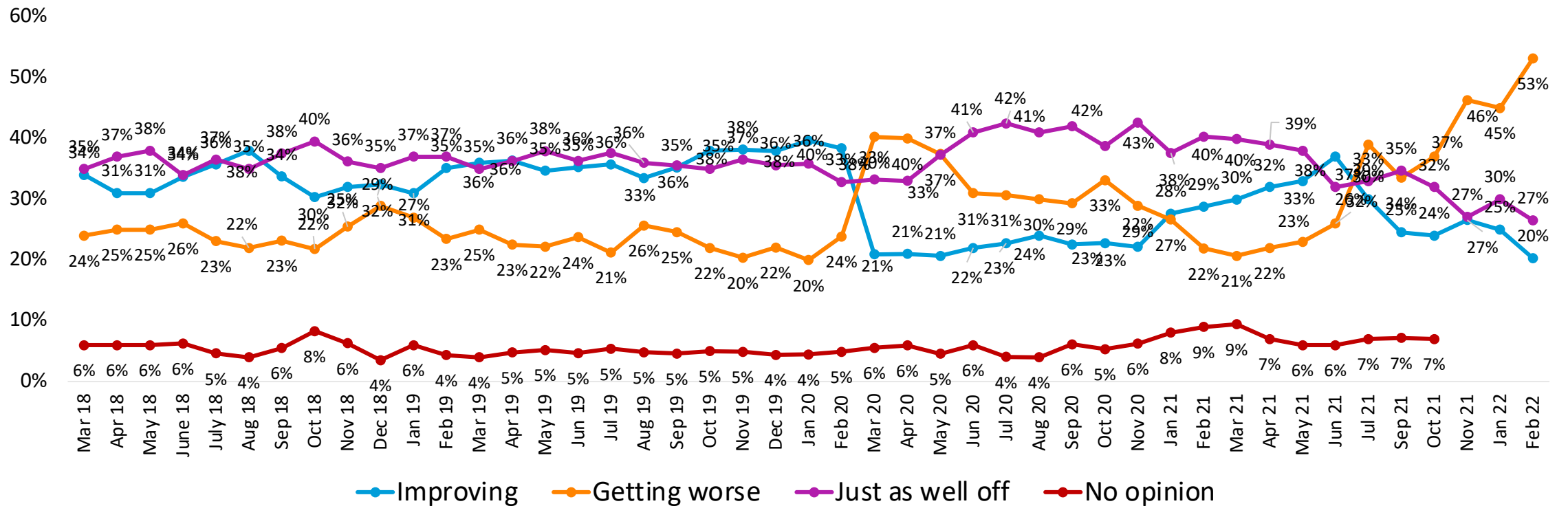
How strong do you think the U.S. economy is today?

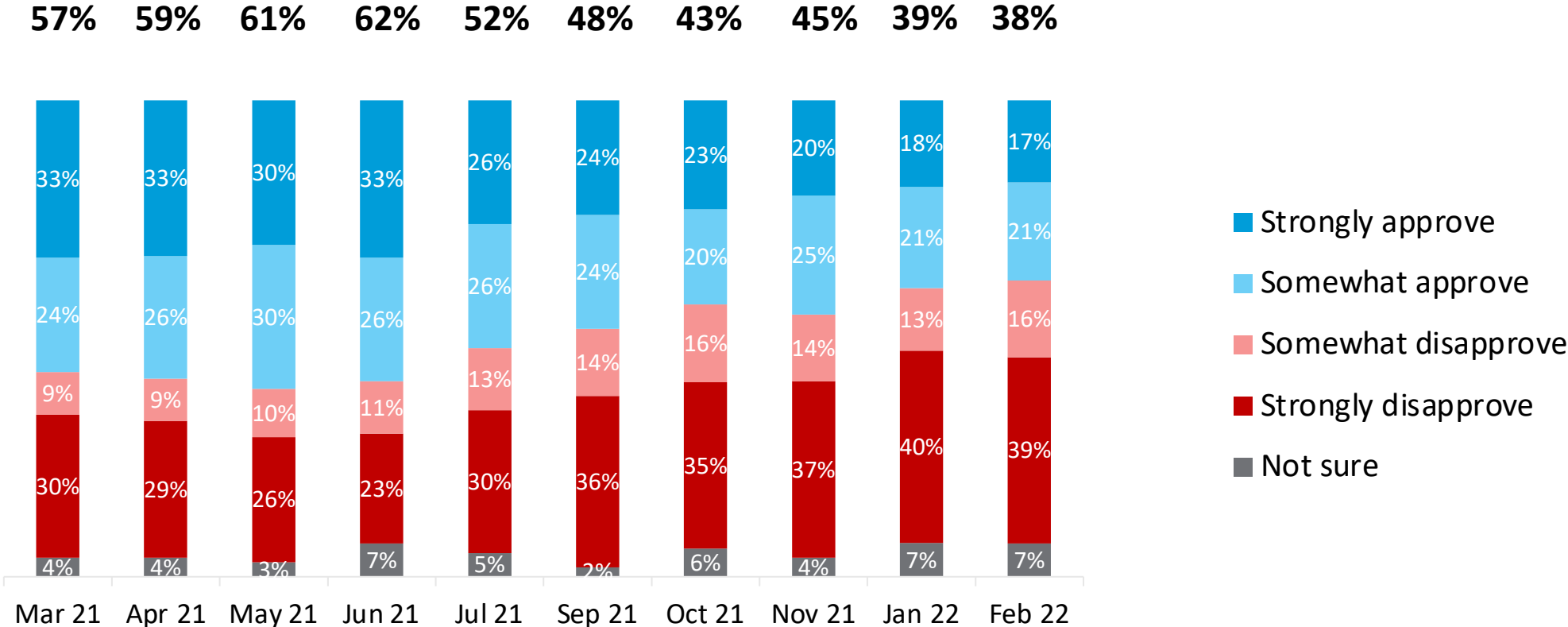
Would you say that your personal financial situation is improving or getting worse?

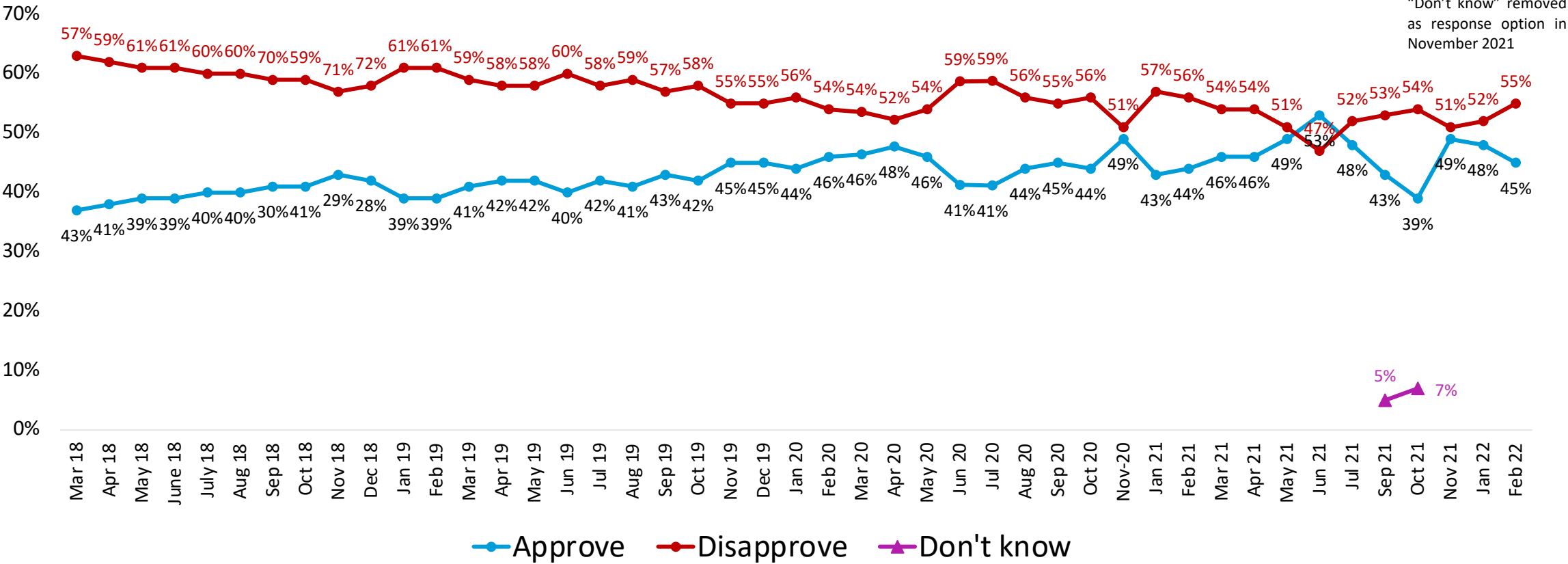

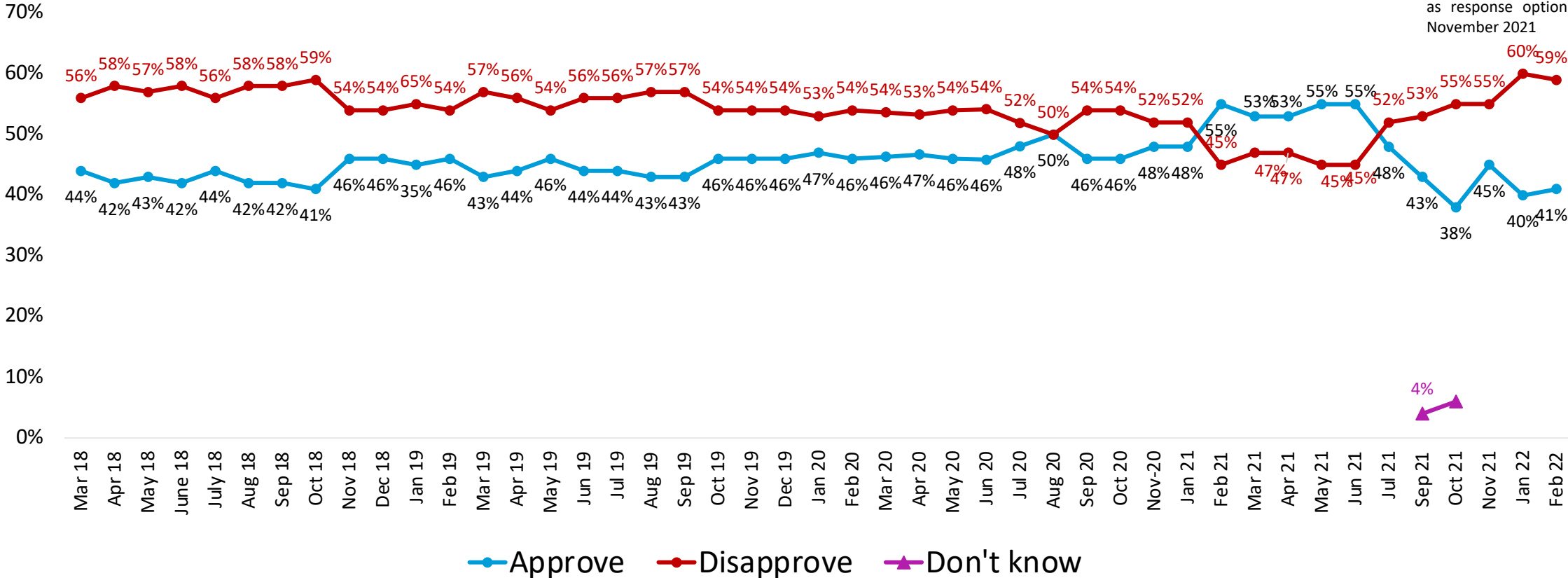

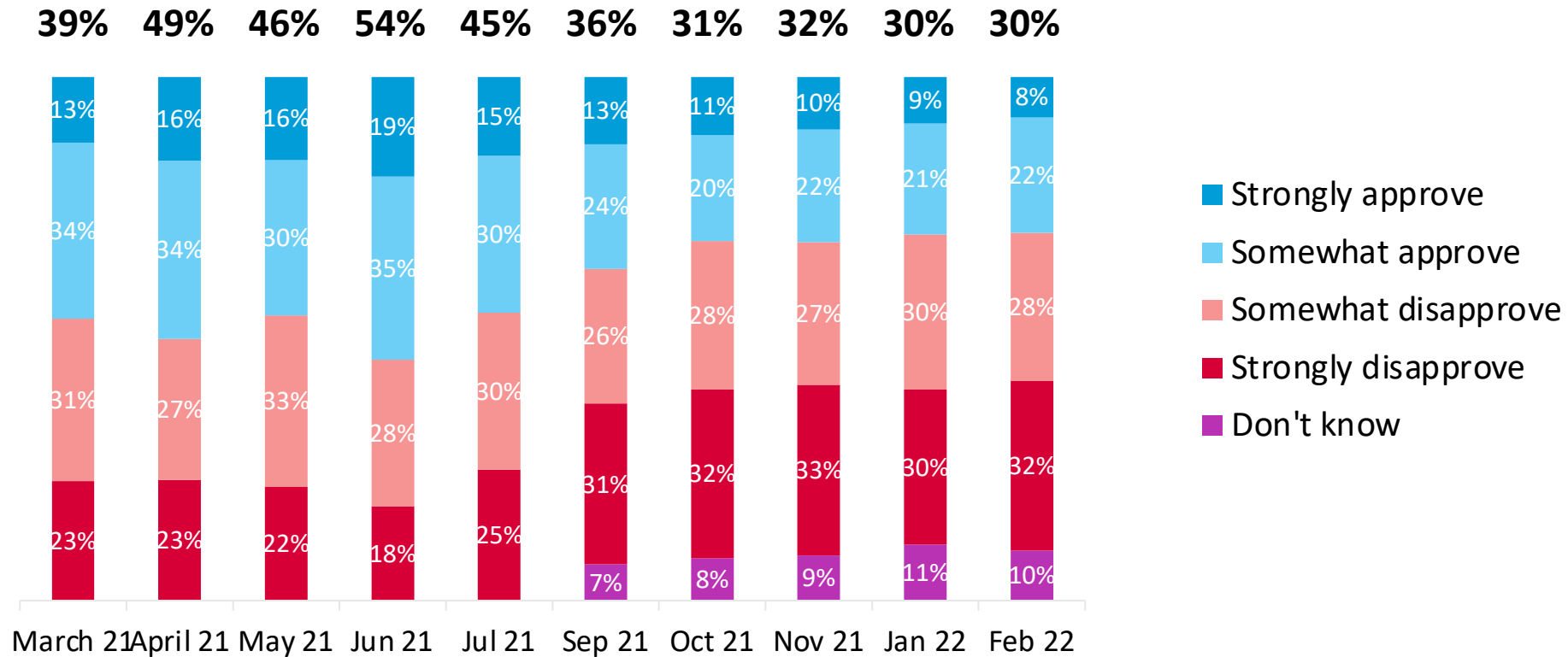

VOTERS OVERALL APPROVAL OF CONGRESS REMAINS AT 30 PERCENT

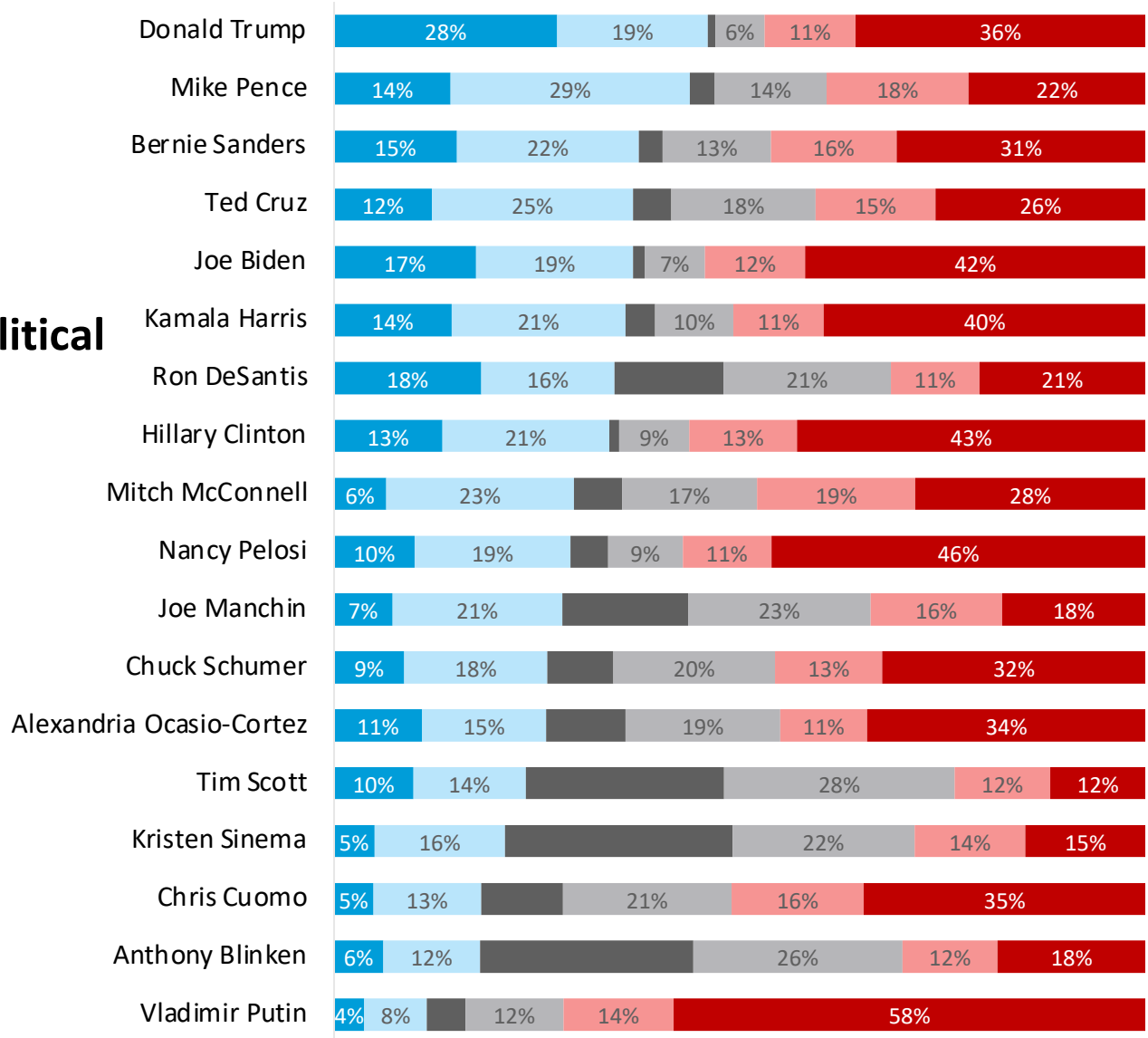

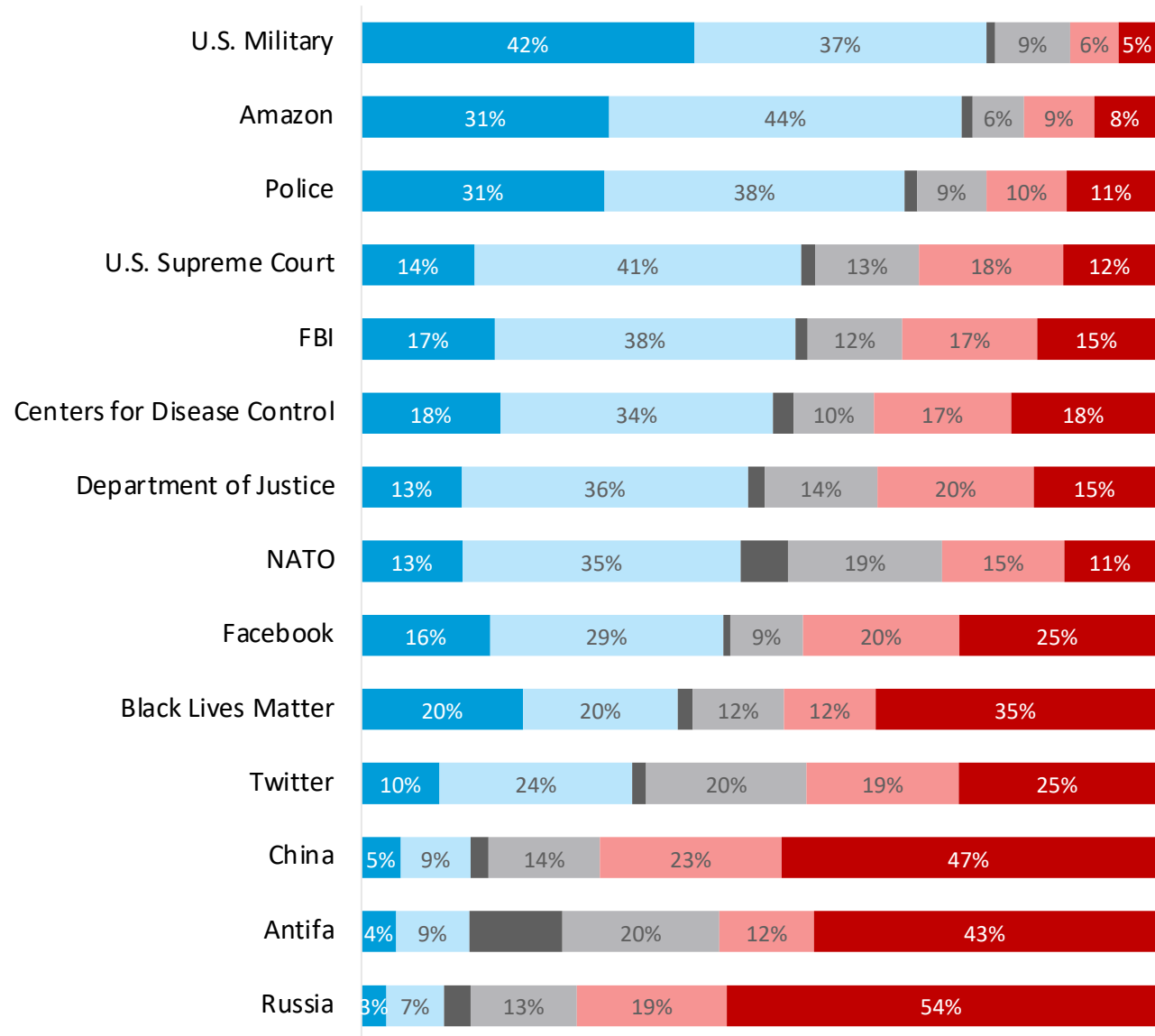

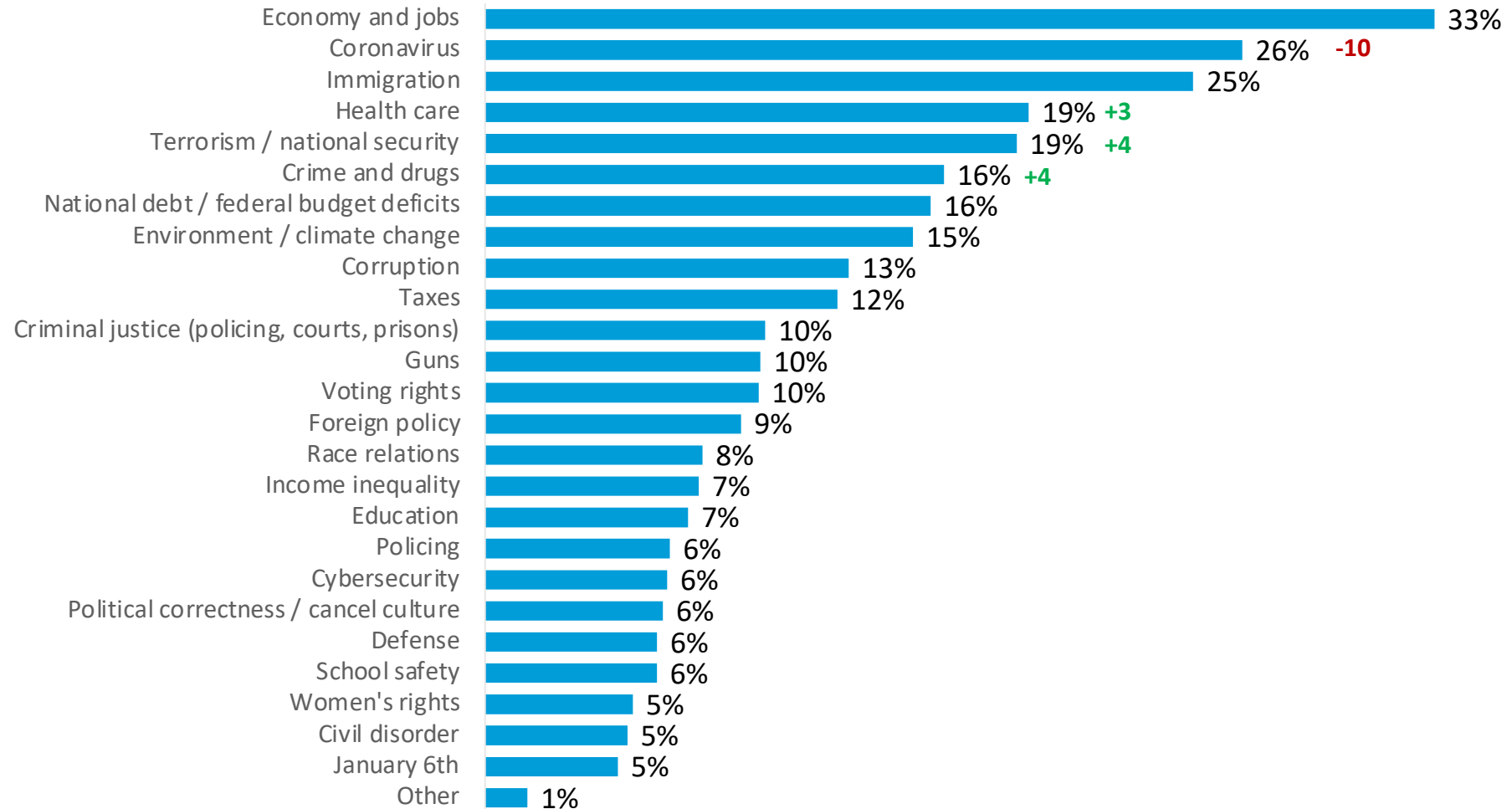

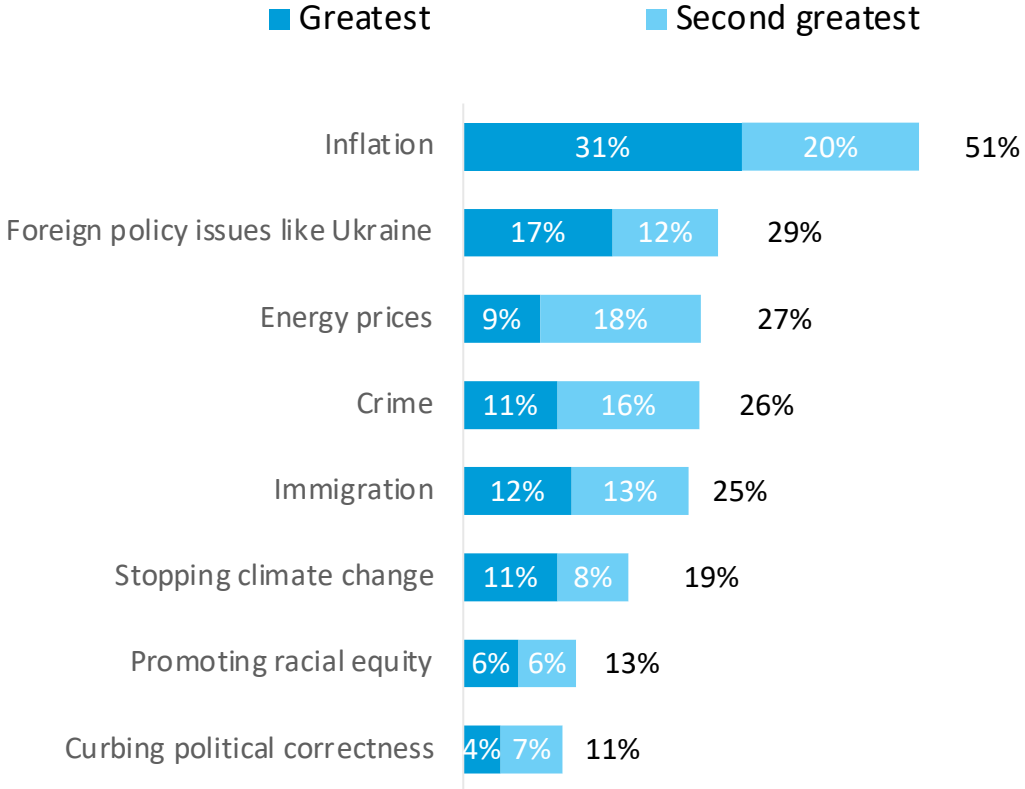
CORONAVIRUS LESS IMPORTANT THAN LAST MONTH, BUT STILL PRESENT AS A TOP THREE ISSUE

What is your greatest / second greatest concern?

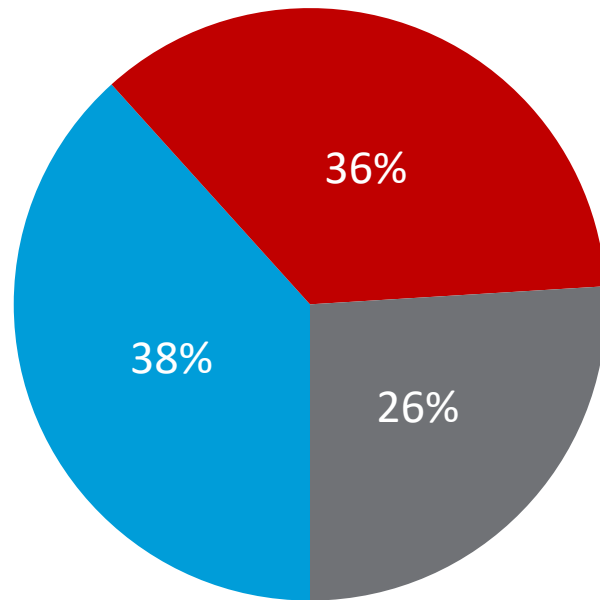

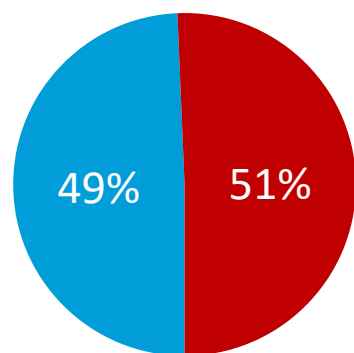

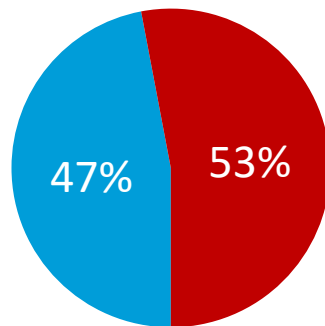

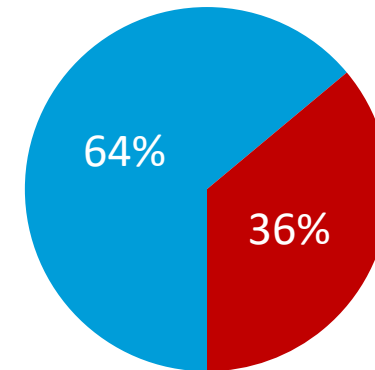

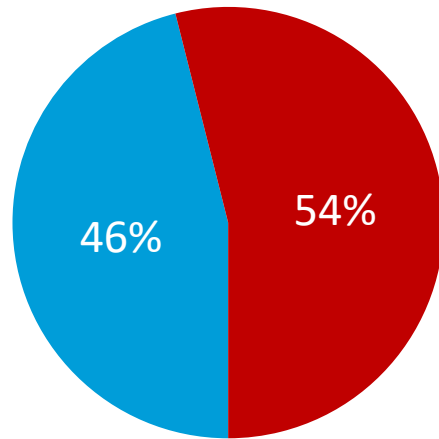

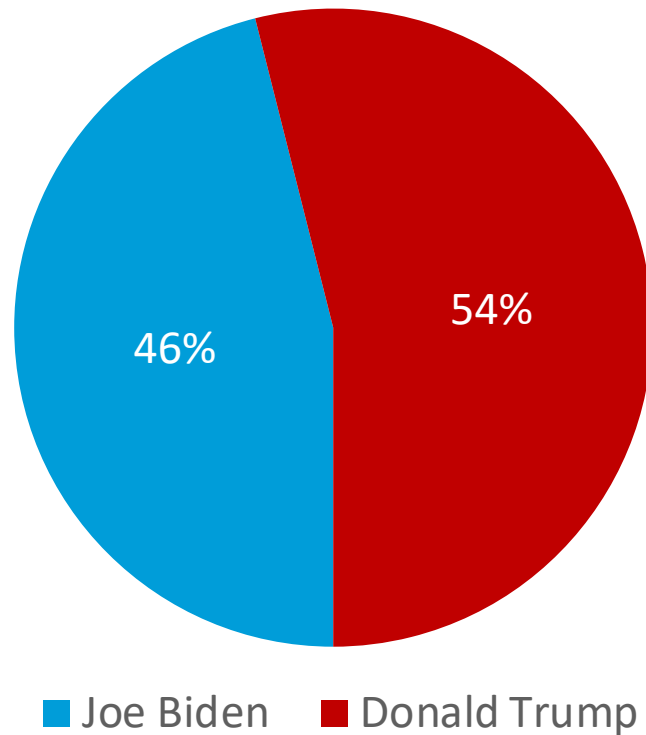

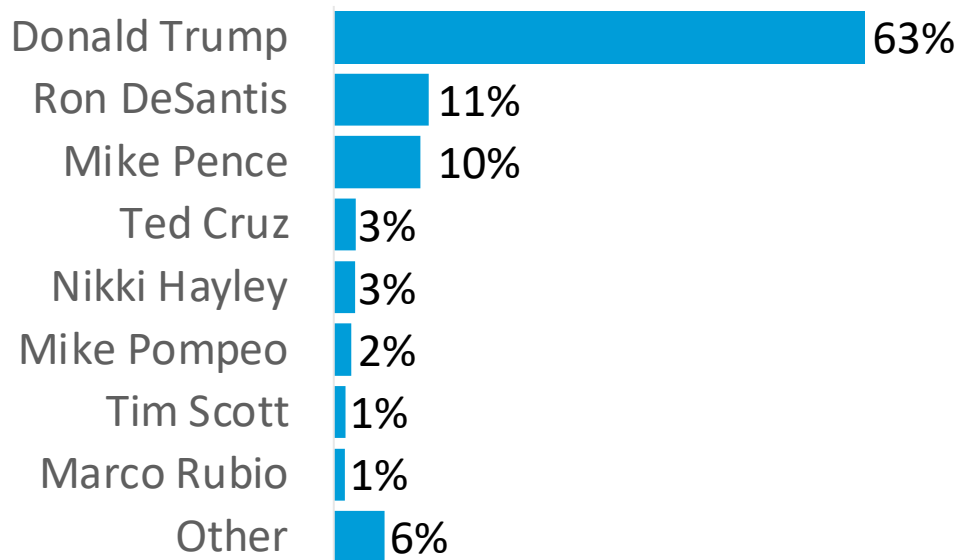

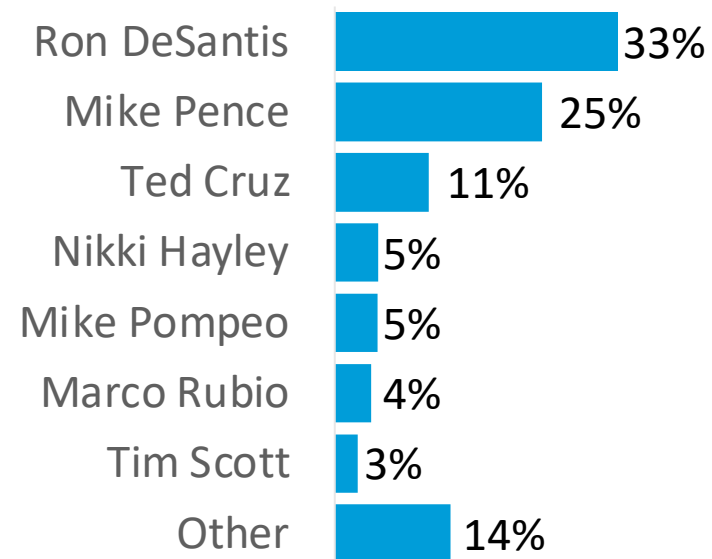

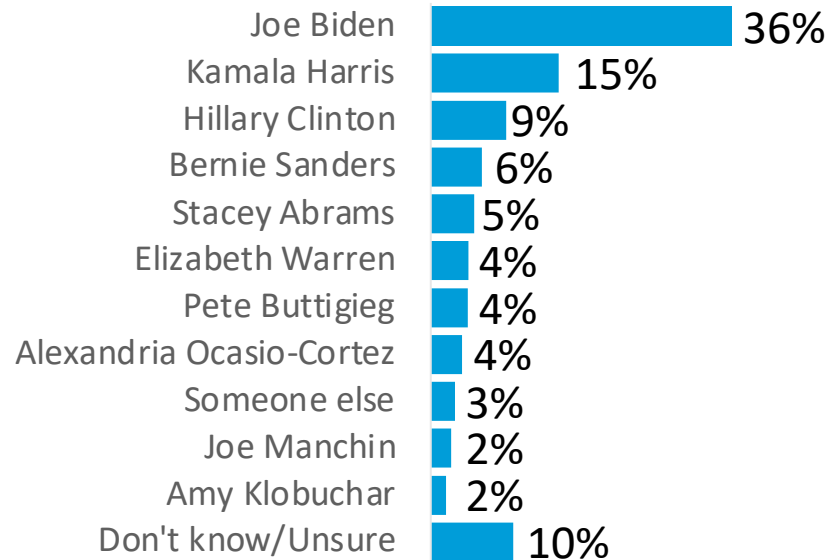

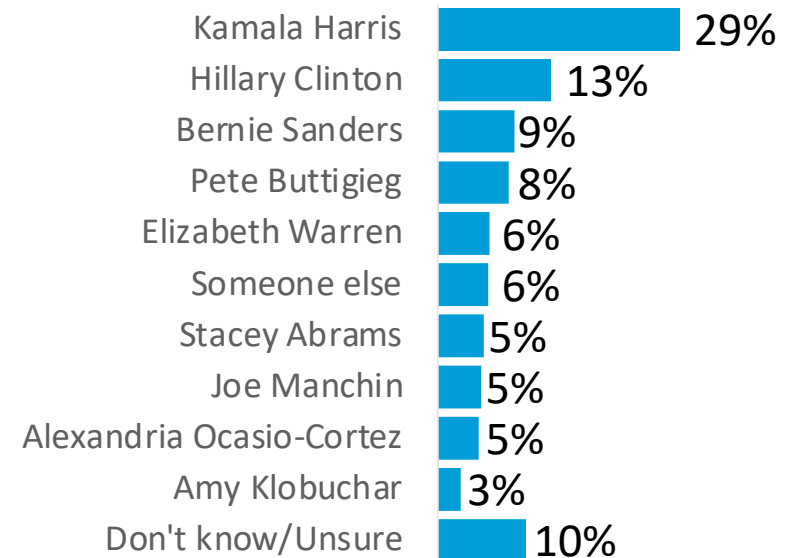

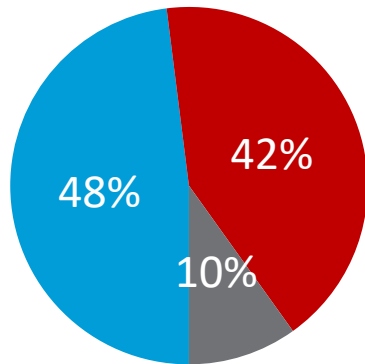

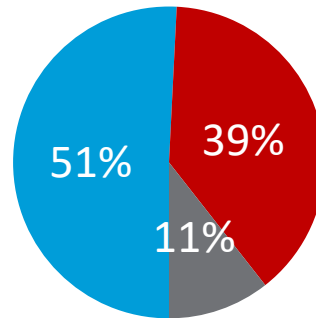

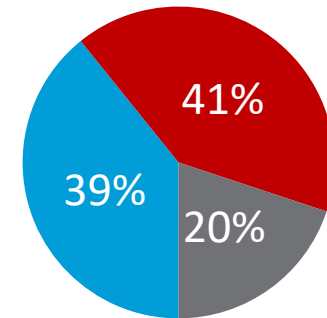

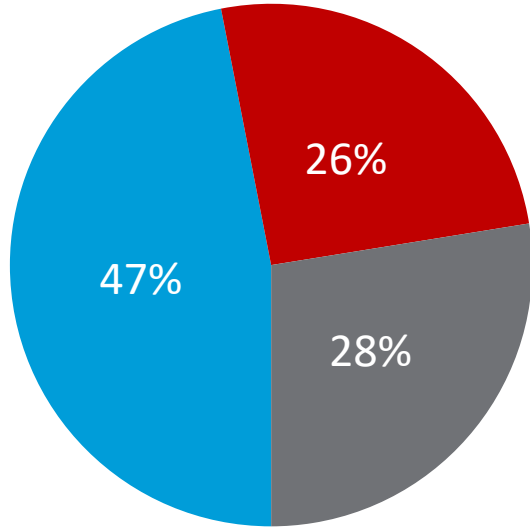

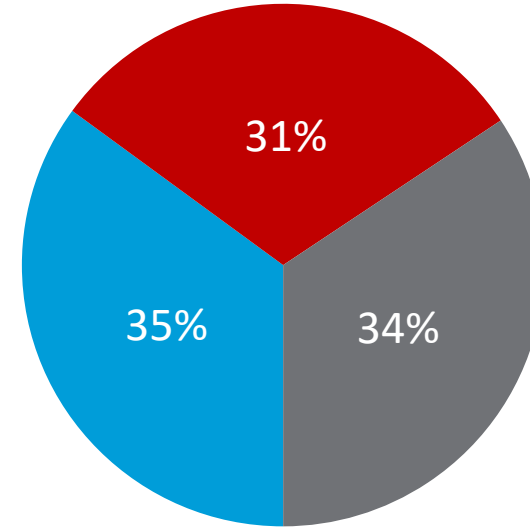

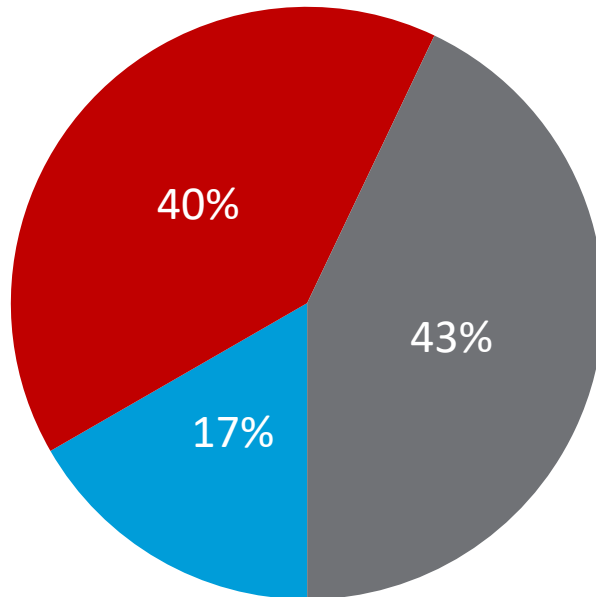

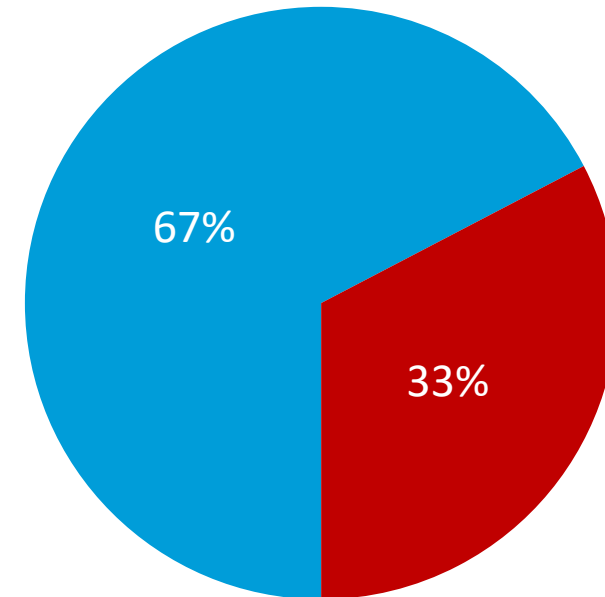

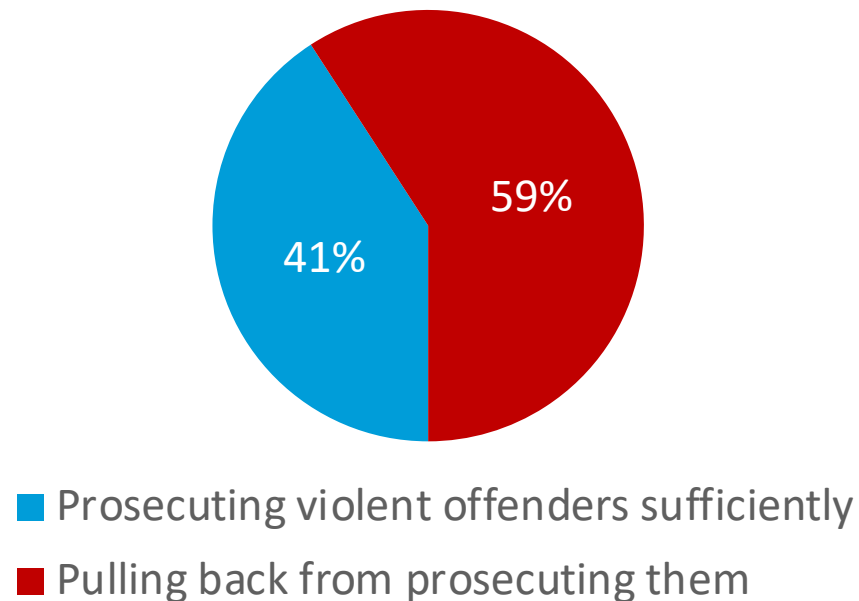

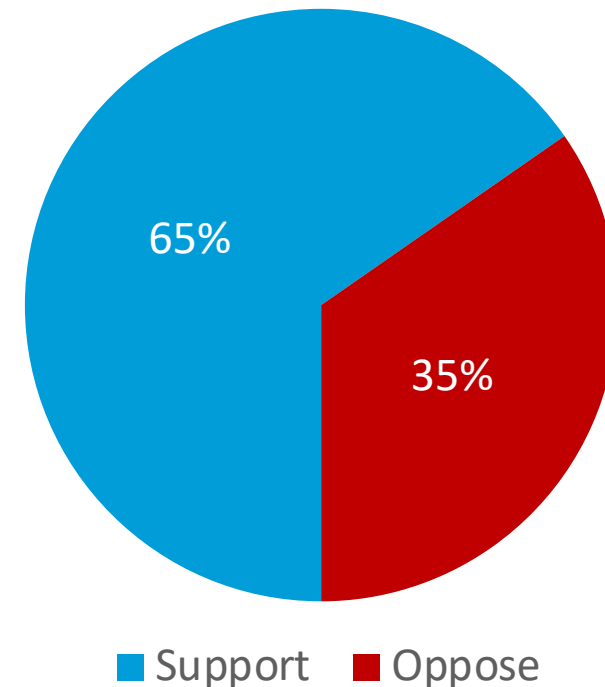

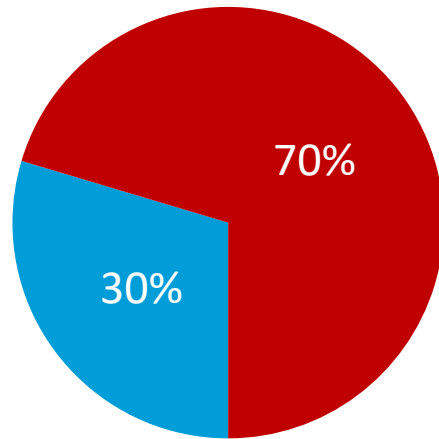

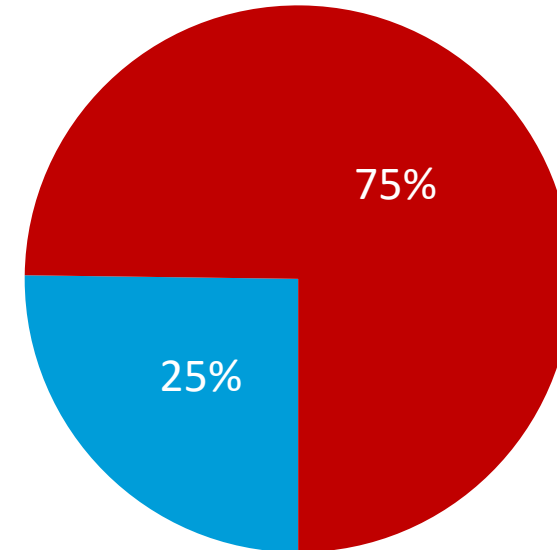

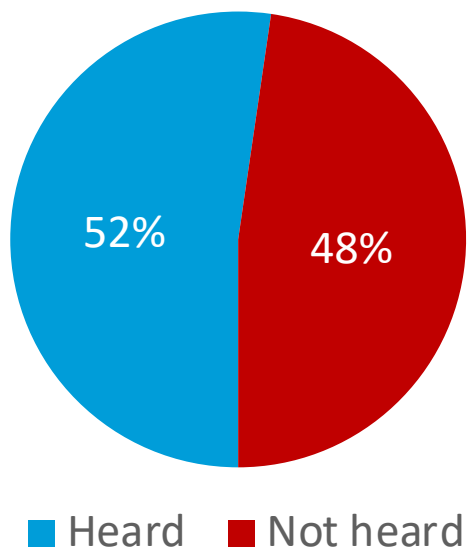

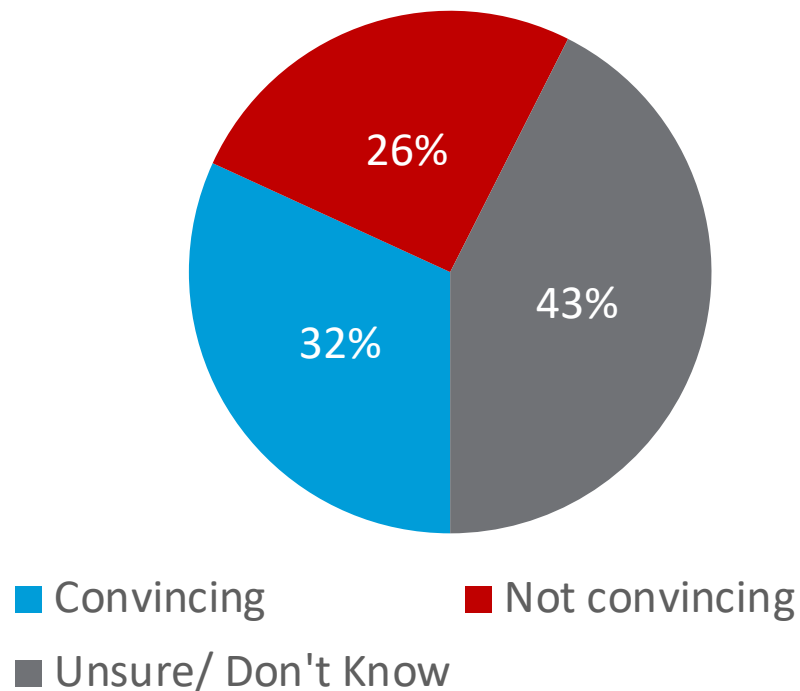

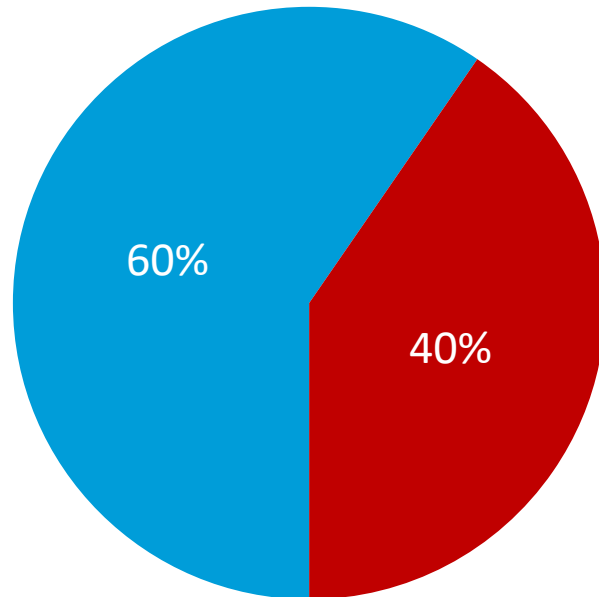

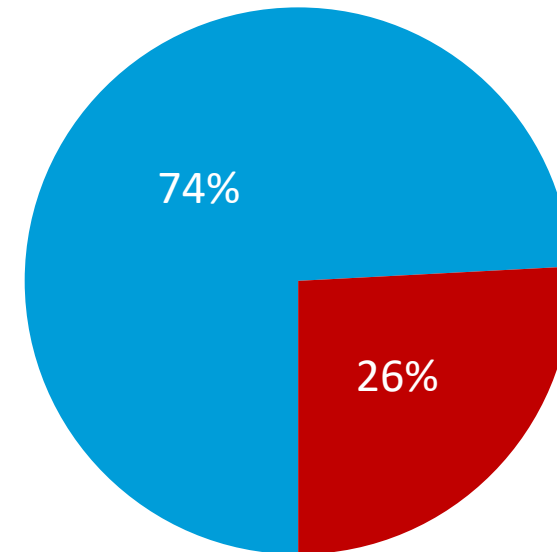

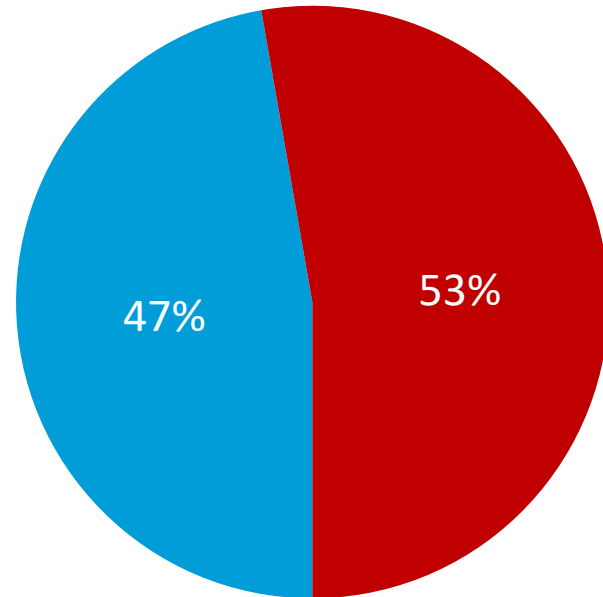

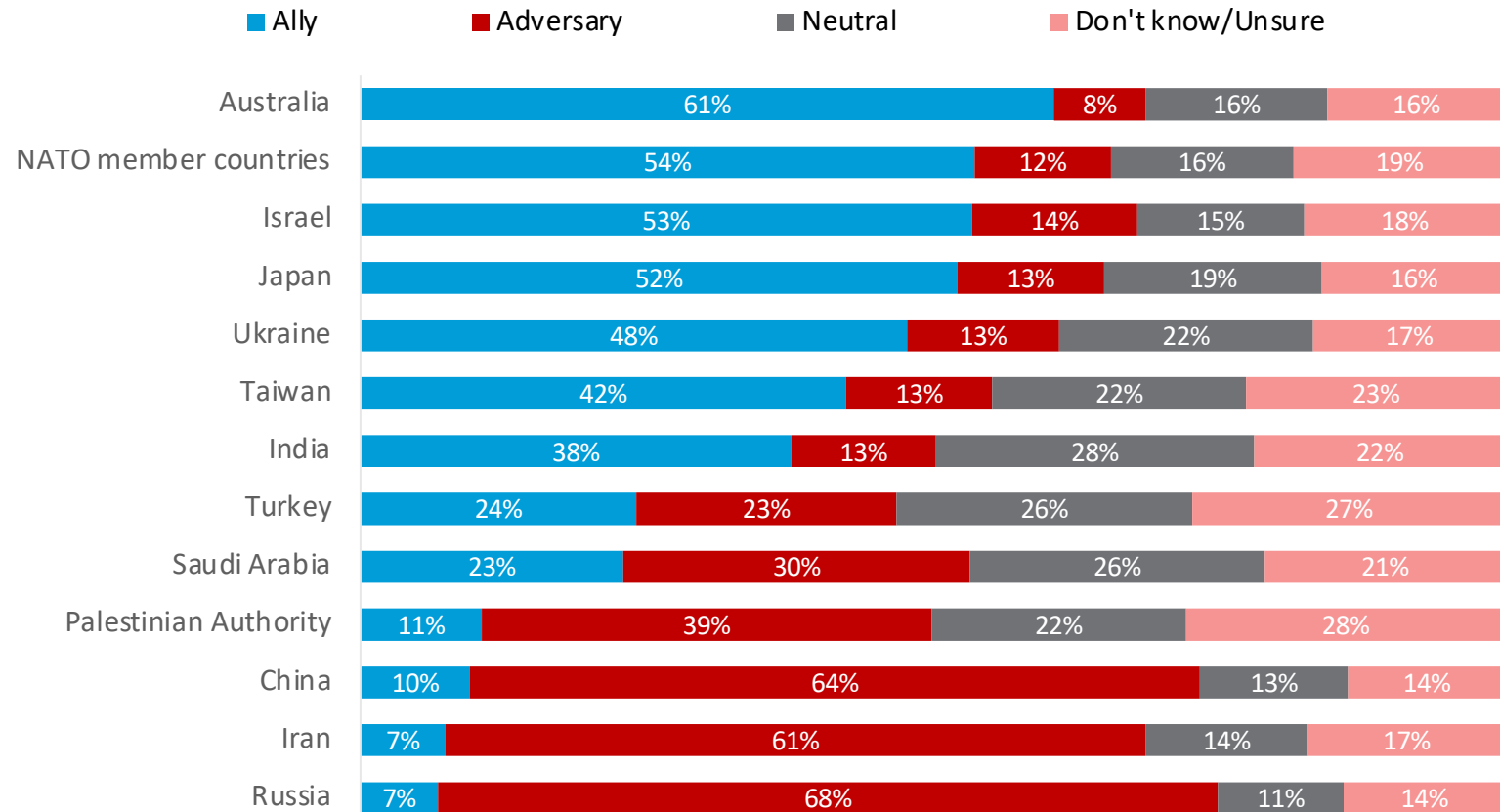

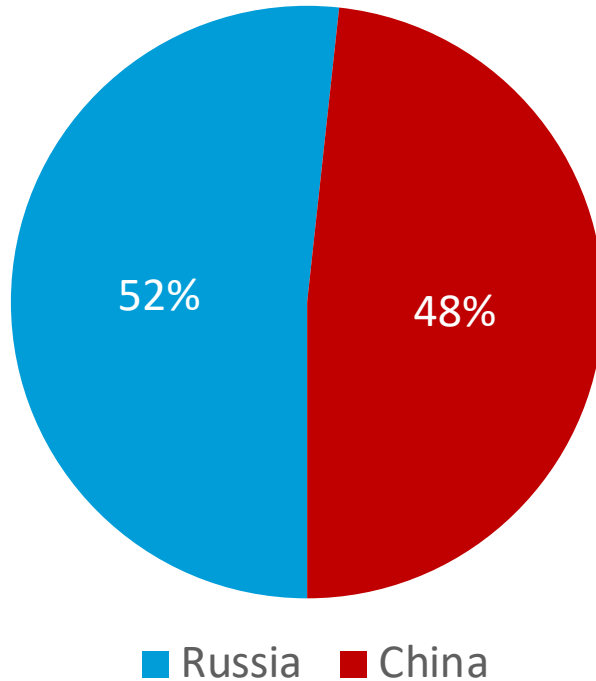

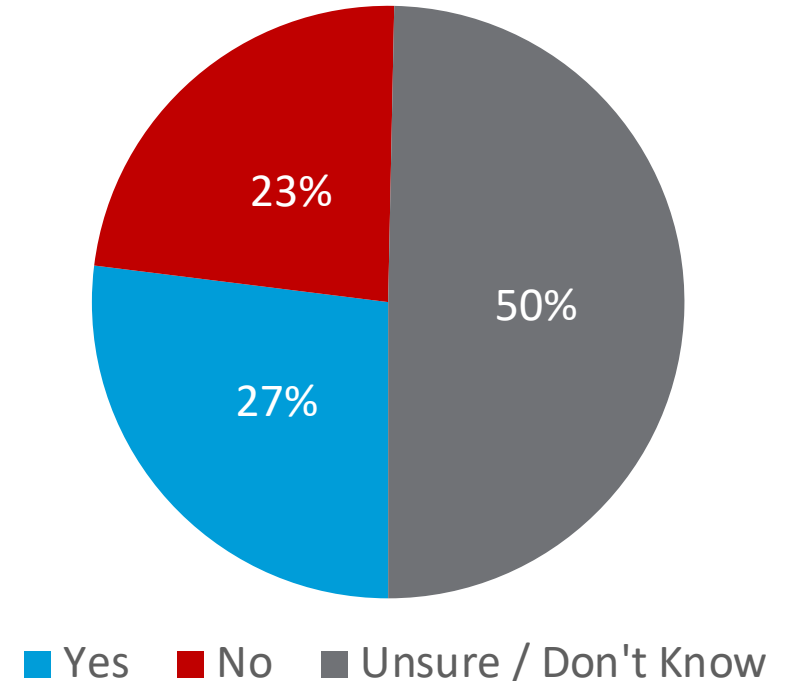

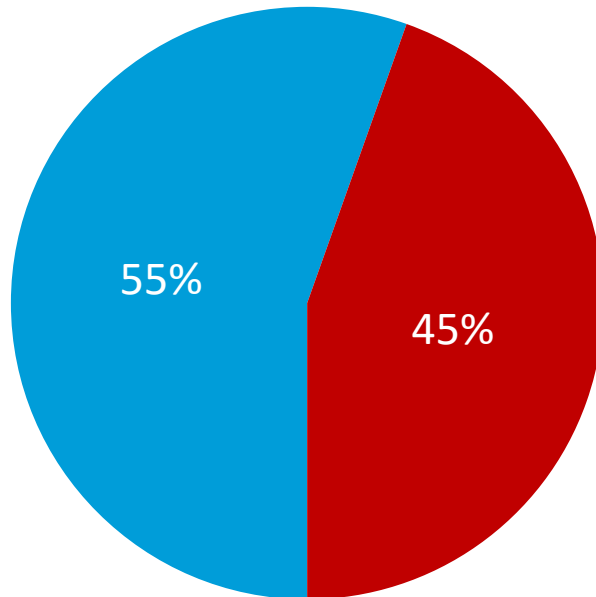

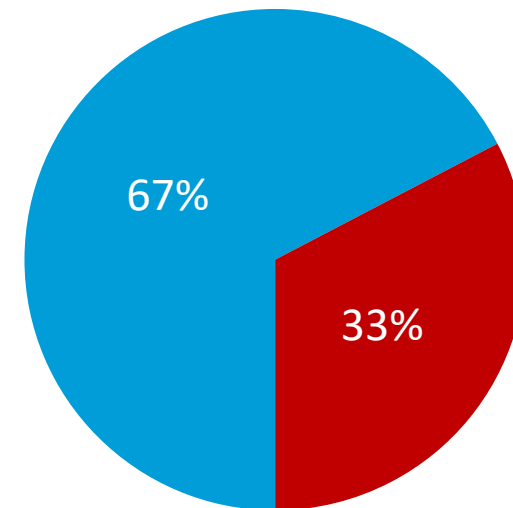

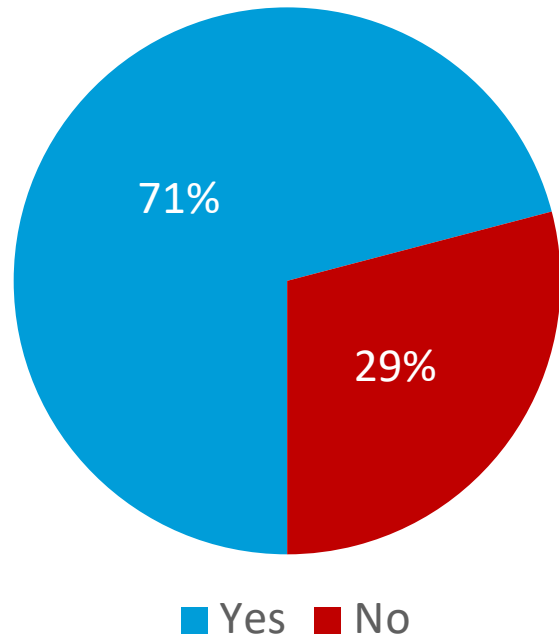

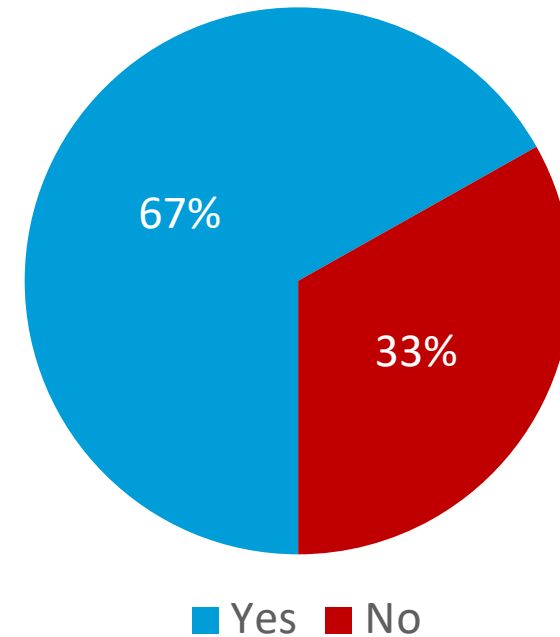

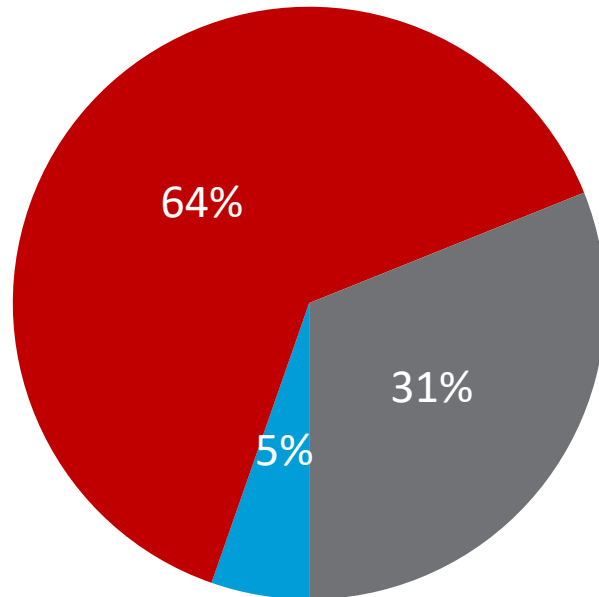

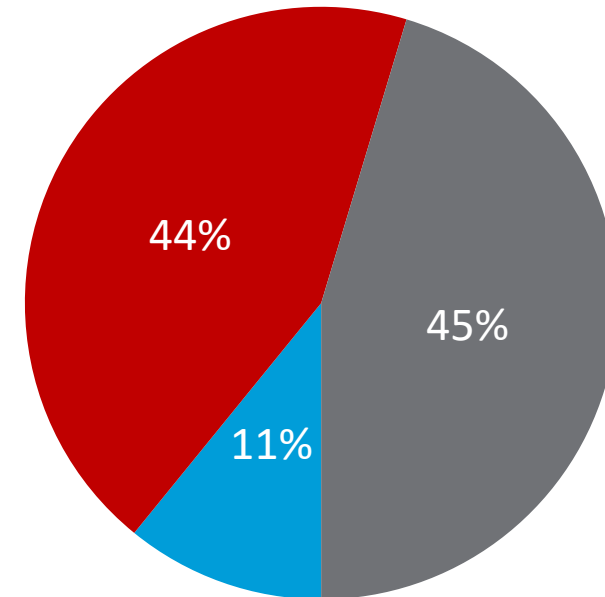

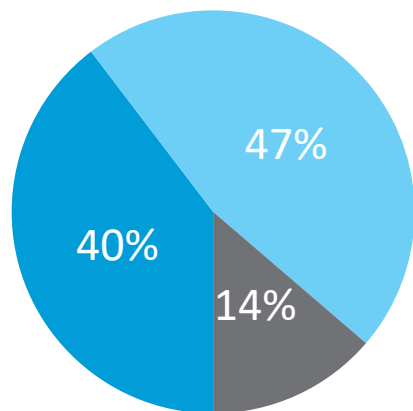

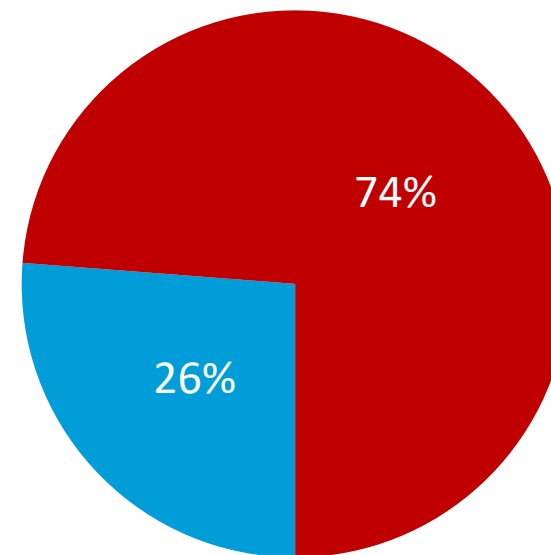

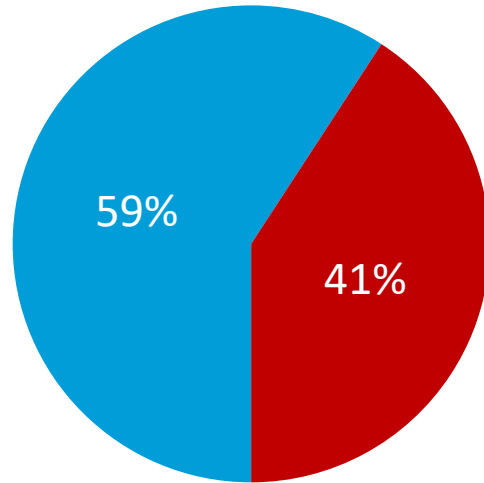

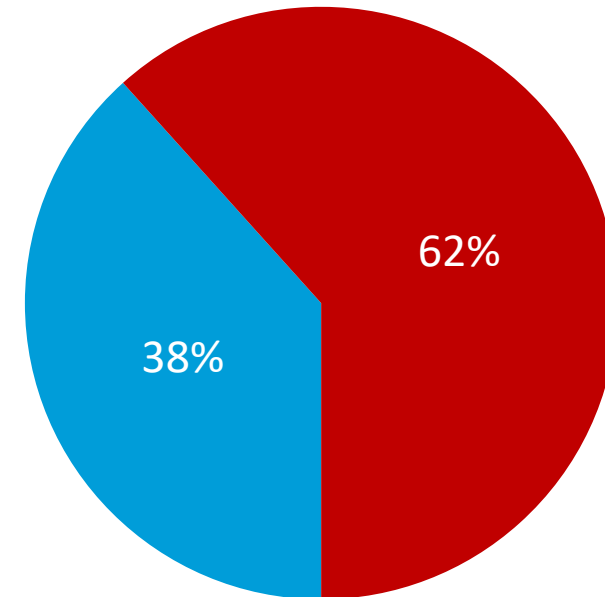

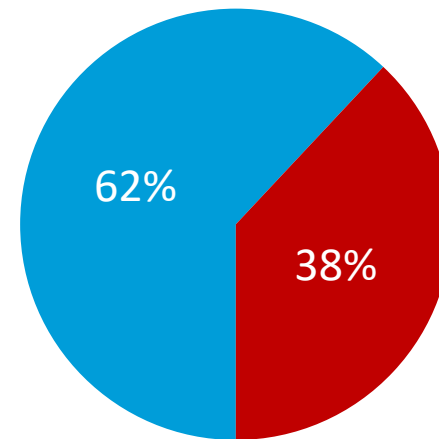

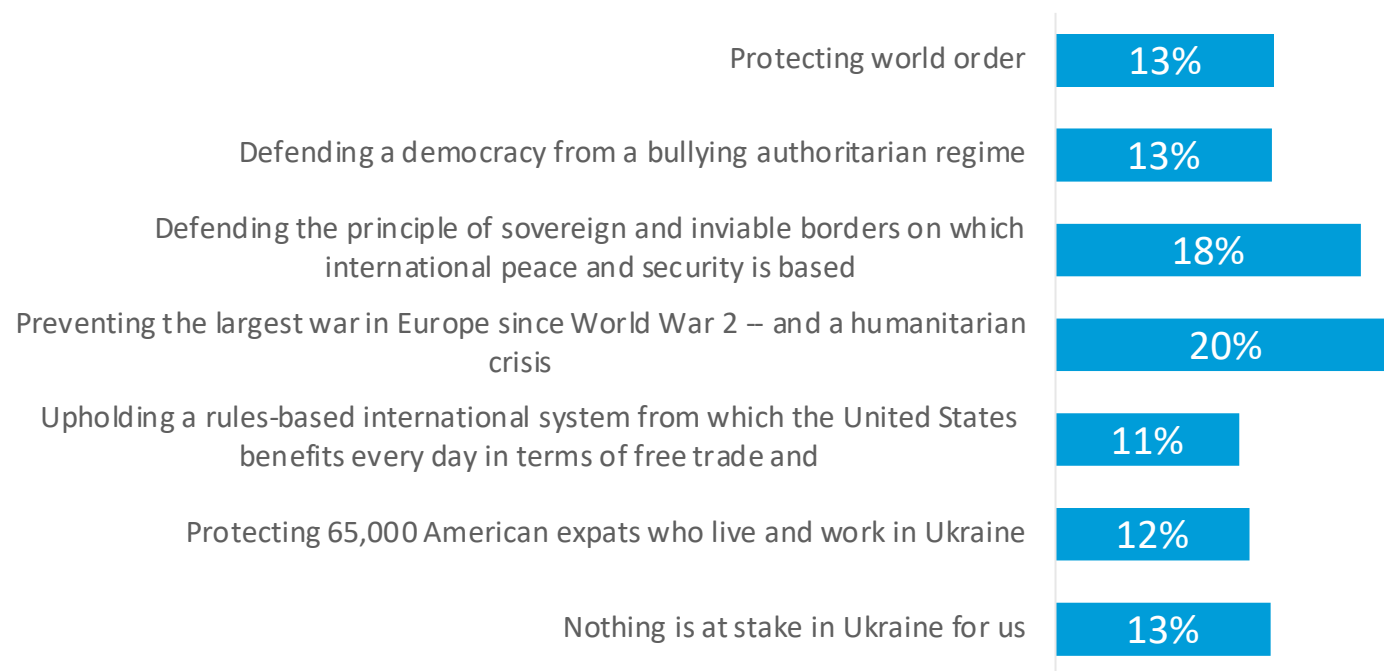

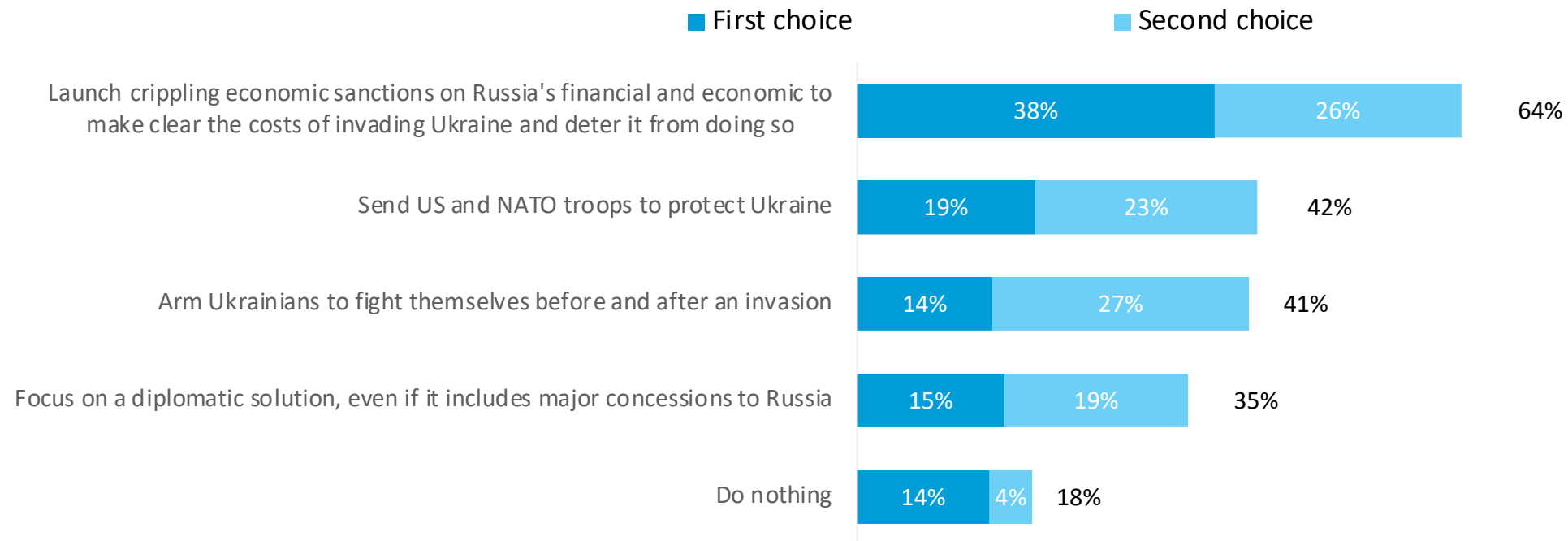

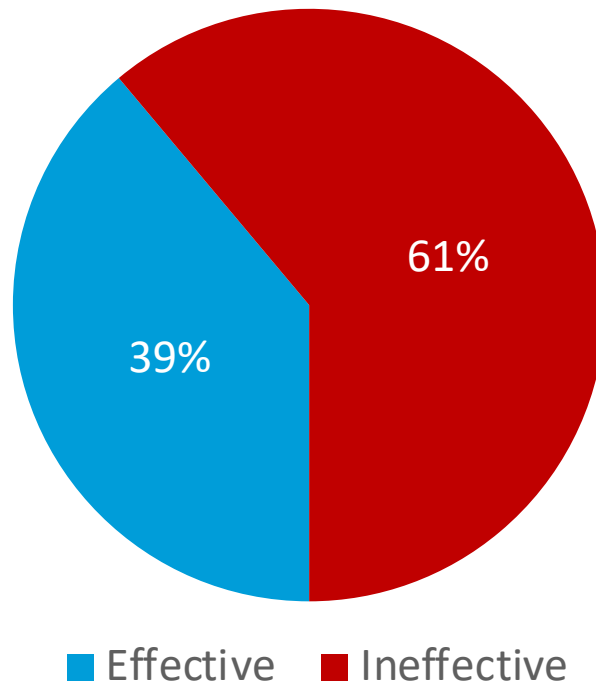

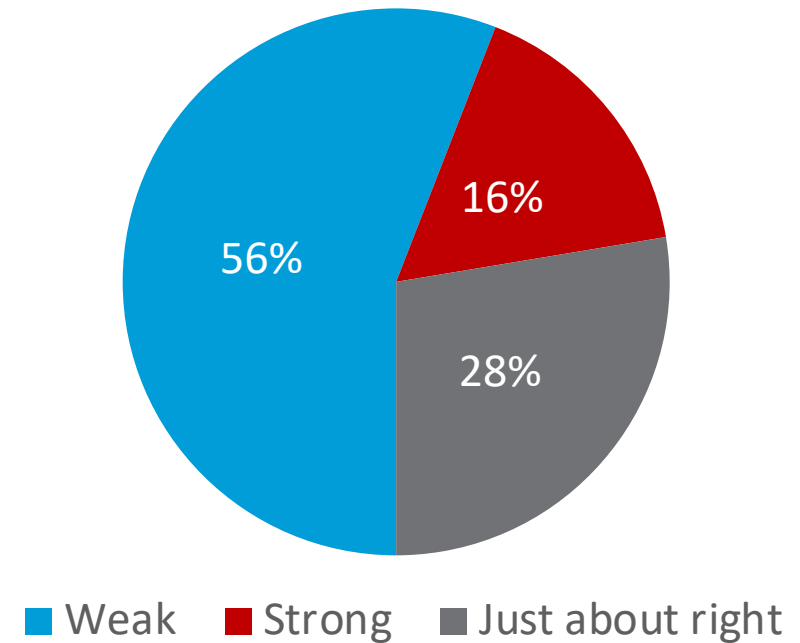

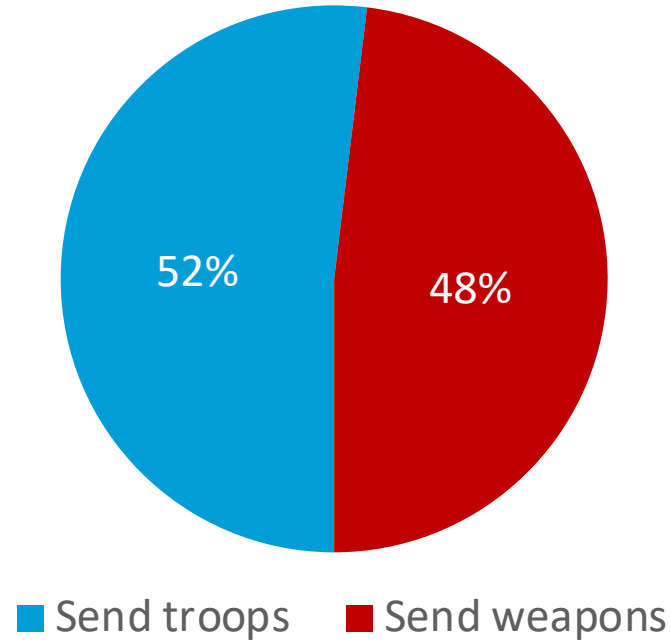

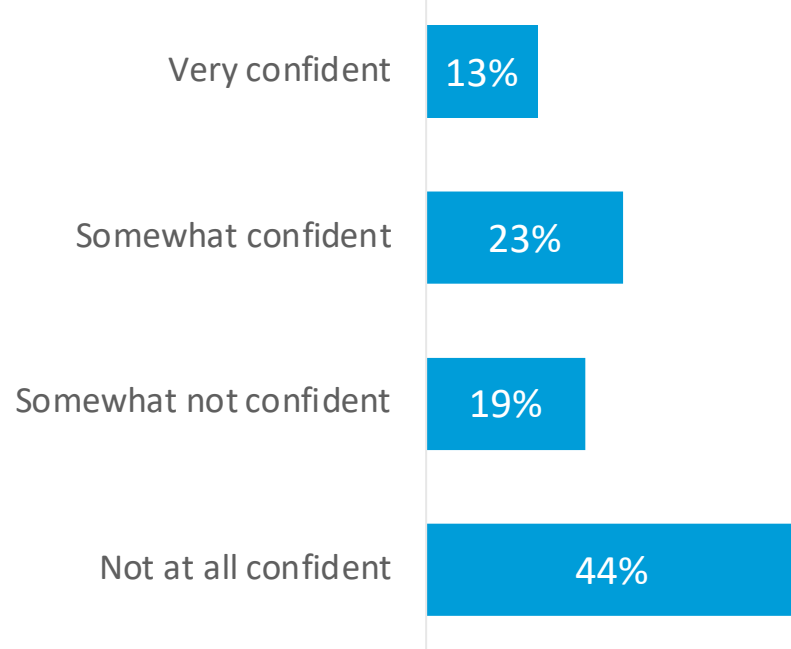

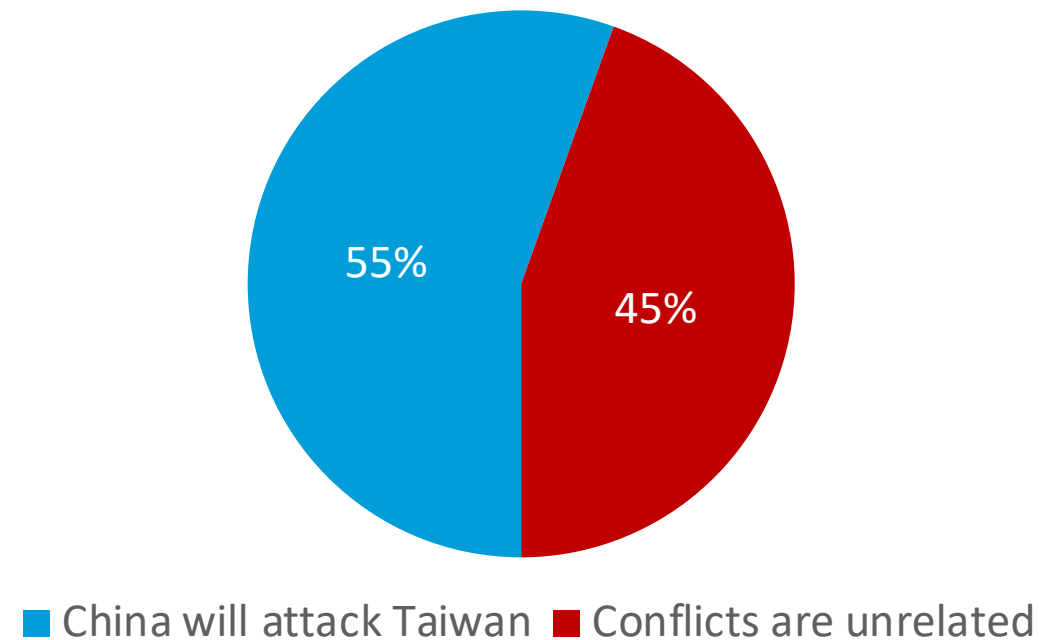

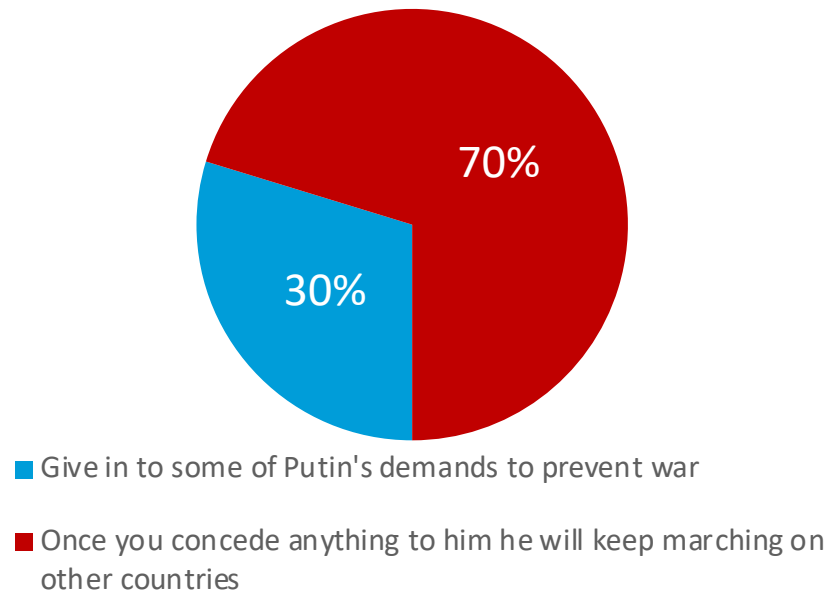

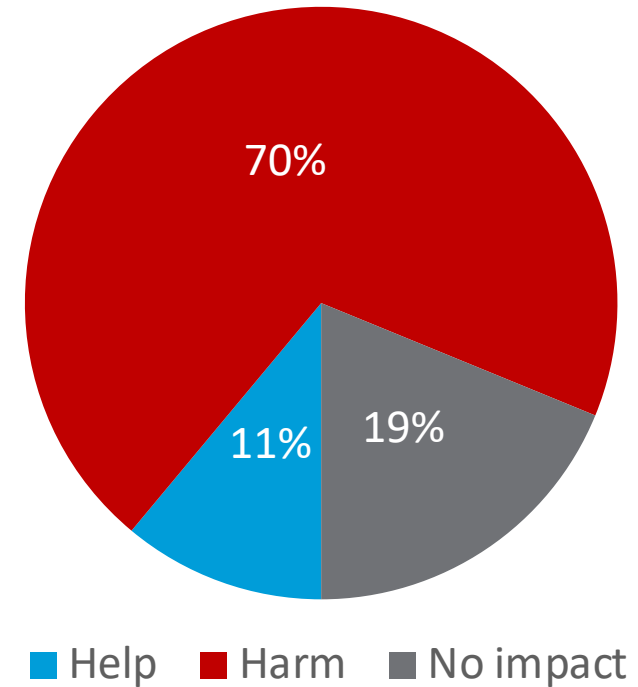

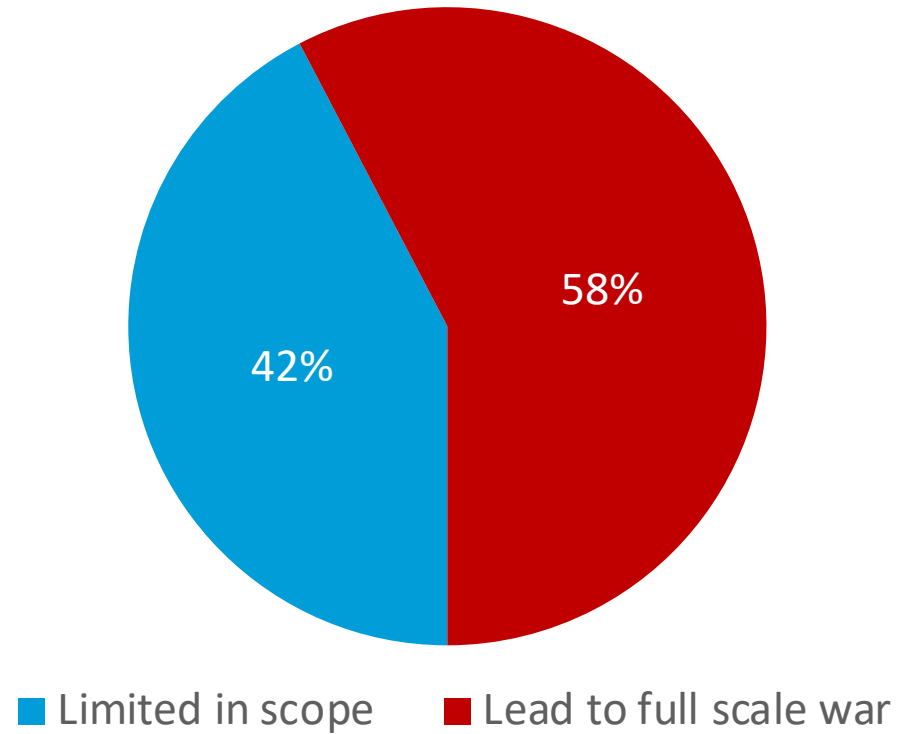

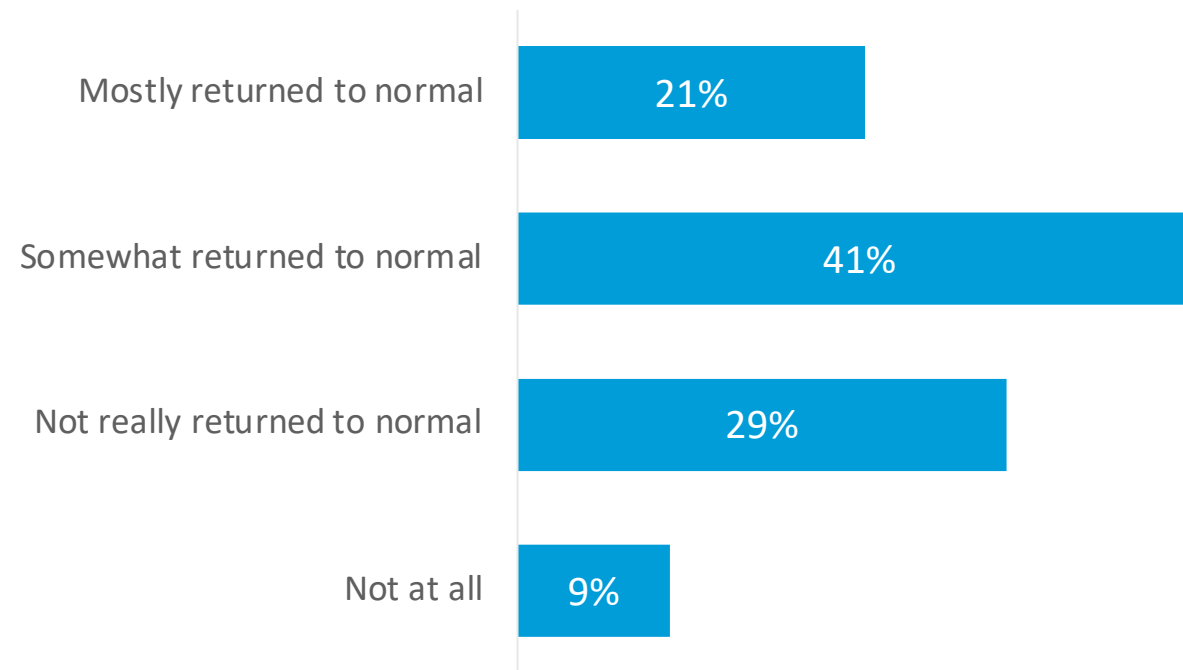

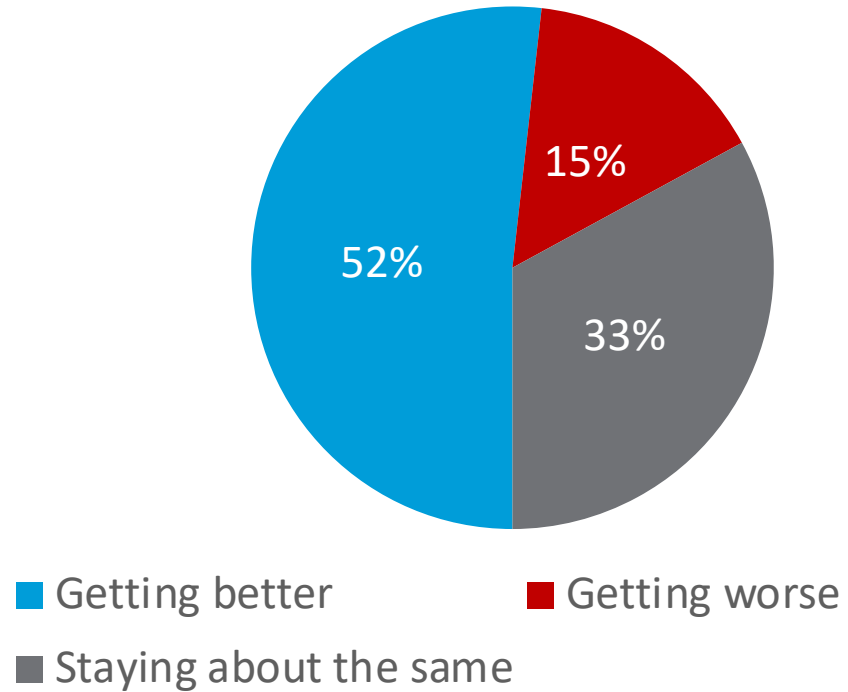

In general, how much do you think your life has returned to normal since the start of the pandemic?

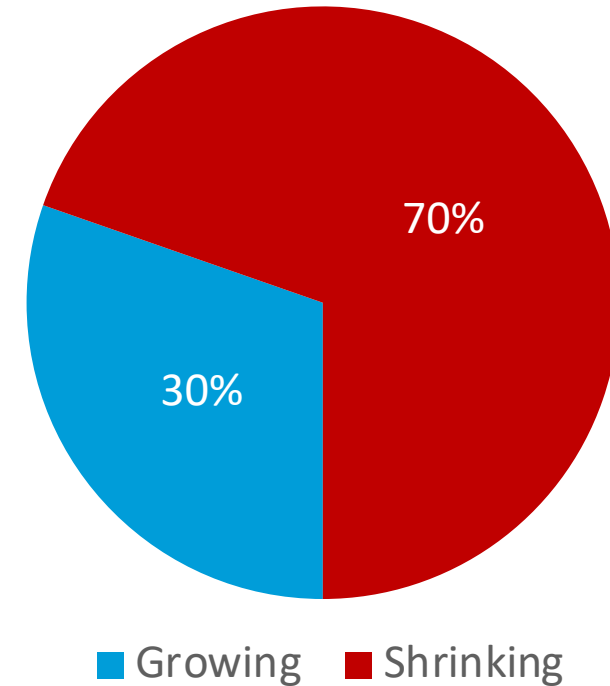

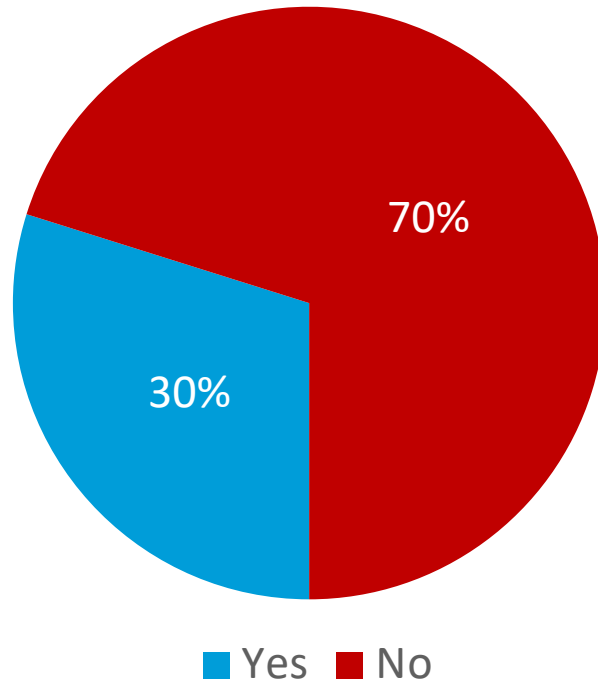

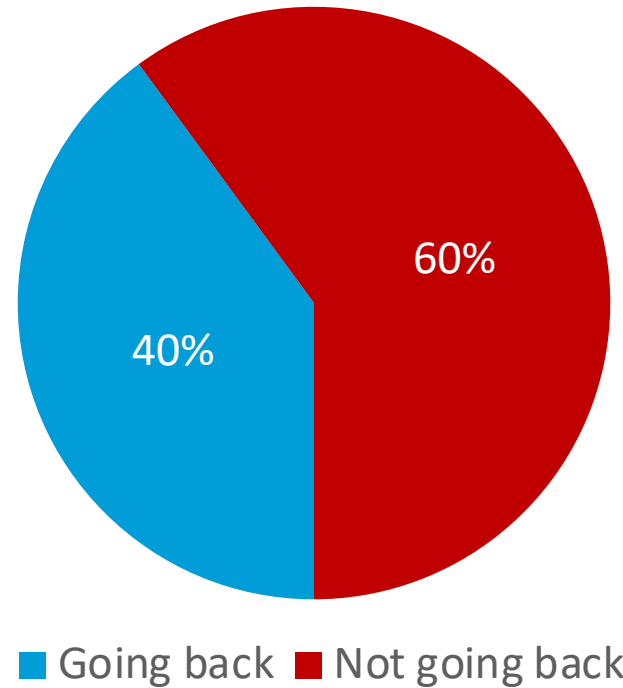

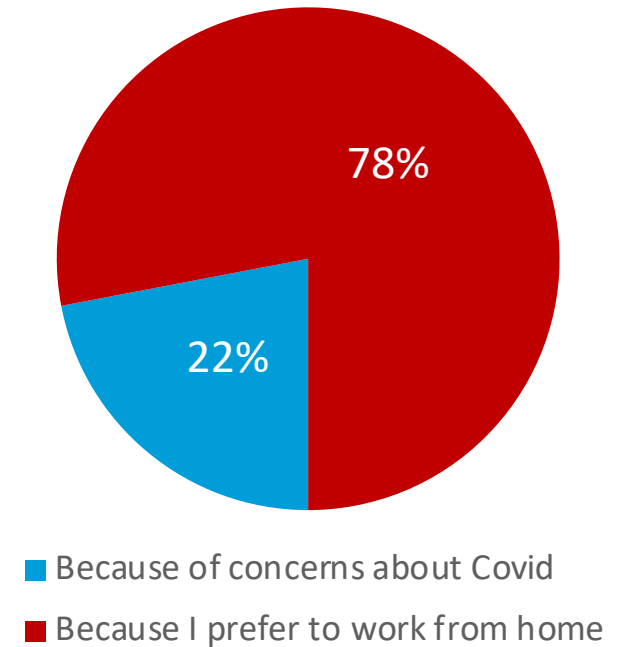

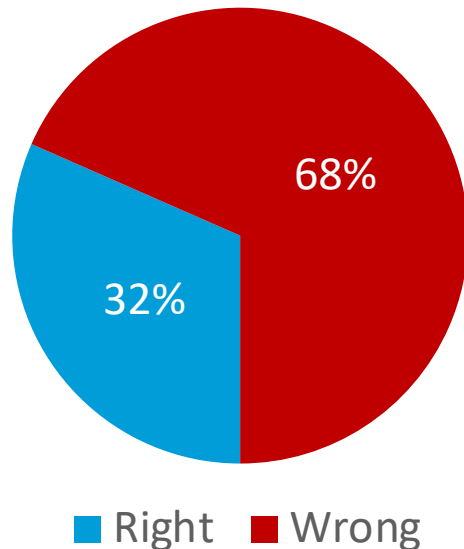

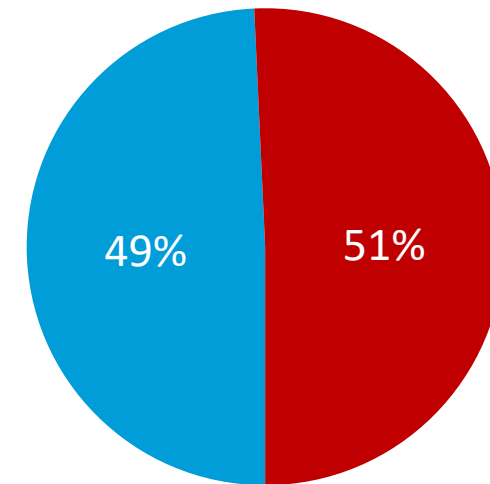

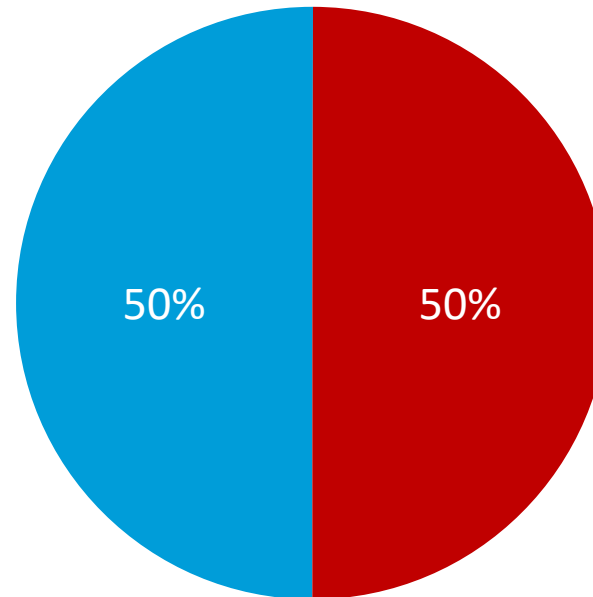

Do you think Democratic states have done a better job controlling Covid and keeping the economy open or that Republican states have done a better job of controlling Covid while keeping the economy open?

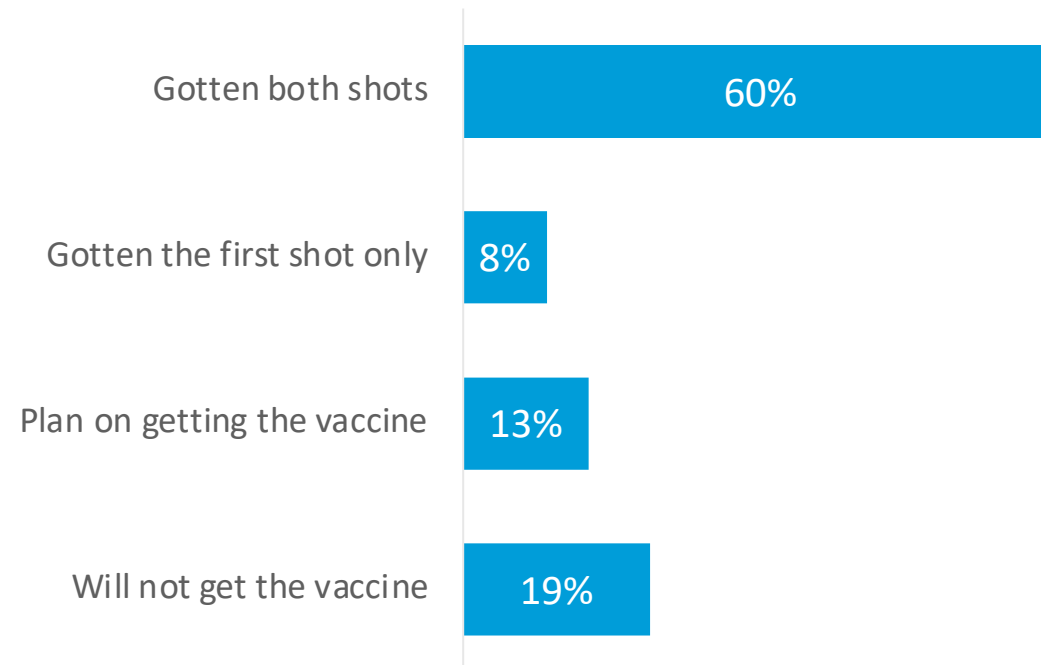

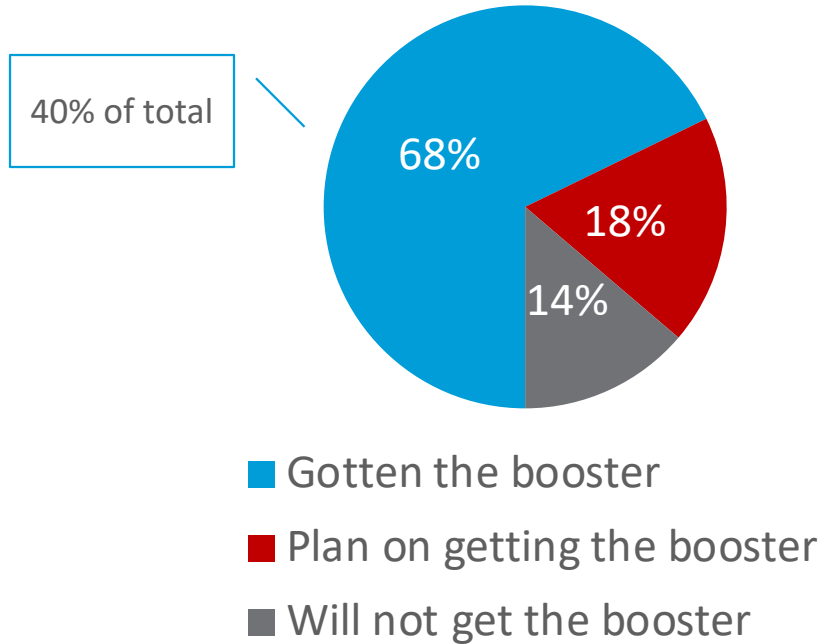

Have you gotten the Covid vaccine, plan on getting the vaccine or will not get the vaccine?

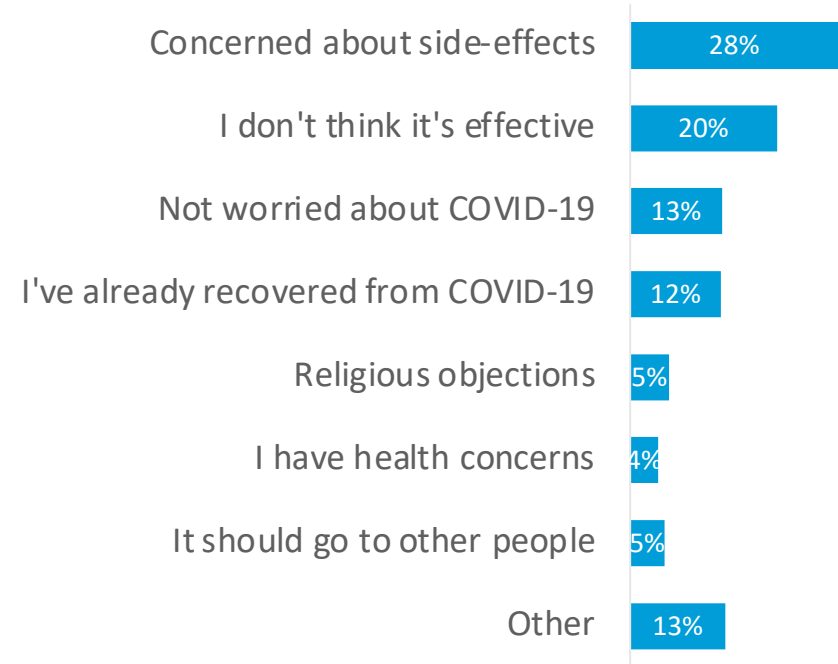


FORTY PERCENT OF VOTERS ARE BOOSTED
