SURVEY METHOD

This survey was conducted online within the United States from **Field Dates: January 19-20, 2022** among **1,815 registered voters** by The Harris Poll.

Results were weighted for age within gender, region, race/ethnicity, marital status, household size, income, employment, education, political party, and political ideology where necessary to align them with their actual proportions in the population. Propensity score weighting was also used to adjust for respondents' propensity to be online.

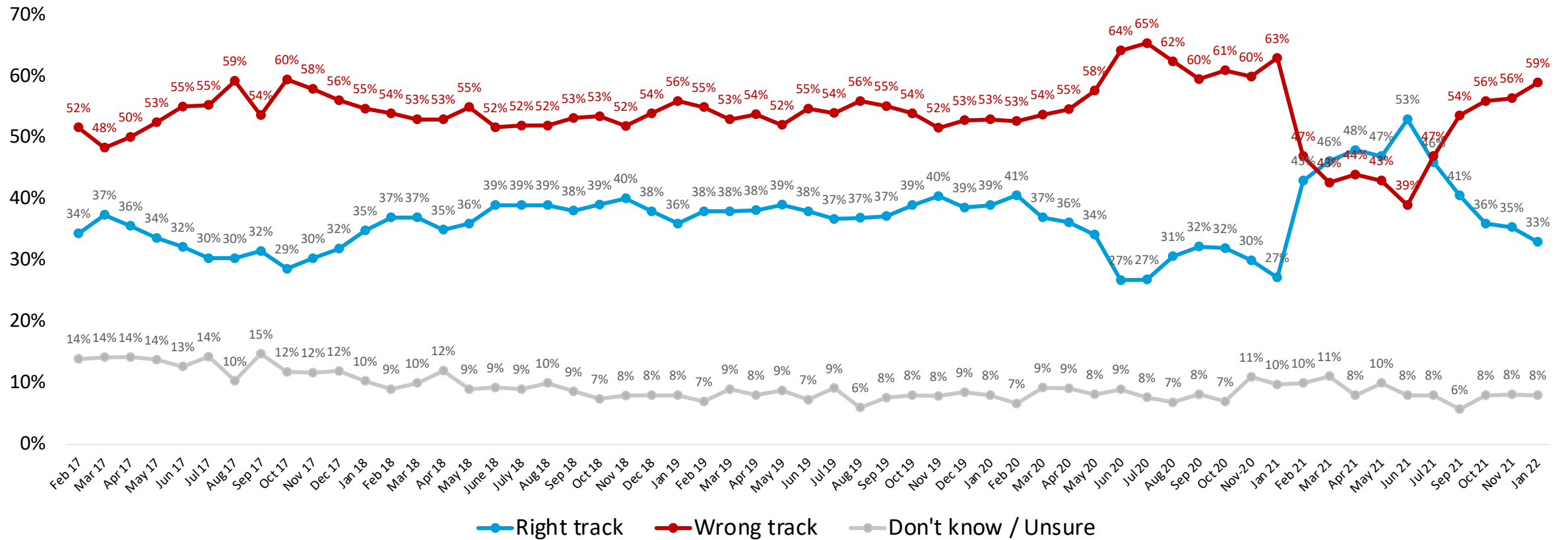

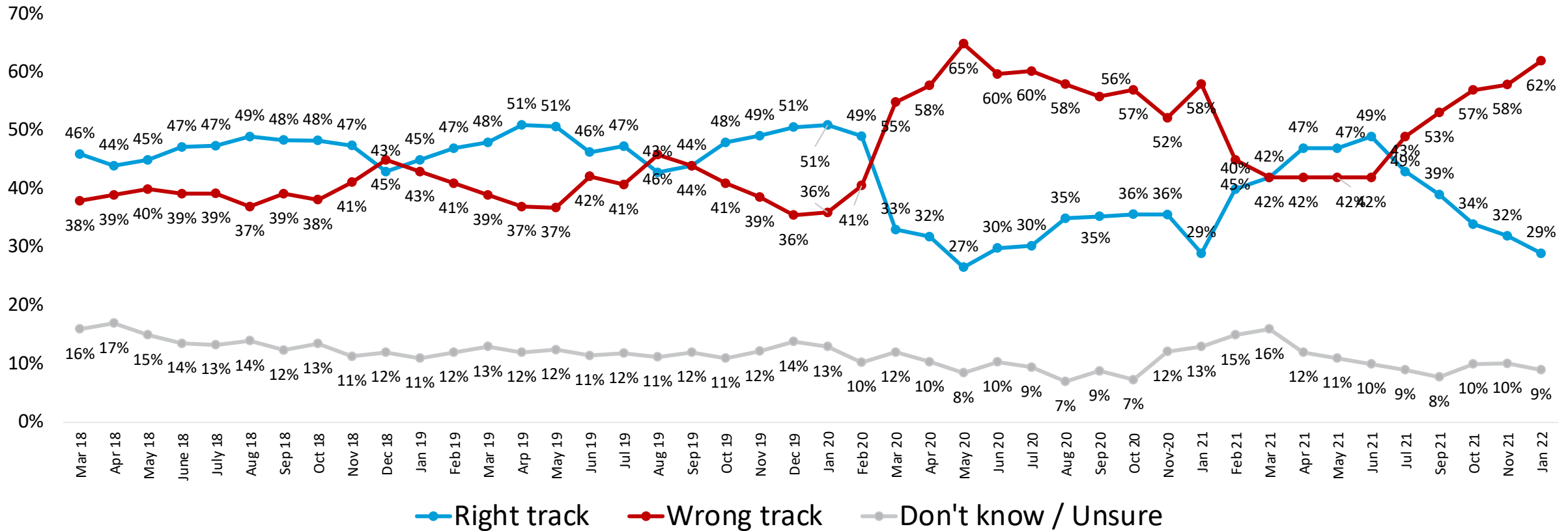

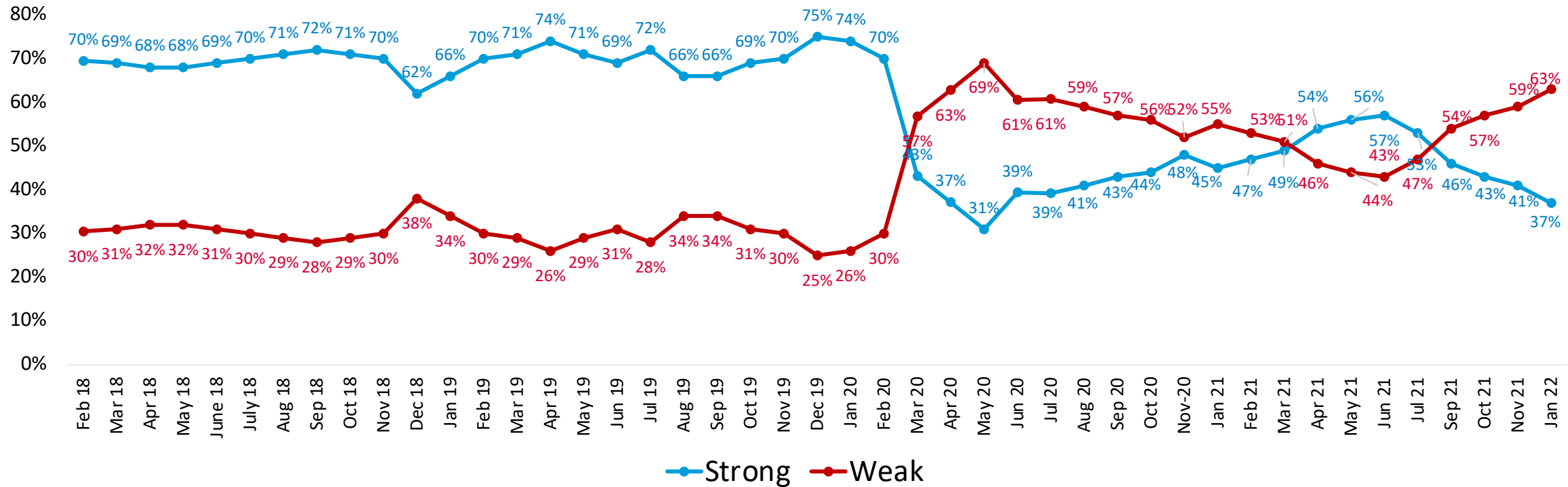

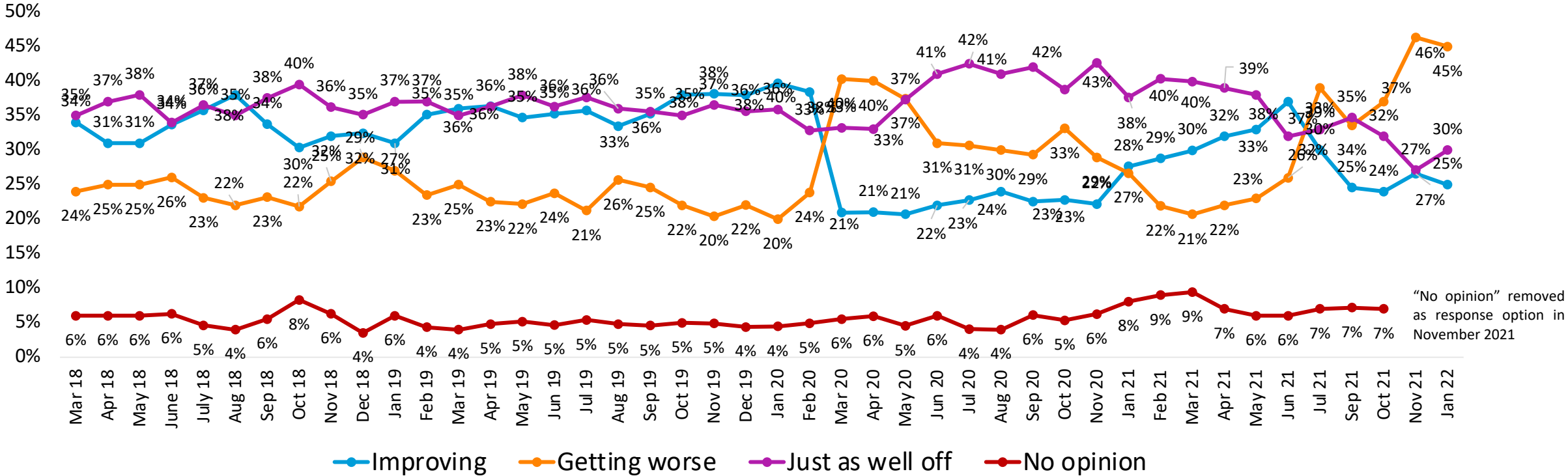
TWO-THIRDS OF AMERICANS TODAY VIEW THE ECONOMY AS BEING WEAK

How strong do you think the U.S. economy is today?



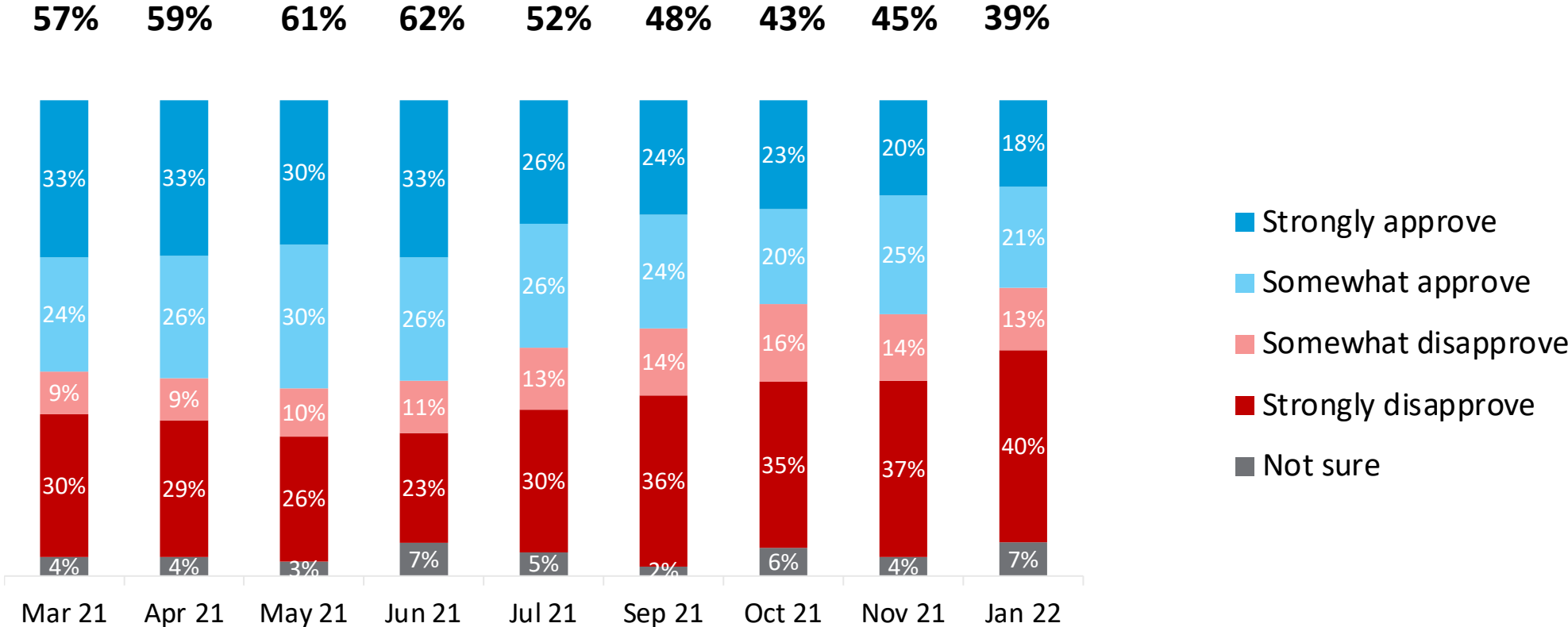

President Biden Overall Approval



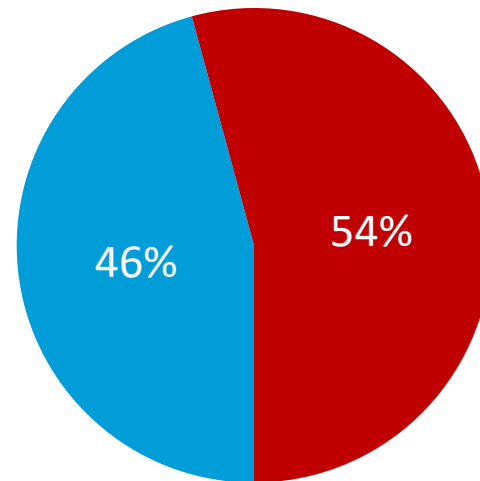

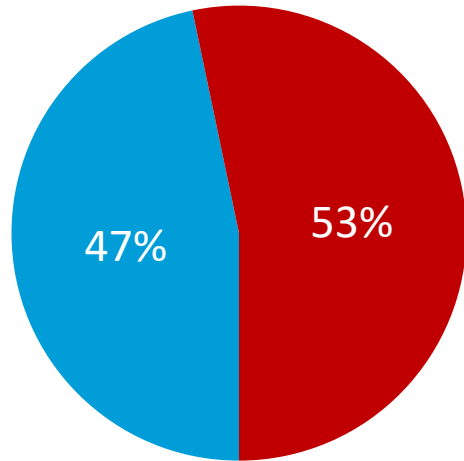

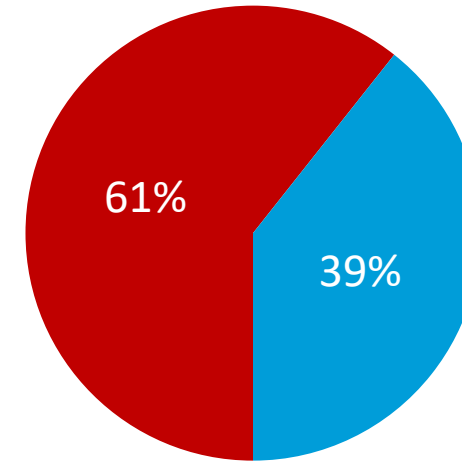

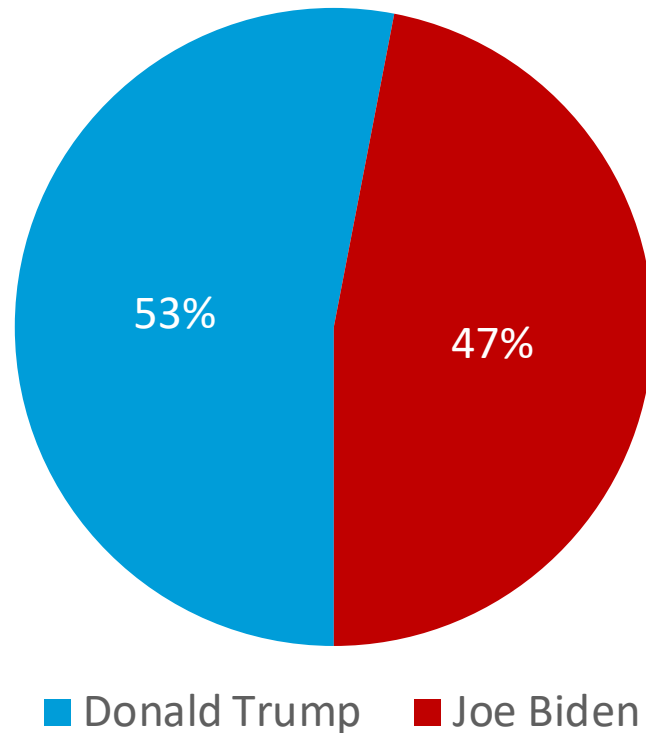

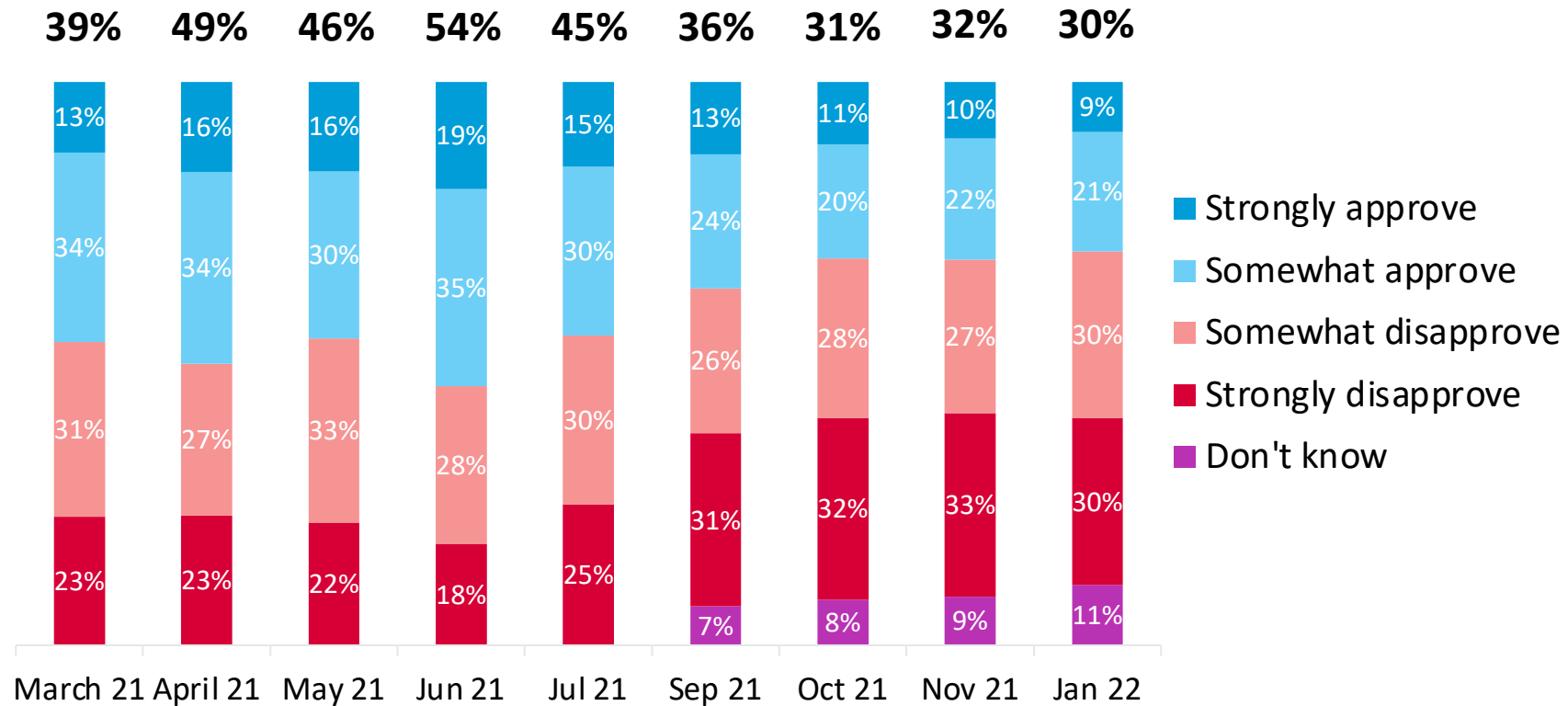

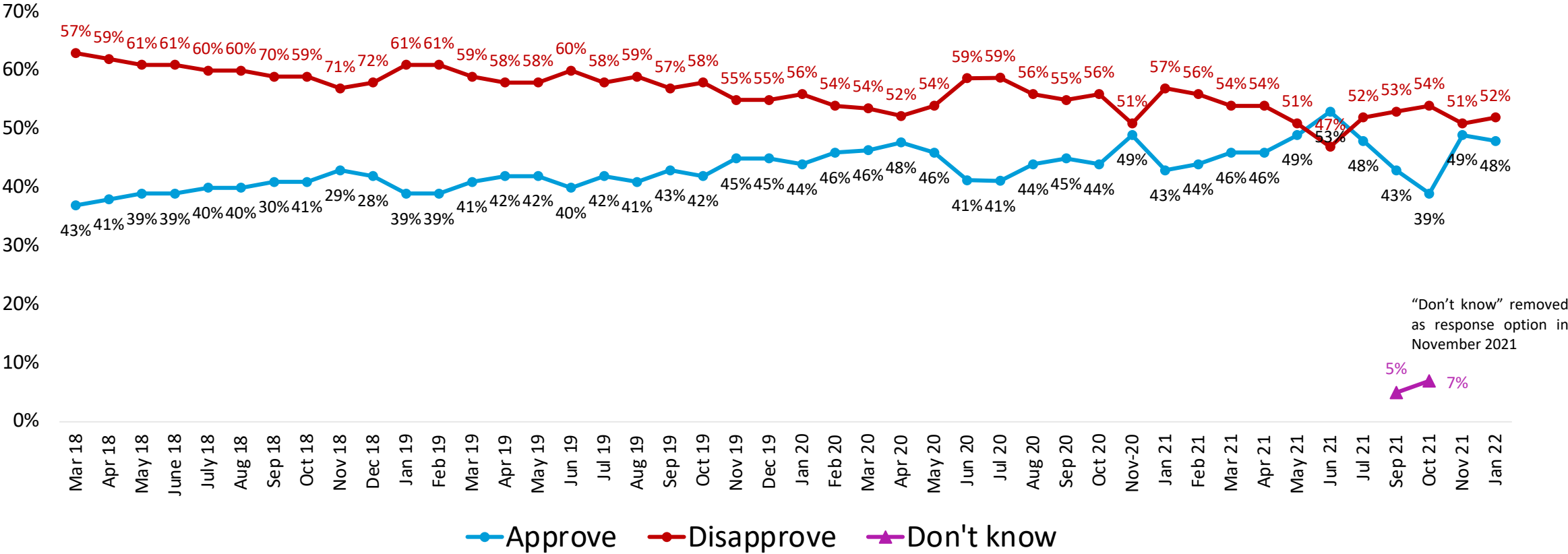

Do you approve or disapprove of the way Congress is doing its job?



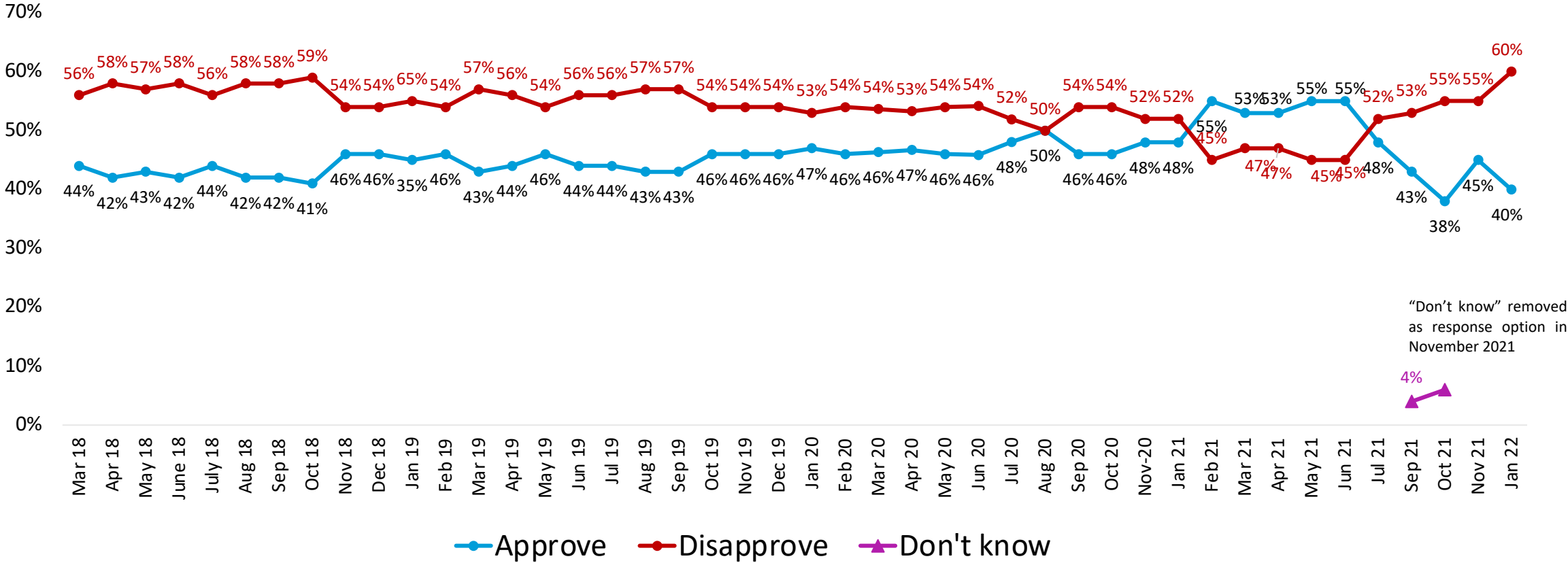

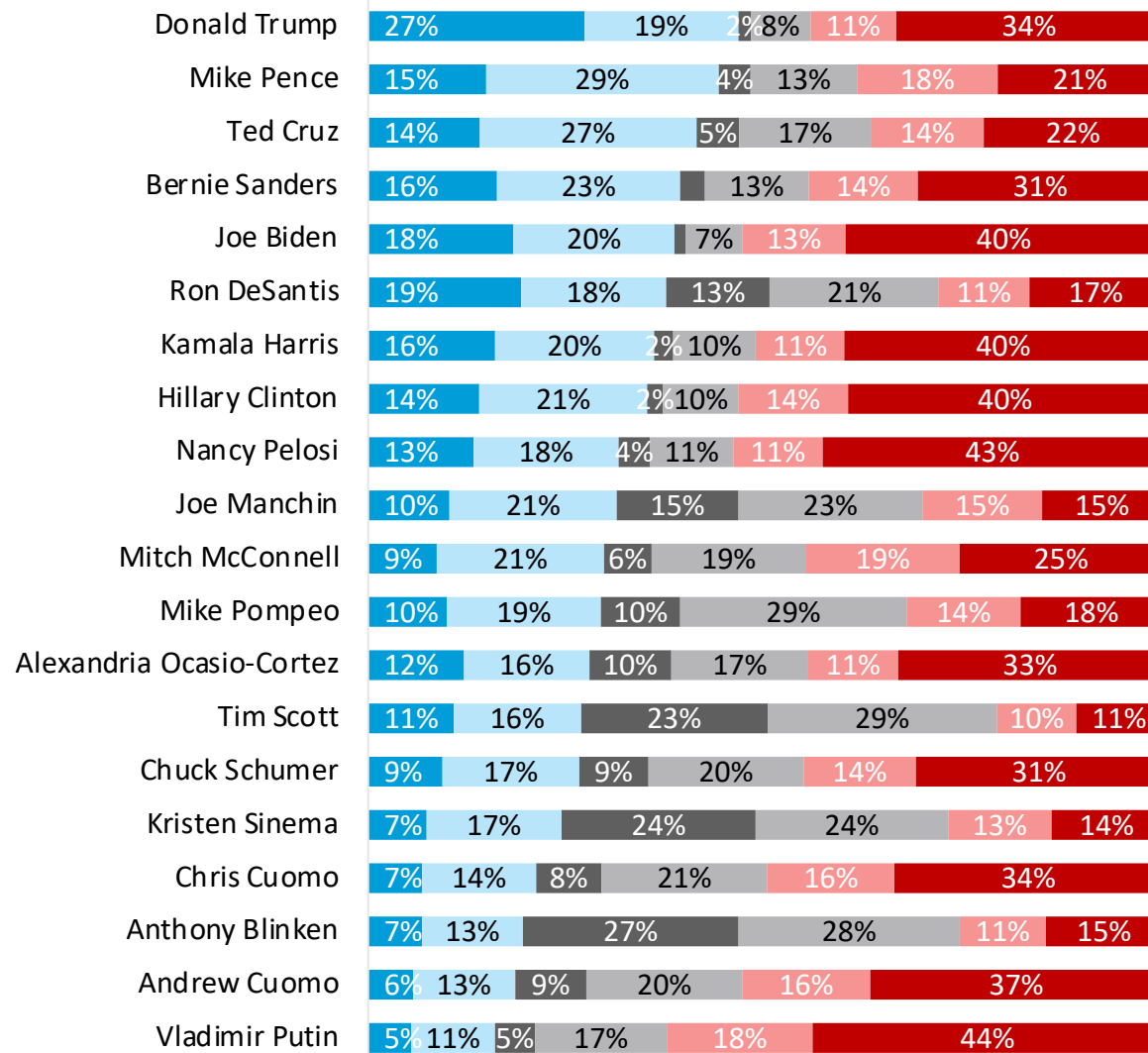

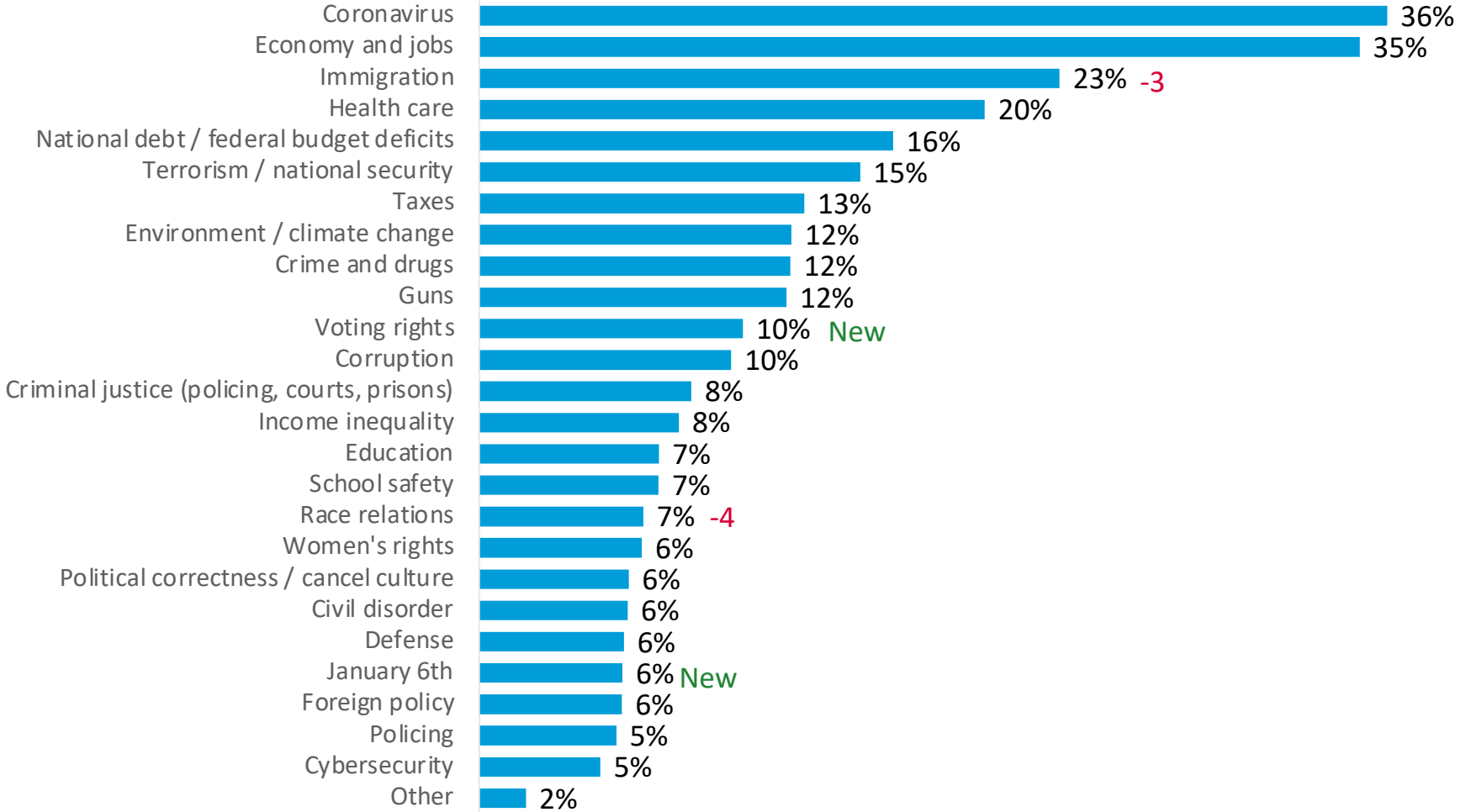

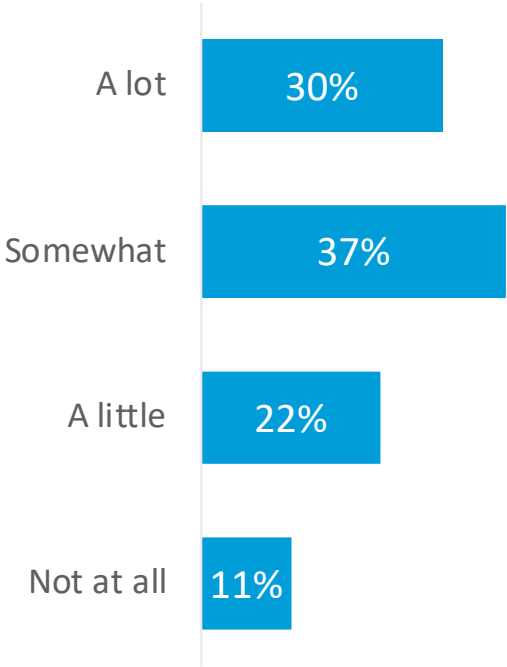
JOBS AND COVID REMAIN THE TOP ISSUES FACING THE NATION

What would you say are the most important issues facing the country today? Please select three.

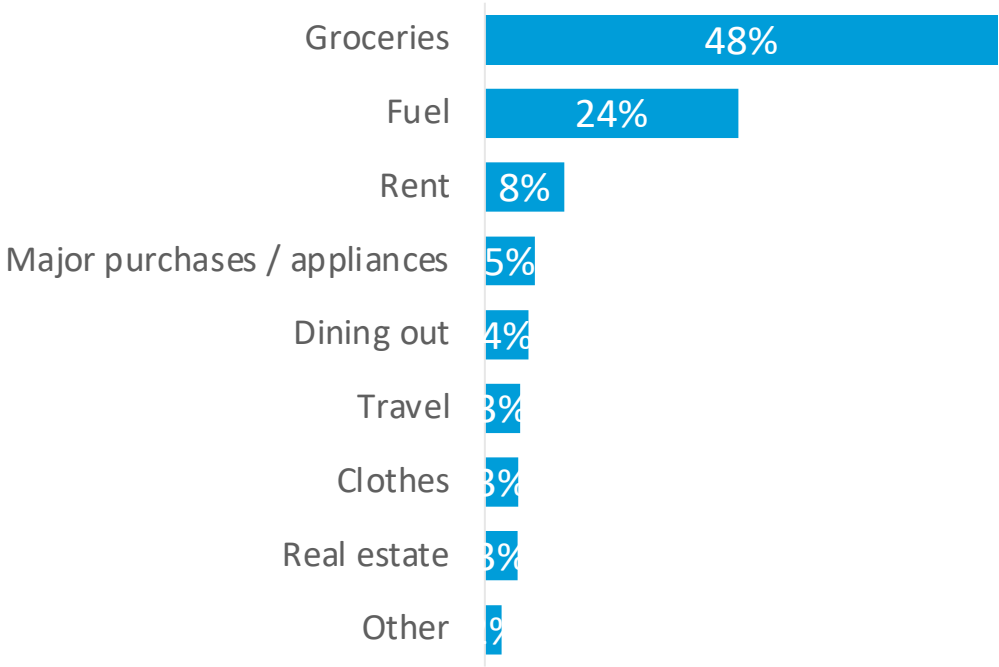

Which impacts of inflation/rising prices have you felt the most, if any?

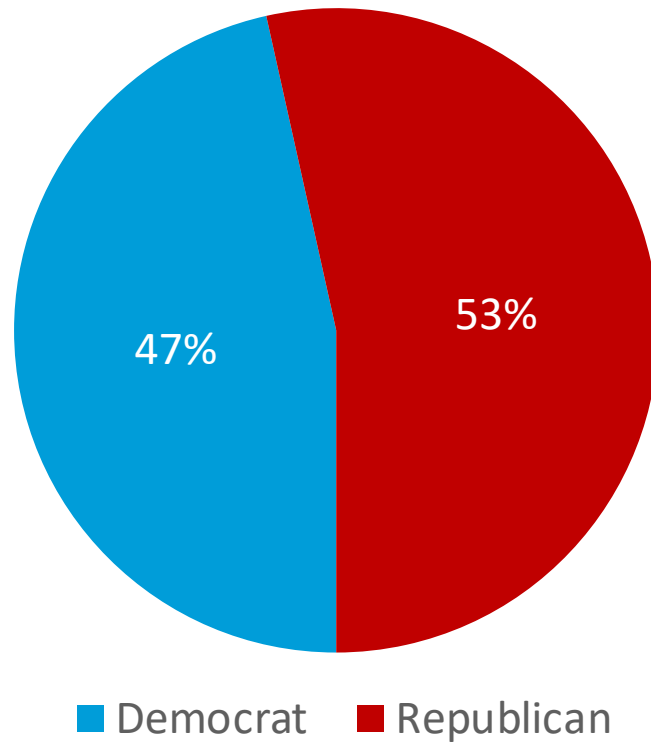

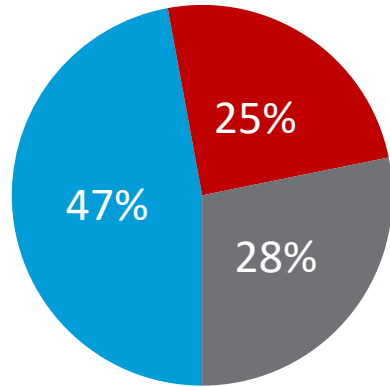

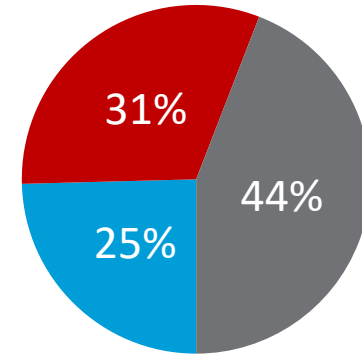

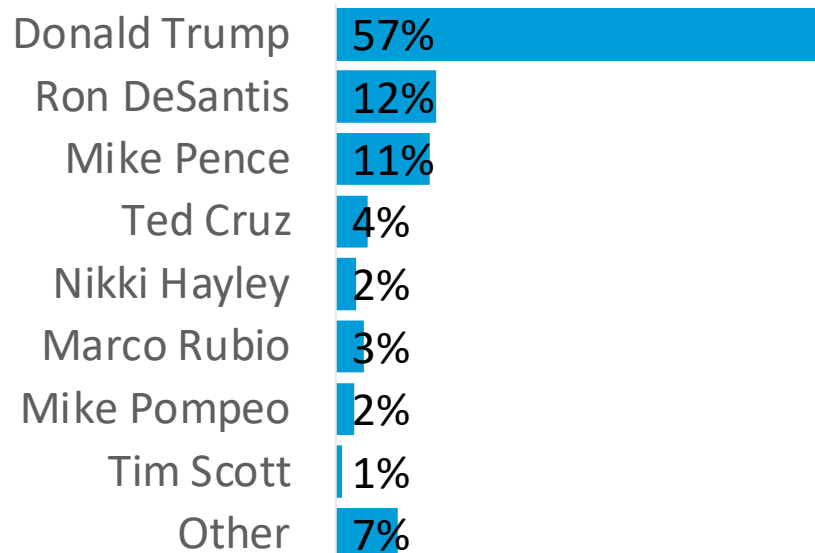

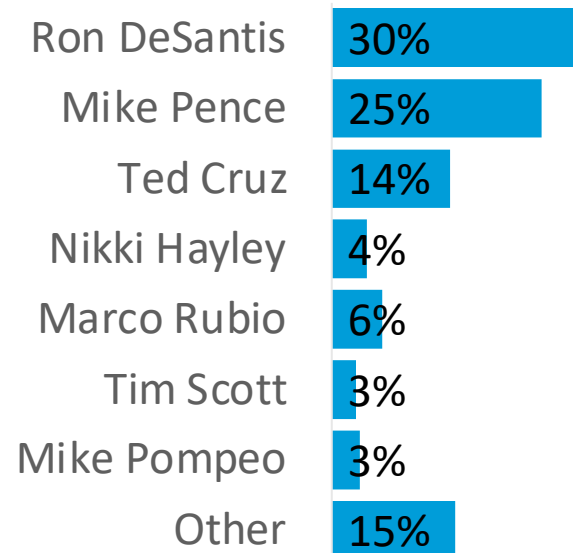

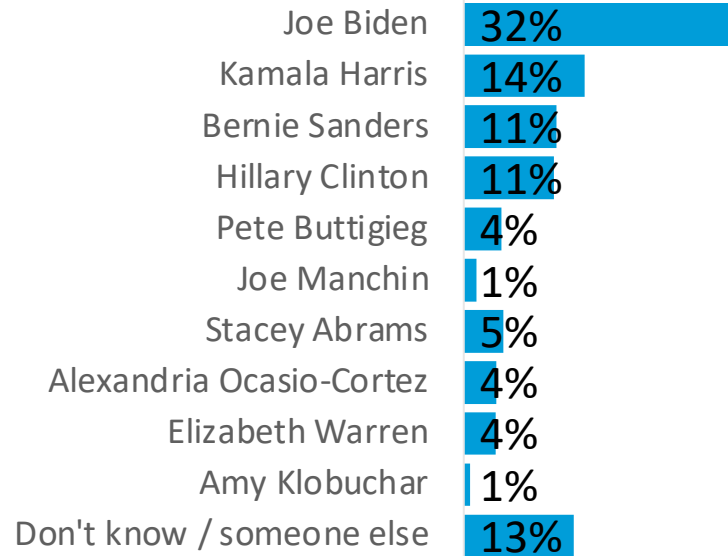

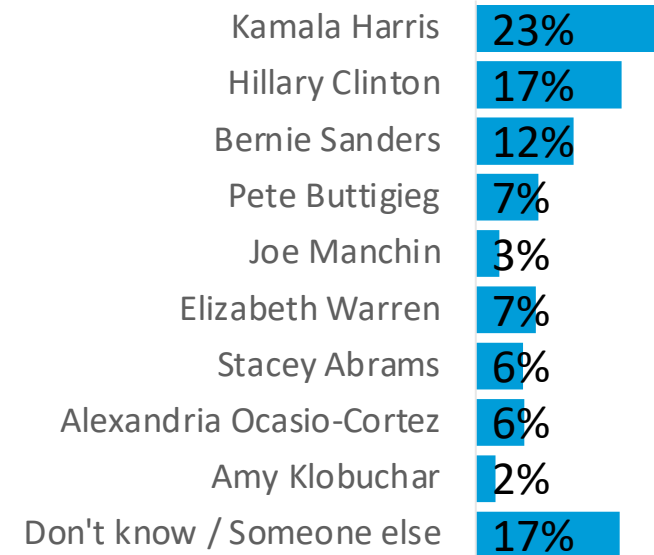

If the Democratic presidential primary for the 2024 election was held today, who would you vote for? (DEM Only)

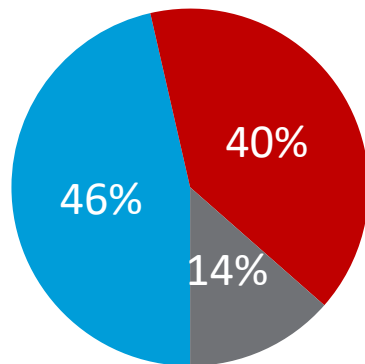


If President Biden decides not to run again in 2024, who would you prefer to be the Democratic candidate? (DEM Only)



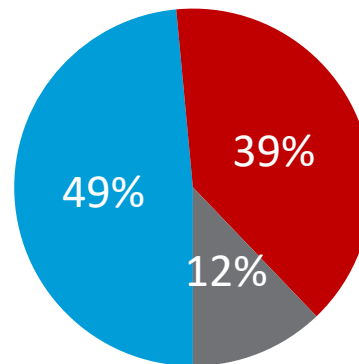

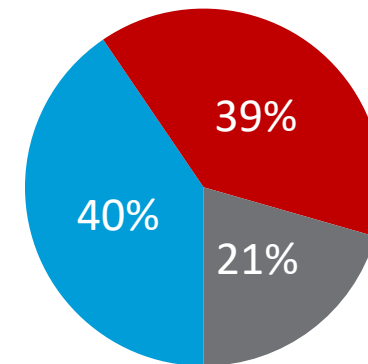

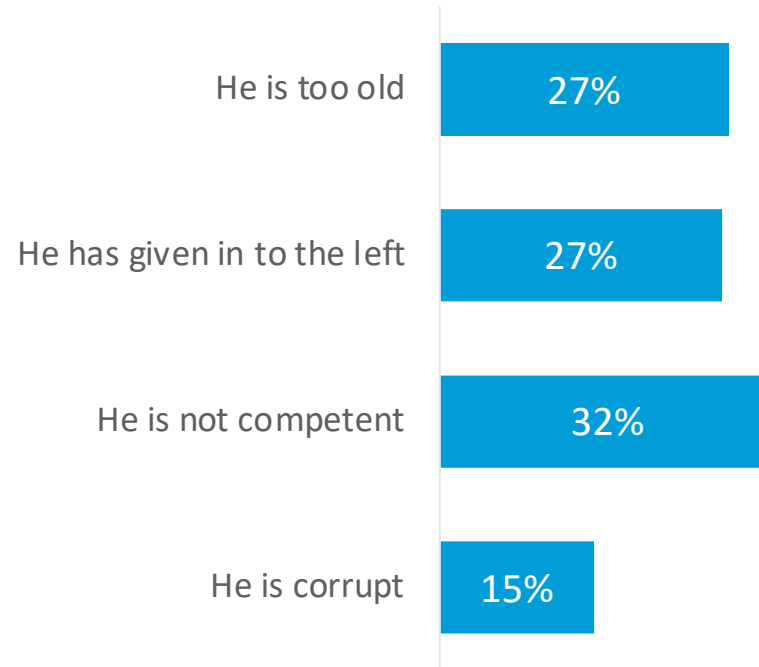

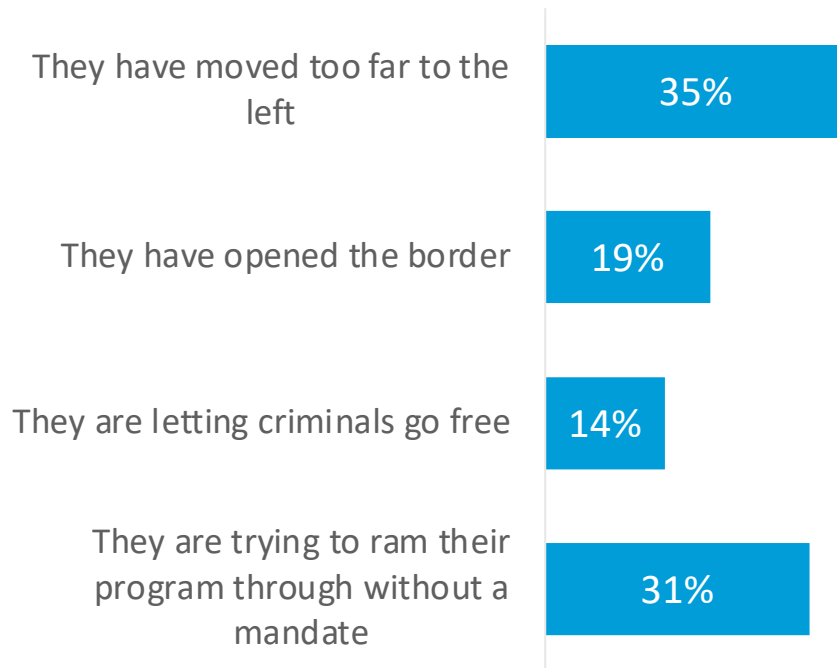

Which of these is your biggest concern about President Biden?

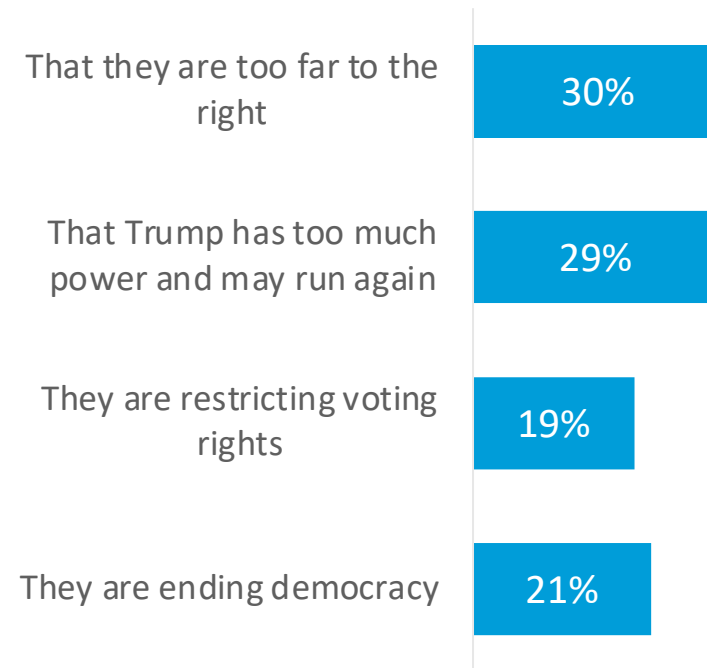


BIGGEST CONCERNS OF PARTIES IS THEY HAVE MOVED TOO FAR LEFT/RIGHT

What is your biggest concern about the Democrats?

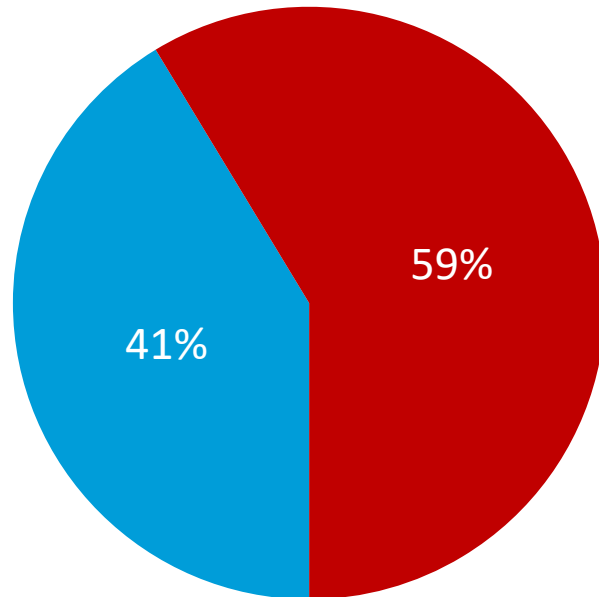

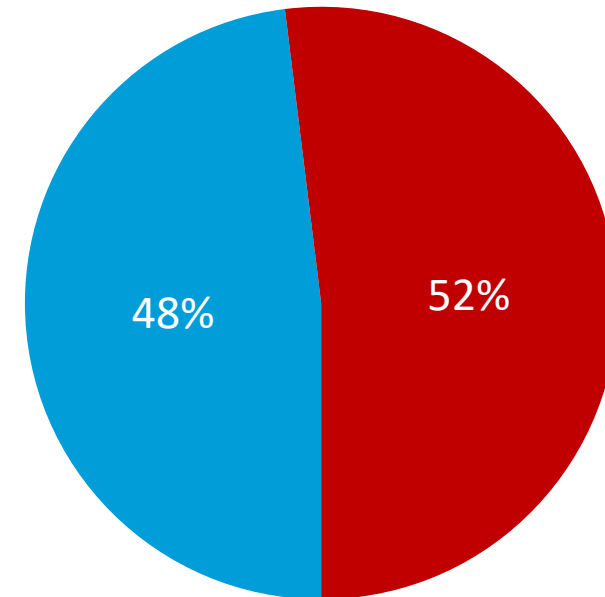

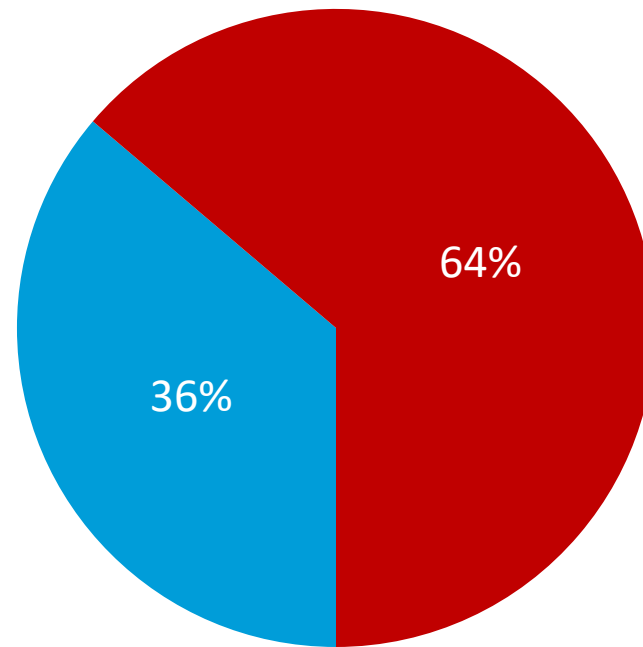

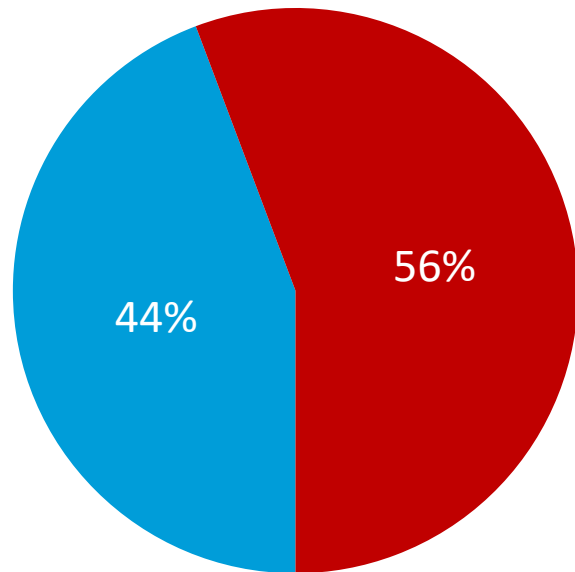

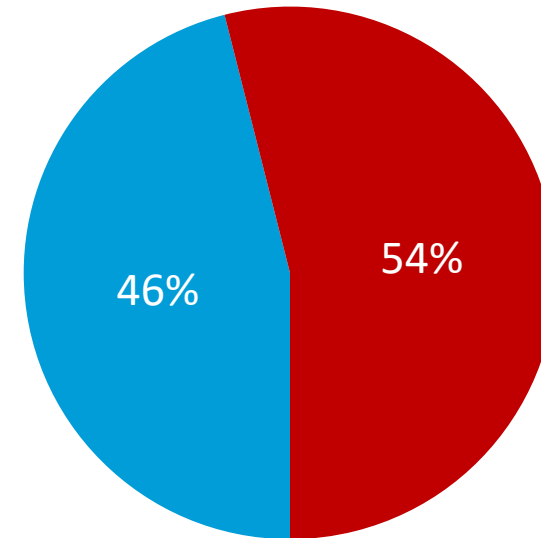

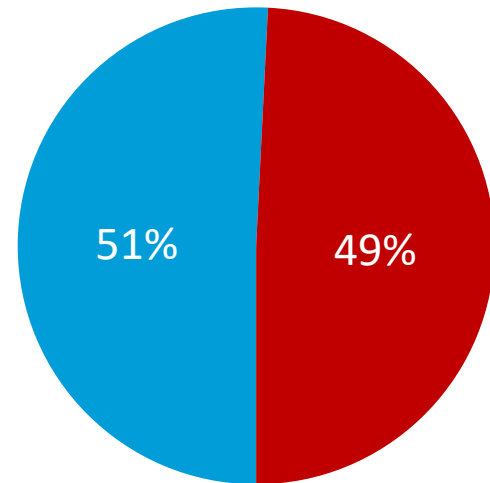

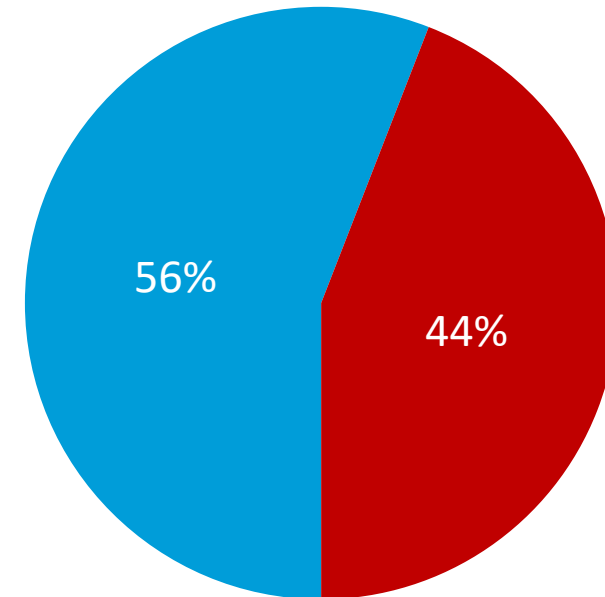

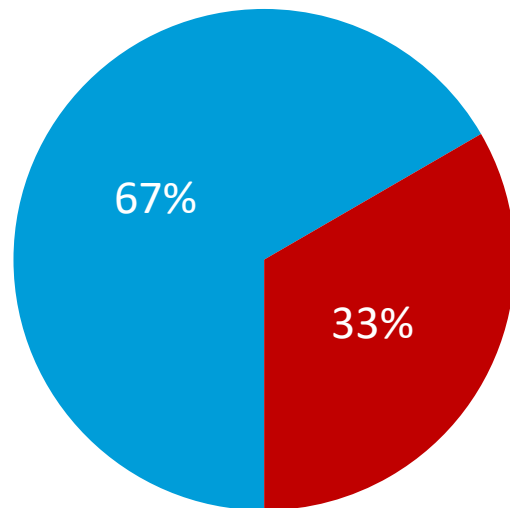

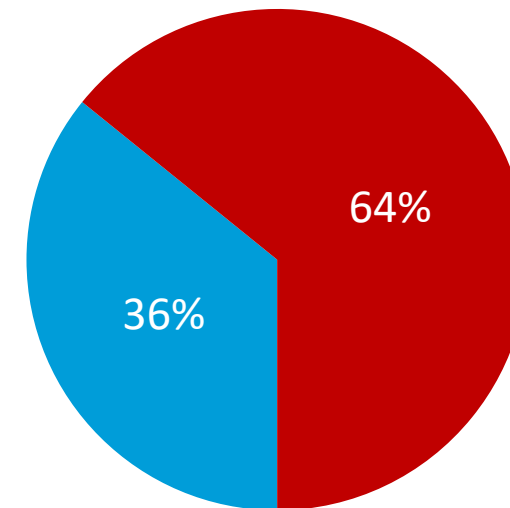

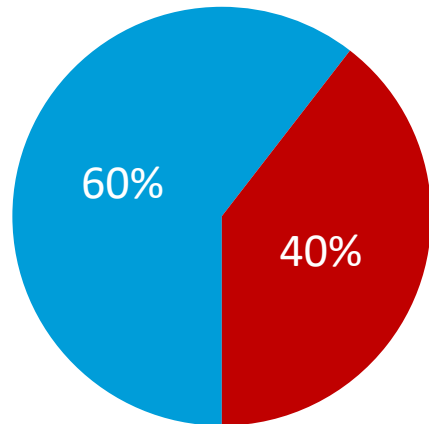

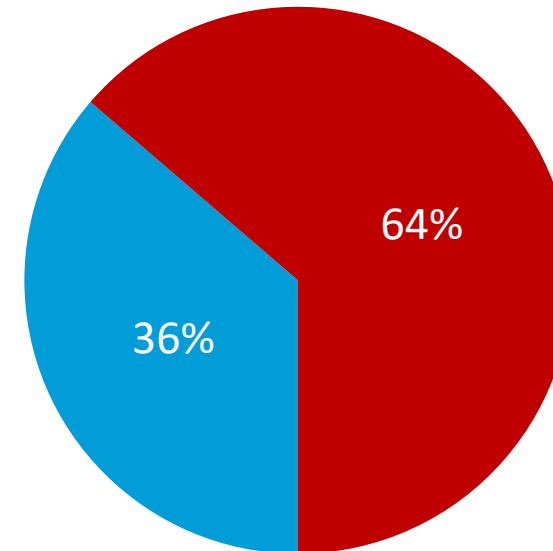

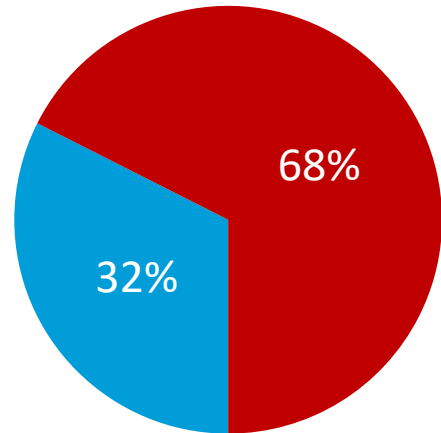

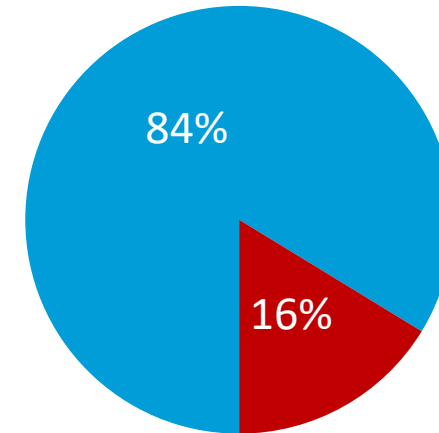

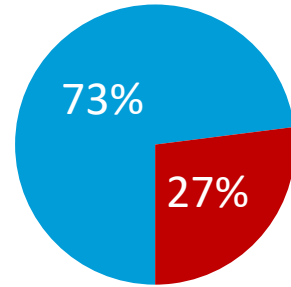

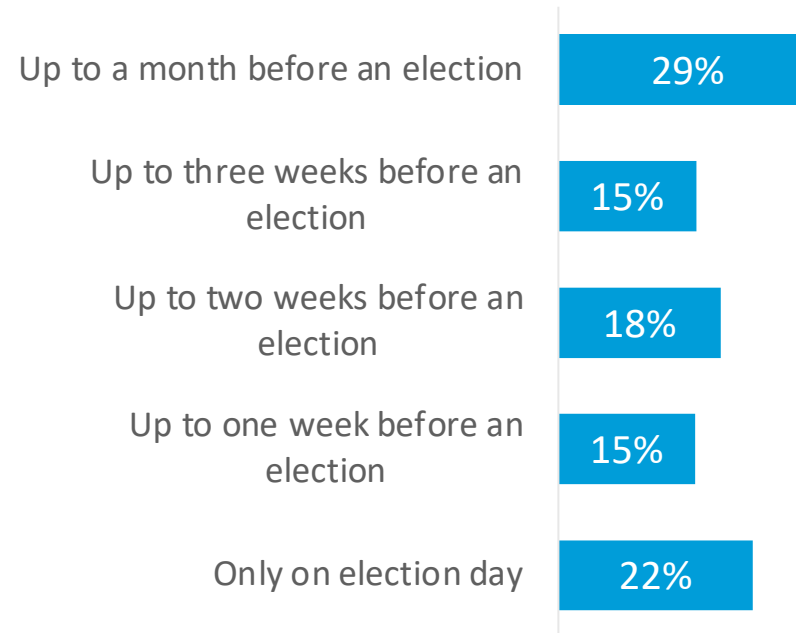

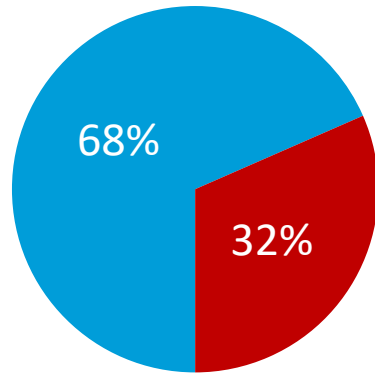

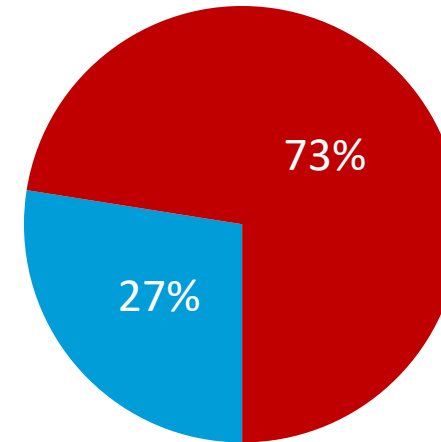

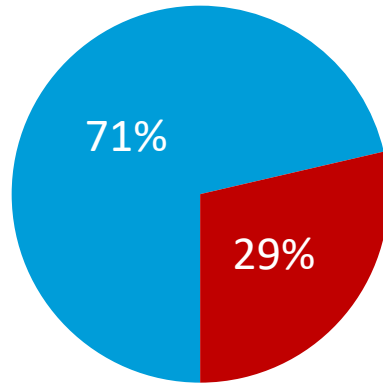

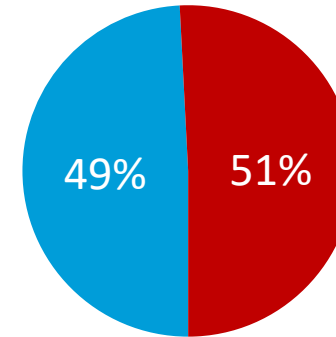

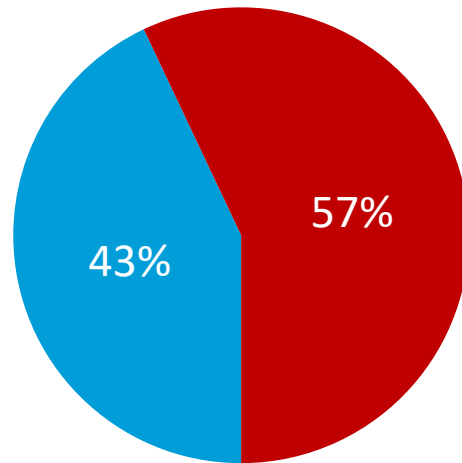

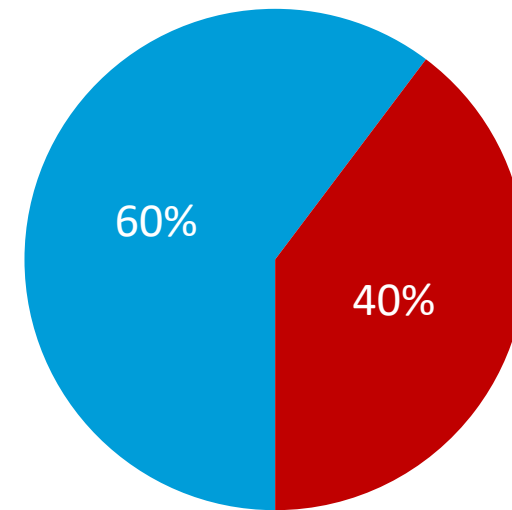

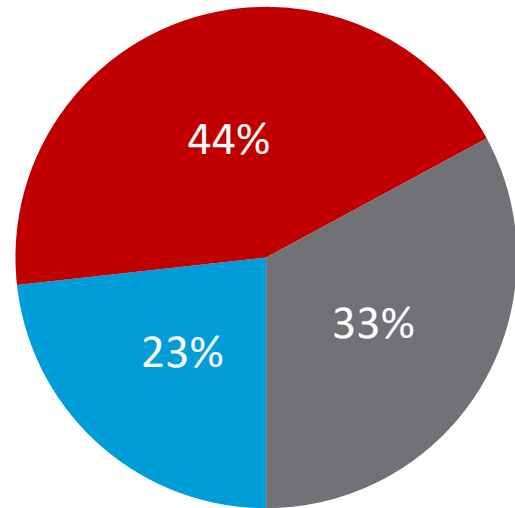

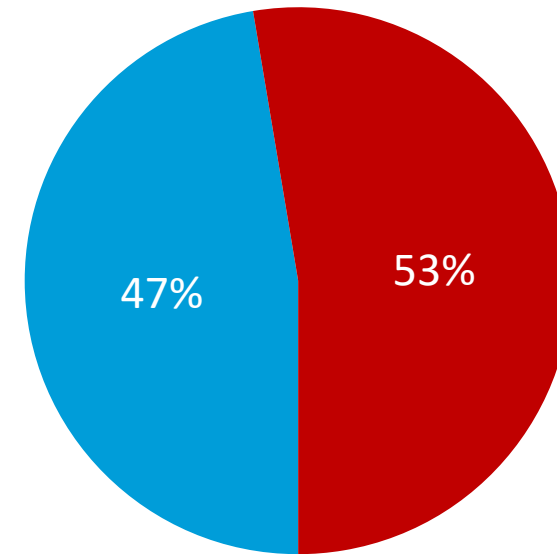

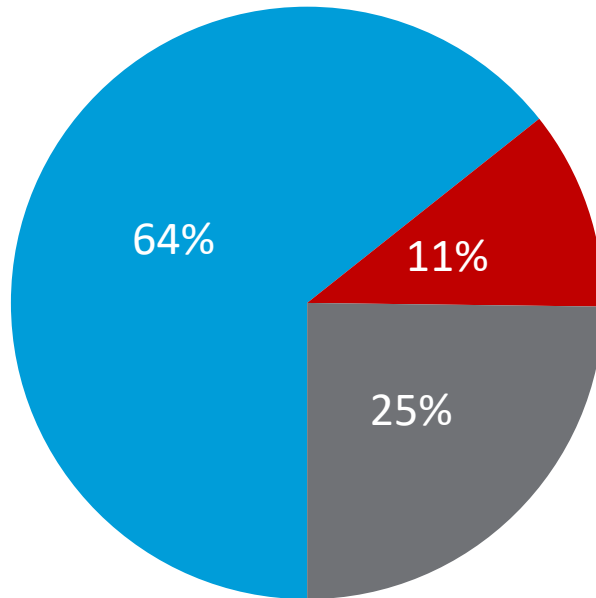

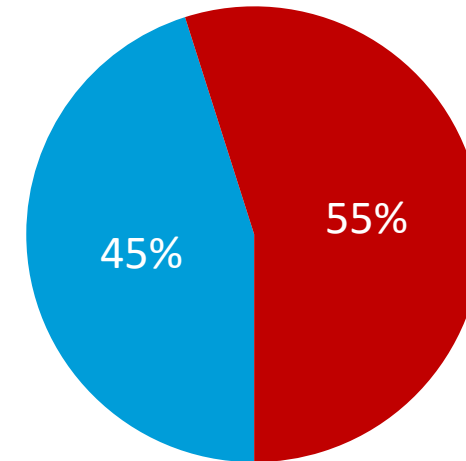

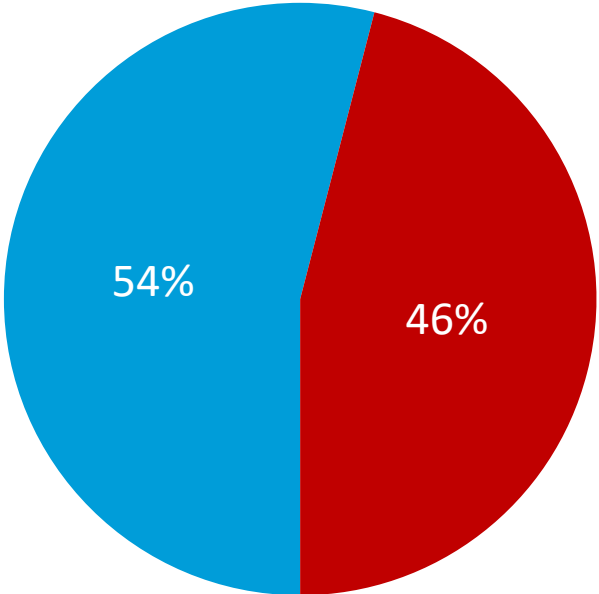

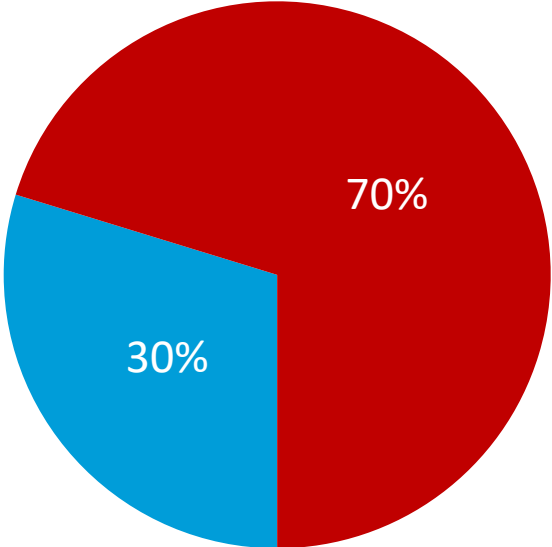

Do you favor or oppose the policy announced by New York District Attorney of no longer prosecuting resisting arrest or armed robbery if no one was hurt?



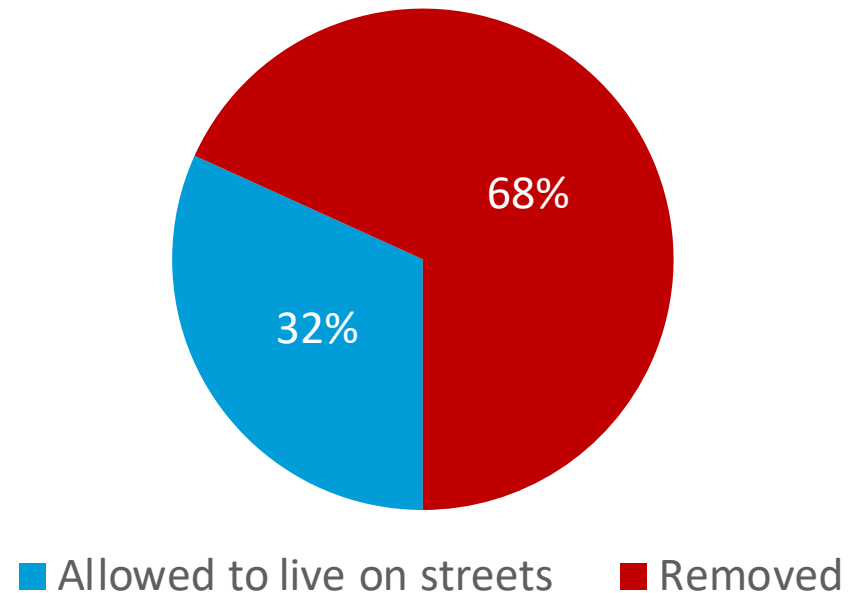

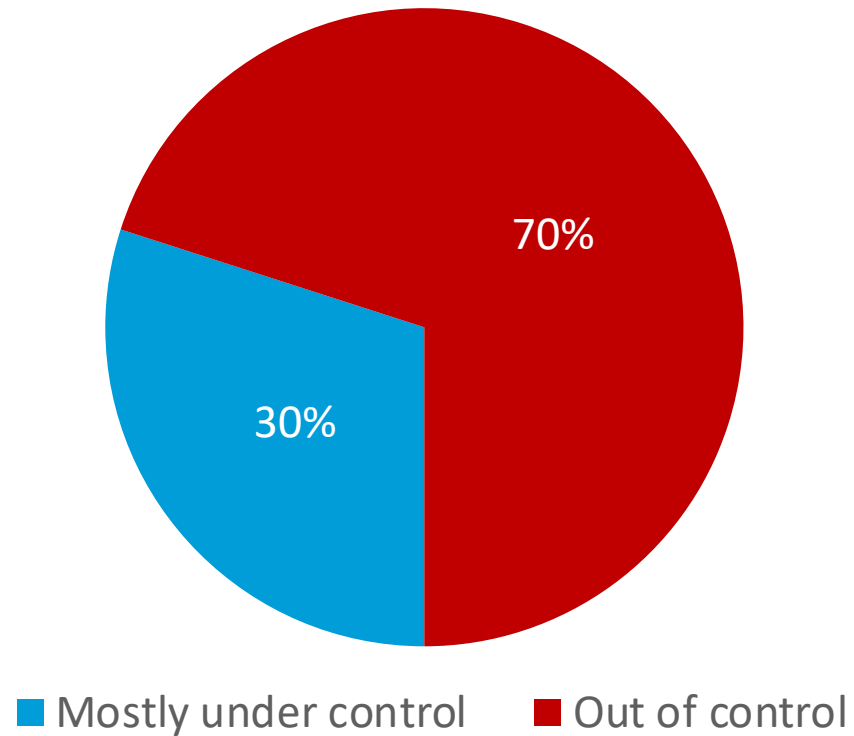

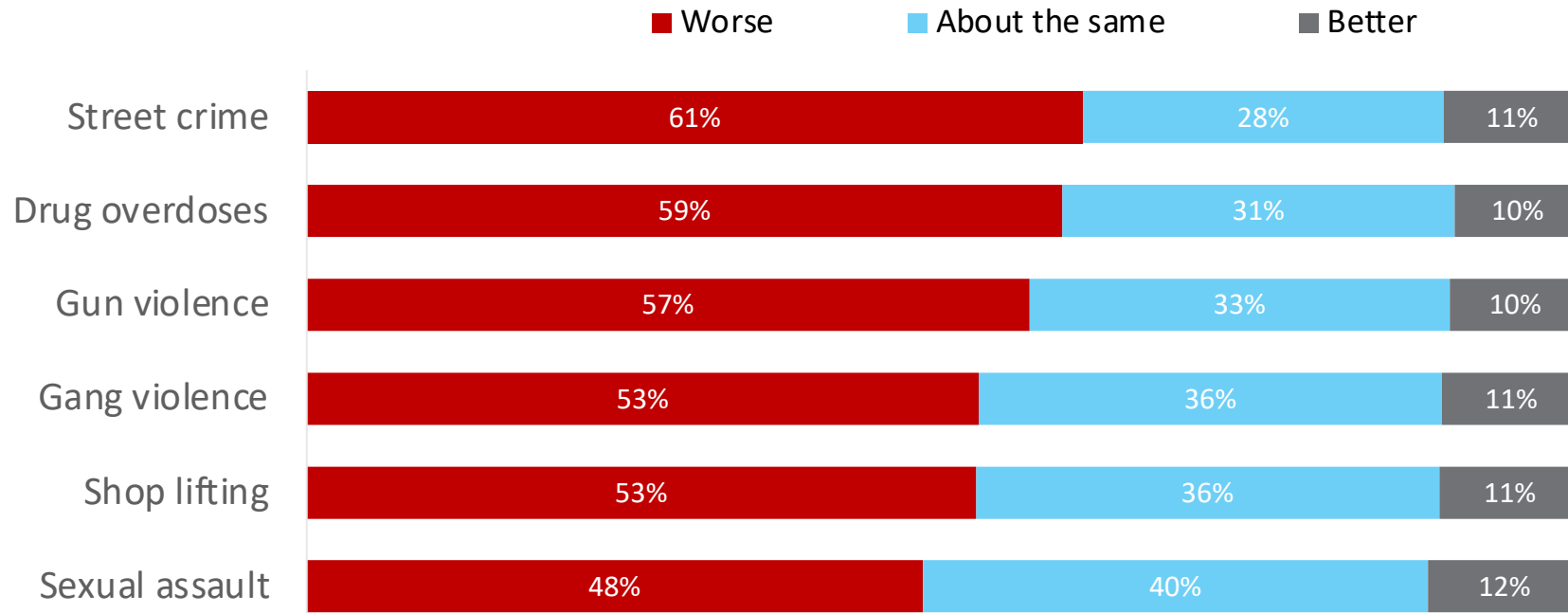

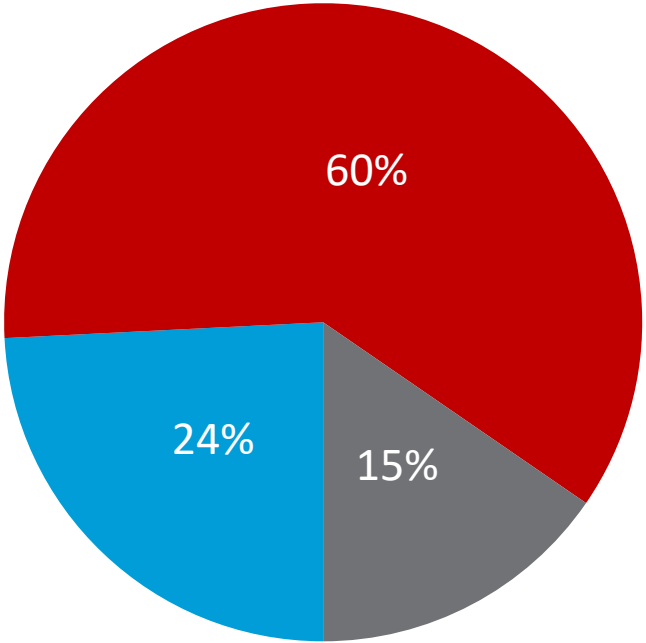

Do you think these issues are getting better or worse throughout the nation?



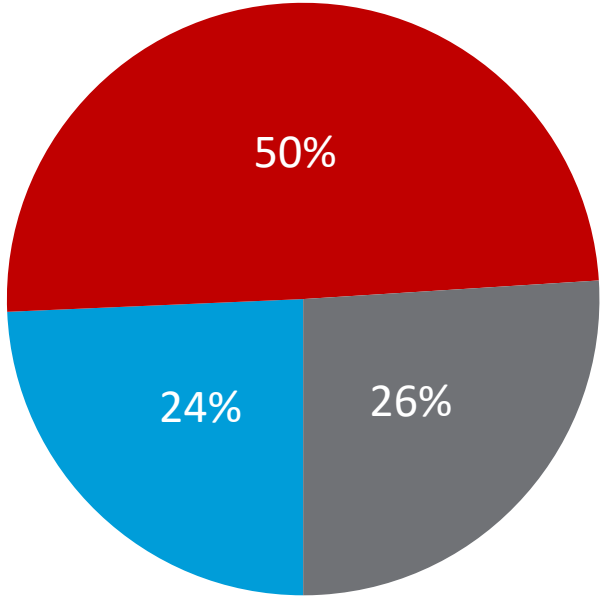

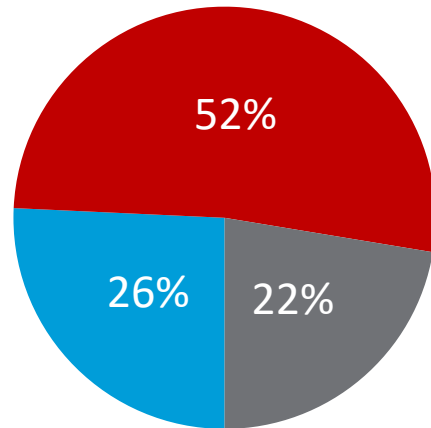

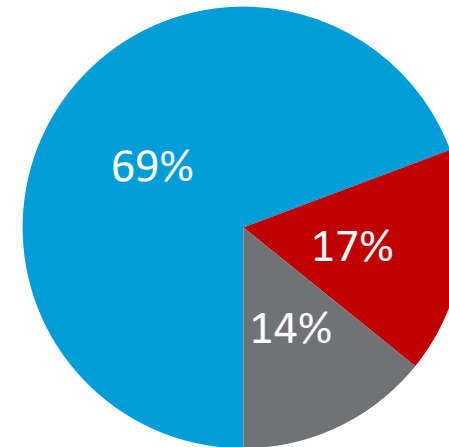

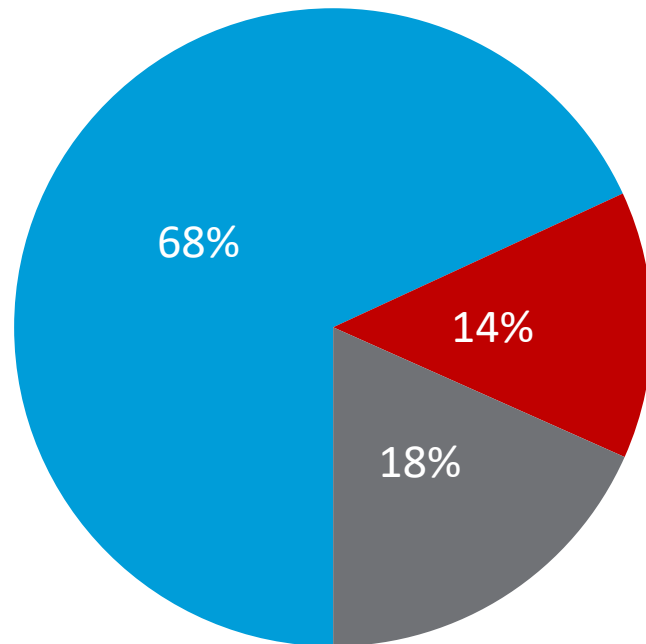

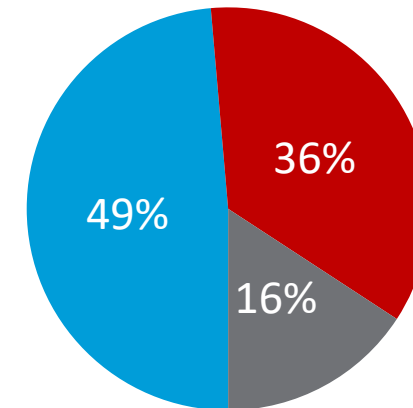

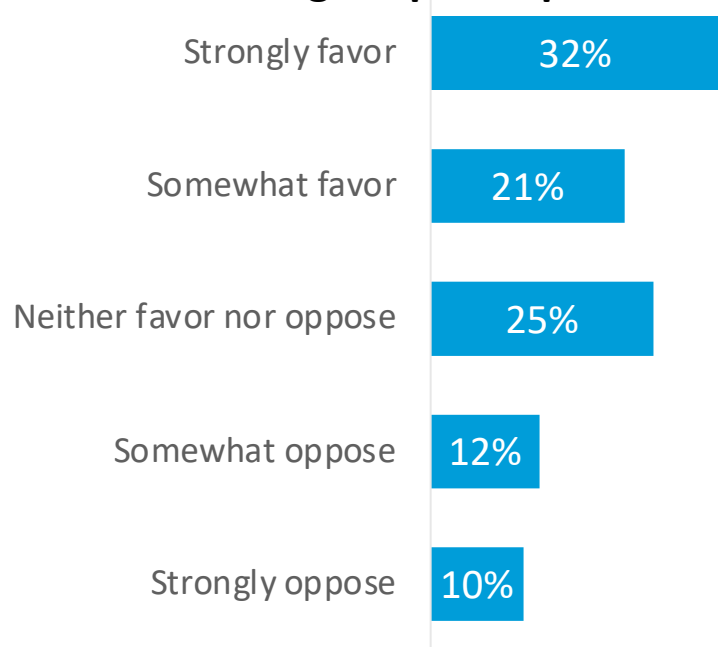

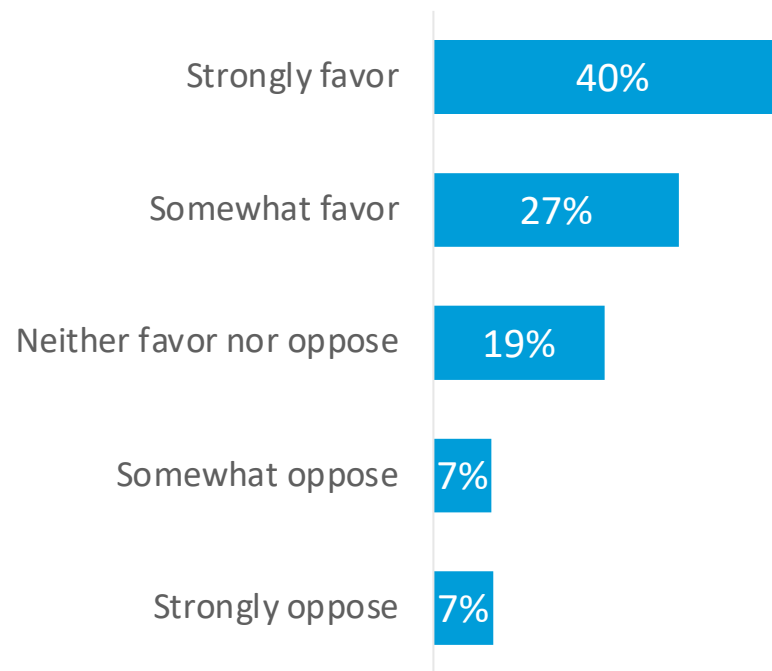

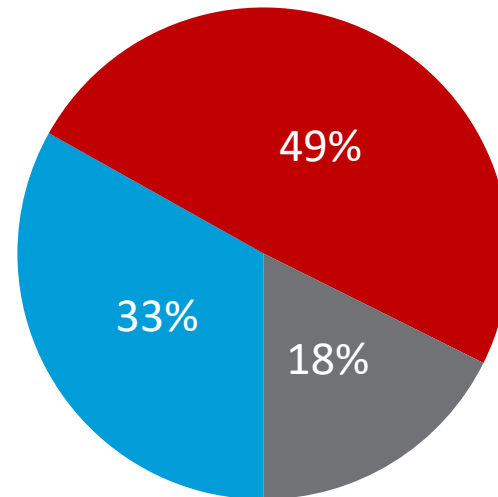

Do you think police reform advocates are primarily helping to improve the justice system or have gone too far and are giving a free pass to some criminals?

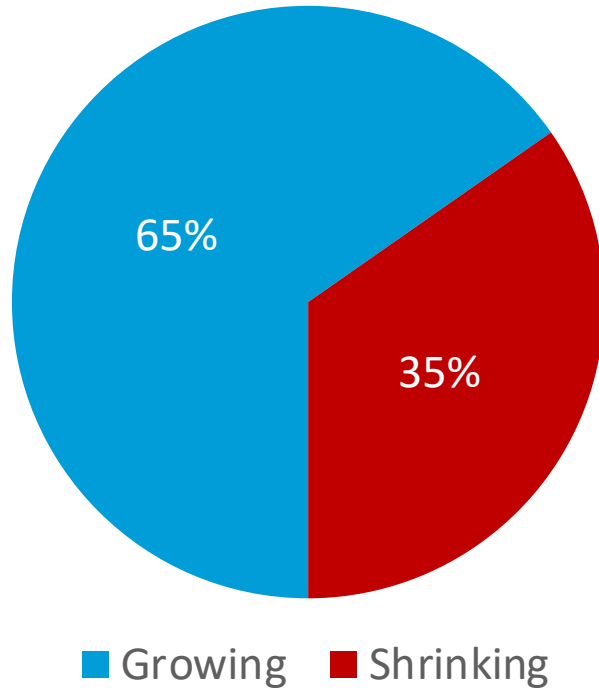

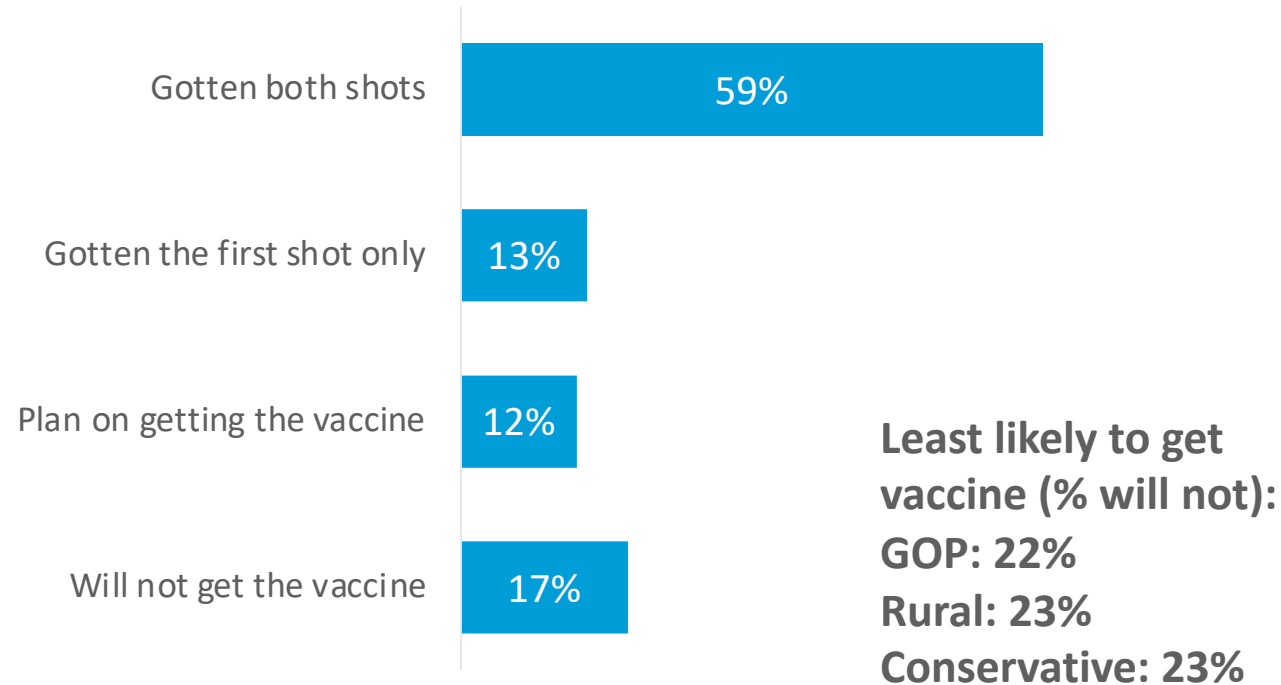
Do you think cases of the virus are growing, shrinking, or staying the same?

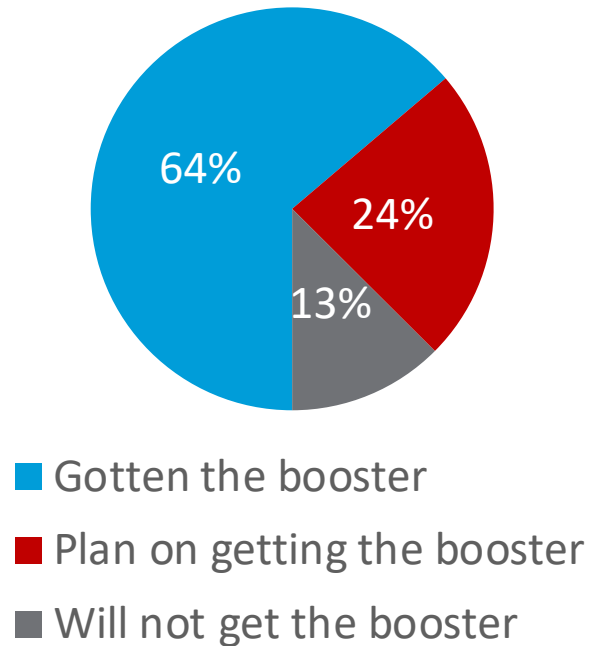

Have you gotten the Covid vaccine, plan on getting the vaccine or will not get the vaccine?

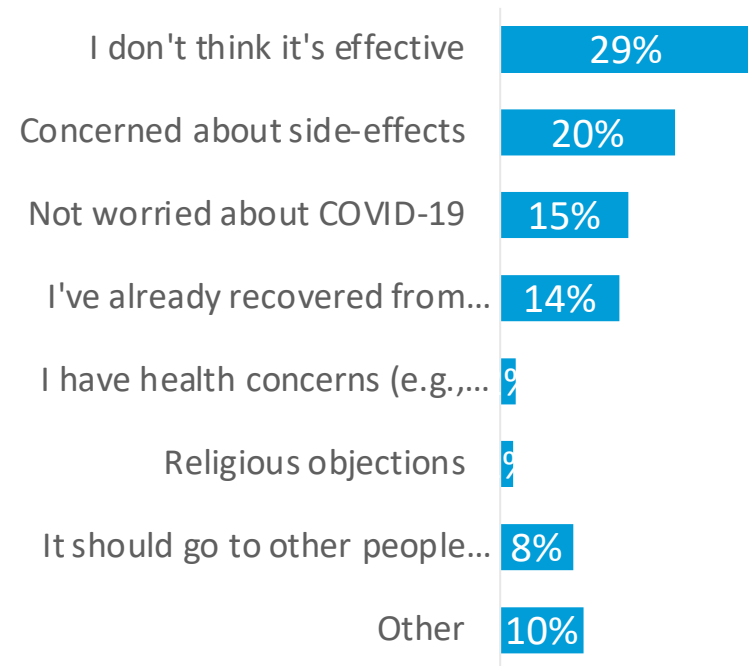

Have you gotten the third covid booster, plan on getting the booster or will not get the booster?

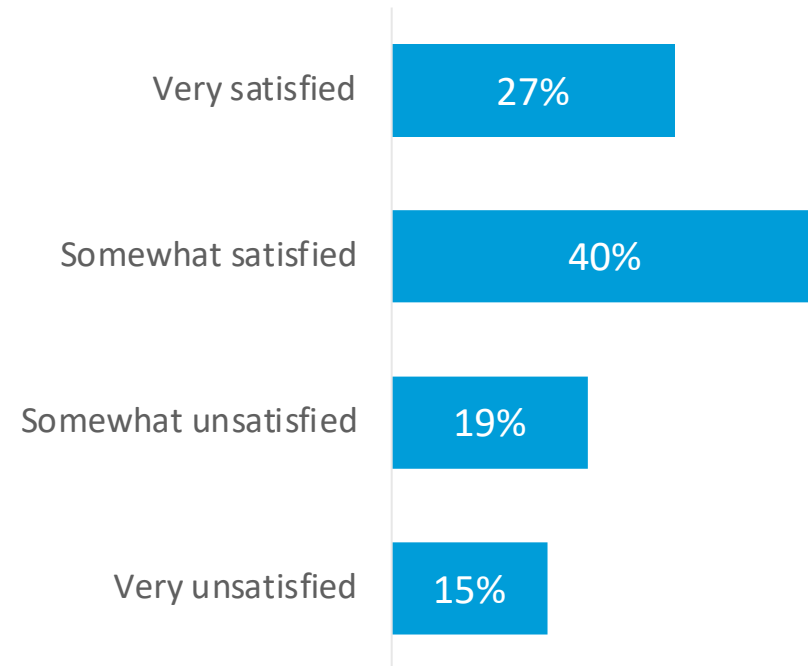

Why are you not willing to take the vaccine?



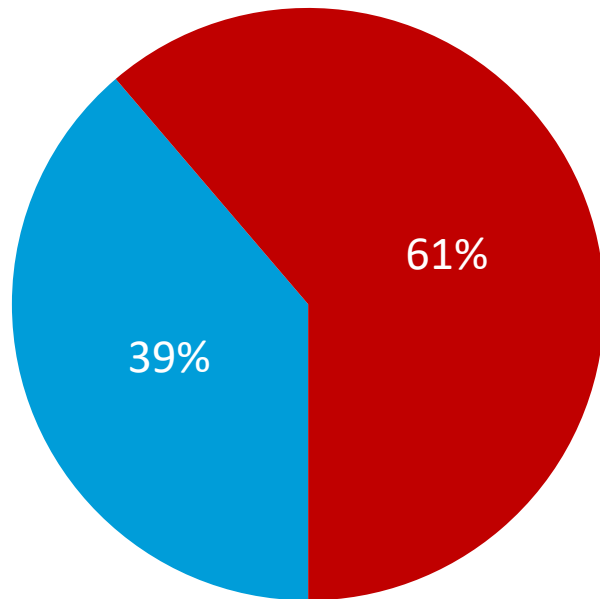
A THIRD OF VOTERS ARE DISSATISFIED WITH COVID TESTING AVAILABILITY

Are you satisfied or unsatisfied with the availability of Covid tests in your area?



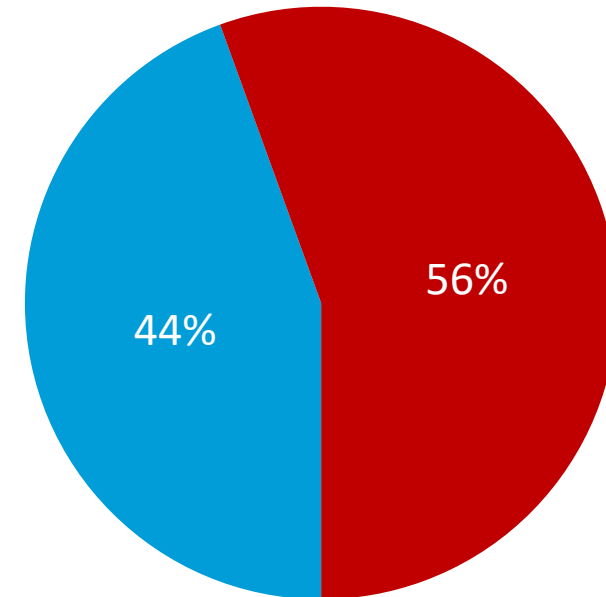
VOTERS SAY THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT AND THEIR STATE WERE UNPREPARED FOR THE OMICRON VARIANT
