SURVEY METHOD

This survey was conducted online within the United States from **December 14-15, 2022**, among **1,851 registered voters** by The Harris Poll and HarrisX.

Results were weighted for age within gender, region, race/ethnicity, marital status, household size, income, employment, education, political party, and political ideology where necessary to align them with their actual proportions in the population. Propensity score weighting was also used to adjust for respondents' propensity to be online.

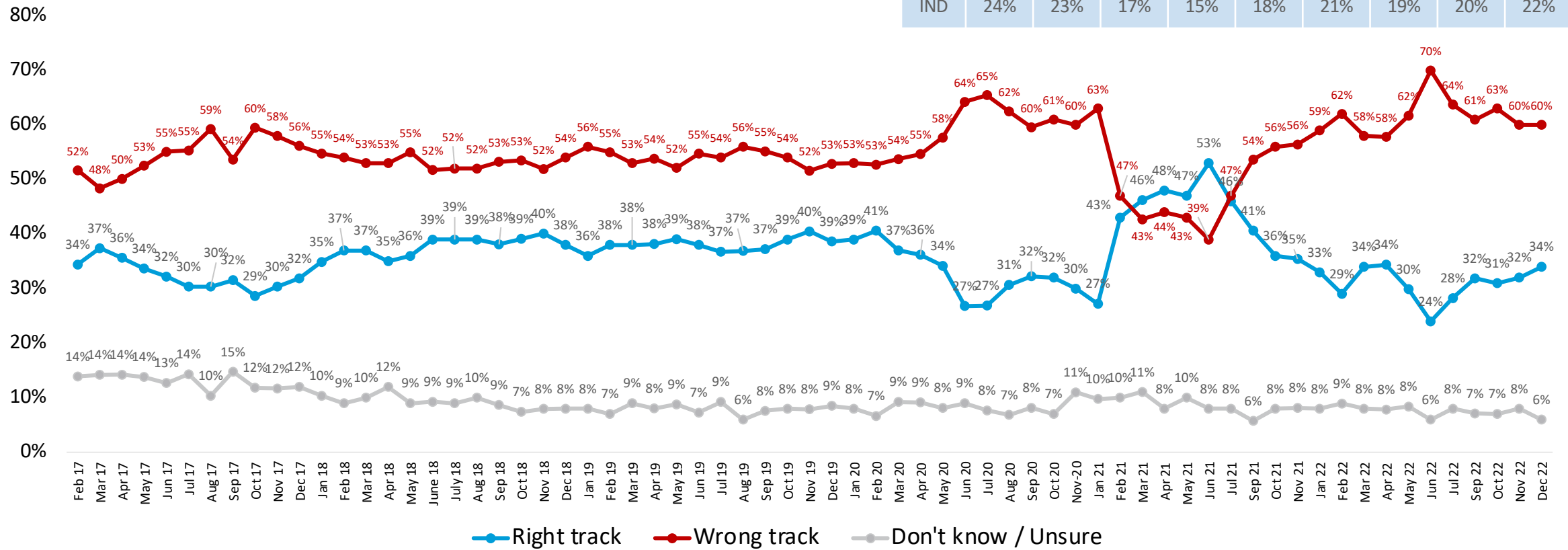

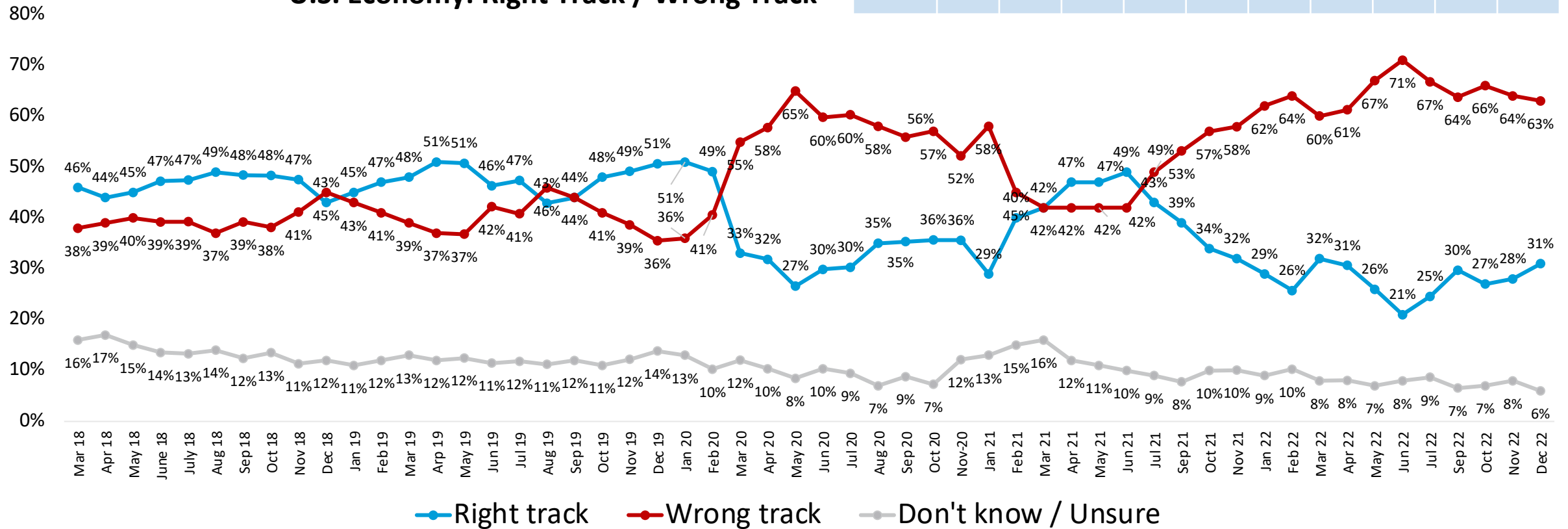

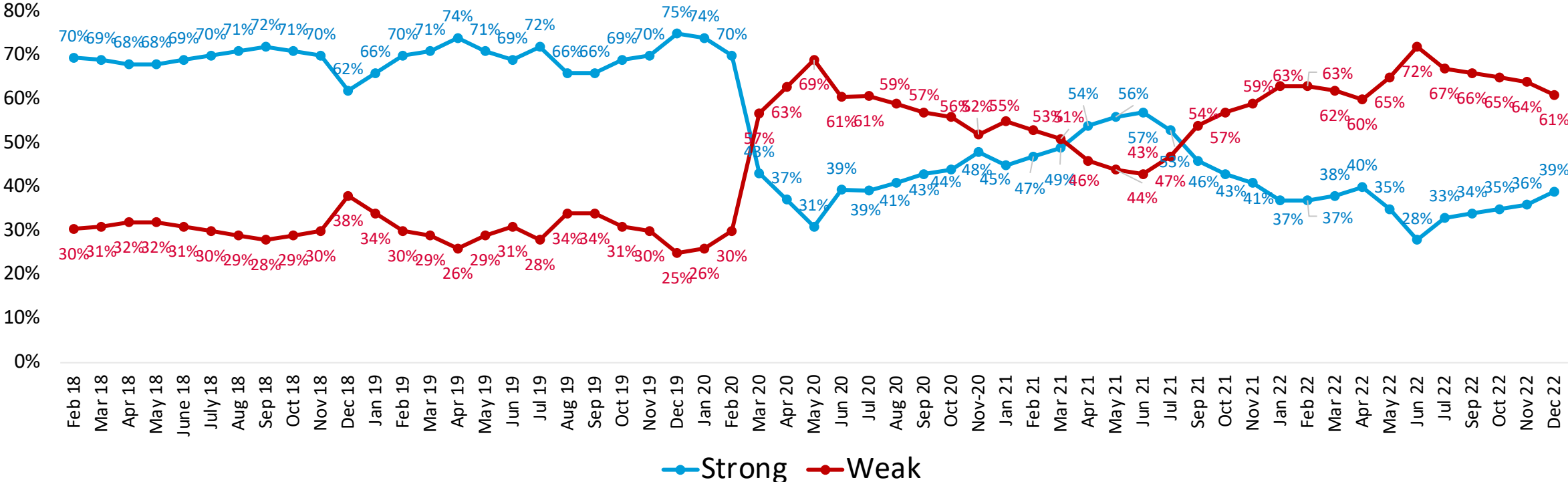

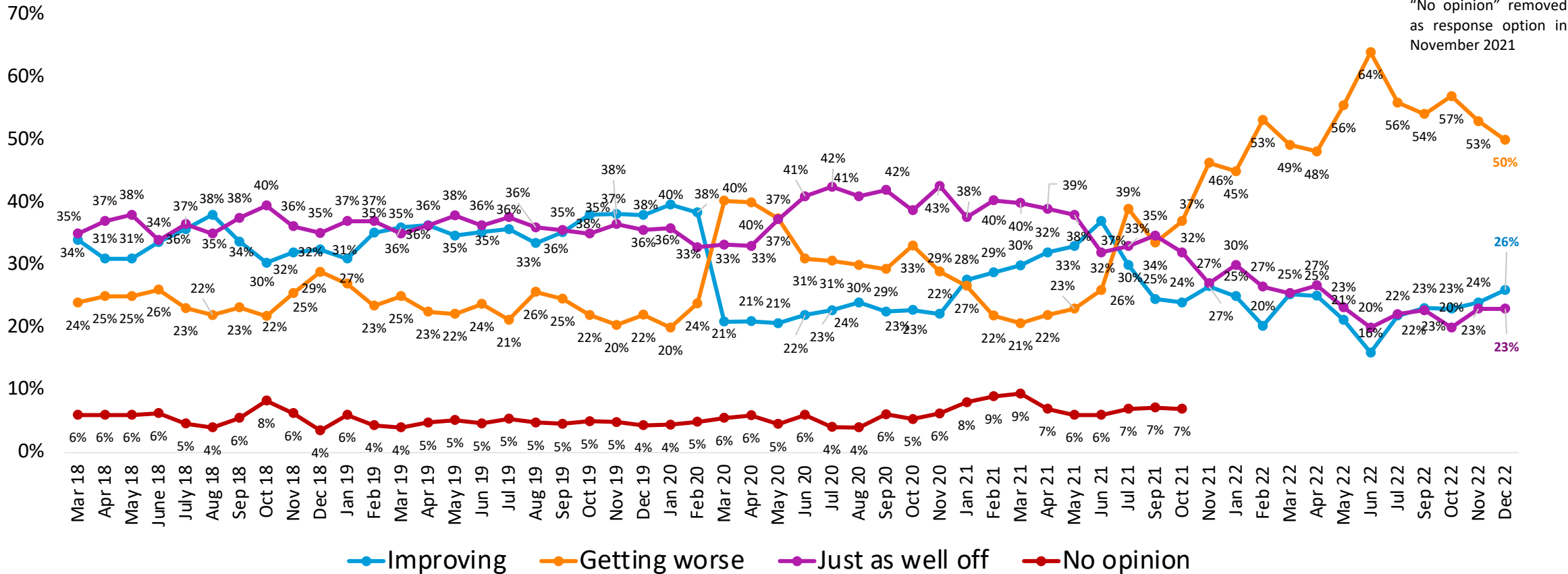

How strong do you think the U.S. economy is today?



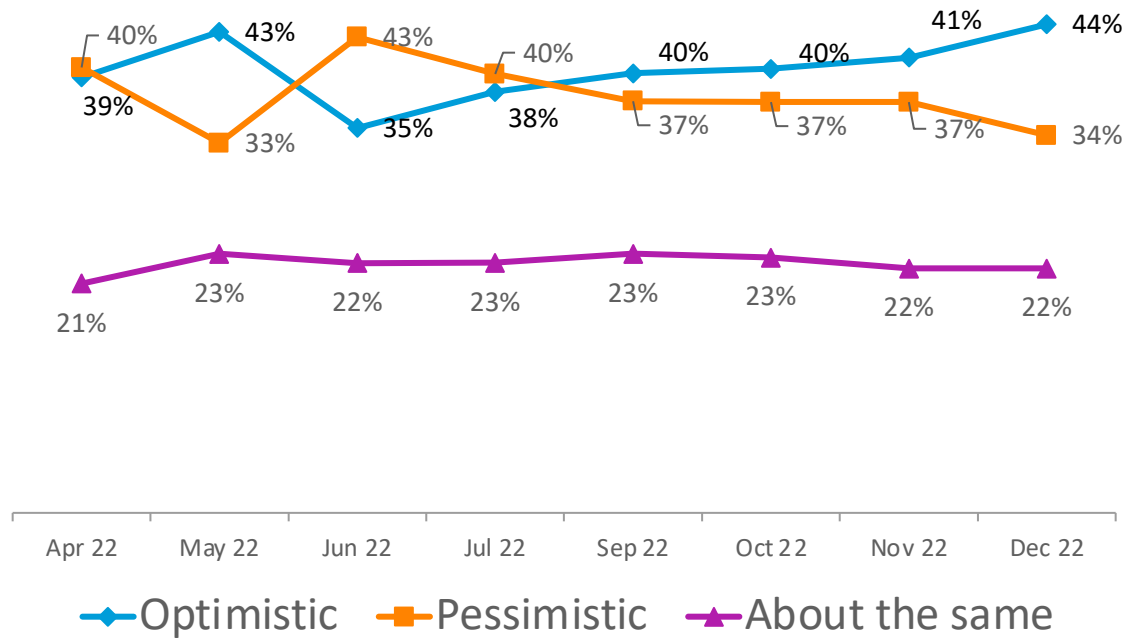
HALF OF AMERICANS STILL SAY THEIR FINANCIAL SITUATION IS WORSENING

Would you say that your personal financial situation is improving or getting worse?

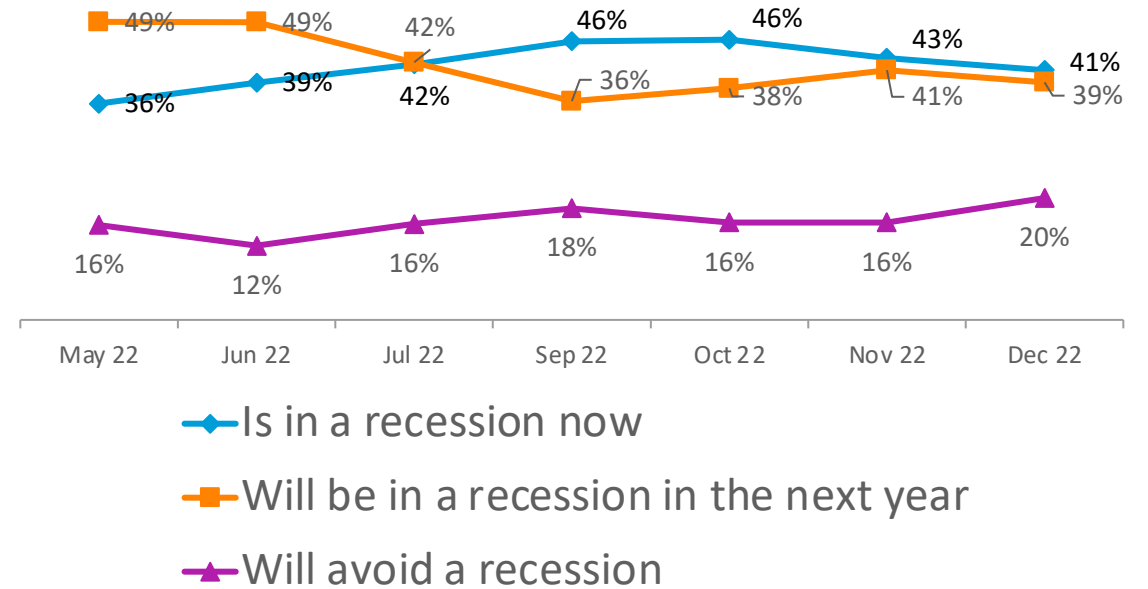

Do you think the U.S. is in a recession now, will be in a recession in the next year or most likely will avoid a recession?

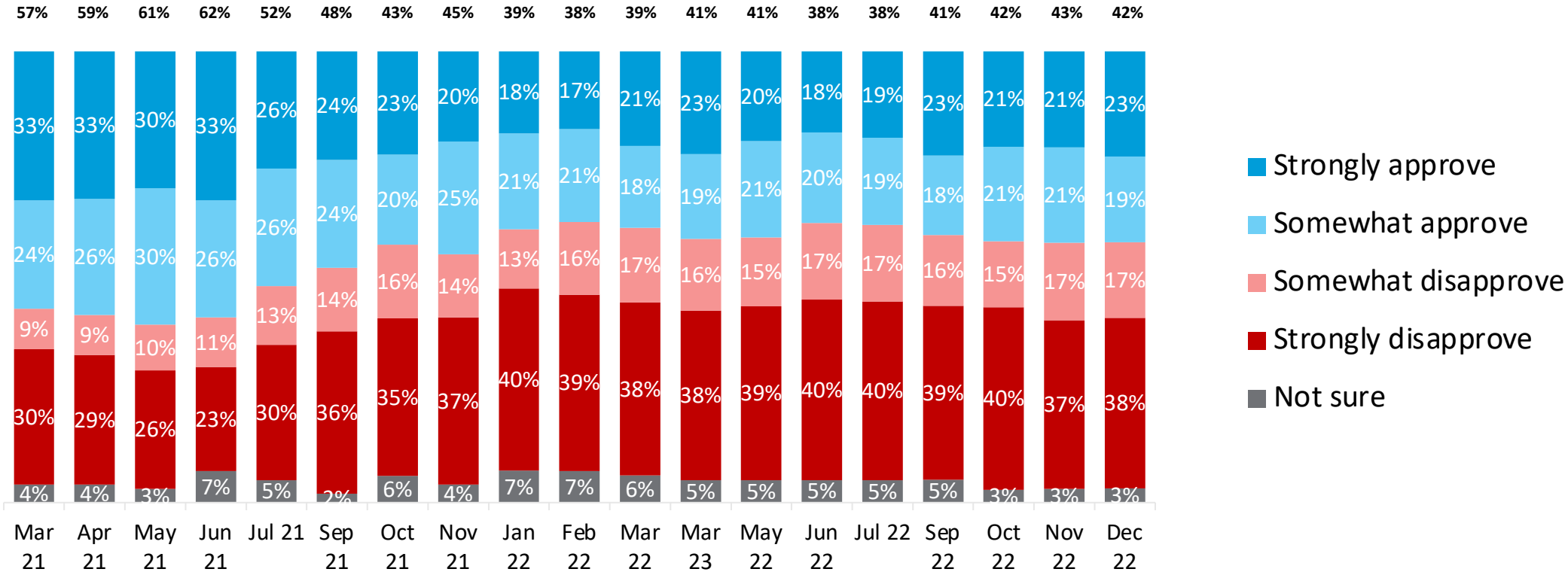

President Biden Overall Approval



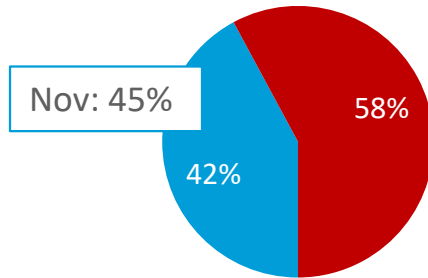

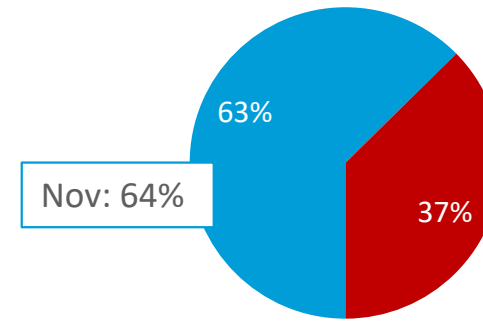

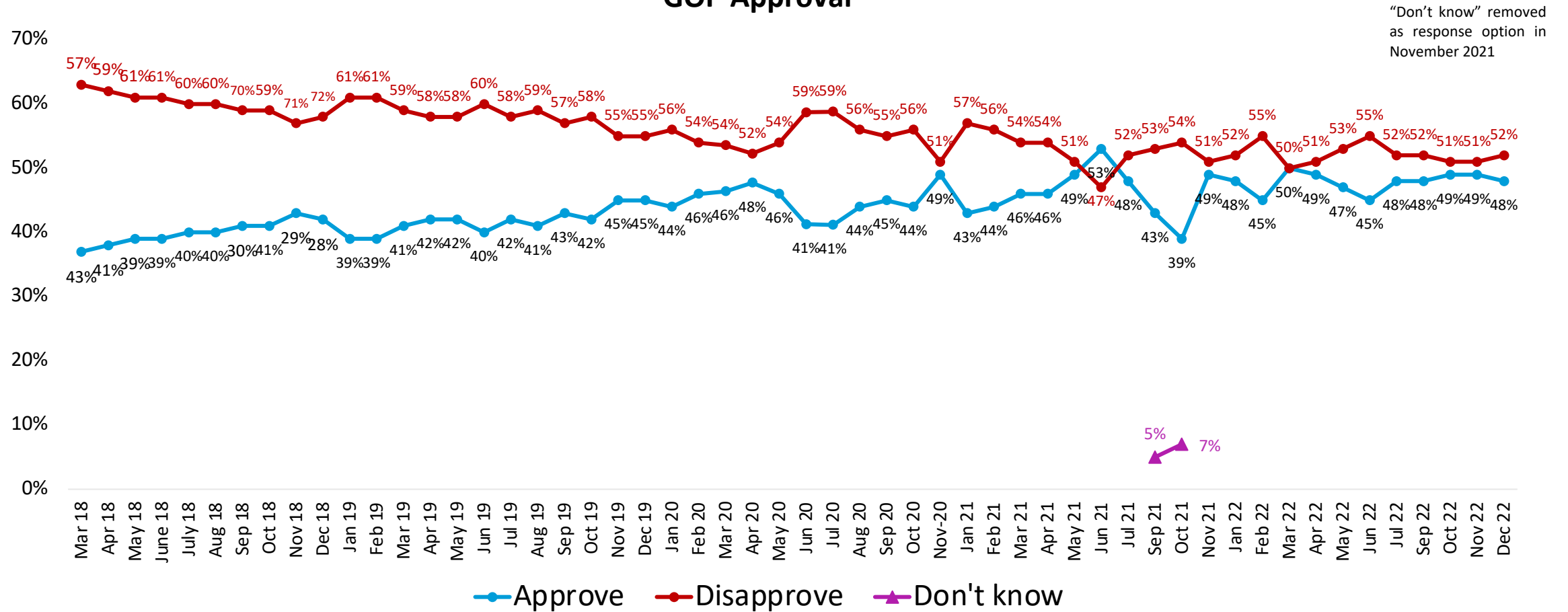

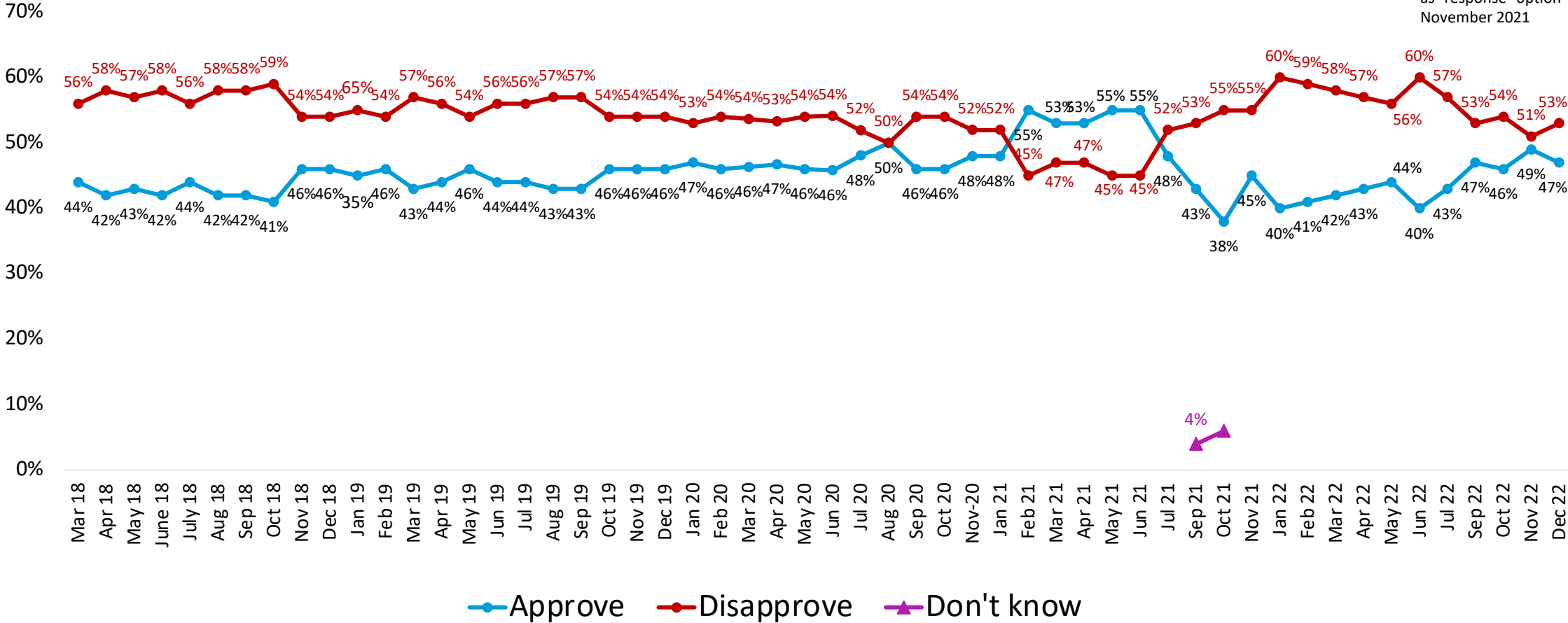

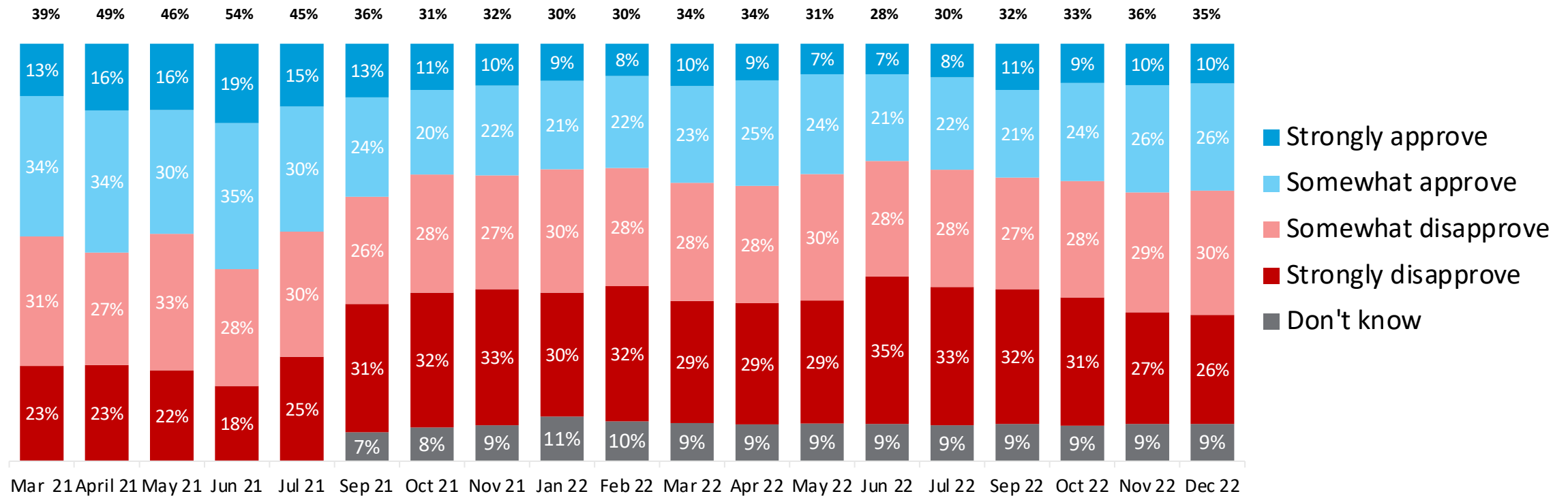

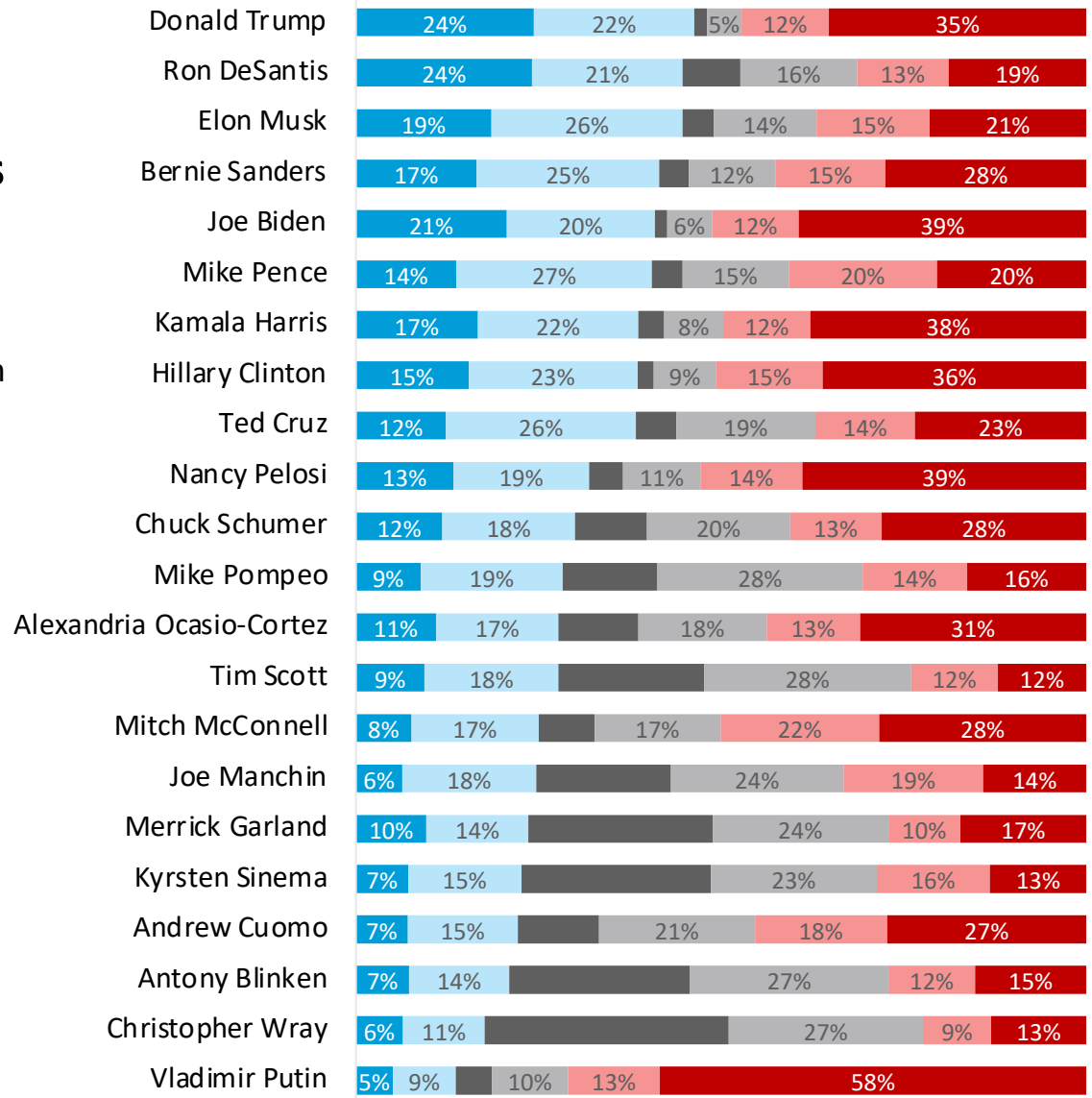

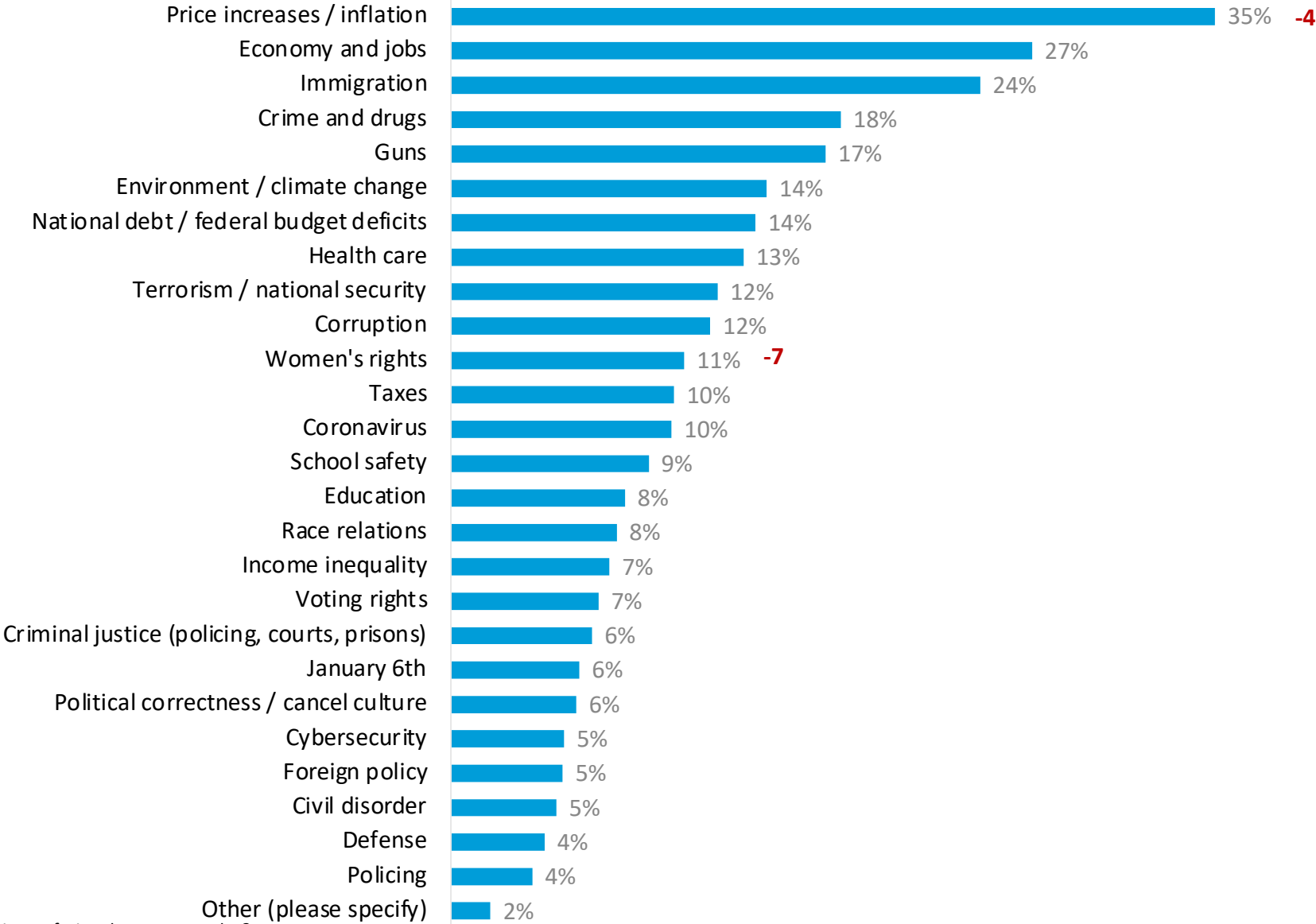

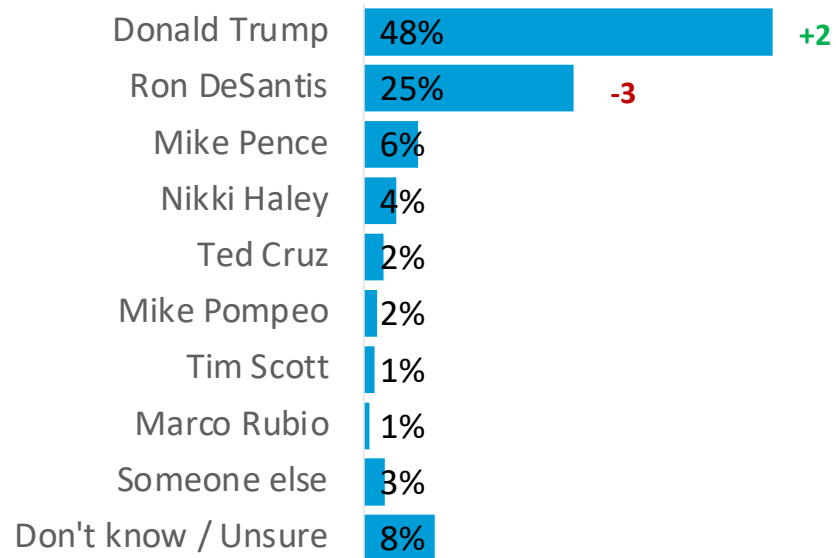

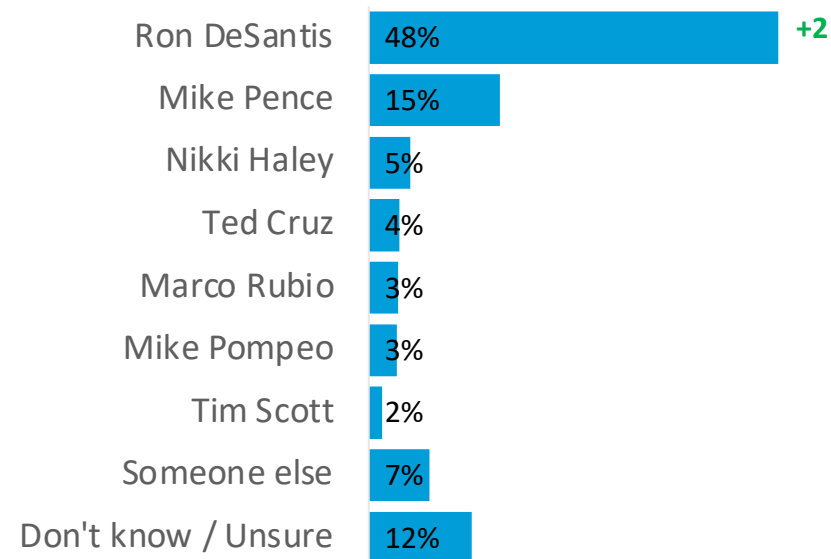

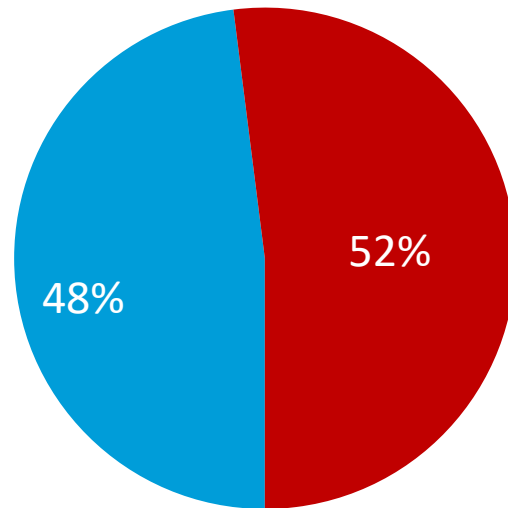

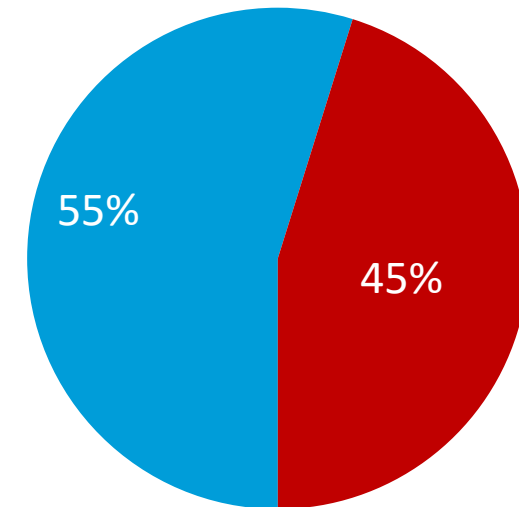

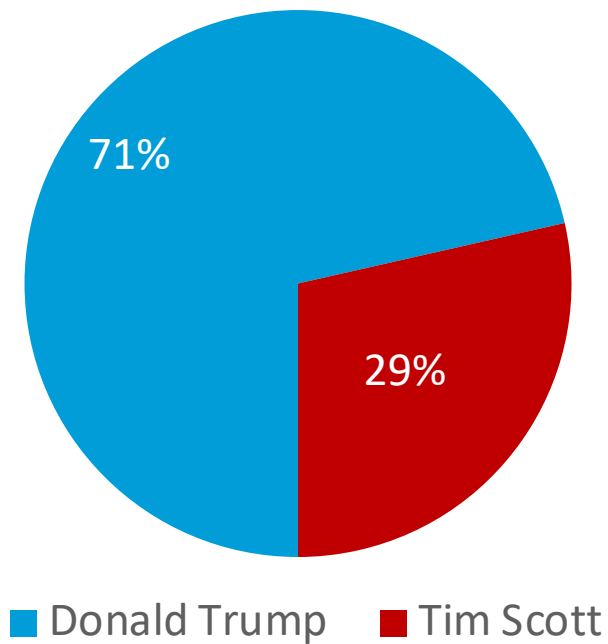

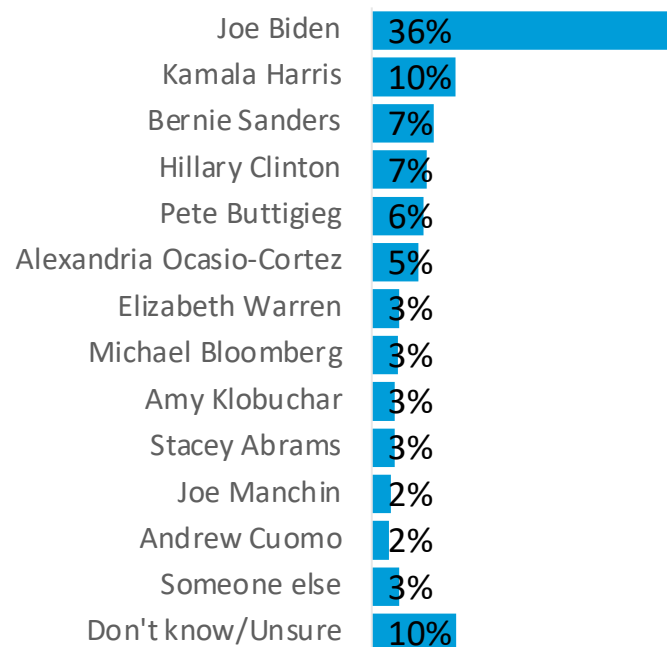

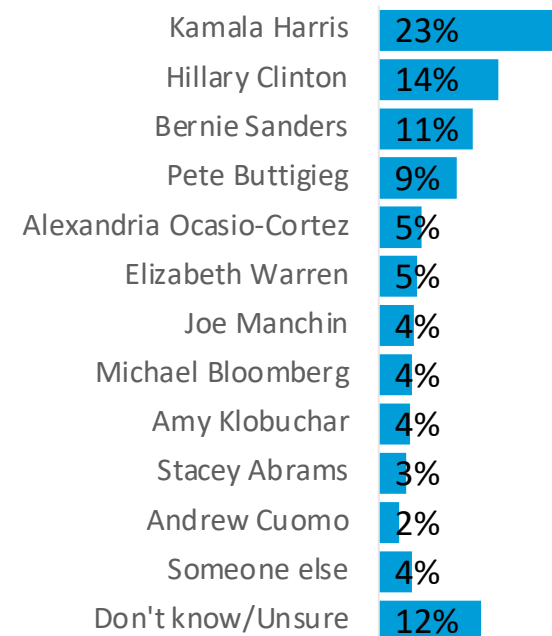

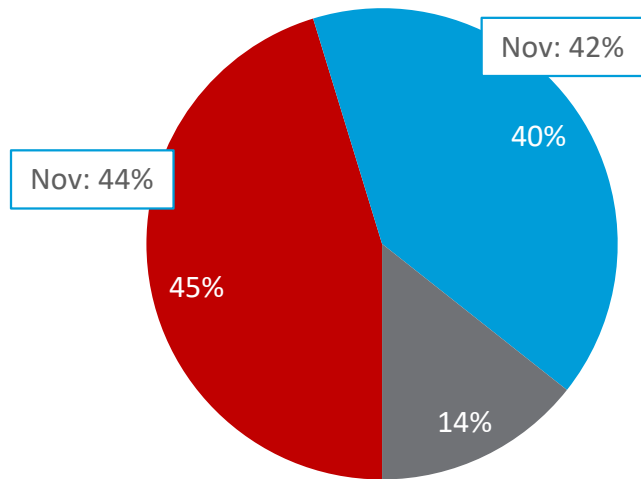

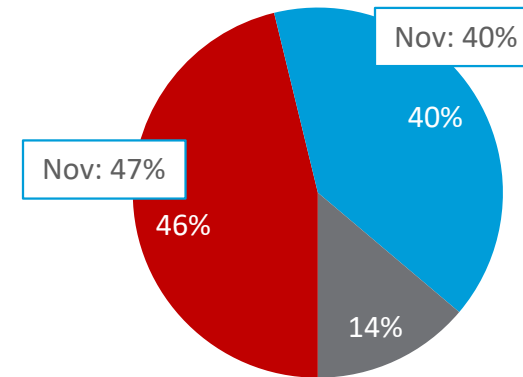

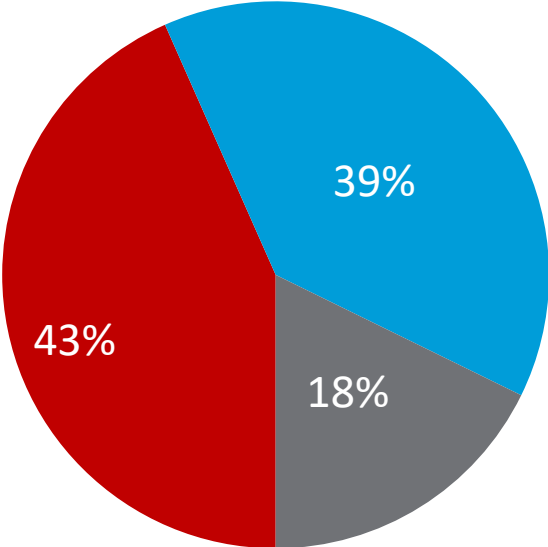

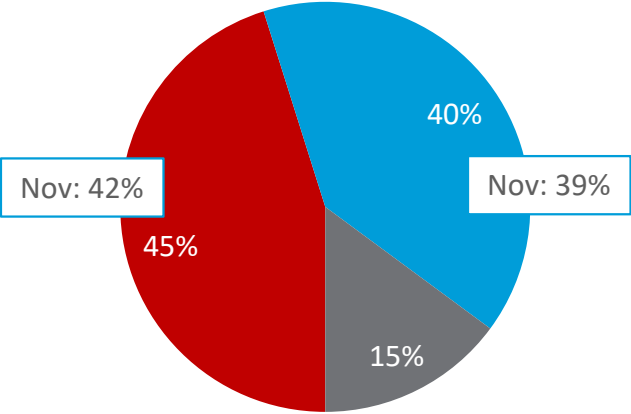

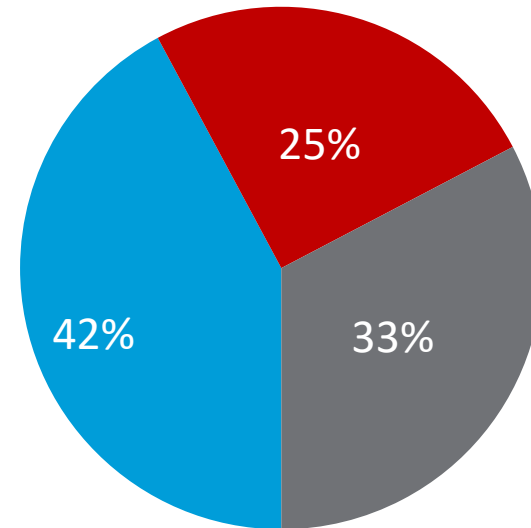

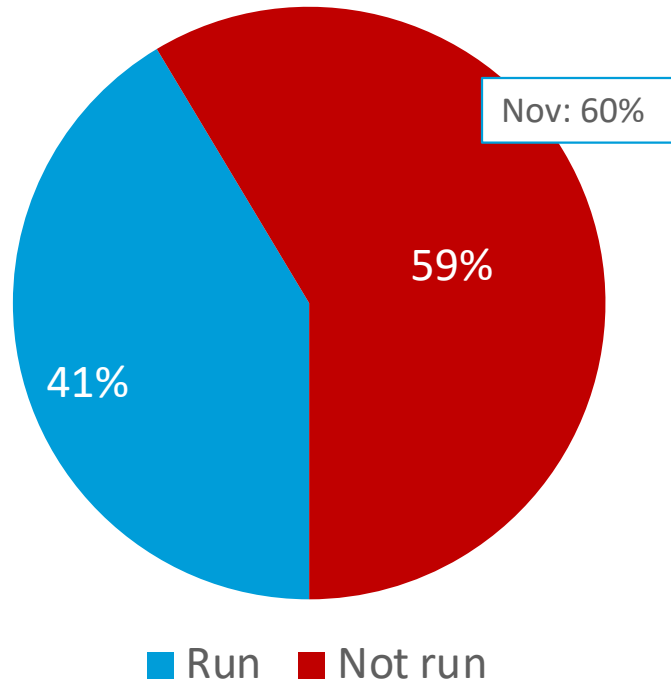

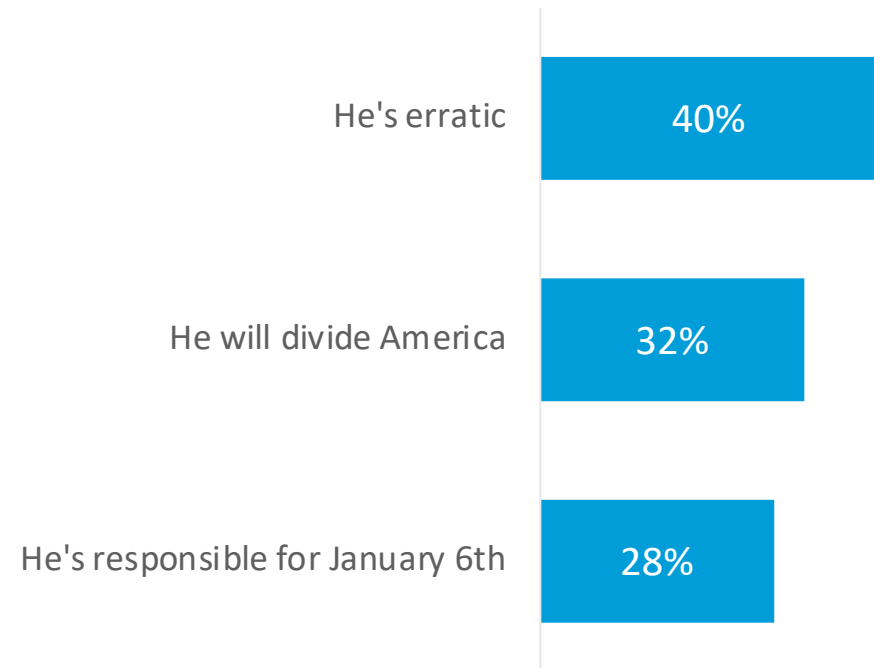

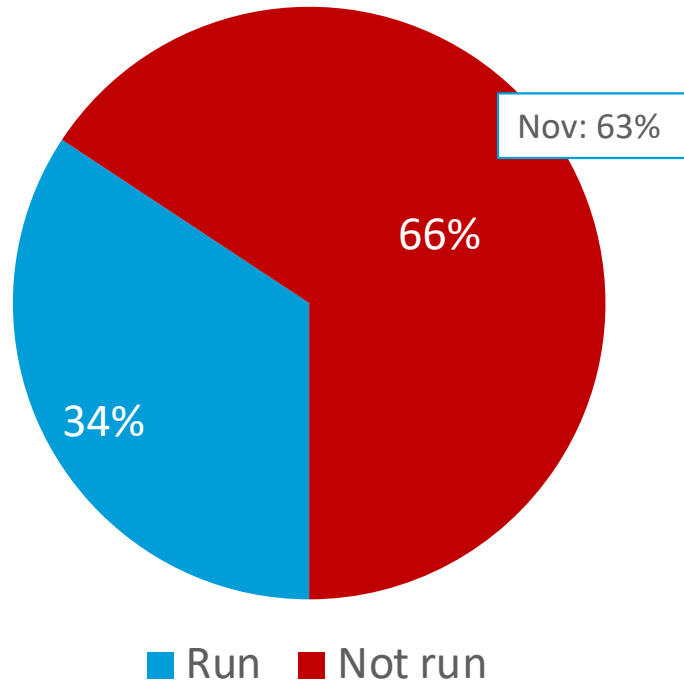


Why should Donald Trump not run for president in 2024?

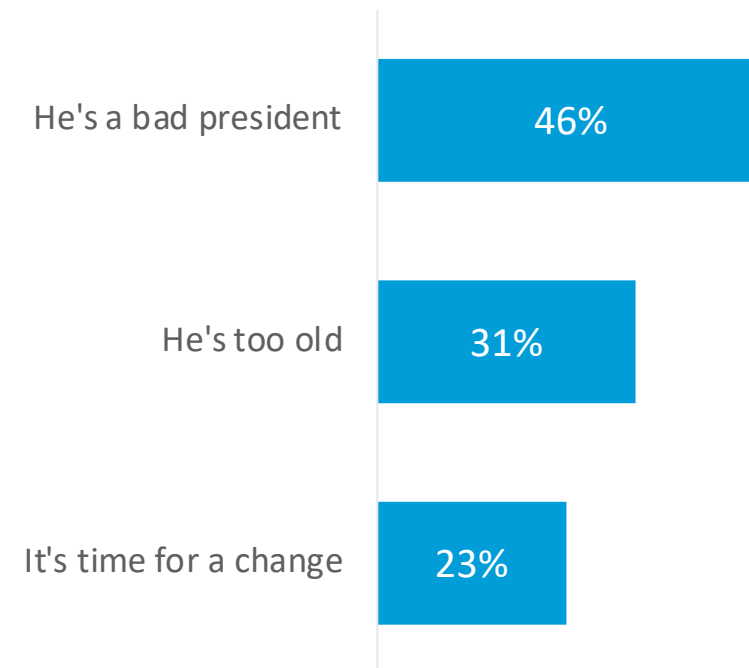

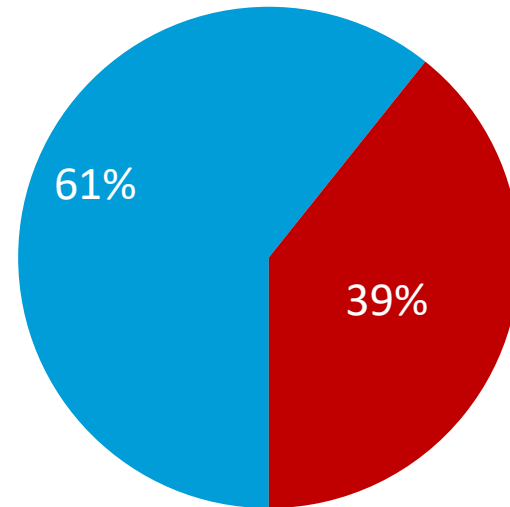

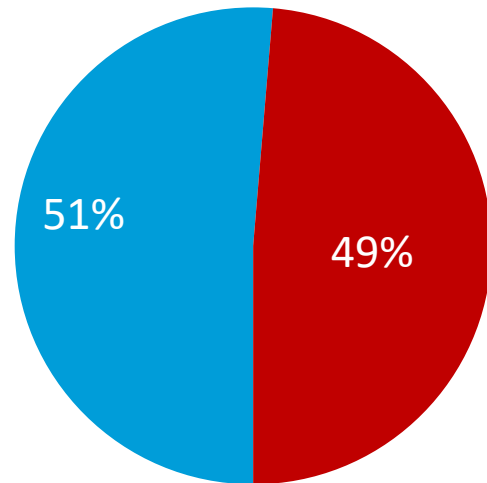

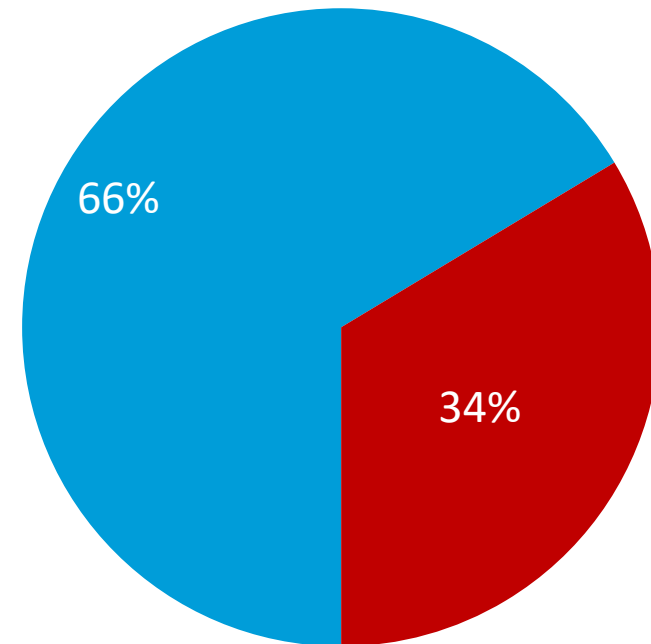

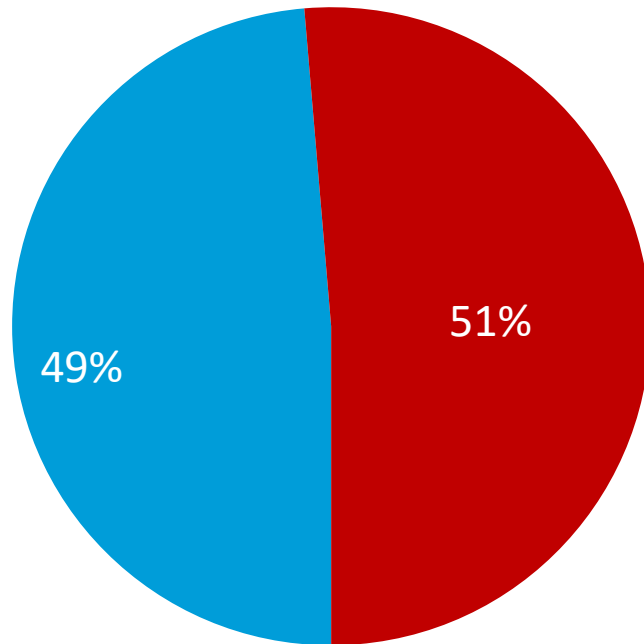

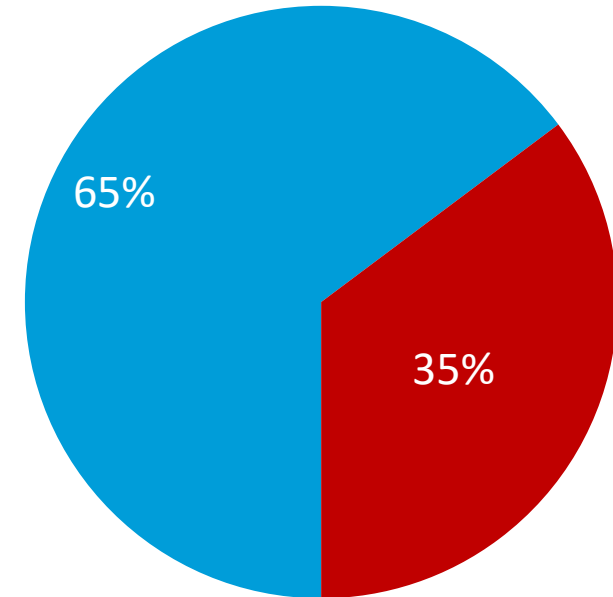

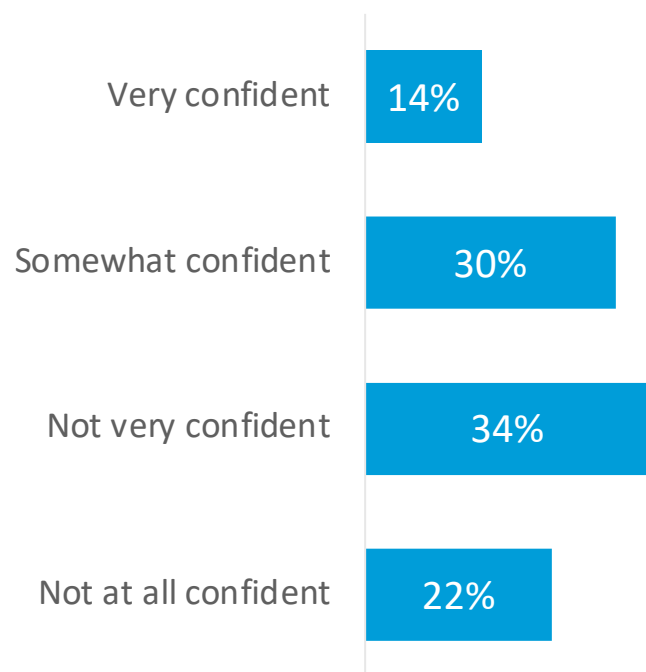

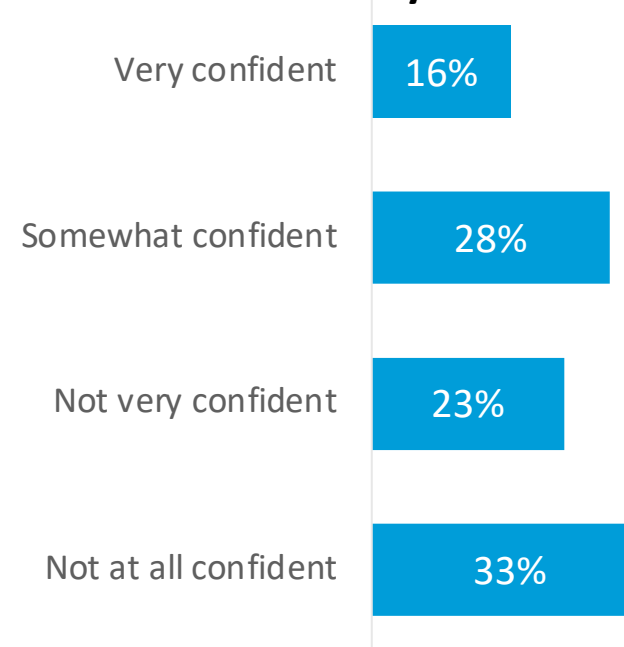

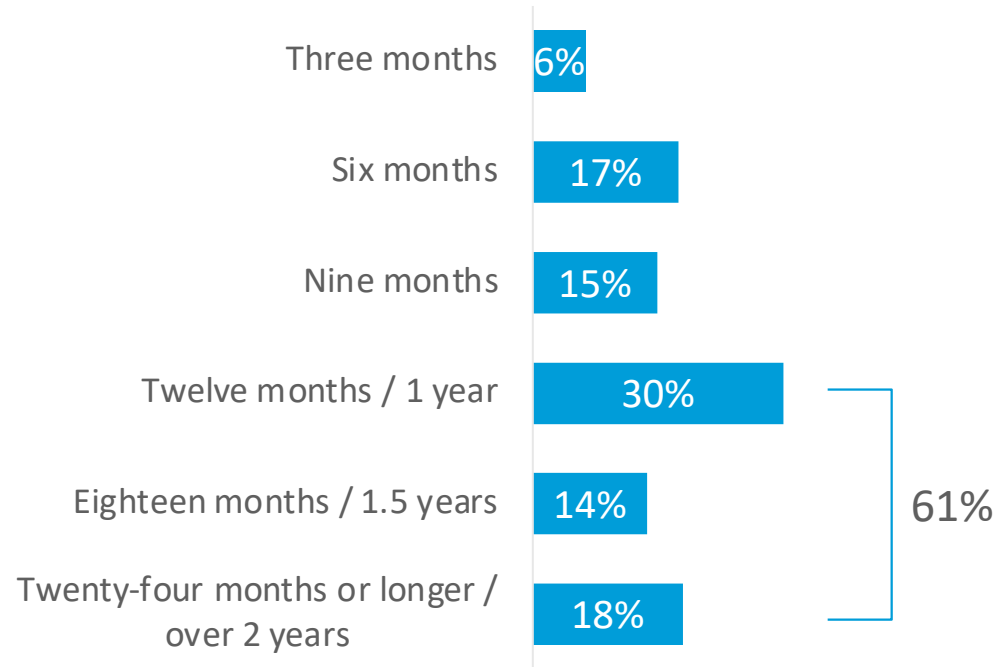

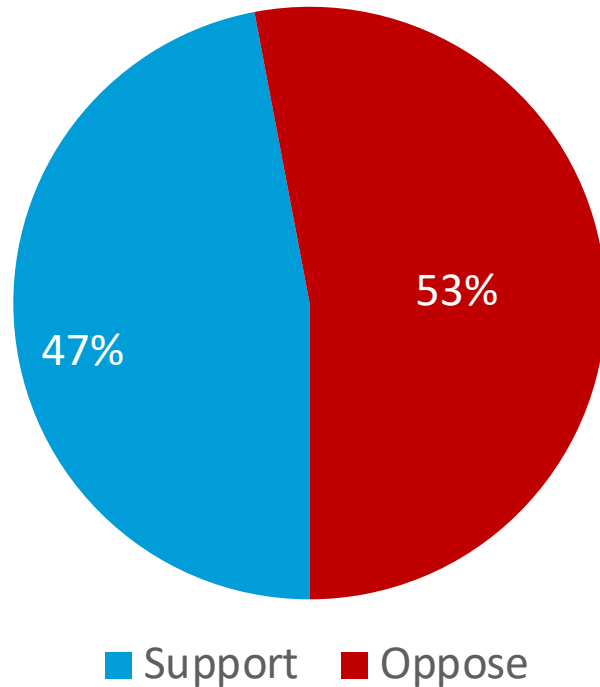

How long do you think will high inflation continue for?

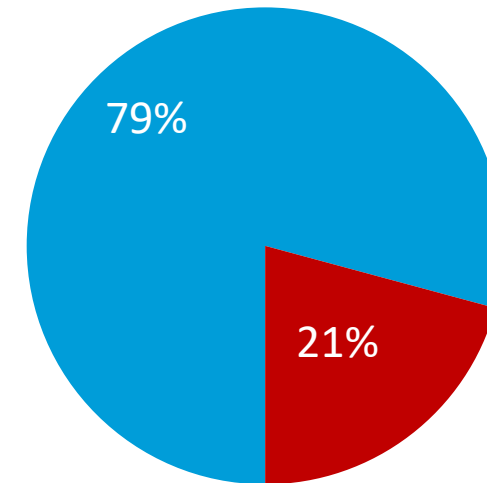

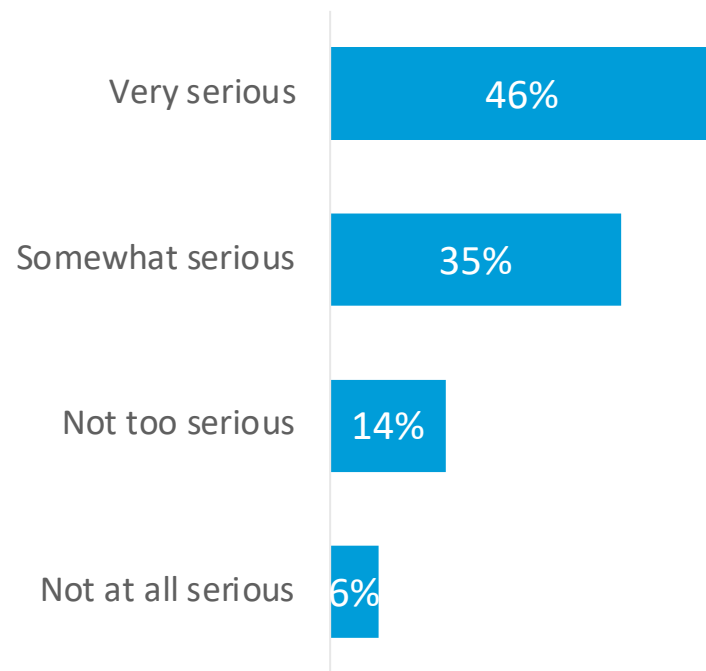

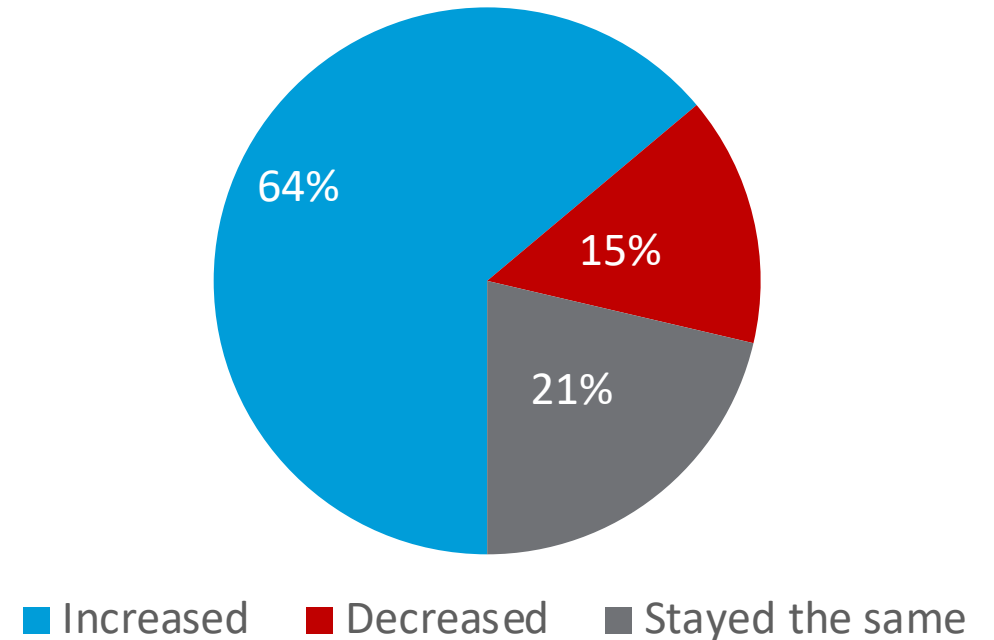

Do you think the number of monthly border crossings by illegal immigrants has increased, decreased, or stayed the same since President Biden took office?

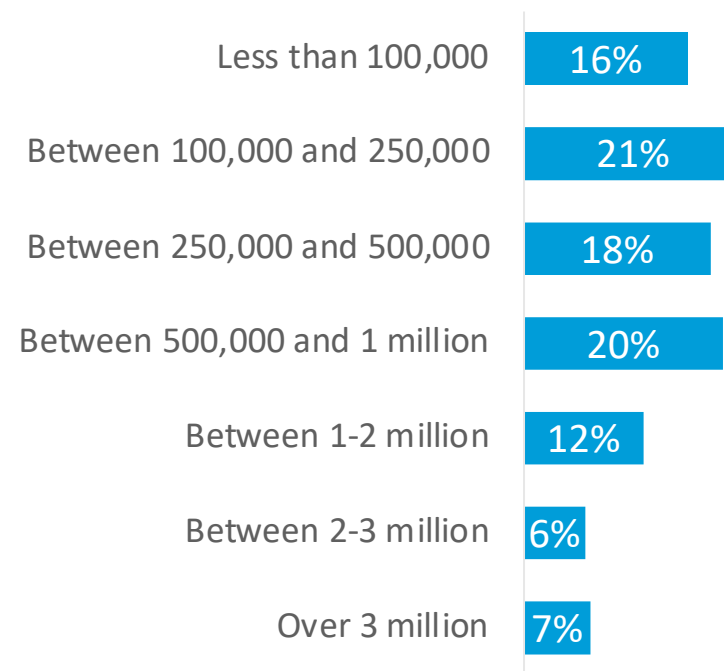

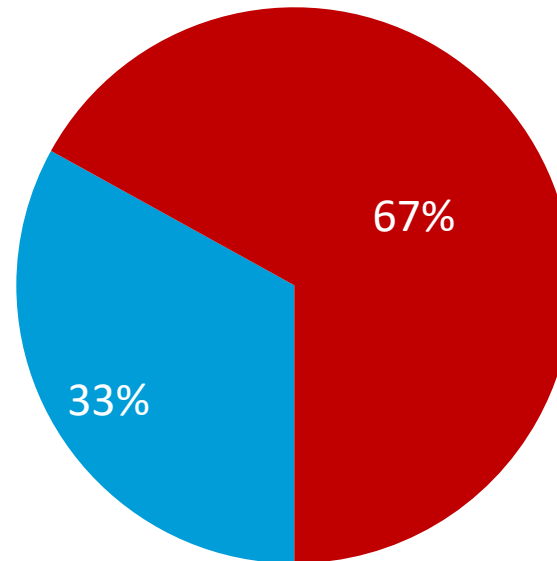

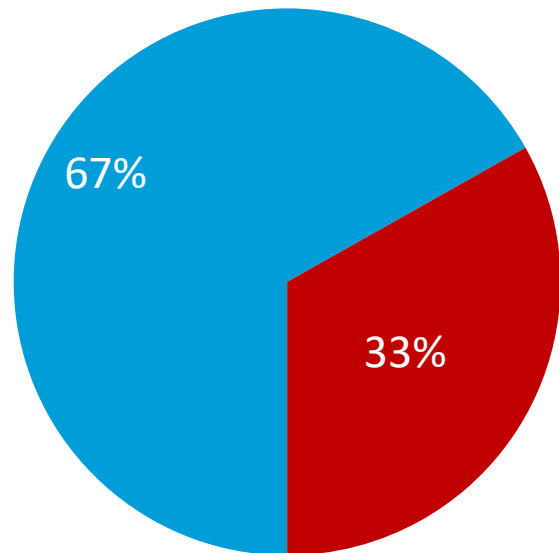

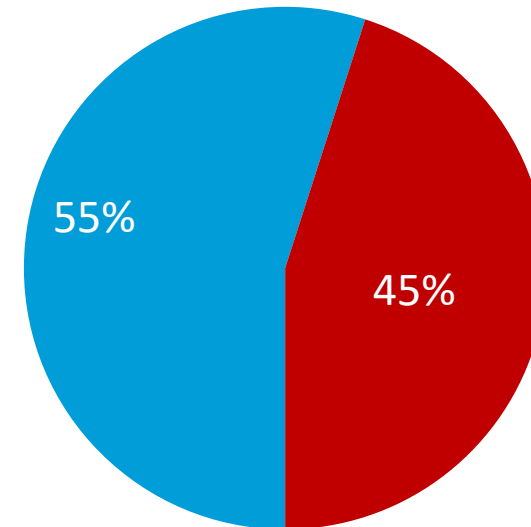

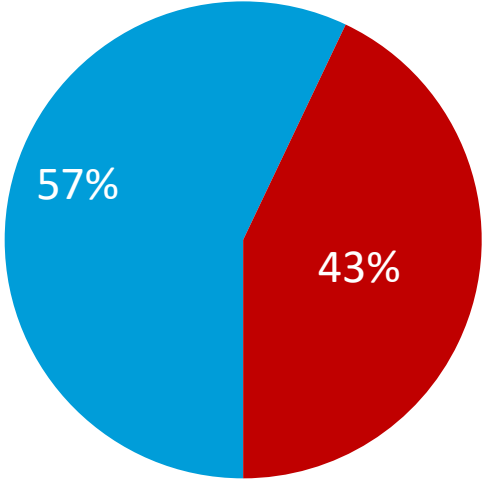

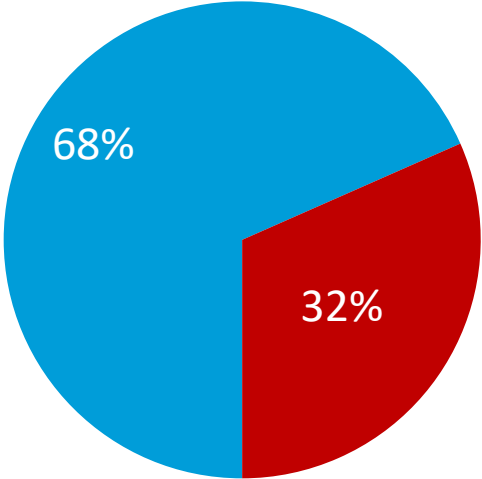

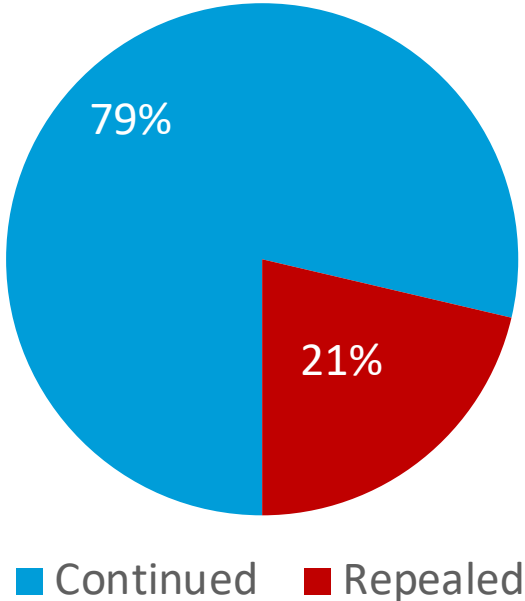

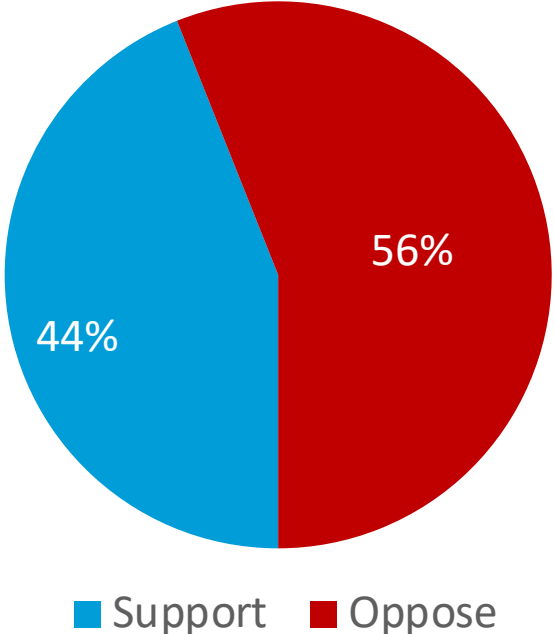

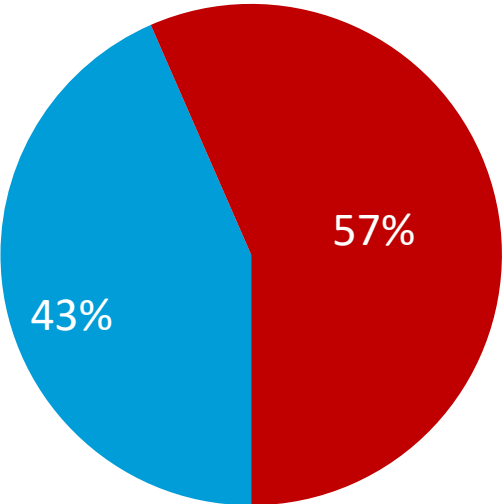

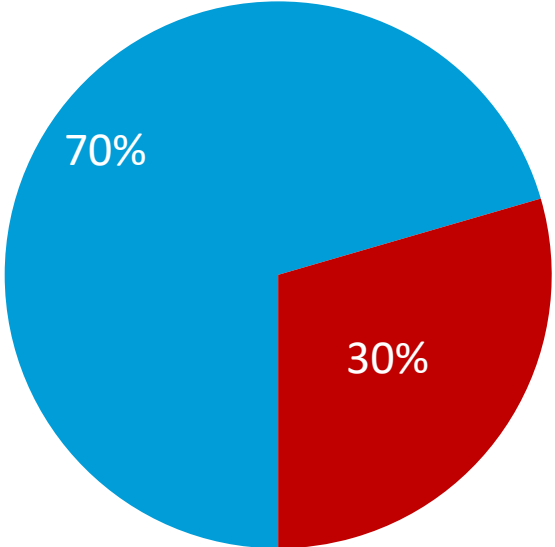

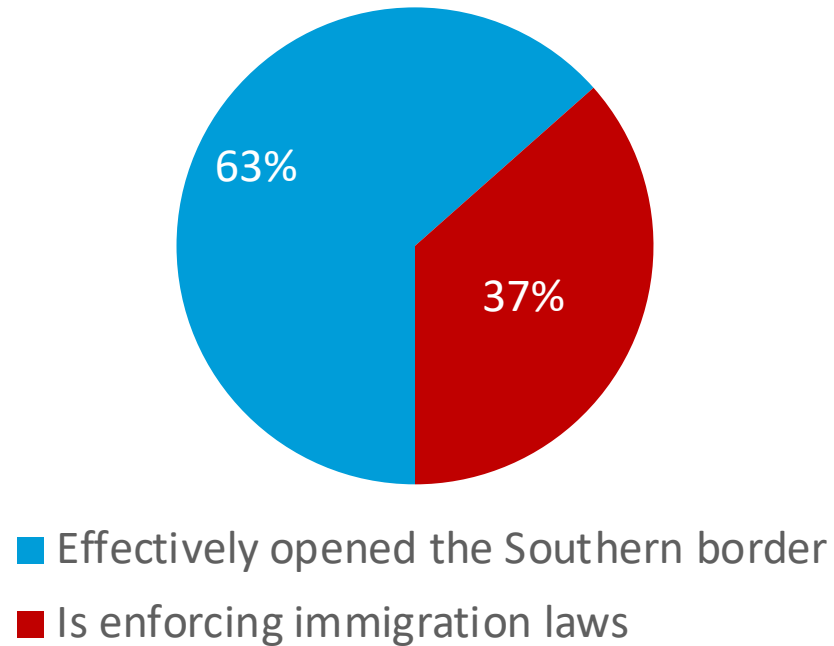

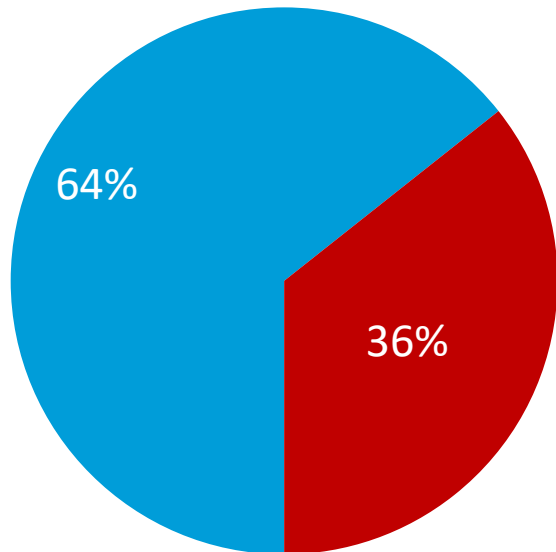

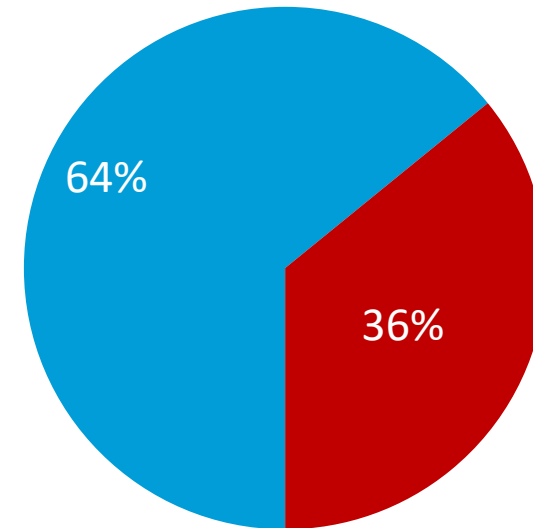

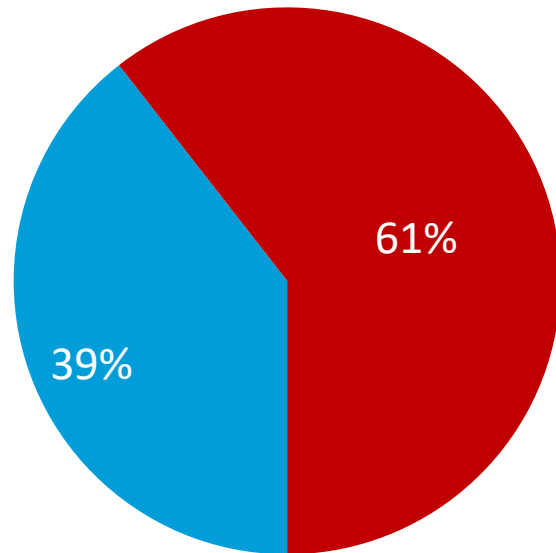

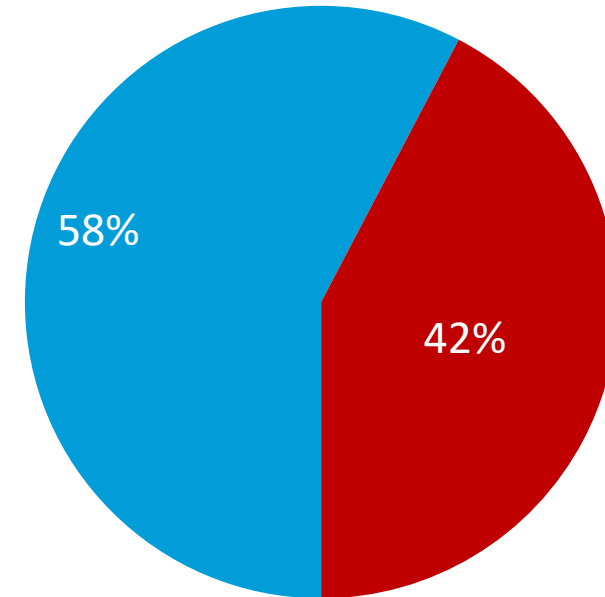

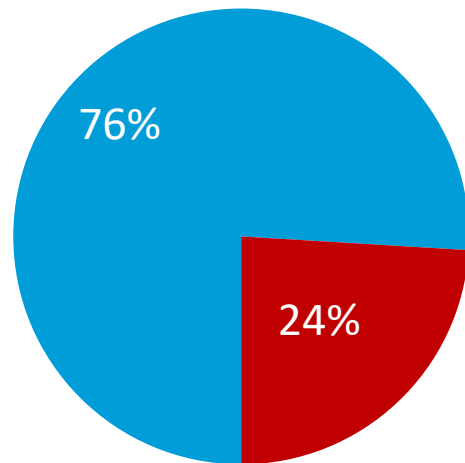

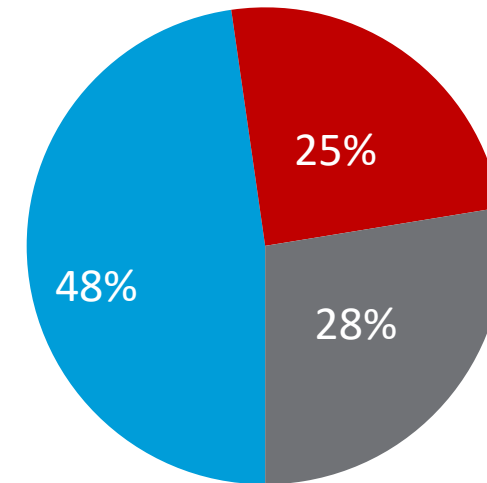

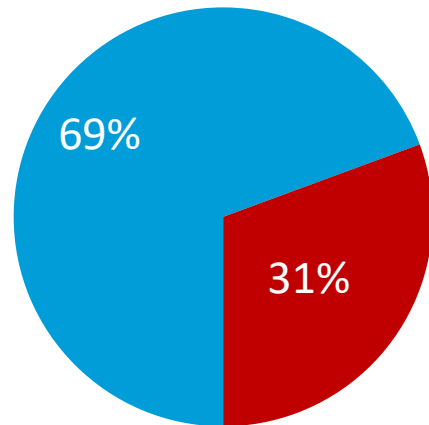

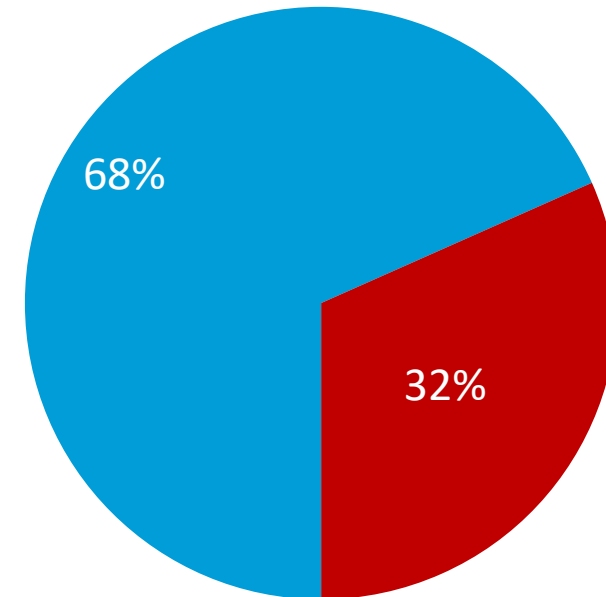

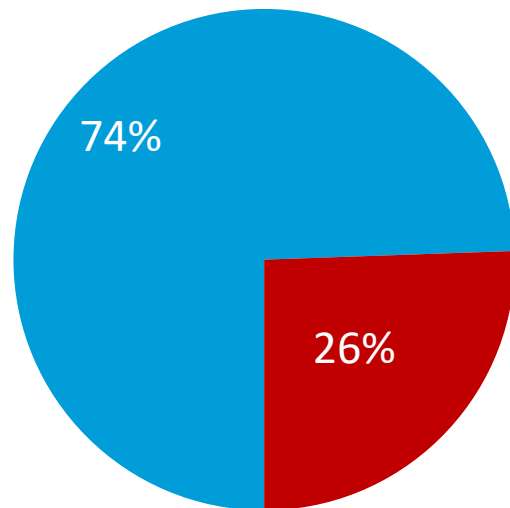

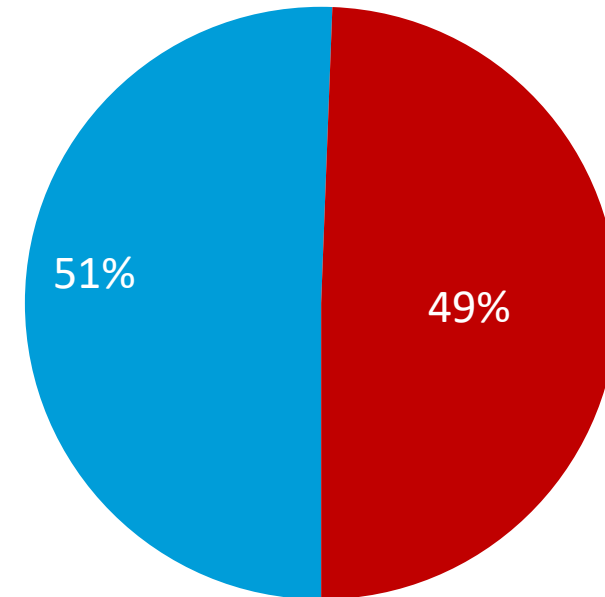

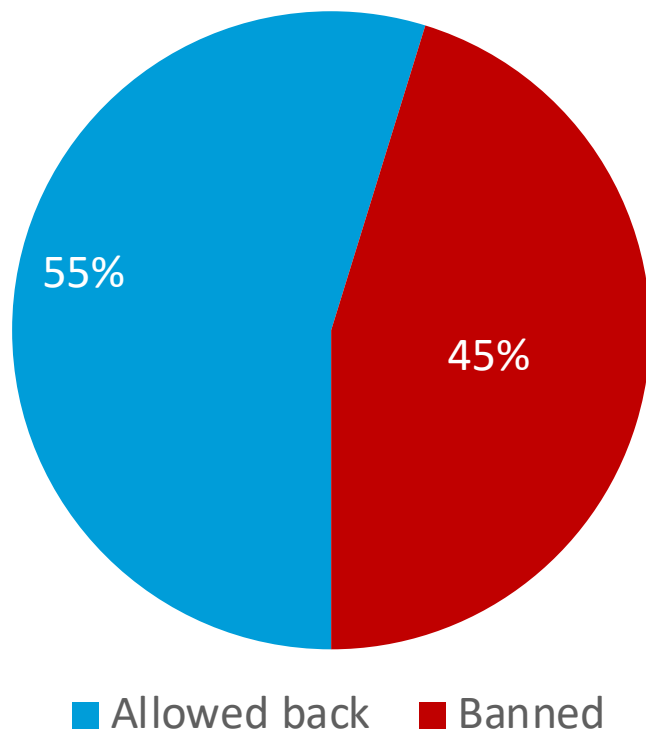

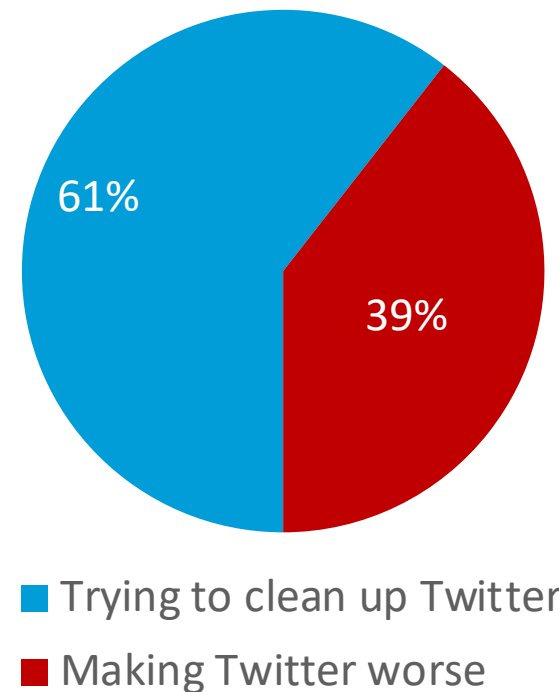

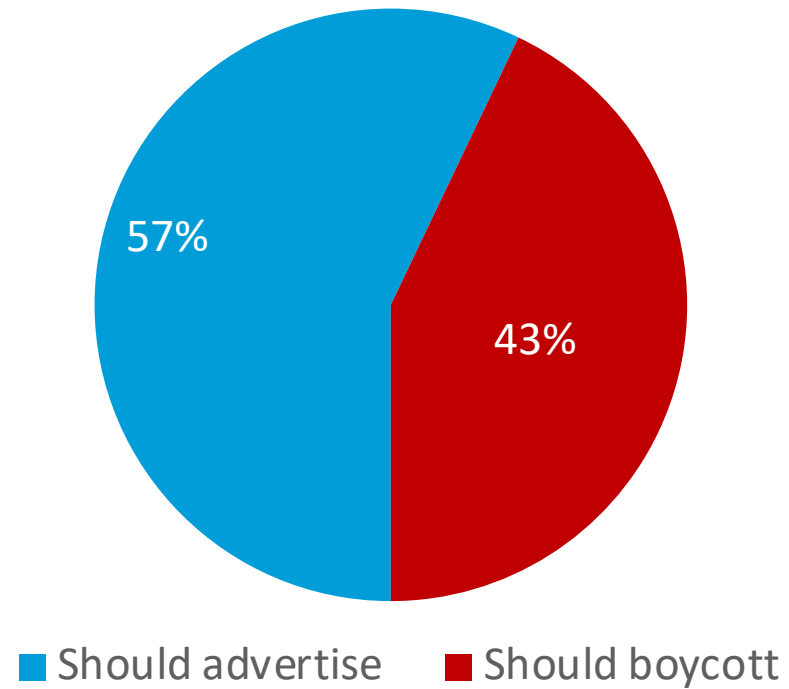

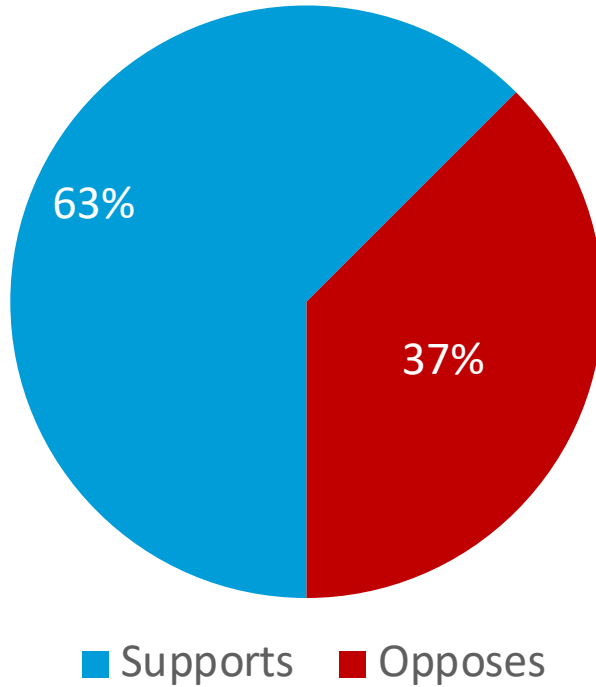

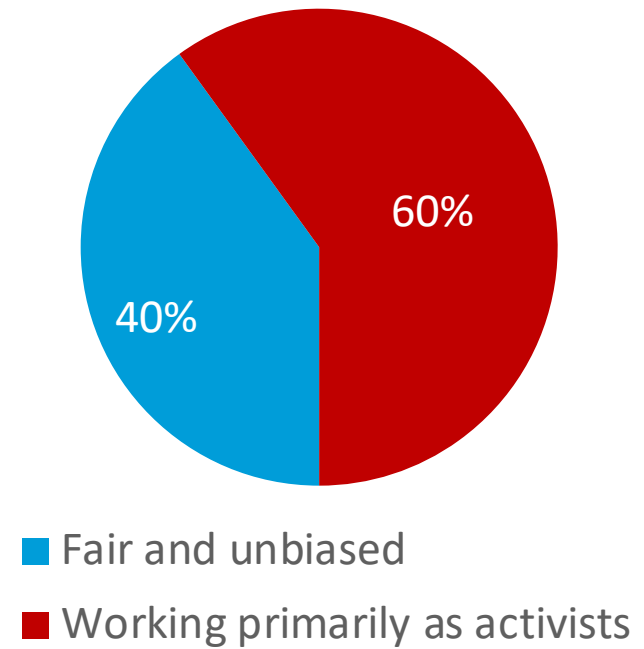

Do you think the mainstream media today is fair and unbiased or working primarily as activists for one political party or smoother?

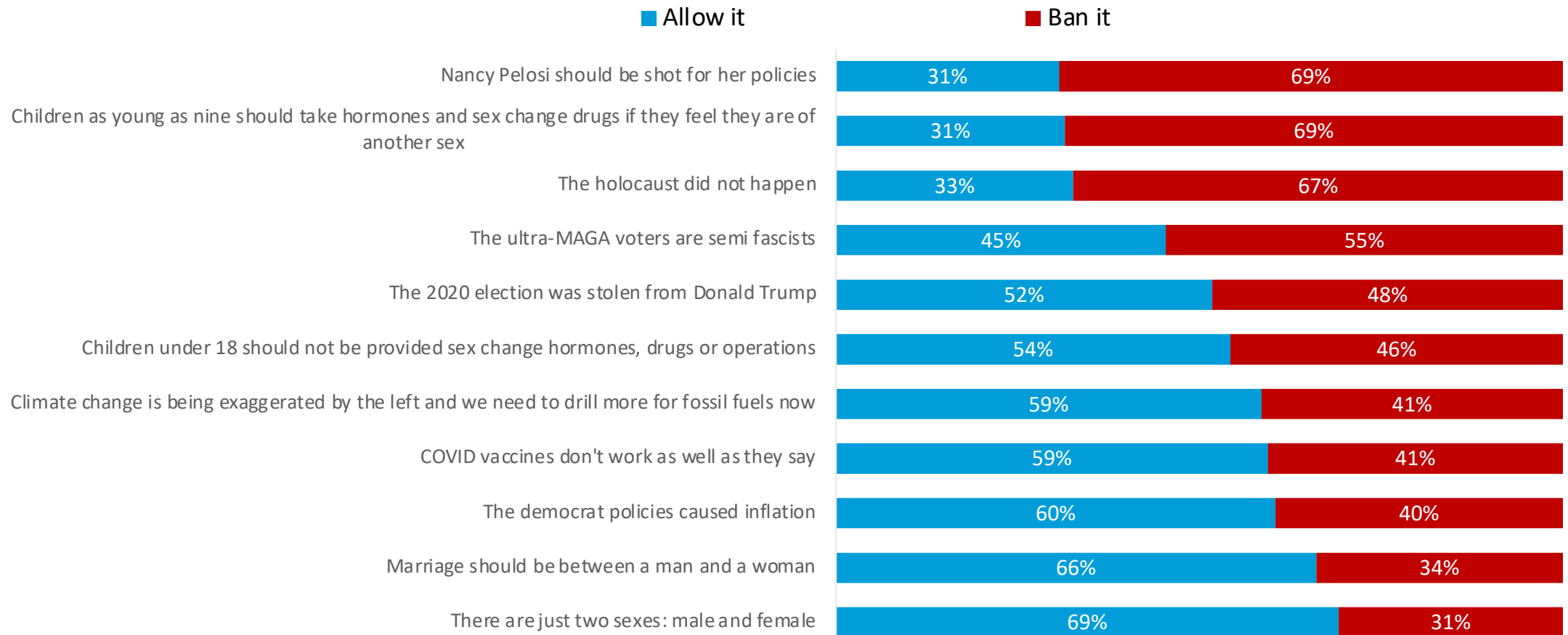

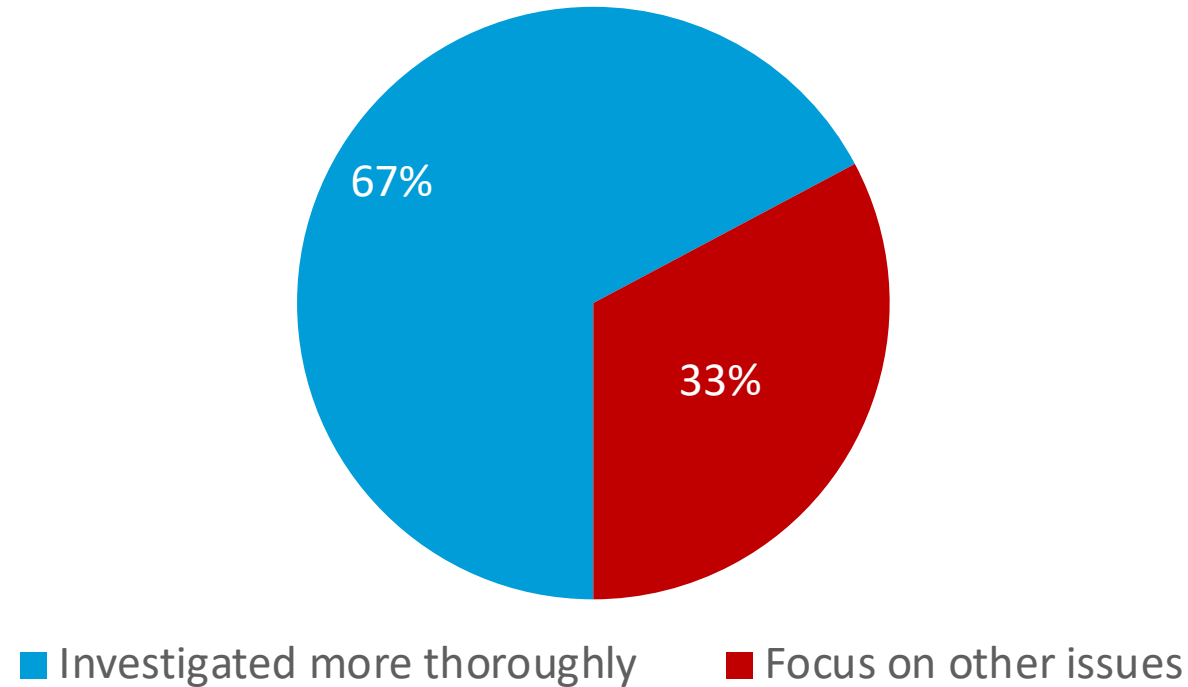

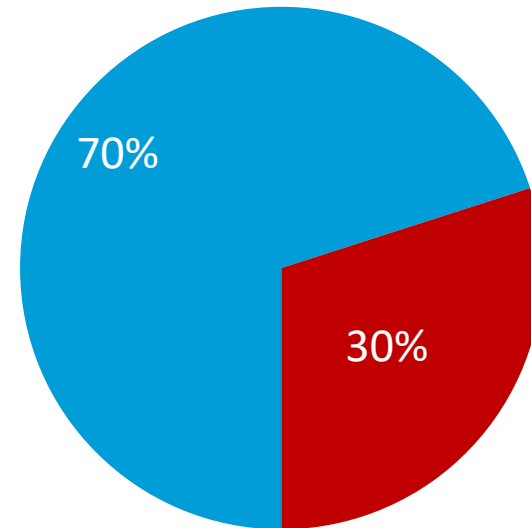
