SURVEY METHOD

This survey was conducted online within the United States from **June 14-15, 2023** among **2,090 registered voters** by **The Harris Poll and HarrisX**.

Results were weighted for age within gender, region, race/ethnicity, marital status, household size, income, employment, education, political party, and political ideology where necessary to align them with their actual proportions in the population. Propensity score weighting was also used to adjust for respondents' propensity to be online.

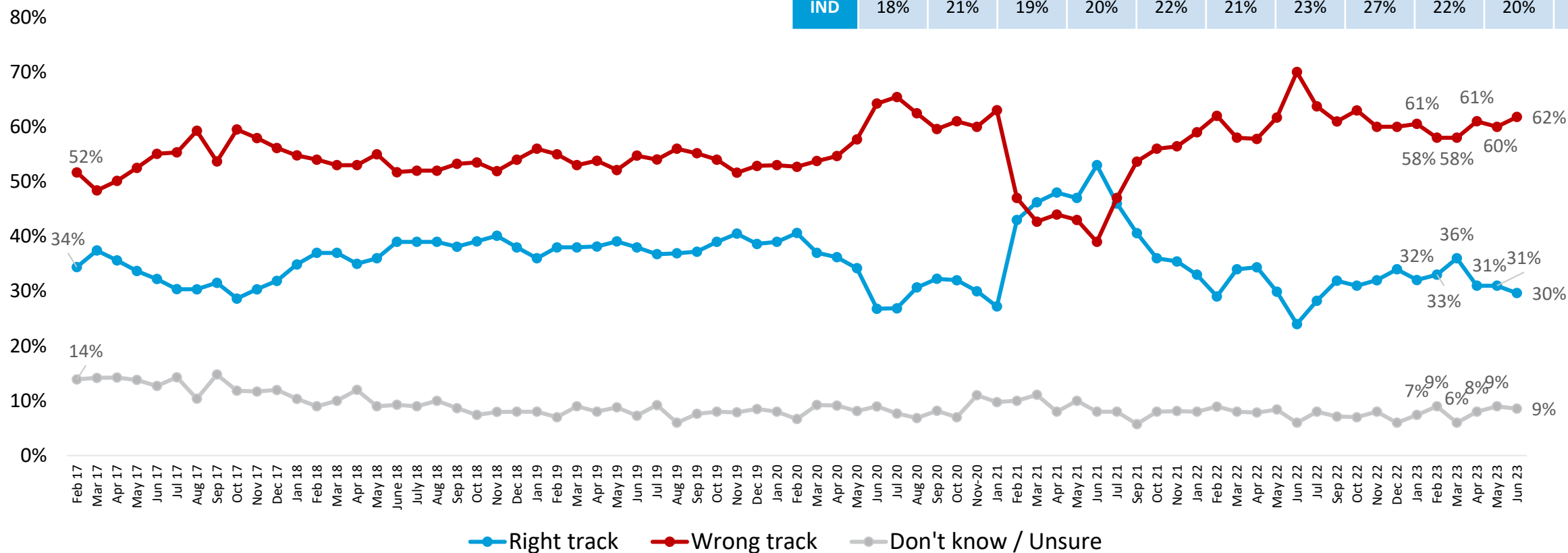

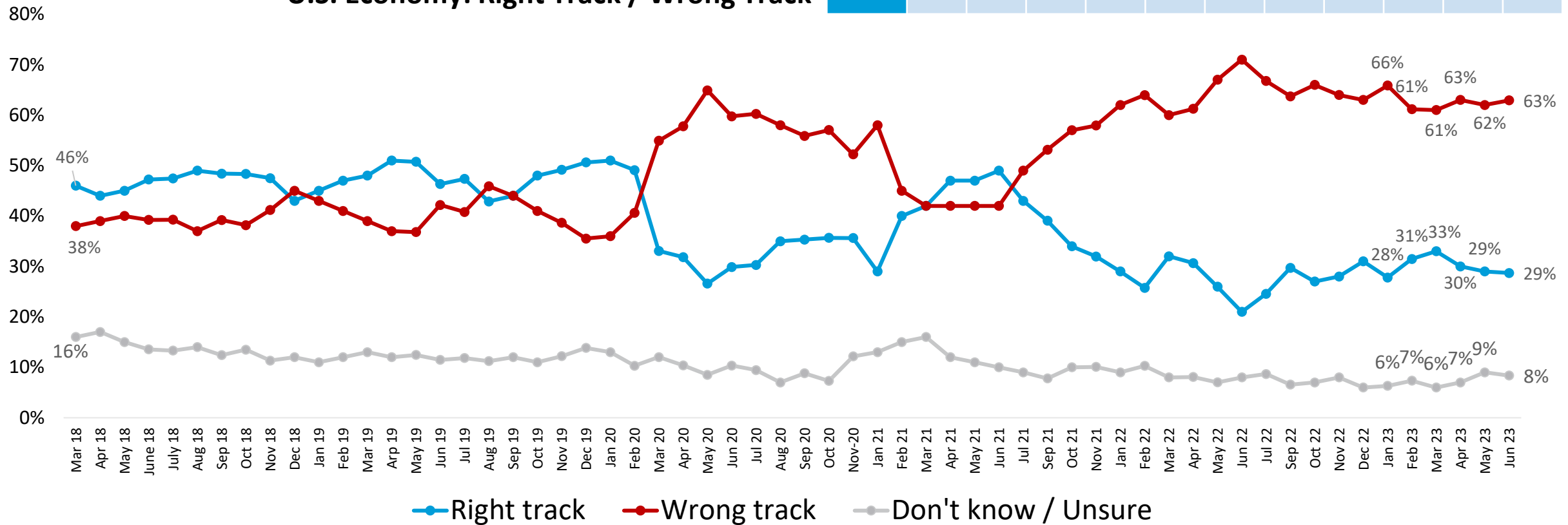

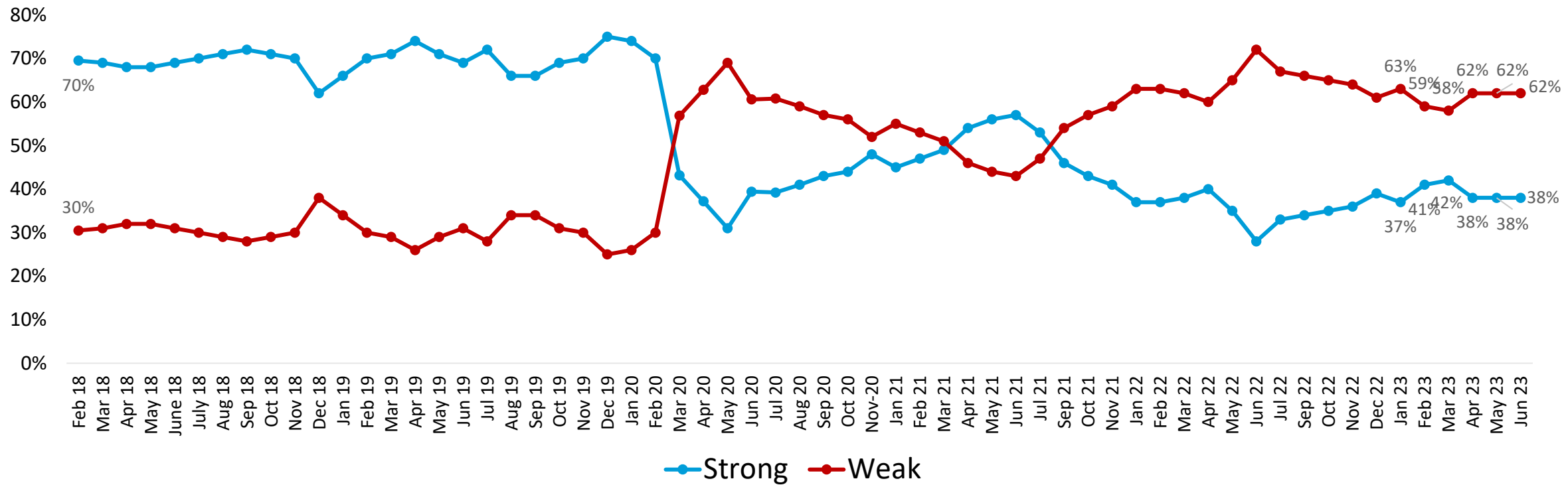

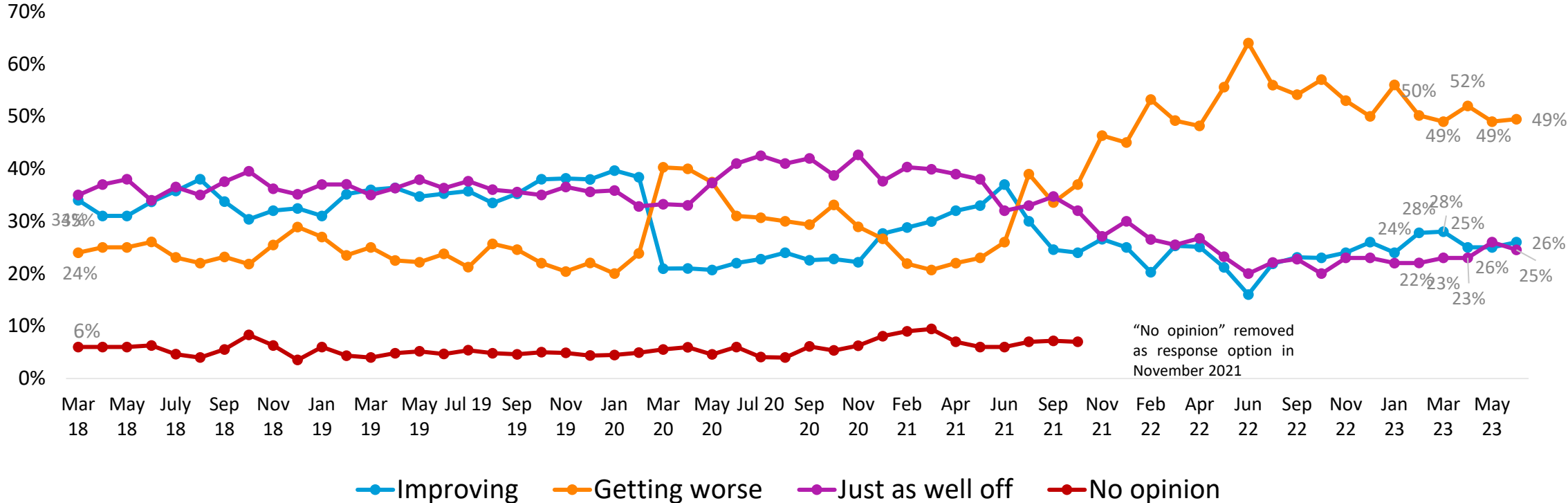
ALMOST 2 IN 3 PERCEIVE THE U.S. ECONOMY AS WEAK TODAY

How strong do you think the U.S. economy is today?



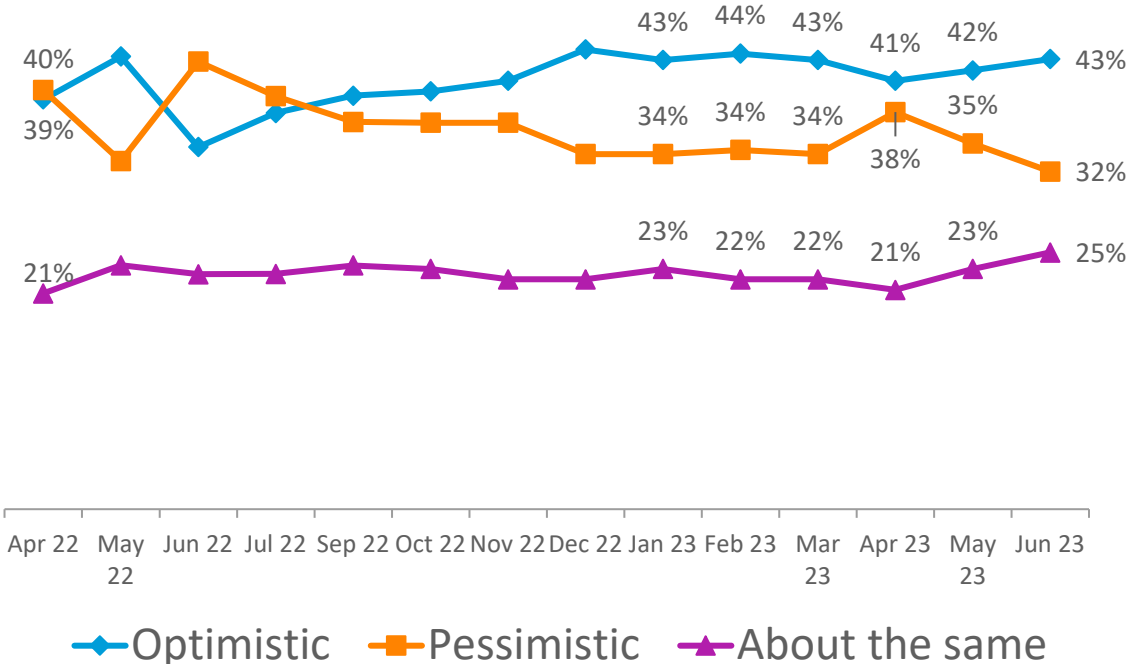
HALF OF VOTERS SAY THEIR PERSONAL FINANCIAL SITUATION IS WORSENING

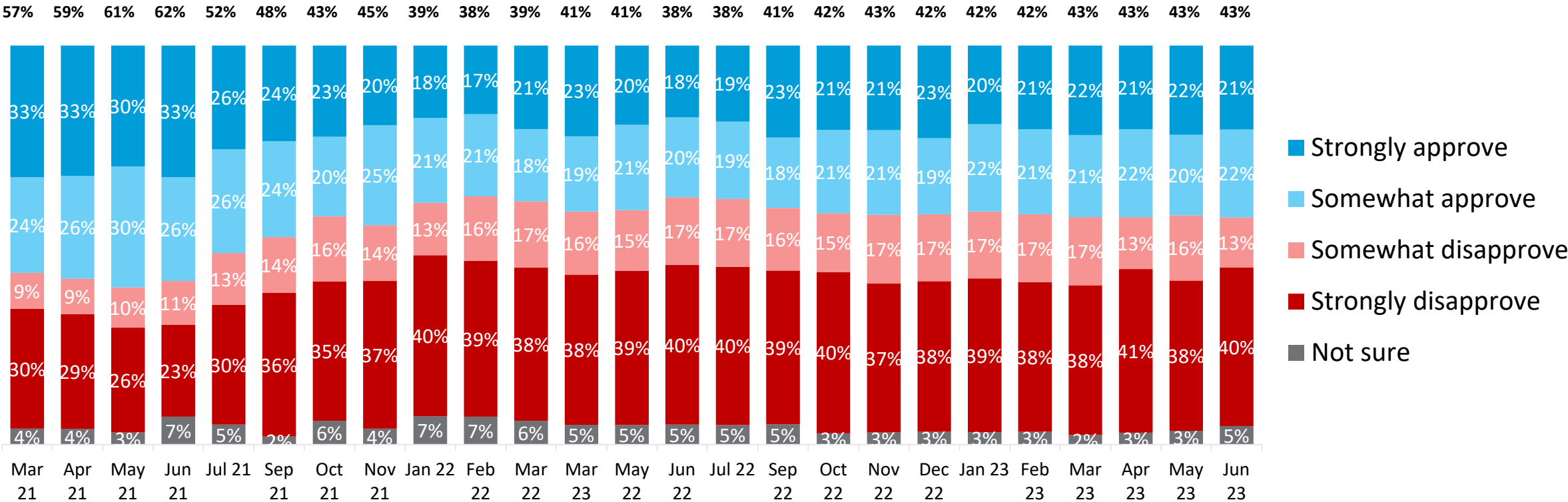

President Biden Overall Approval



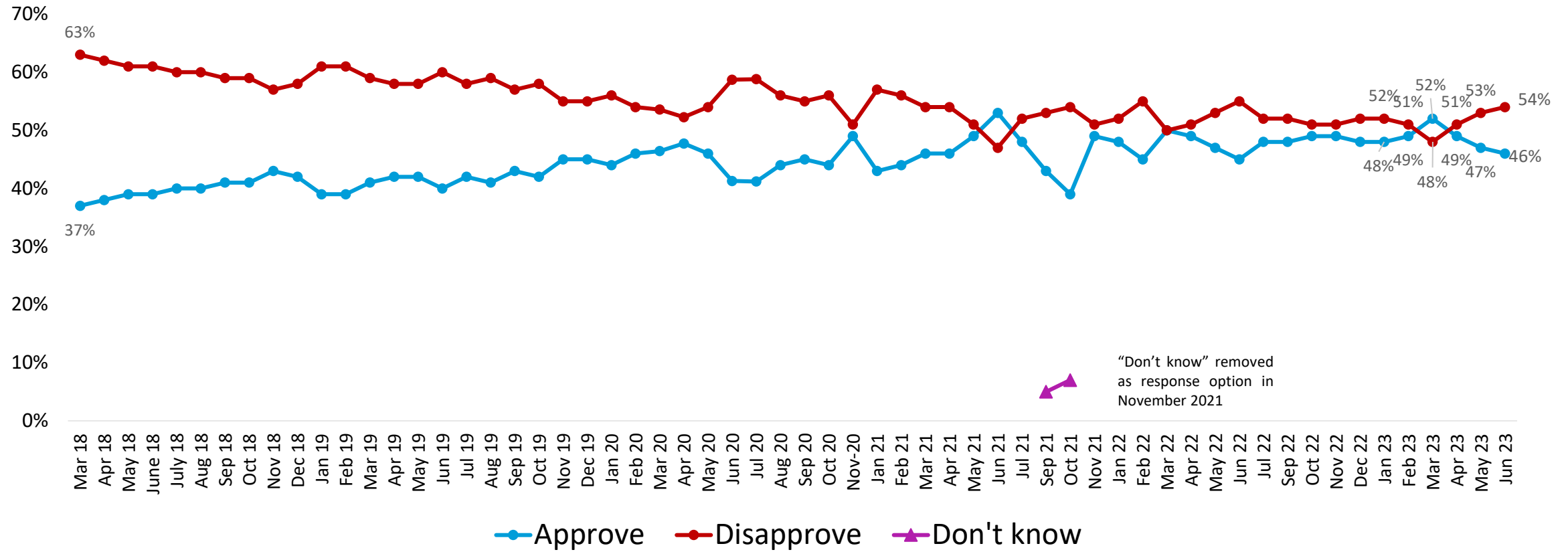

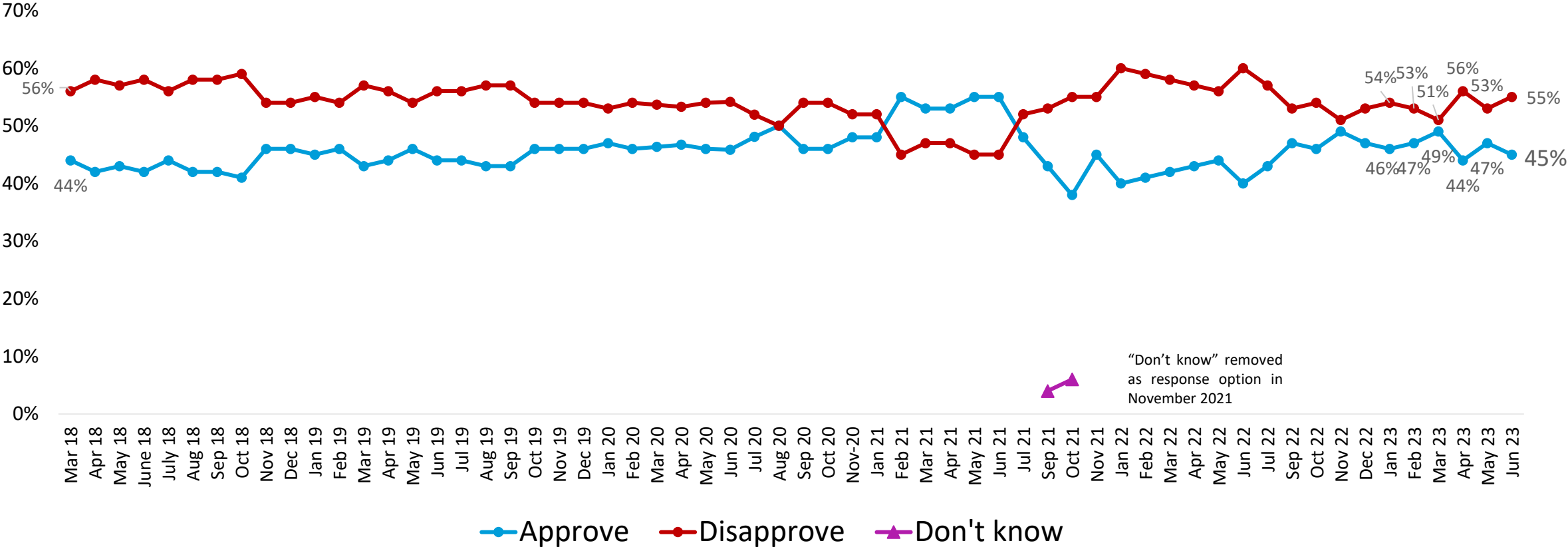

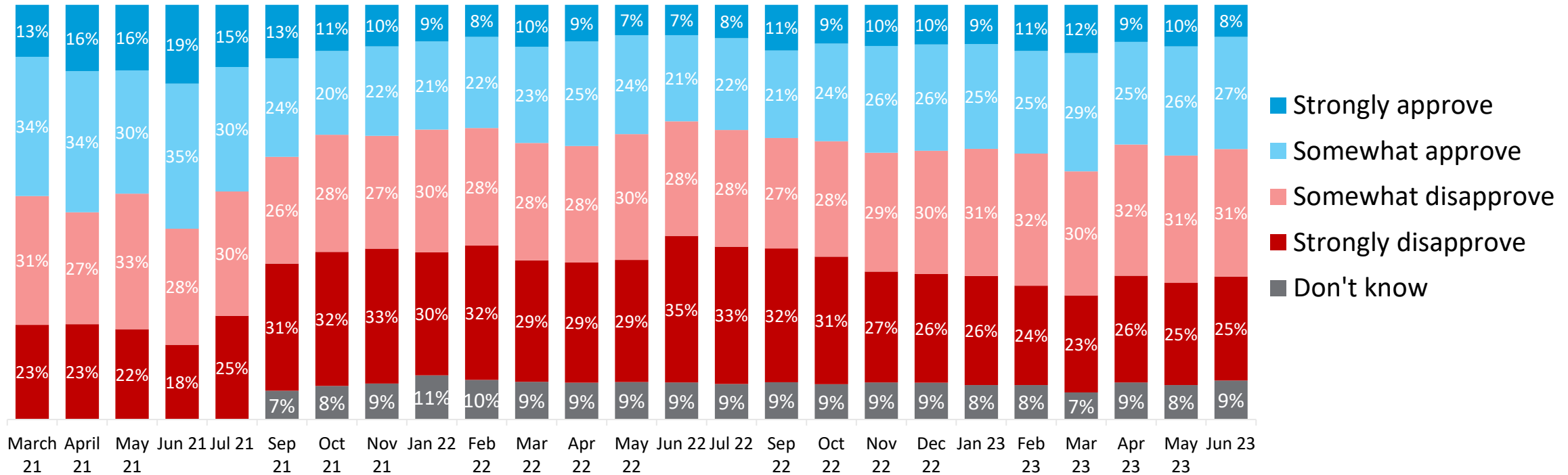

Do you approve or disapprove of the way Congress is doing its job?

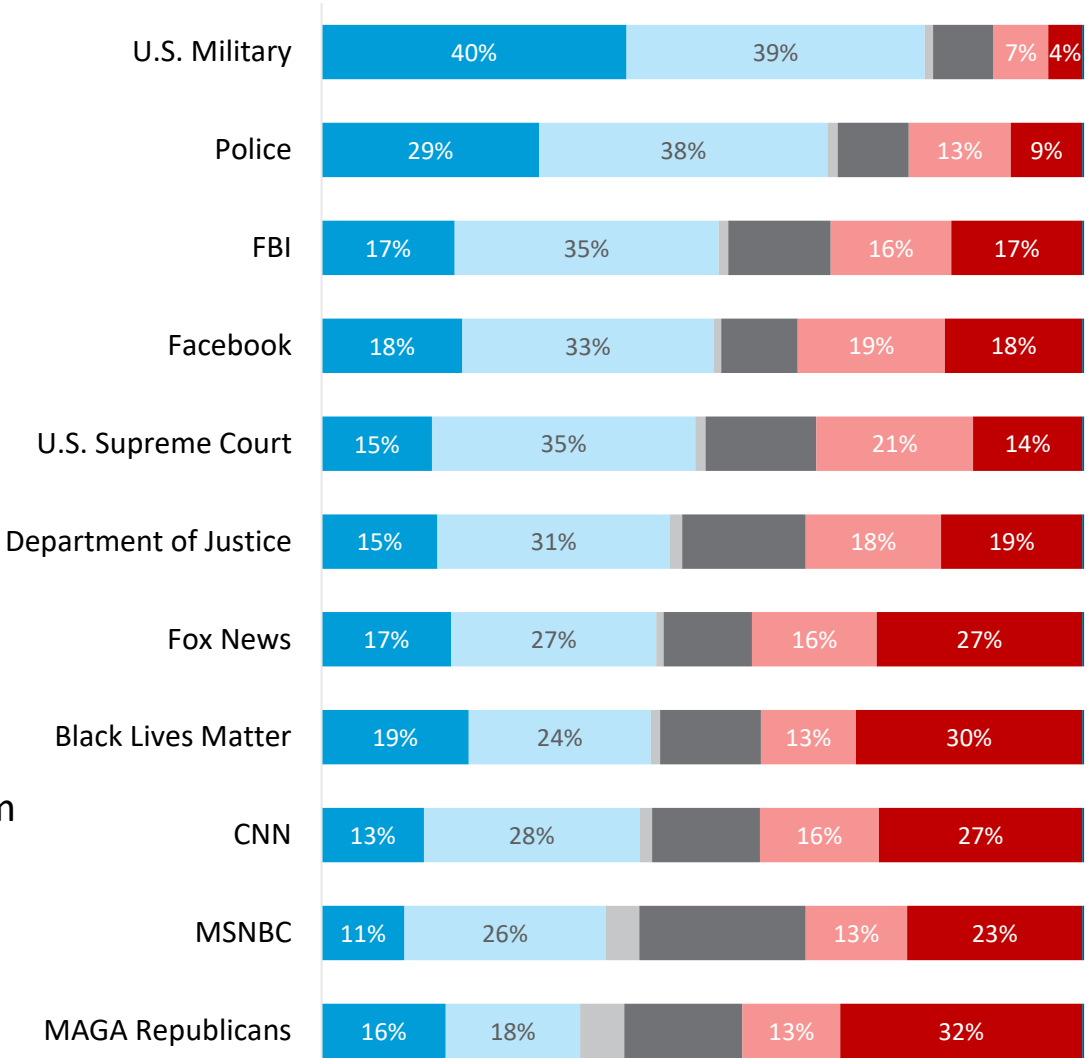

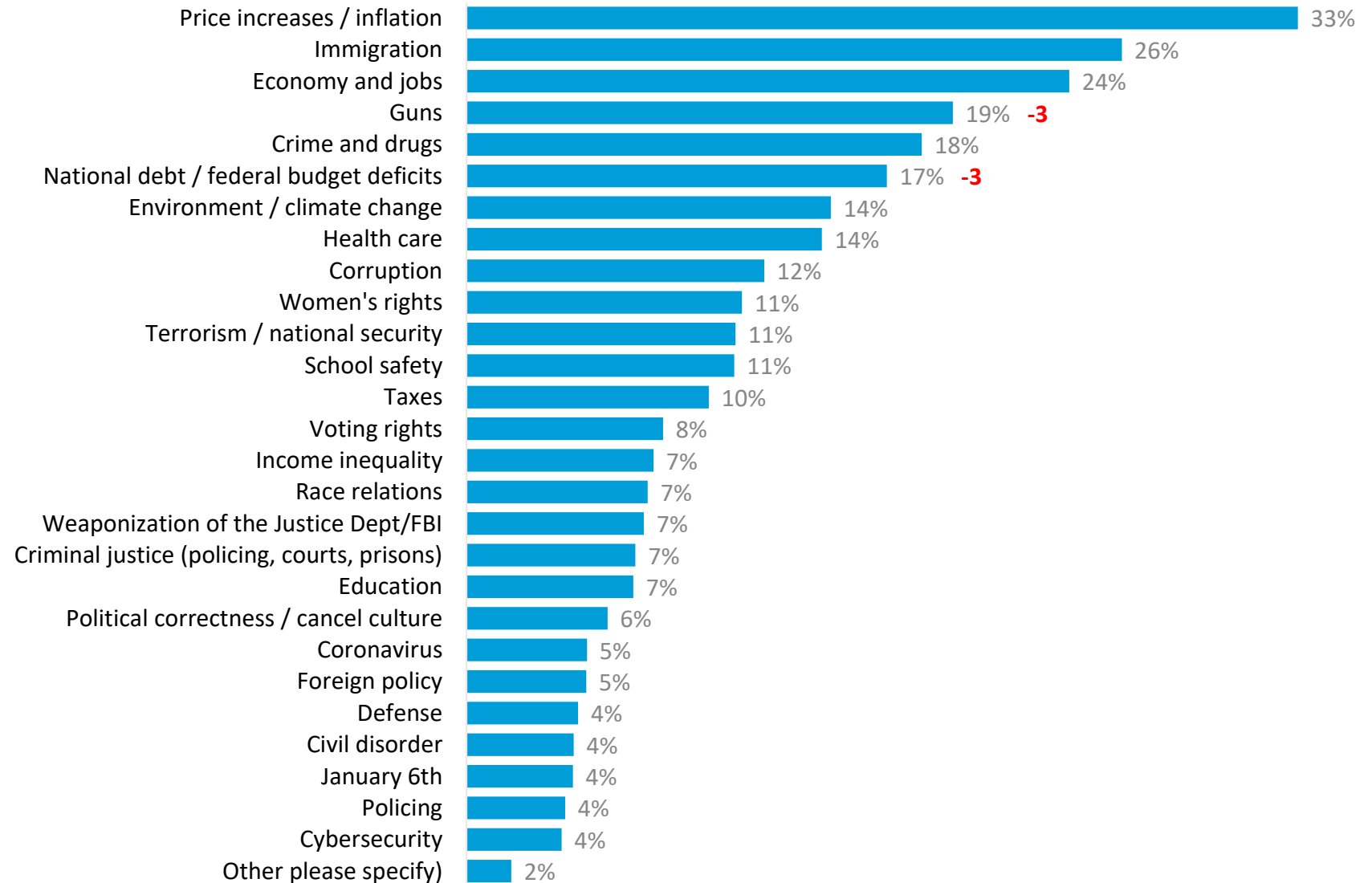

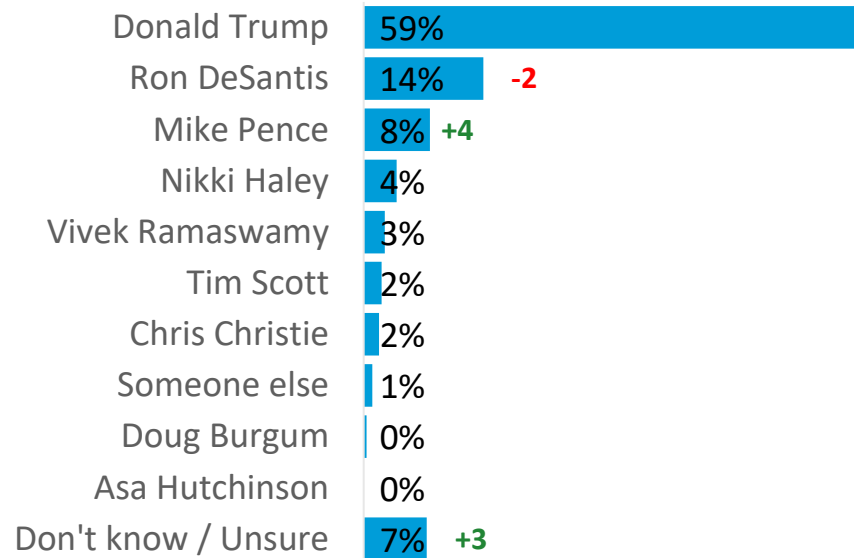
What would you say are the most important issues facing the country today?



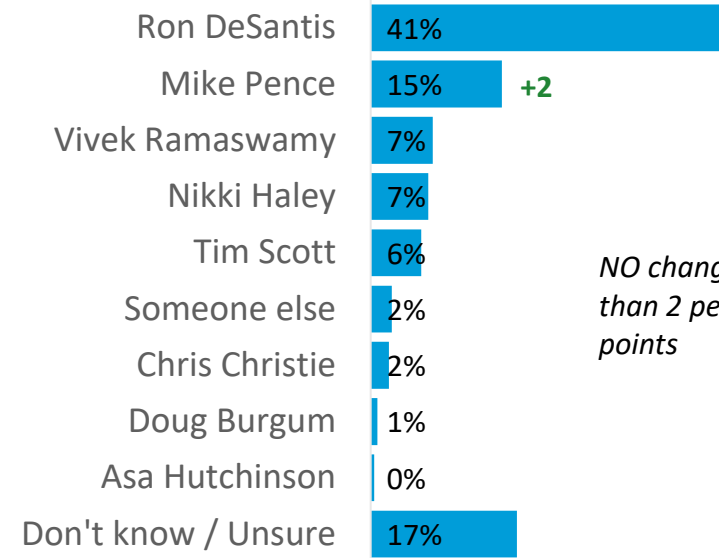

If former President Donald Trump does not run for president in 2024, who would you vote for in the GOP primary? (GOP Voters)

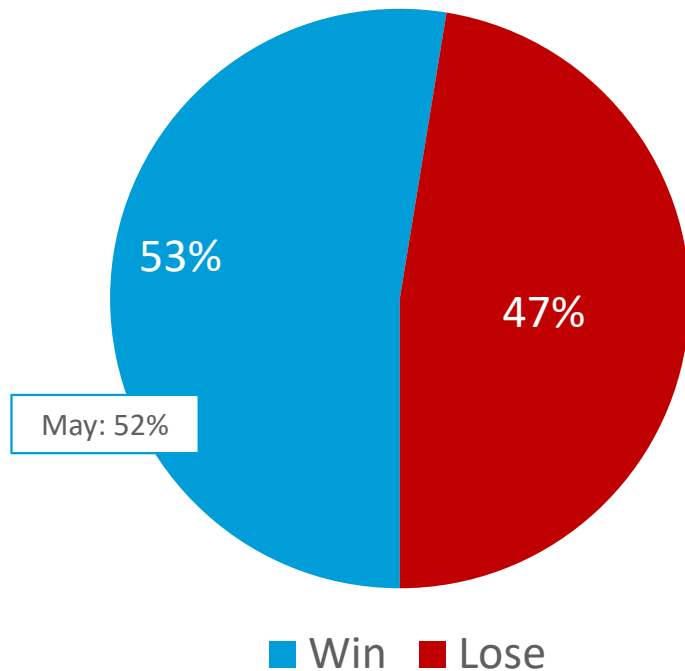

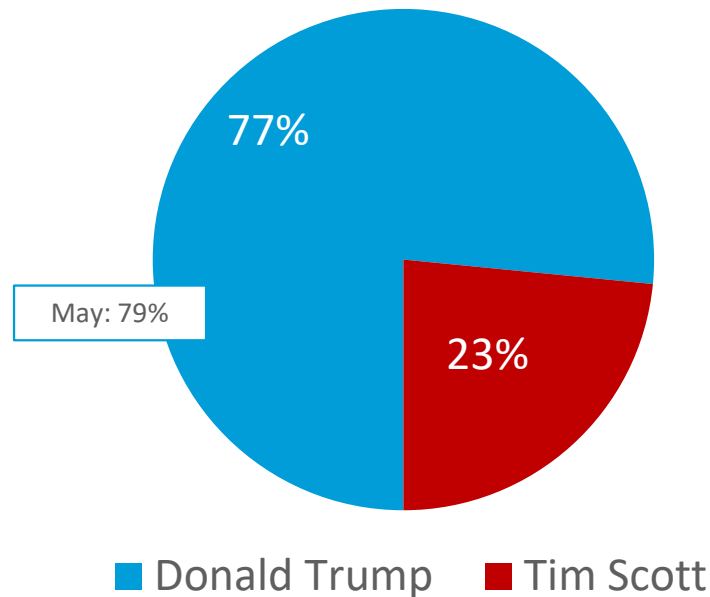

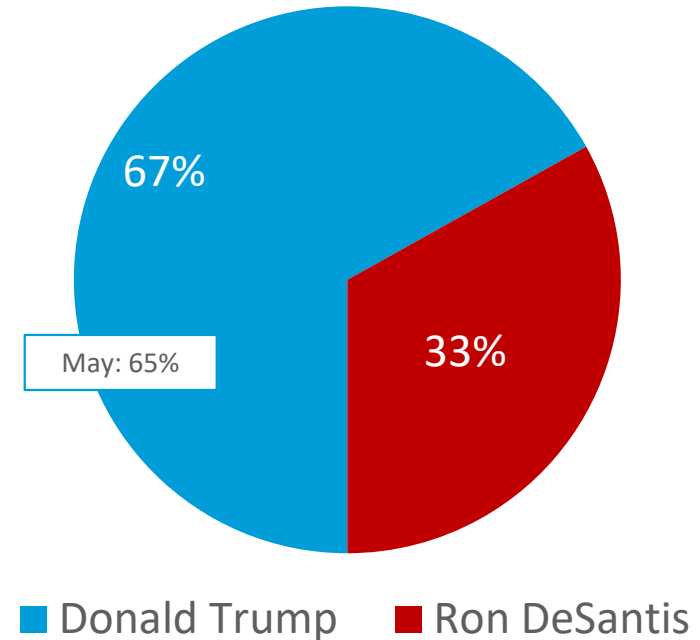

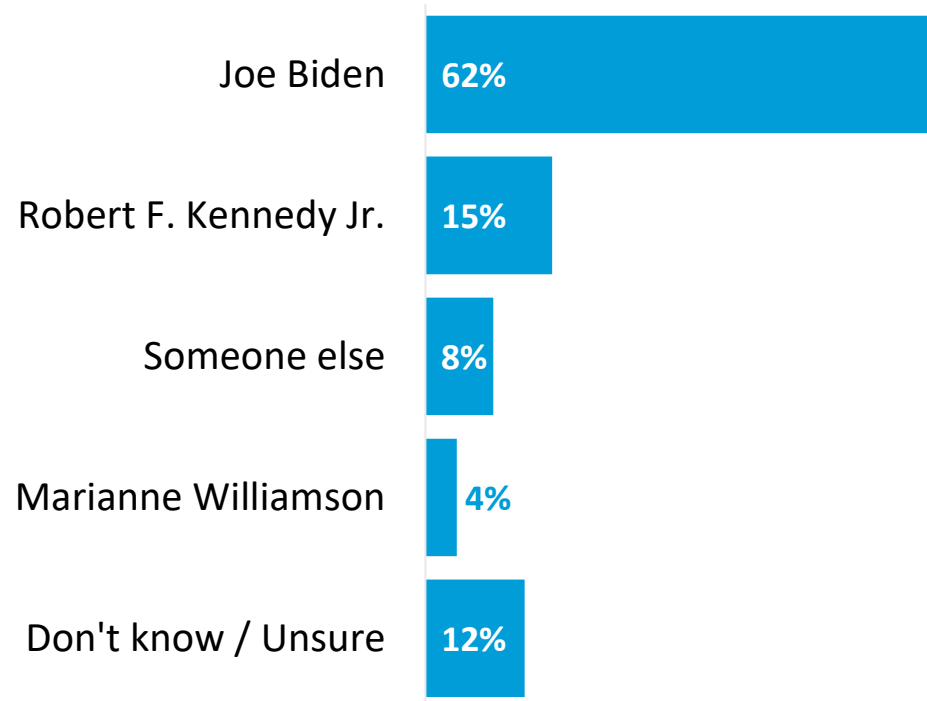

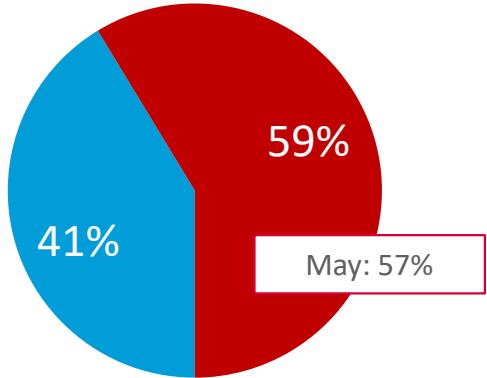

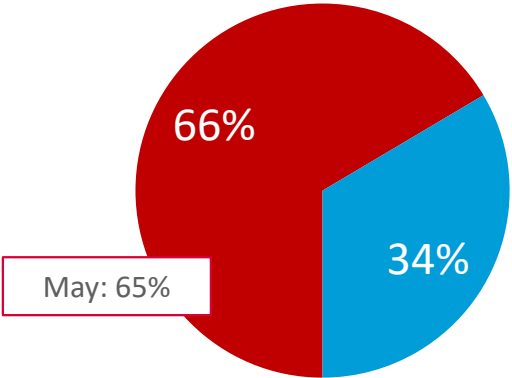

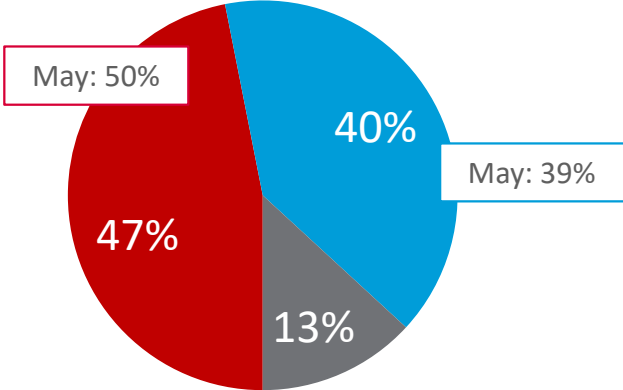

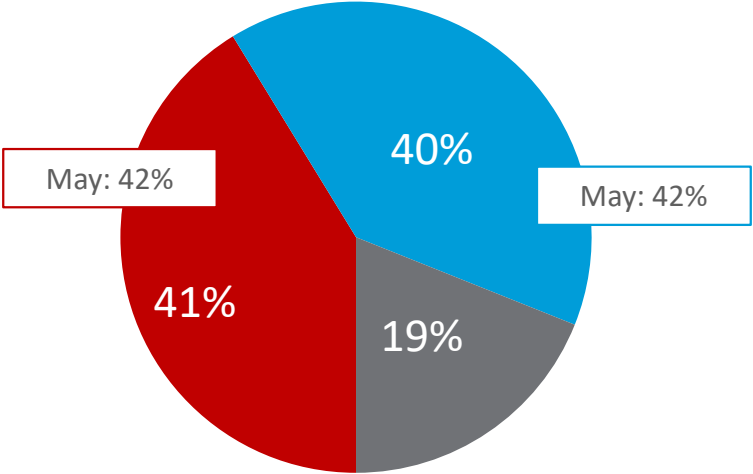

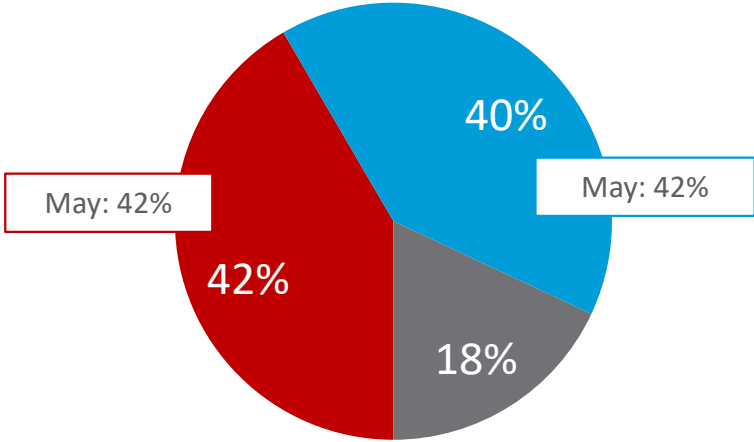

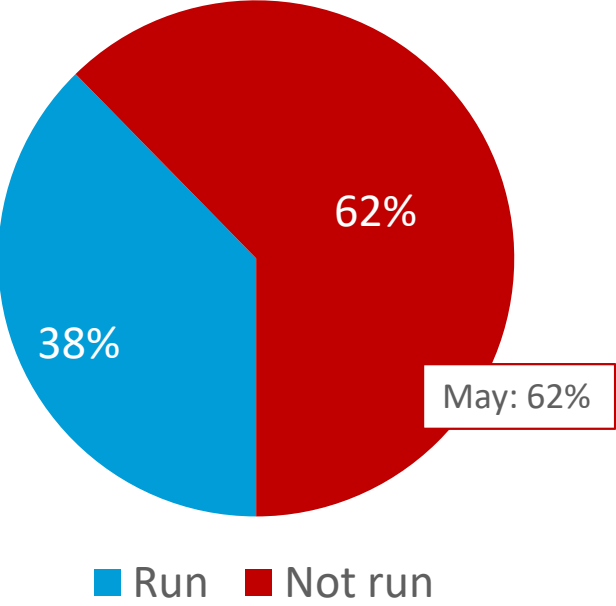

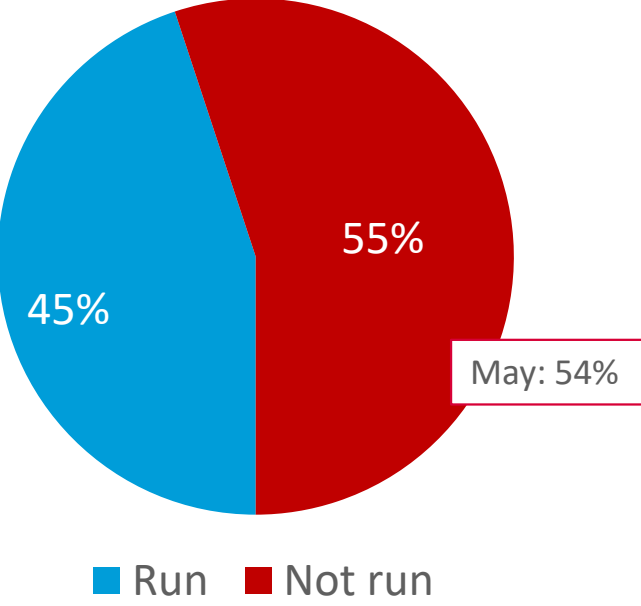

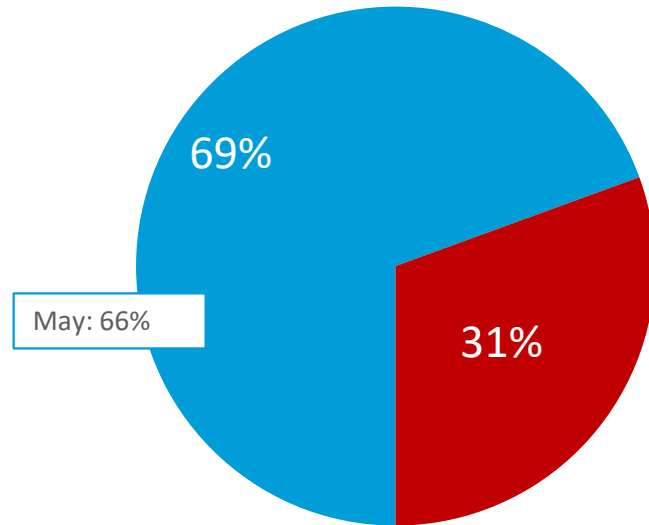

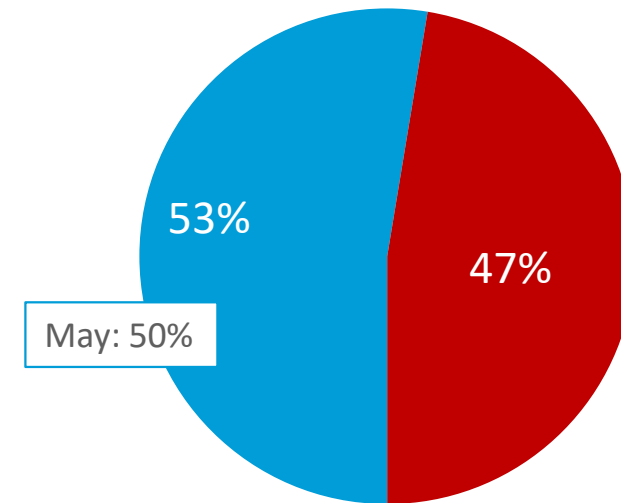

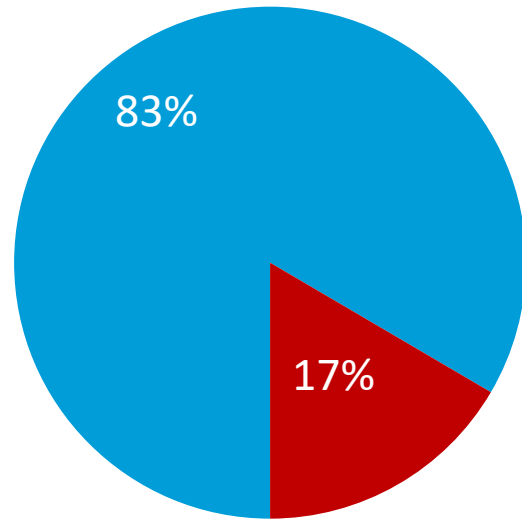

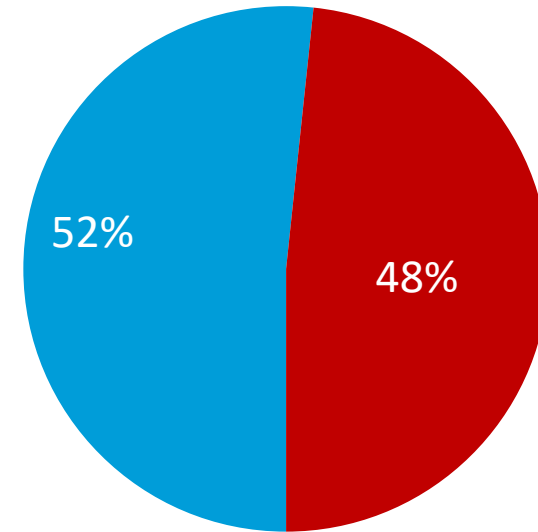

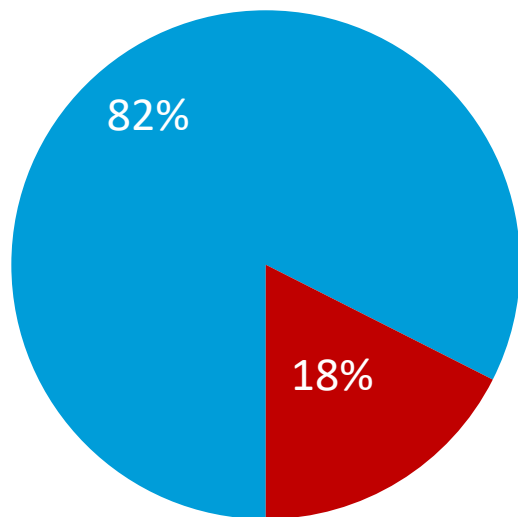

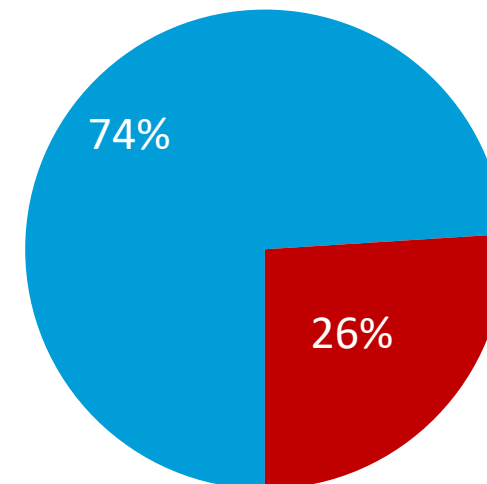

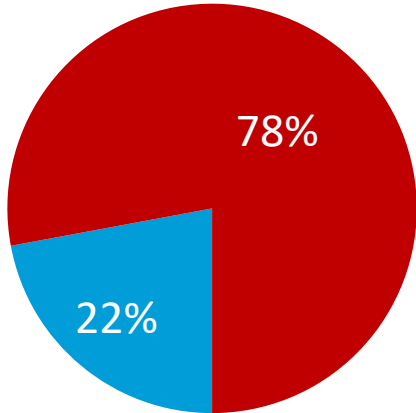

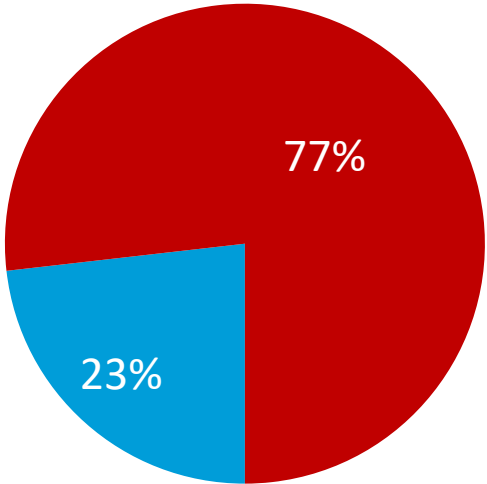

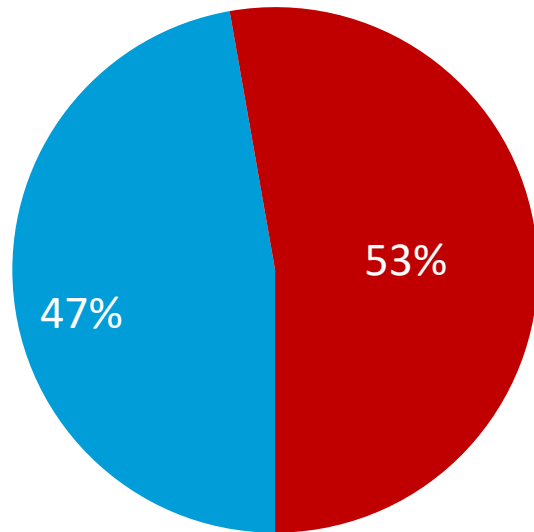

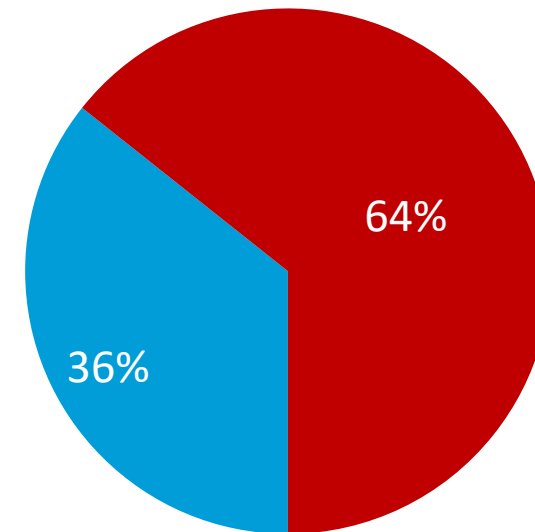

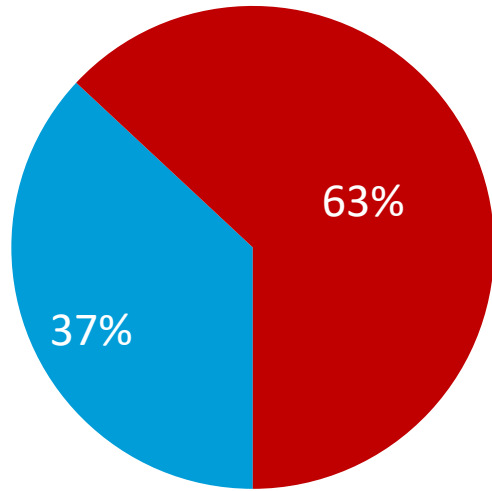

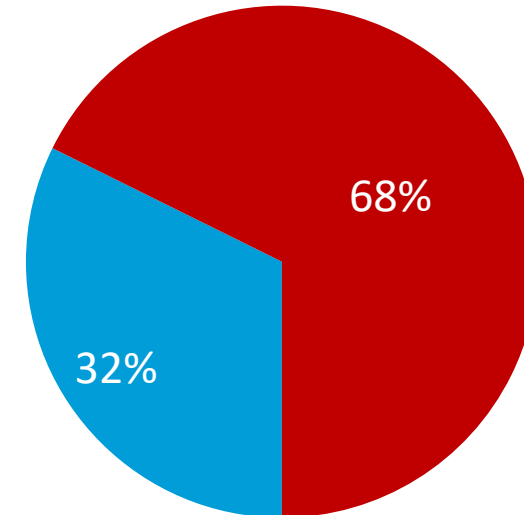

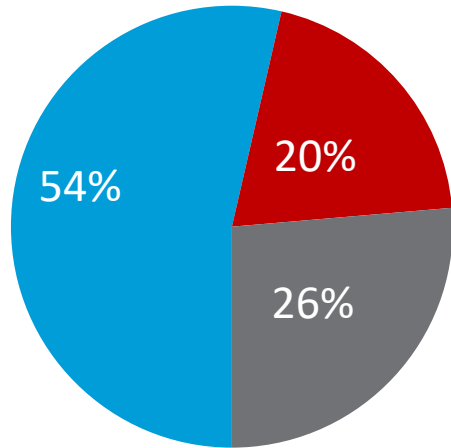

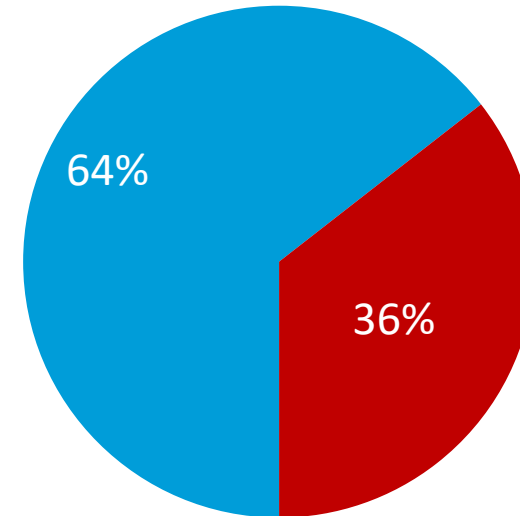

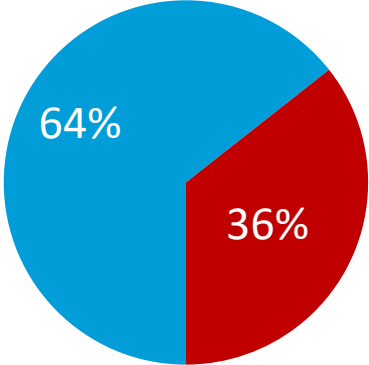

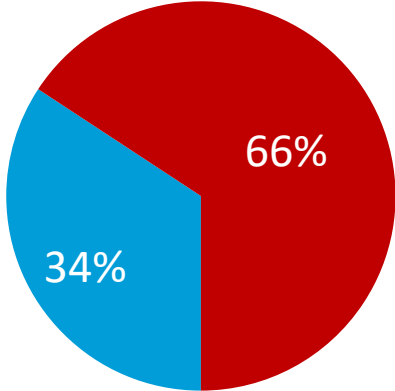

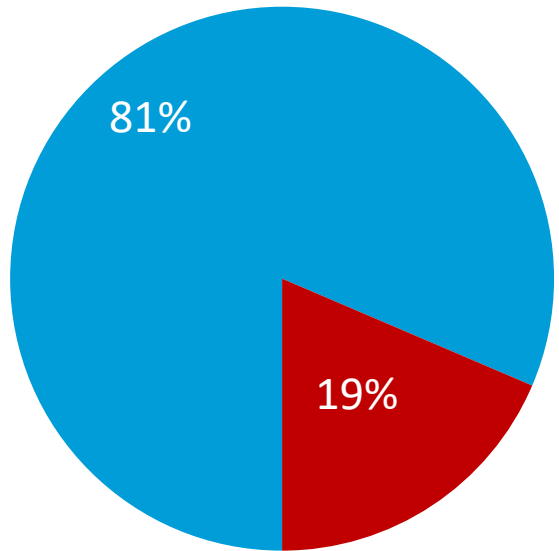

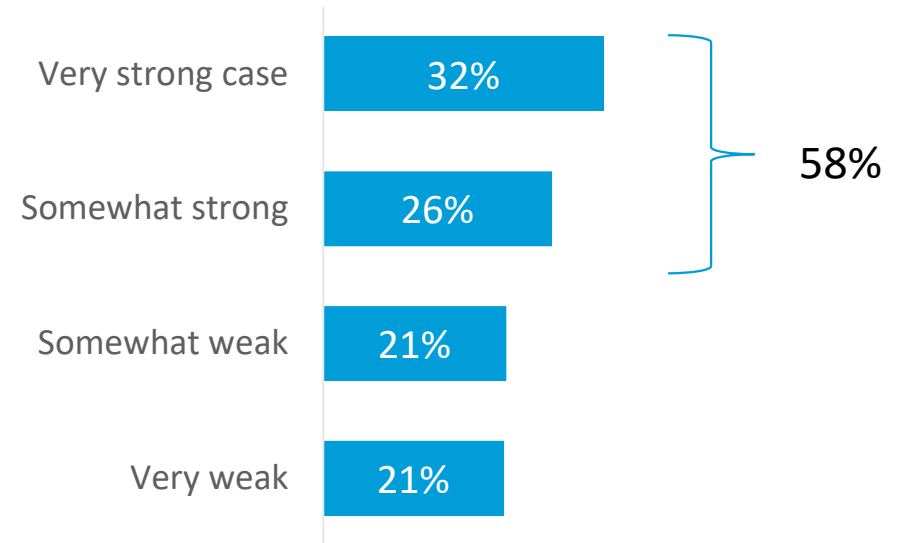

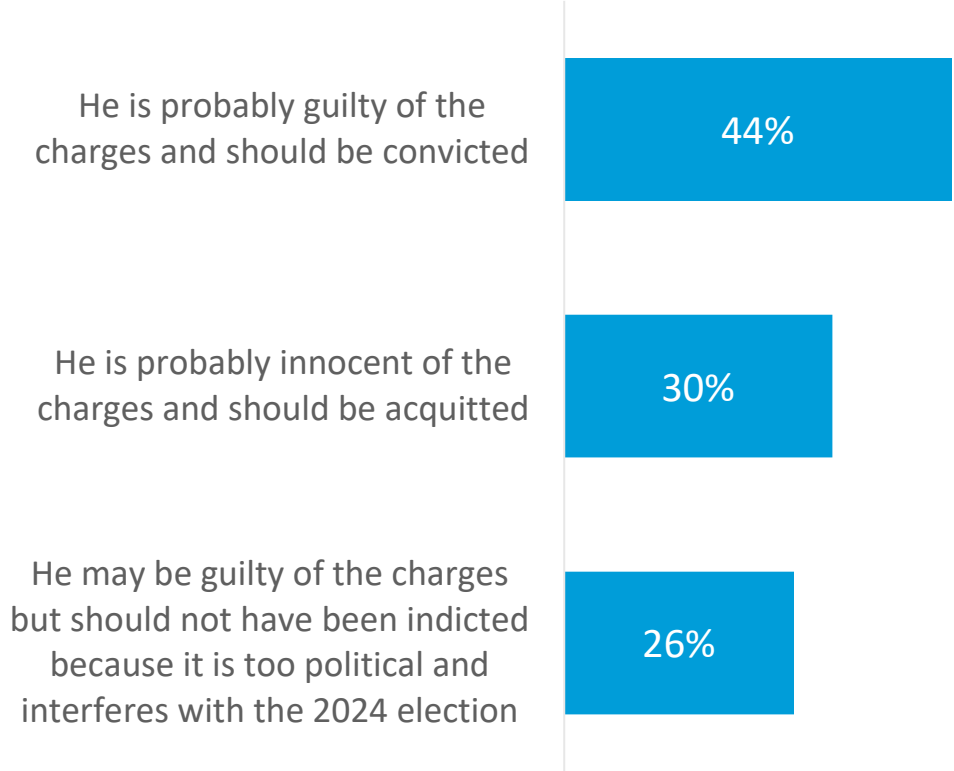

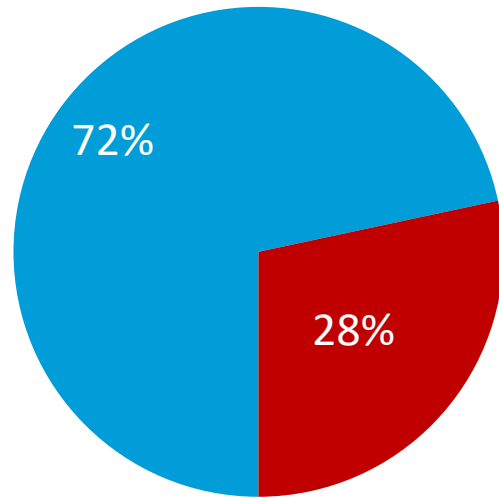

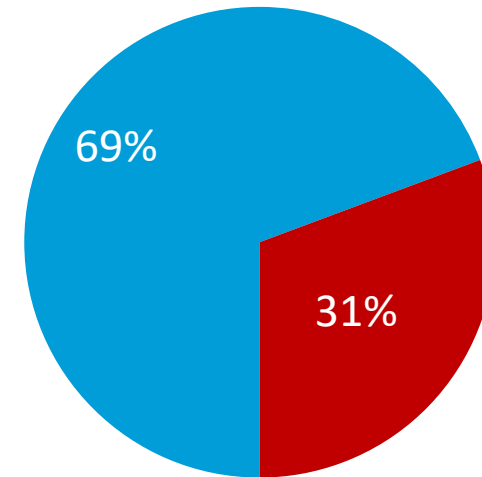

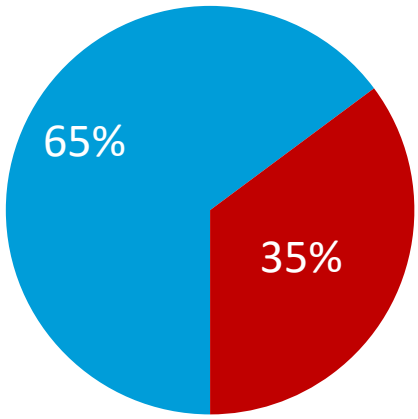

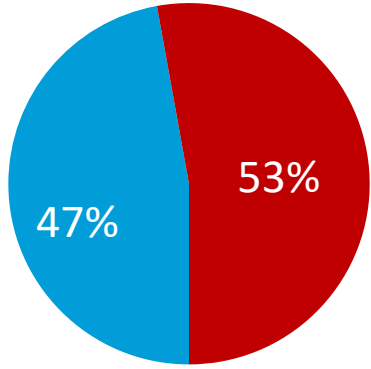

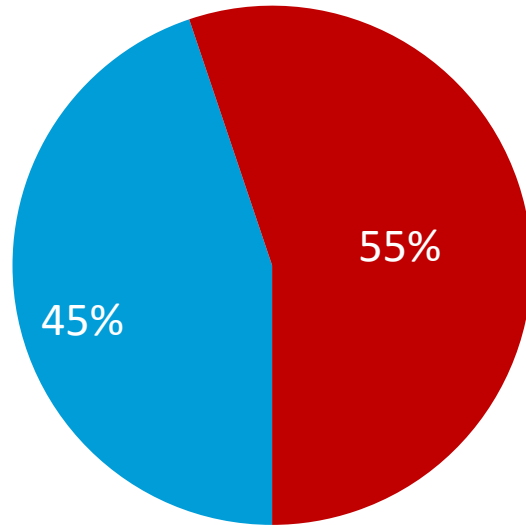

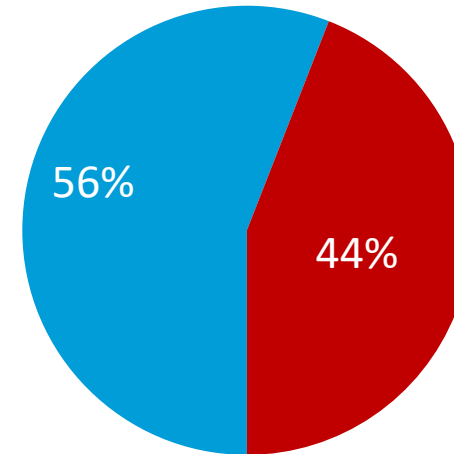

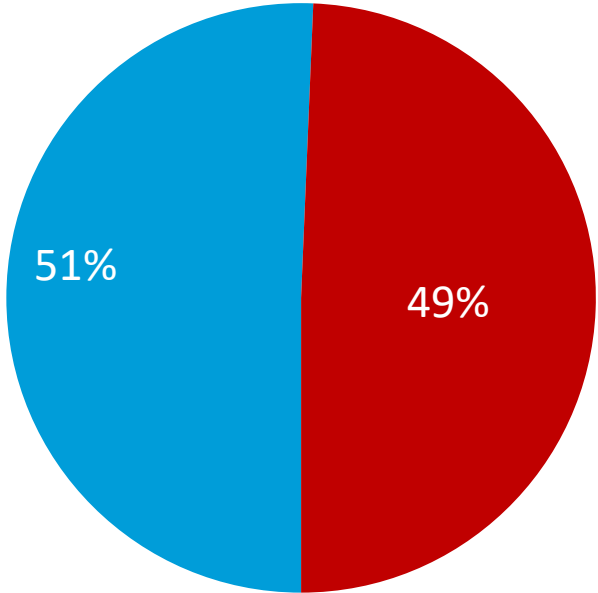

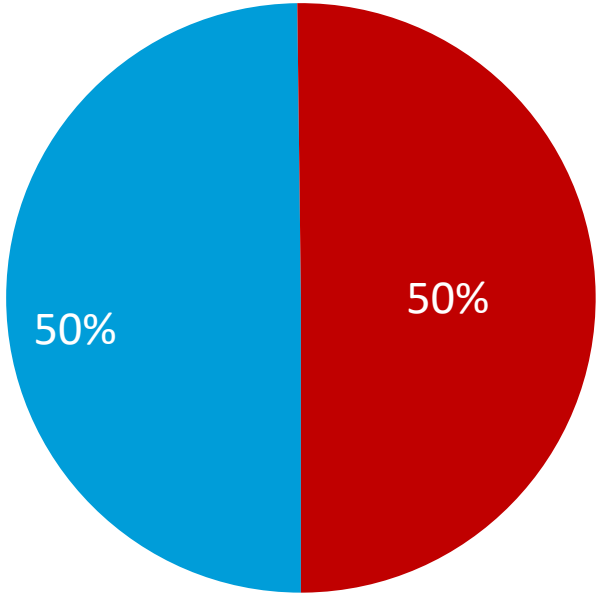

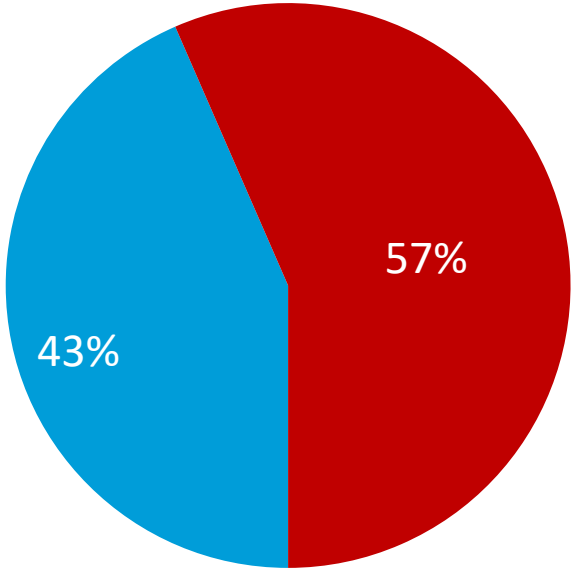

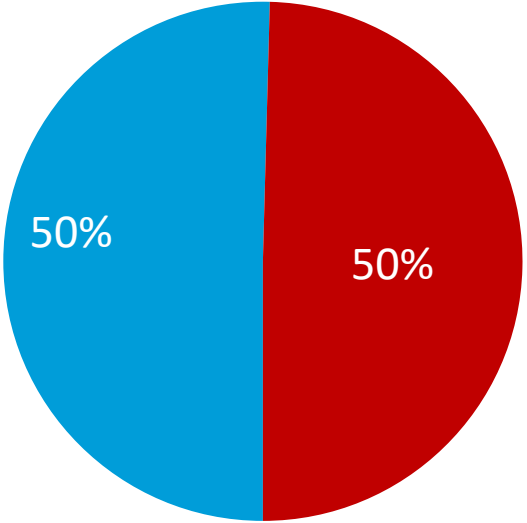

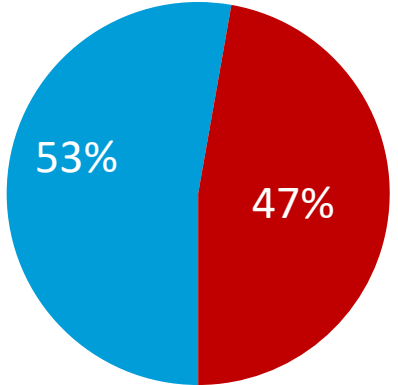

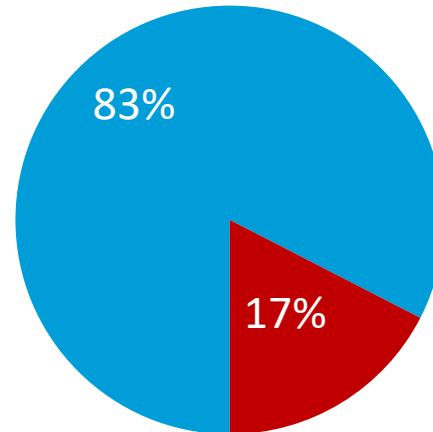

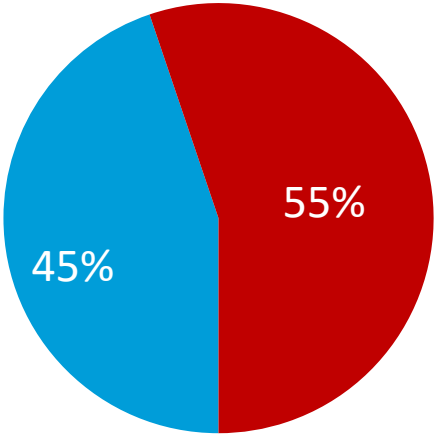

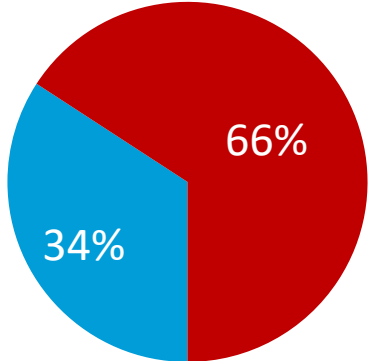

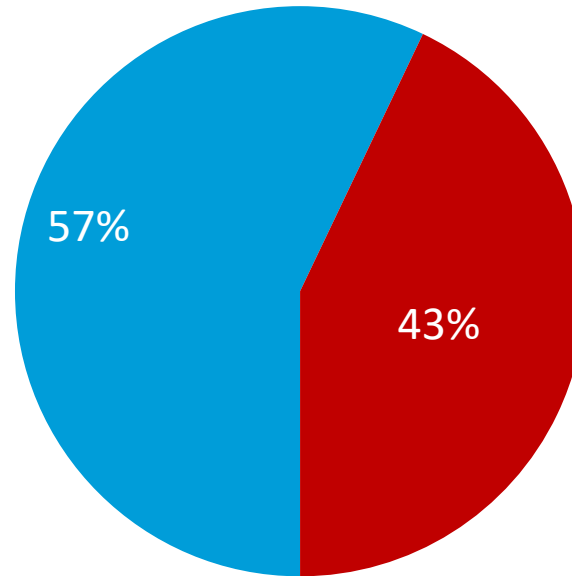

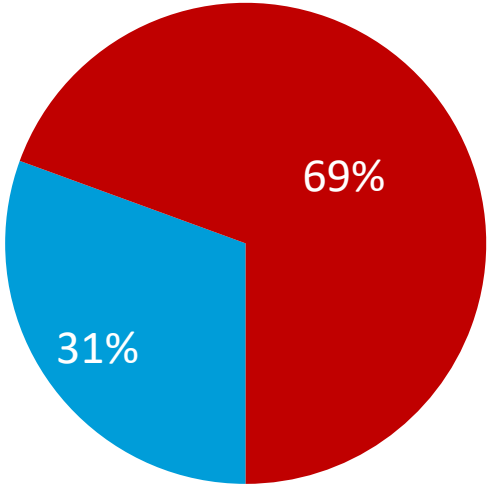

Would you favor or oppose governmental rules that would virtually eliminate gas stoves from kitchens?



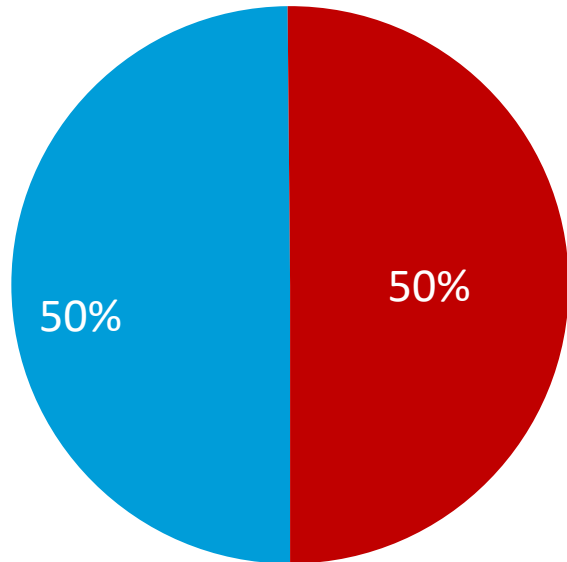

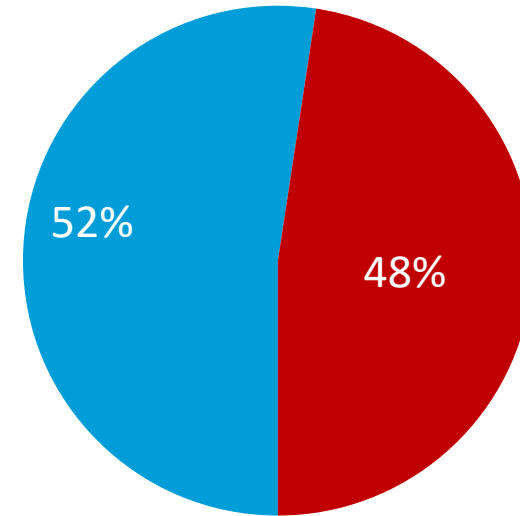

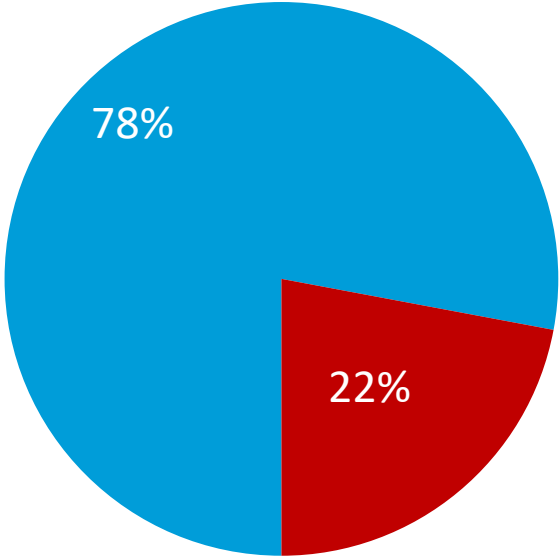

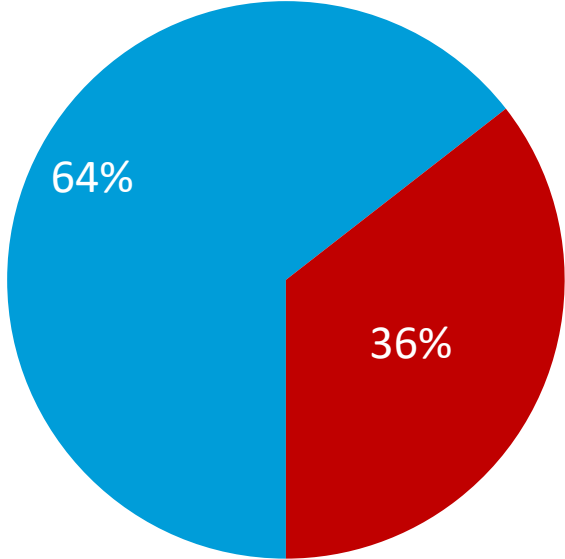

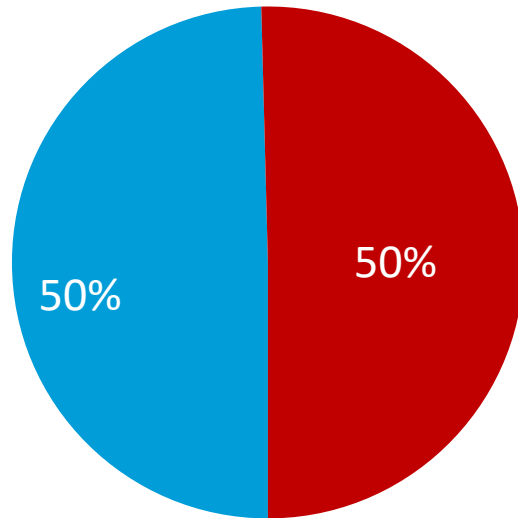

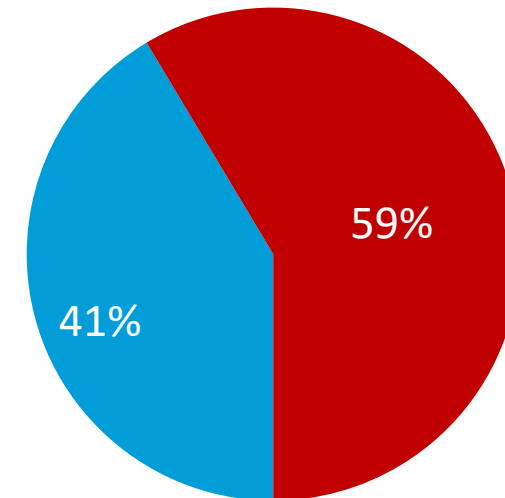

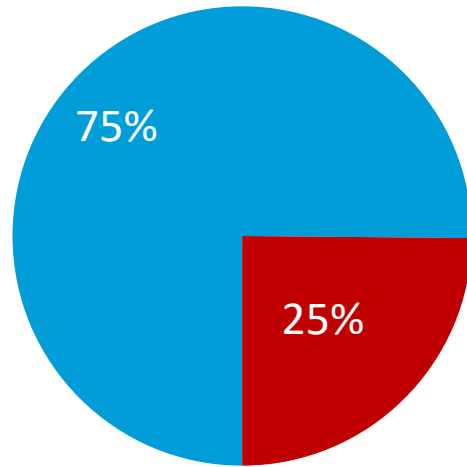

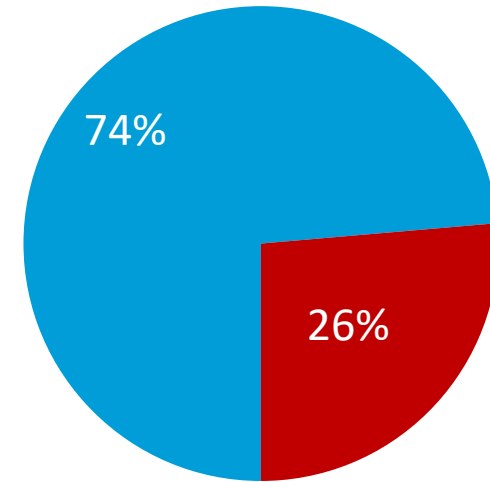

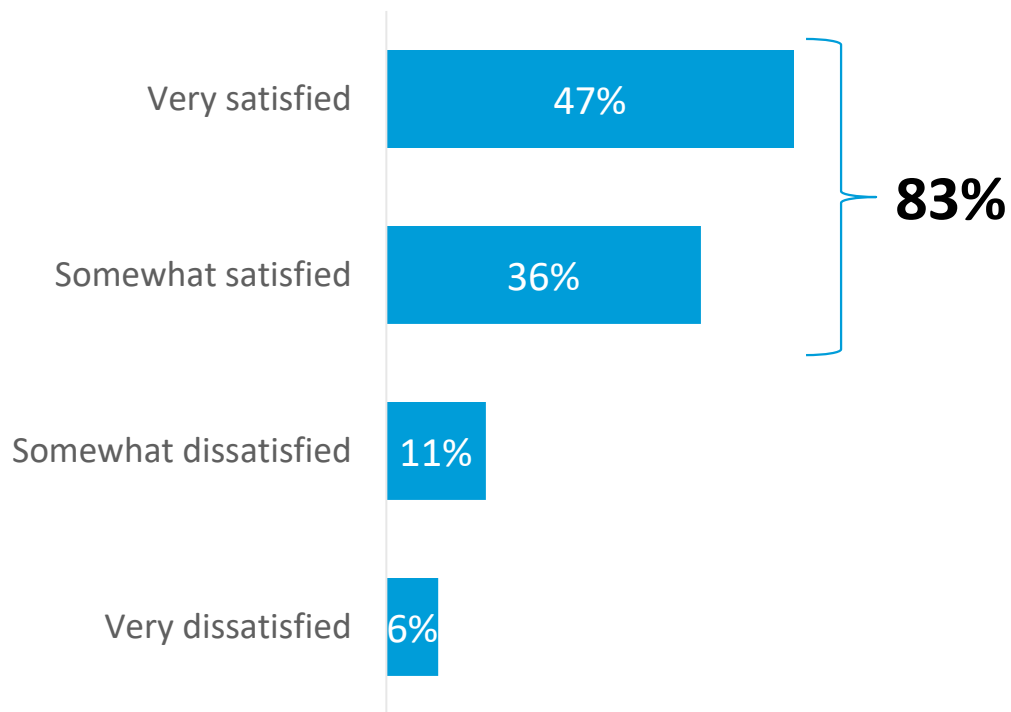

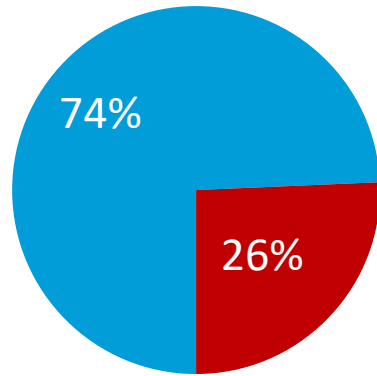

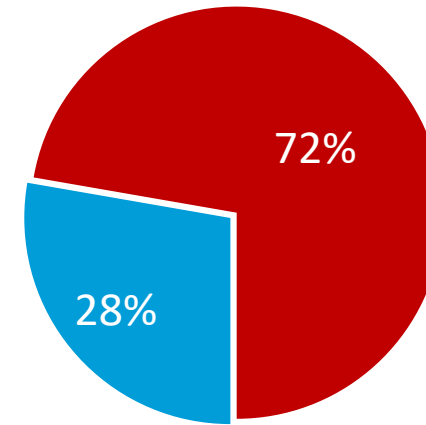

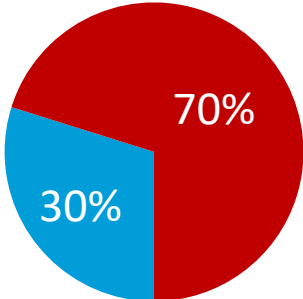

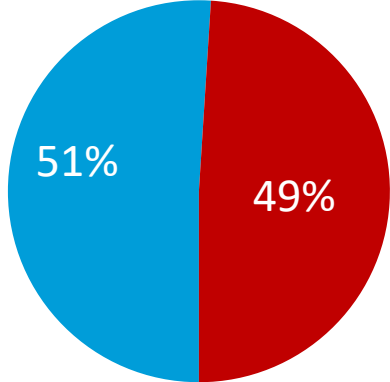

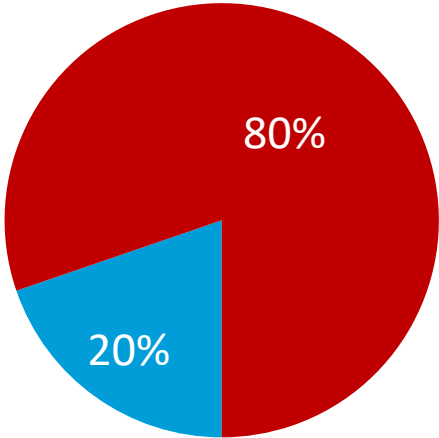

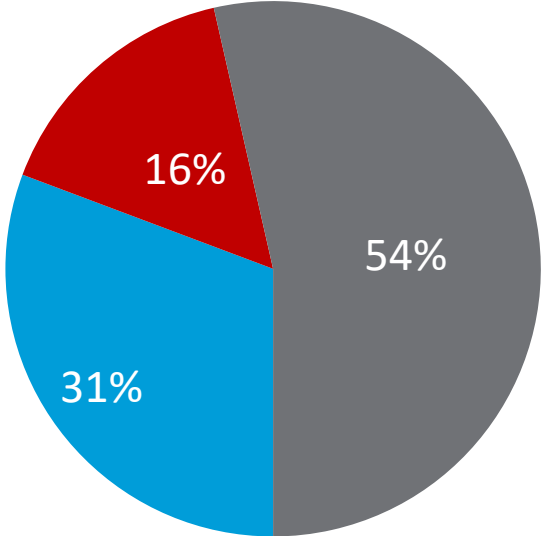

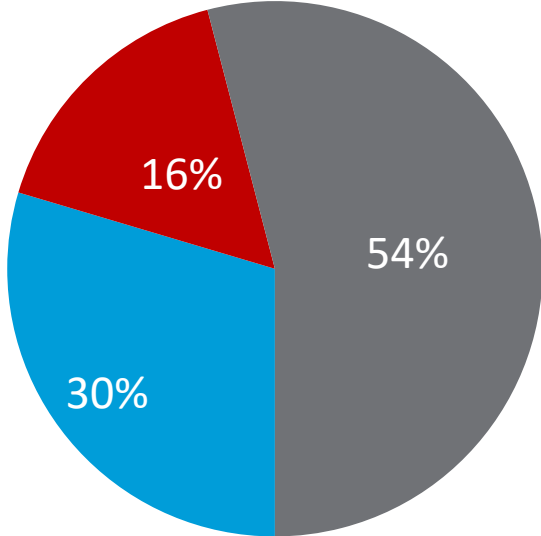

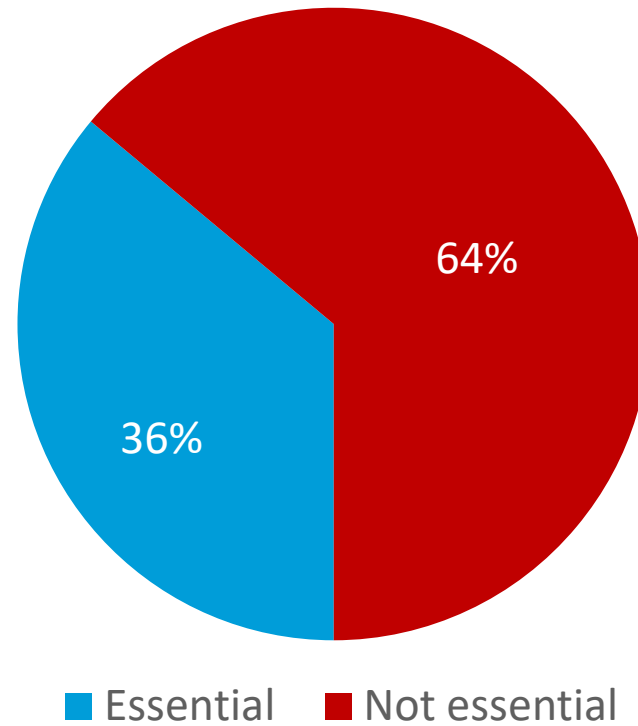
