

Field Dates: September 13-14, 2023



This survey was conducted online within the United States from September 12-14, 2023 among **2,103** registered voters by The Harris Poll and HarrisX.

Results were weighted for age within gender, region, race/ethnicity, marital status, household size, income, employment, education, political party, and political ideology where necessary to align them with their actual proportions in the population. Propensity score weighting was also used to adjust for respondents' propensity to be online.






PERCEPTION OF THE U.S. ECONOMY REMAINS LOW AS WELL




How strong do you think the U.S. economy is today?



HALF OF VOTERS SAY THEIR PERSONAL FINANCIAL SITUATION IS GETTING WORSE




Would you say that your personal financial situation is improving or getting worse?


In general, are you feeling optimistic or pessimistic about your life over the next year?







Do you think the U.S. is in a recession now, will be in a recession in the next year or most likely will avoid a recession?










Do you approve or disapprove of the way Congress is doing its job?





Which of these issues is most important to you personally?








Is Joe Biden mentally fit to serve as President of the United States or do you have doubts about his fitness for office?




If the Republican presidential primary for the 2024 election was held today, who would you vote for?















If the Republican presidential primary for the 2024 election was held today, who would you vote for?




If the Democratic presidential primary for the 2024 election was held today, who would you vote for?

If President Biden decides not to run again in 2024, who would you prefer to be the Democratic candidate?






















Do you support or oppose House Speaker Kevin McCarthy opening a formal impeachment inquiry into President Biden?




Do you think Joe Biden had direct and detailed knowledge of his son's business dealings or not?

Do you think to date Joe Biden has made false or misleading statements about his son's business dealings, and what he knew about them, or not?





Do you think president Biden's impeachment inquiry raises legitimate legal questions or is it mostly politically motivated?













Do you think the Federal Reserve has raised interest rates enough or needs to raise them more to deal with inflation?



Is Bidenomics working or not working?








Is illegal immigration to the United States getting better or worse?



Do you favor or oppose sanctuary cities that limit or deny cooperation with federal agencies in enforcing immigration law?








