

This survey was conducted online within the United States from October 18-19, 2023 among **2,116** registered voters by The Harris Poll and HarrisX.

Results were weighted for age within gender, region, race/ethnicity, marital status, household size, income, employment, education, political party, and political ideology where necessary to align them with their actual proportions in the population. Propensity score weighting was also used to adjust for respondents' propensity to be online. The margin of error for the poll is +/- 2%.






How strong do you think the U.S. economy is today?


Would you say that your personal financial situation is improving or getting worse?


In general, are you feeling optimistic or pessimistic about your life over the next year?







Do you think the U.S. is in a recession now, will be in a recession in the next year or most likely will avoid a recession?










DEMOCRATIC PARTY APPROVAL ALSO UNDERWATER, BUT IMPROVED +4PT SINCE LAST MONTH




Do you approve or disapprove of the way Congress is doing its job?


RFK JR., NETANYAHU, HALEY, AND MUSK HAVE HIGHEST NET FAVORABILITY














Is Joe Biden mentally fit to serve as President of the United States or do you have doubts about his fitness for office? (Split sample)






If the Republican presidential primary for the 2024 election was held today, who would you vote for?

If former President Donald Trump does not run for president in 2024, who would you vote for in the GOP primary?



Do you think Donald Trump will win or lose the Republican primary for president?






If the Republican presidential primary for the 2024 election was held today, who would you vote for? Among GOP Voters





If President Biden decides not to run again in 2024, who would you prefer to be the Democratic candidate?
















































Do you think the recent attack focused on the Israeli military or indiscriminately targeted civilians?






Do you think Hamas fighters are more appropriately called militants or terrorists?






Do you think Hamas is designated as a terrorist group by the U.S. government or is that not the case?














Do you strongly approve, somewhat approve, somewhat disapprove or strongly disapprove of Joe Biden's Israel policy?










Does Israel have a responsibility to protect its citizens from terrorist attacks and rockets by retaliating against Hamas terrorists or not?




A SMALL MAJORITY THINK THAT HAMAS RATHER THAN ISRAEL RULES GAZA






Do you think Israel should eliminate Hamas or agree instead to end its campaign now?

Do you think it was right or wrong for Israel to cutoff power, water, and food to Gaza until its hostages are returned?






Do you approve or disapprove of the decision by Israel, at urging of President Biden, to provide food and water to Gaza even while hostages are still being held?










Is Israel justified in eliminating the Hamas government in Gaza which launched the terror attacks or not?


























Does the United States have a responsibility to militarily support Israel when the country and population is under attack by terrorist groups or not?














Do you think antisemitism is growing in the United States or not growing?










