

# HARVARD CAPS HARRIS POLL



Field Dates: October 19, 2023



## SURVEY METHOD

This survey was conducted online within the United States from **October 18-19, 2023** among **2,116 registered voters** by The Harris Poll and HarrisX.

Results were weighted for age within gender, region, race/ethnicity, marital status, household size, income, employment, education, political party, and political ideology where necessary to align them with their actual proportions in the population. Propensity score weighting was also used to adjust for respondents' propensity to be online. The margin of error for the poll is +/- 2%.

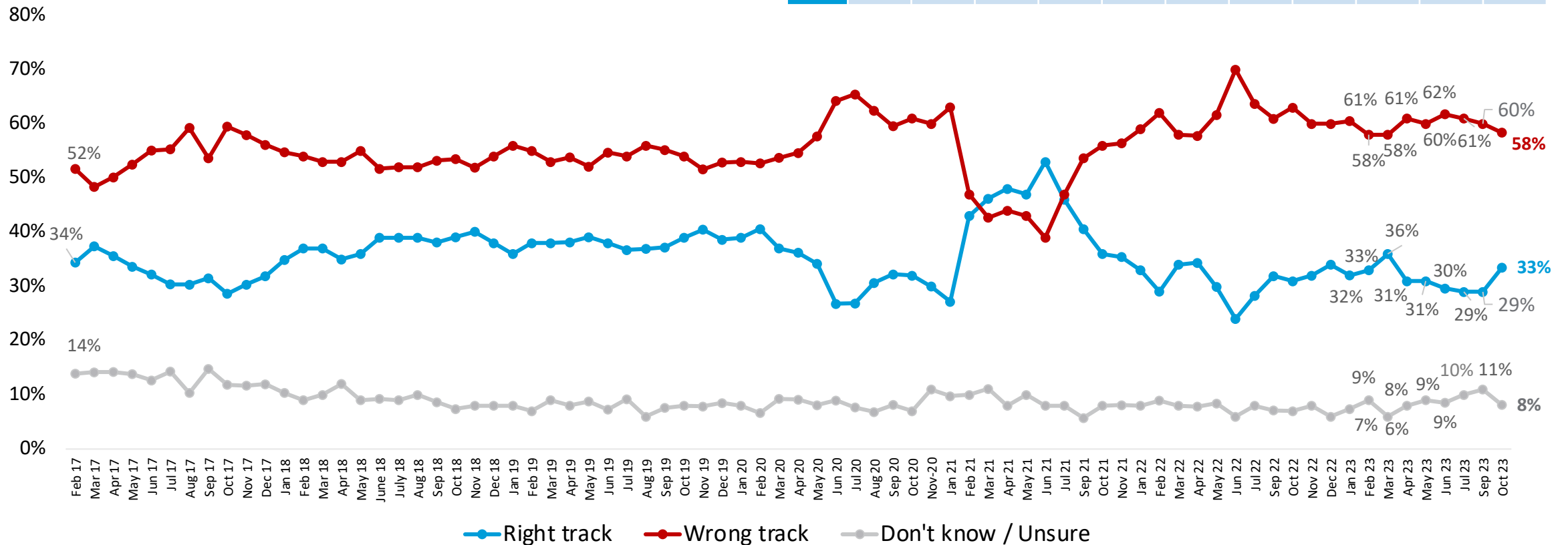

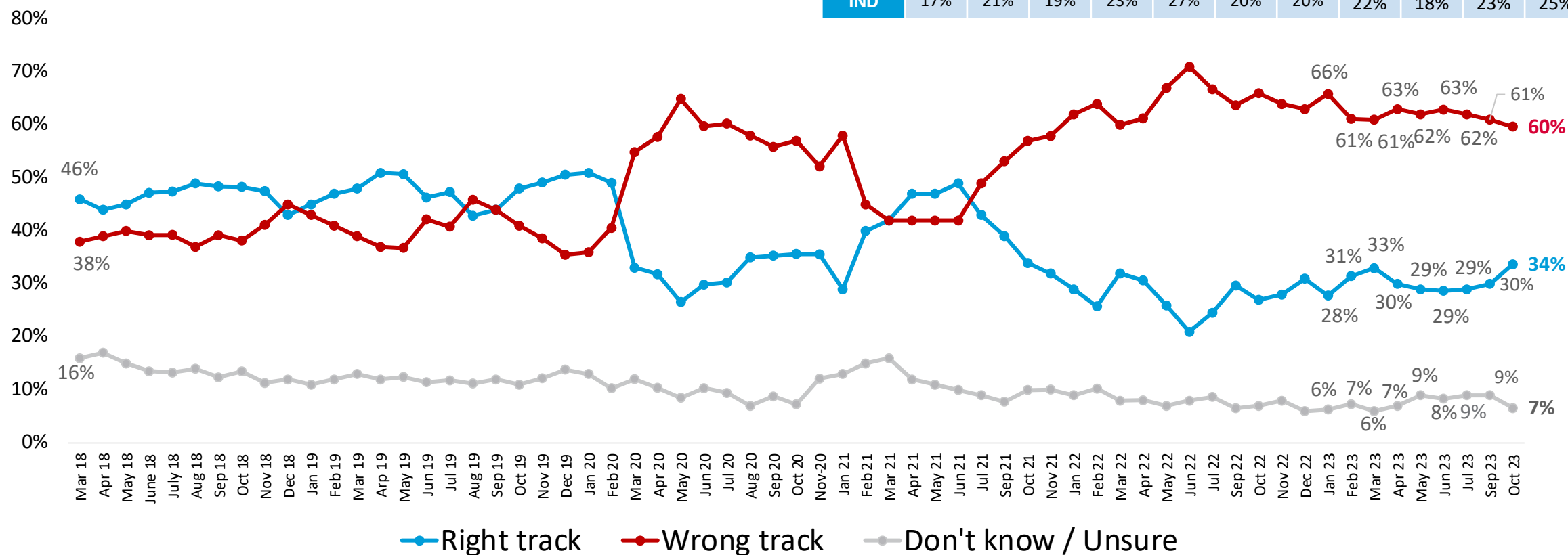

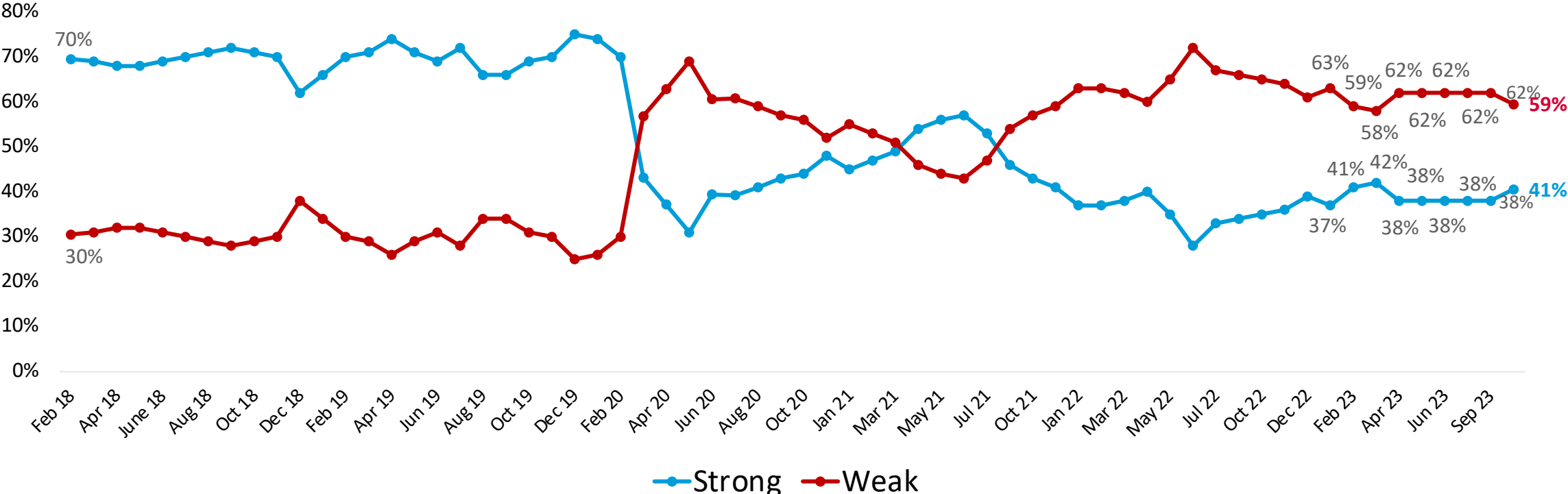

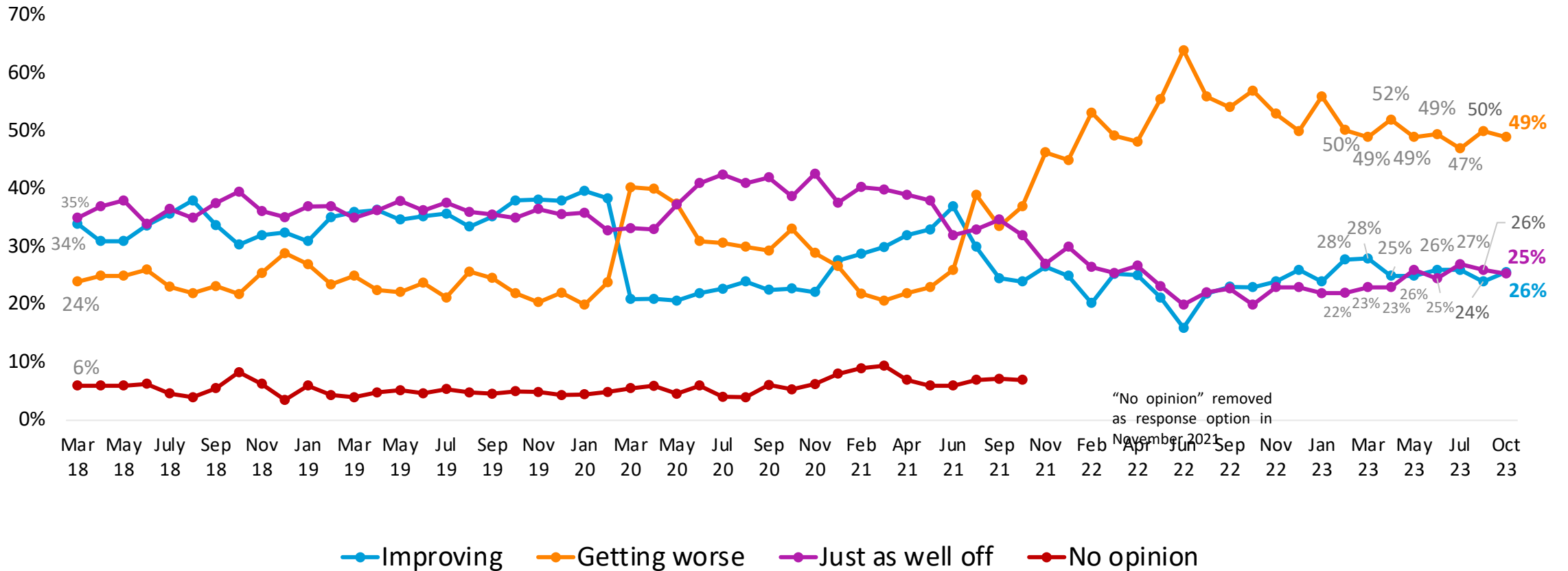

How strong do you think the U.S. economy is today?



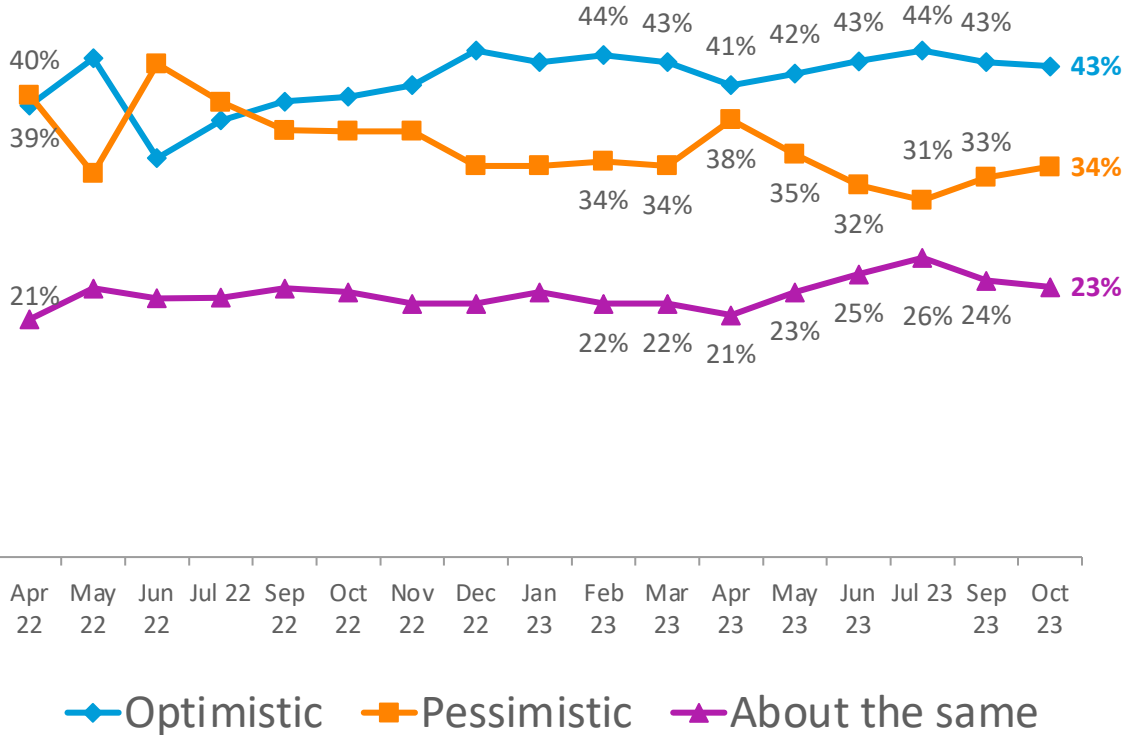

## Would you say that your personal financial situation is improving or getting worse?

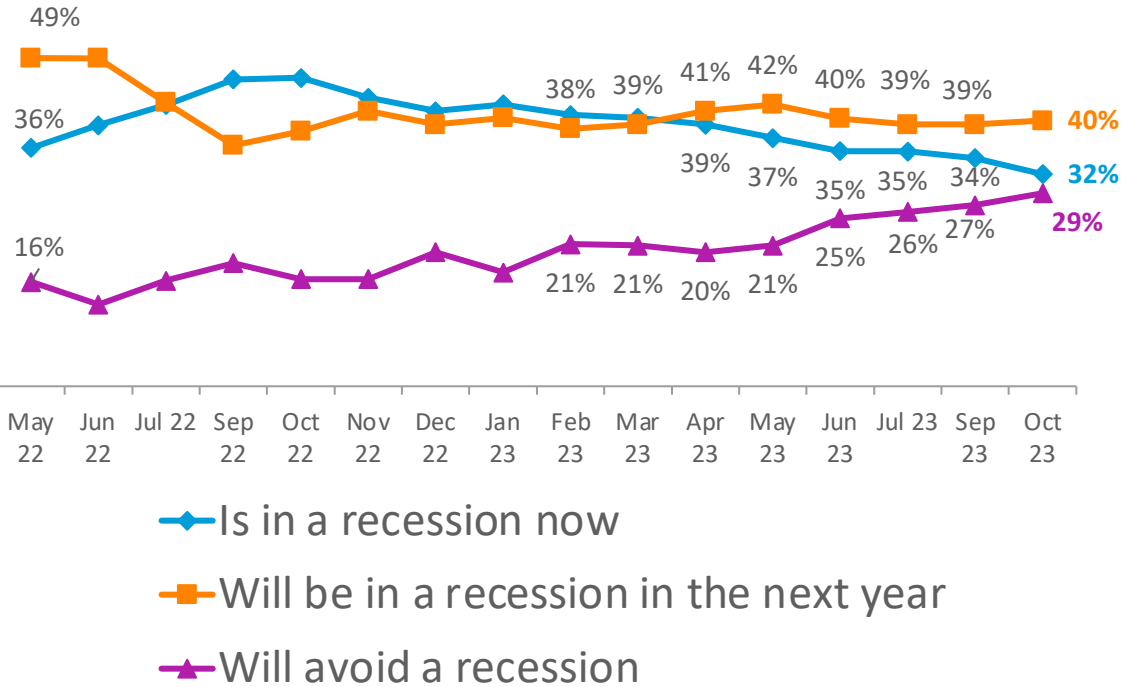

Do you think the U.S. is in a recession now, will be in a recession in the next year or most likely will avoid a recession?

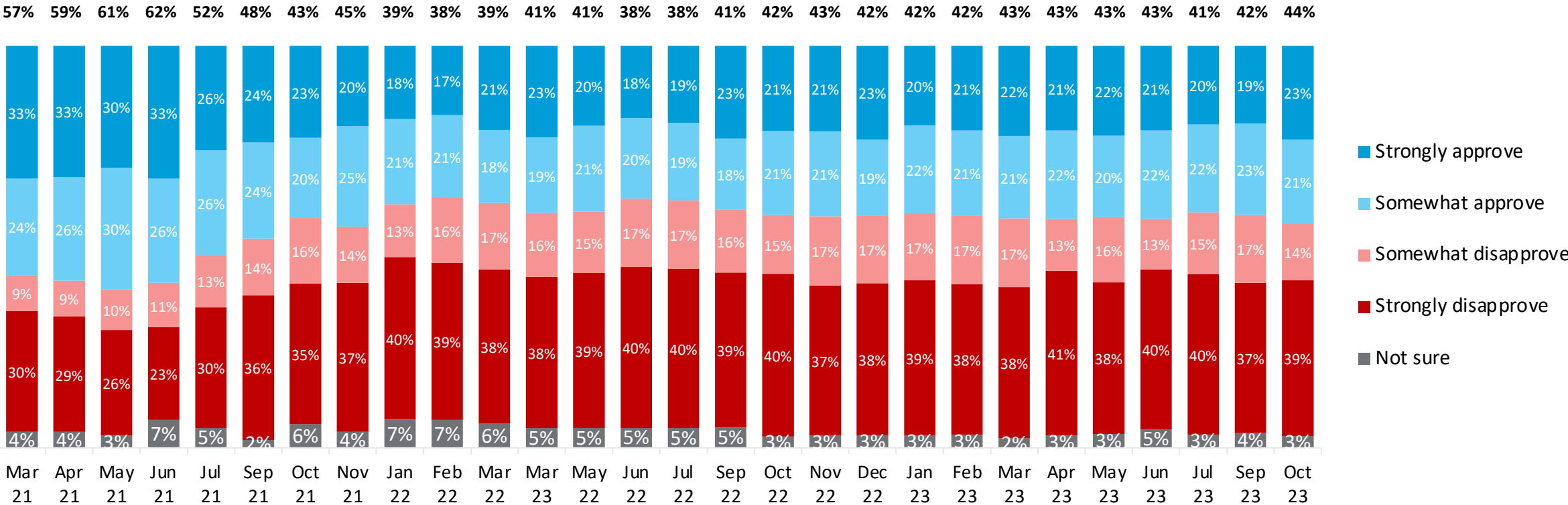

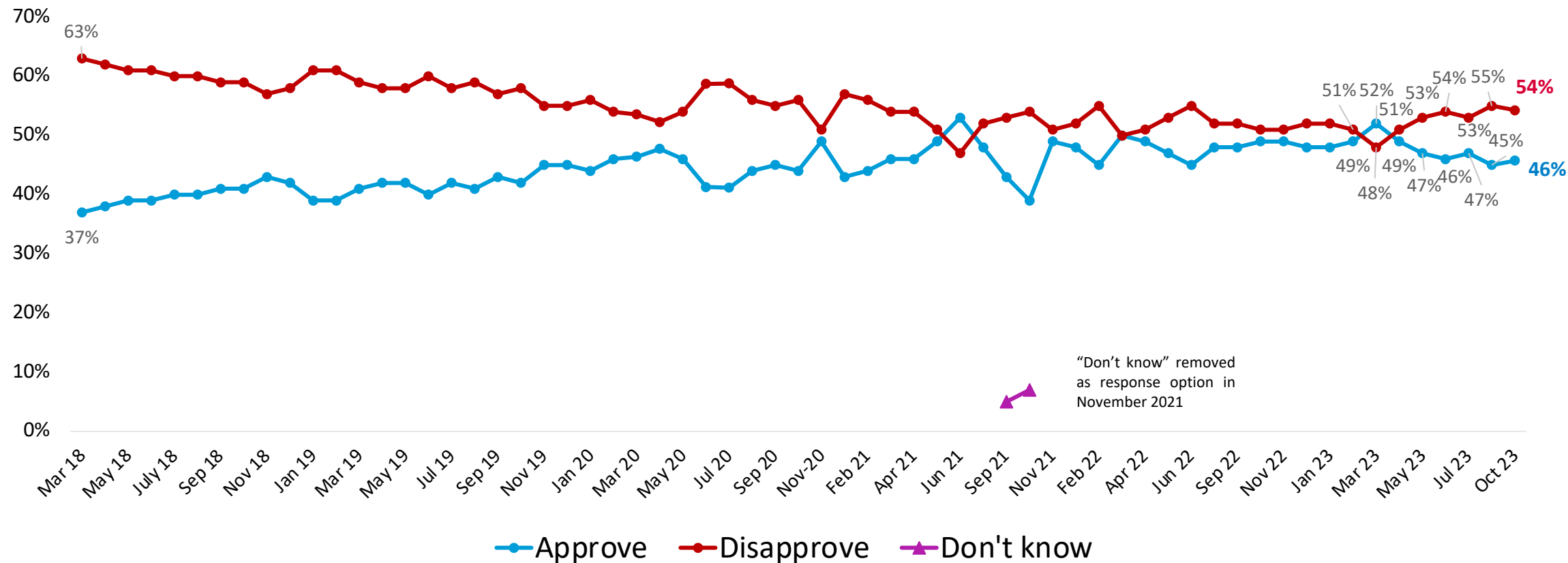

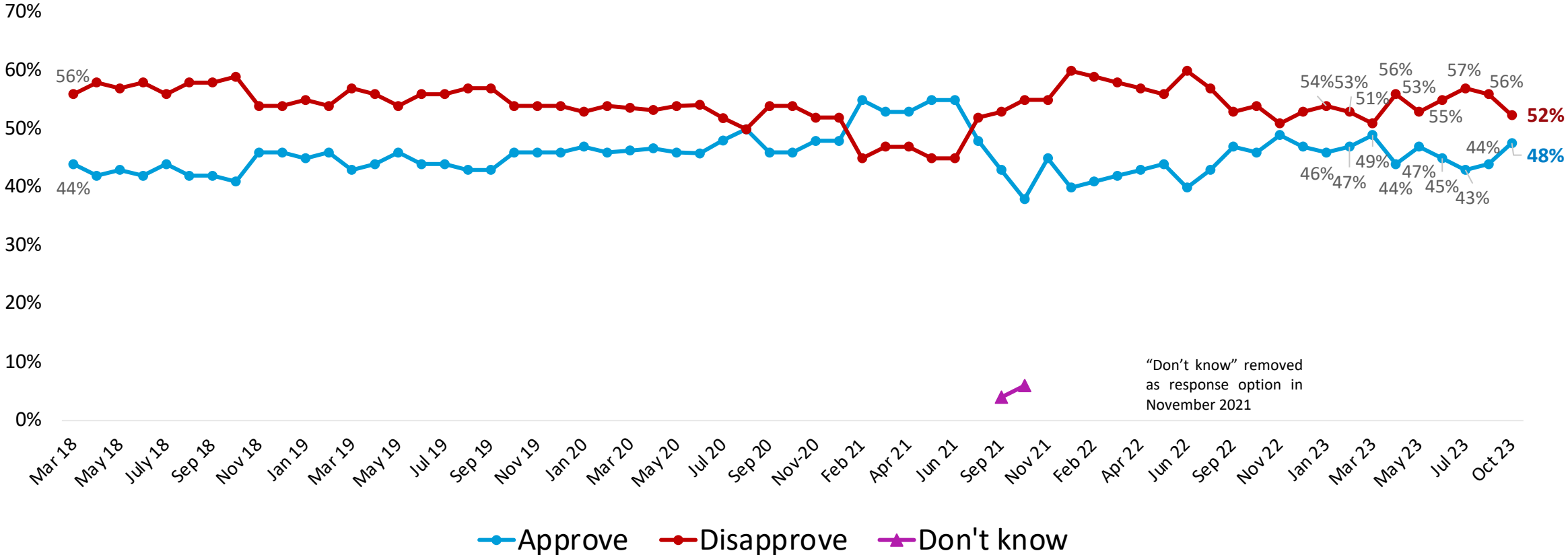

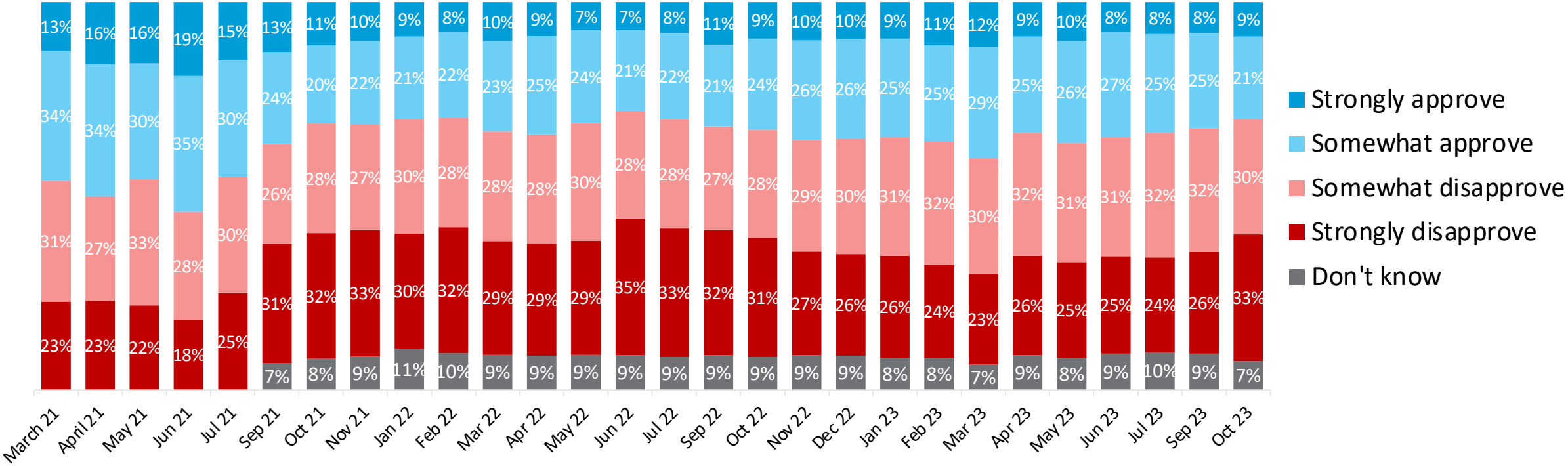

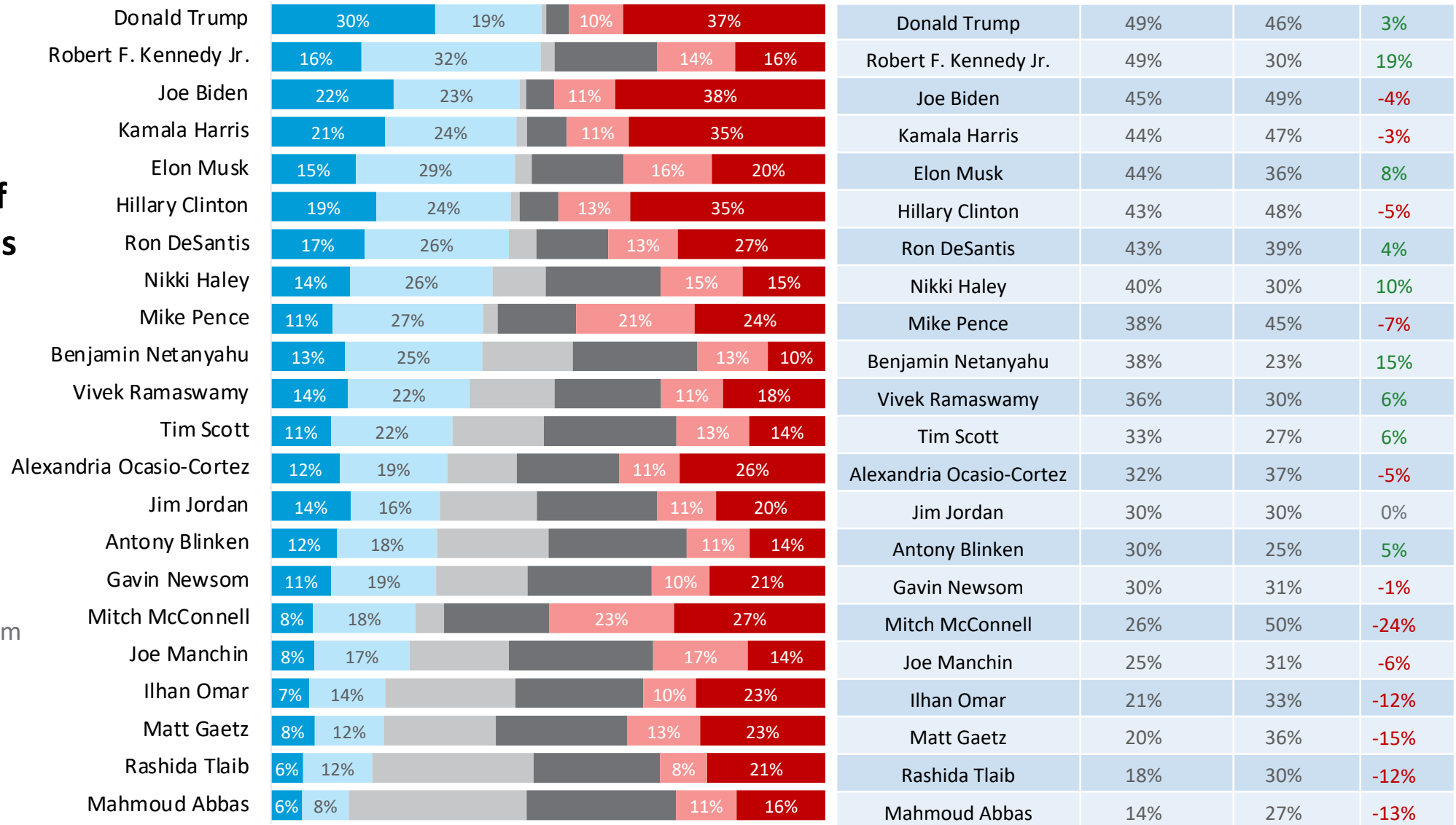

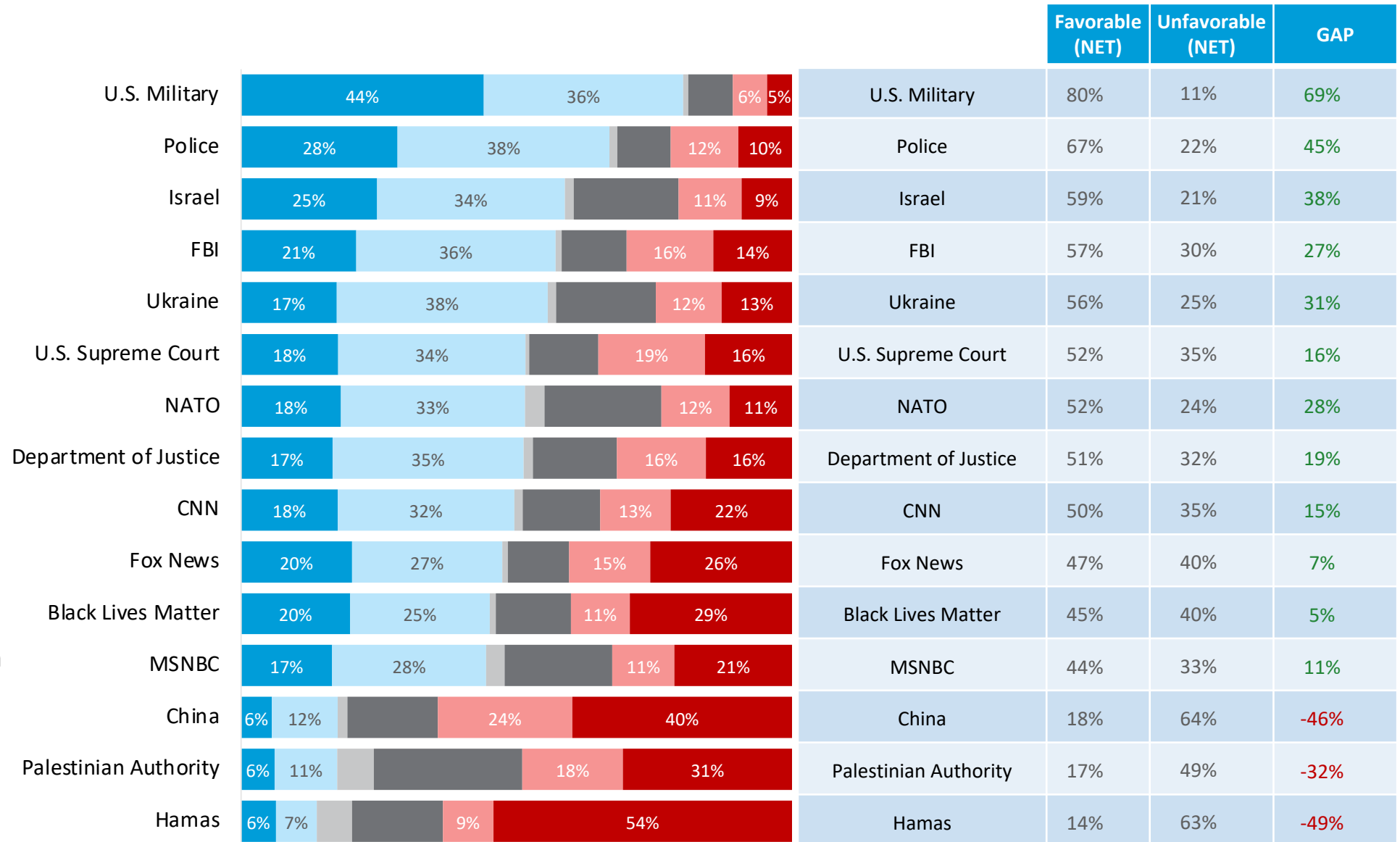
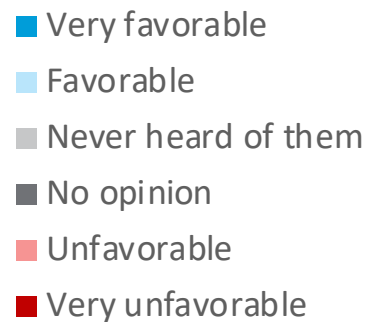

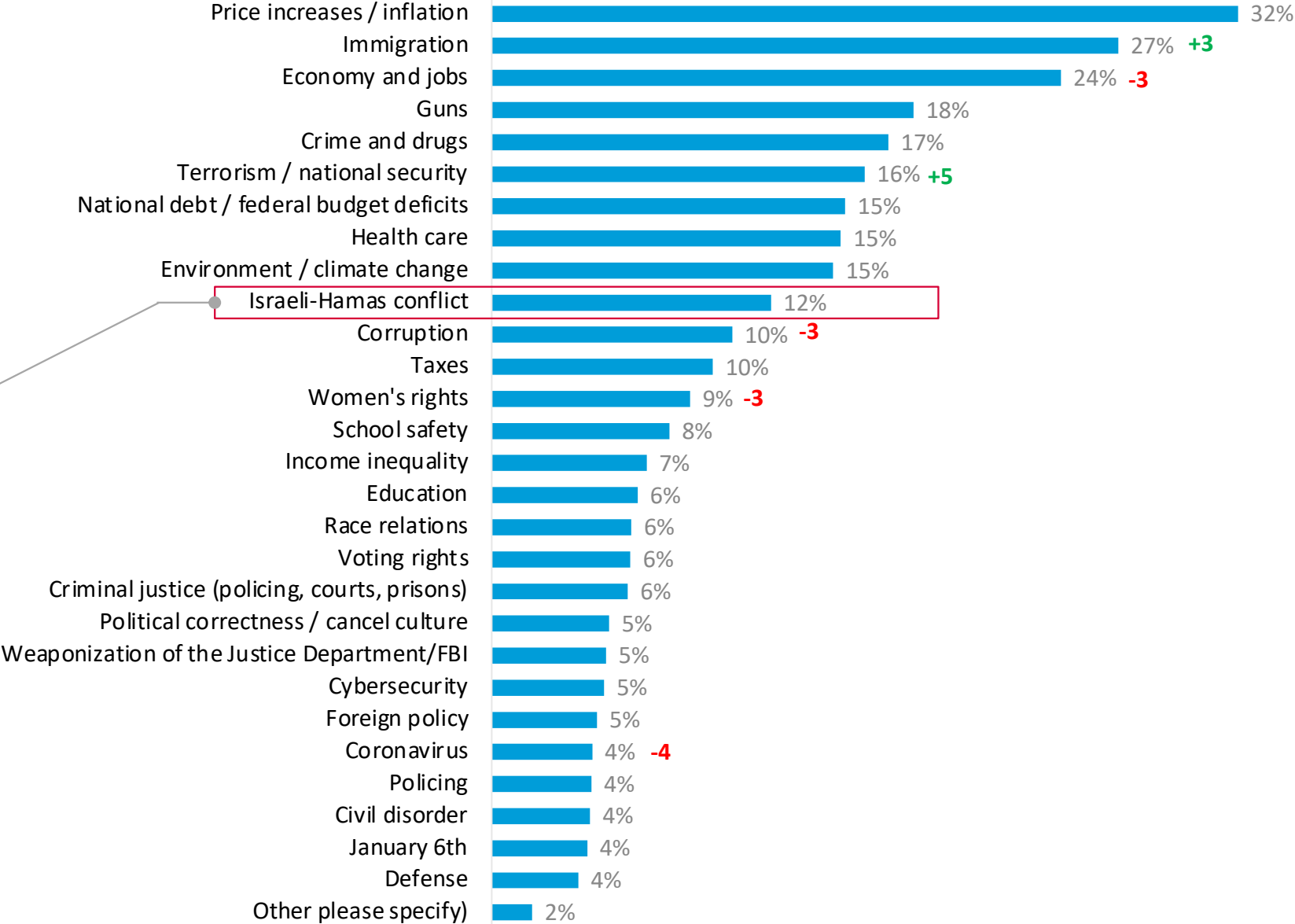

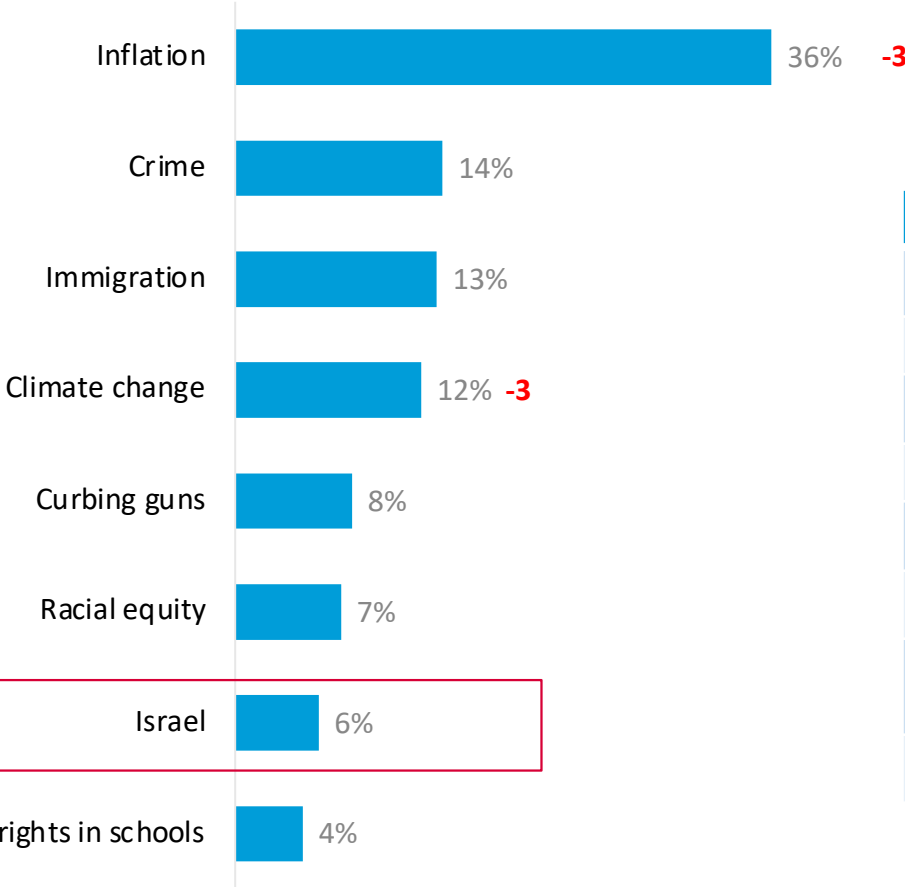

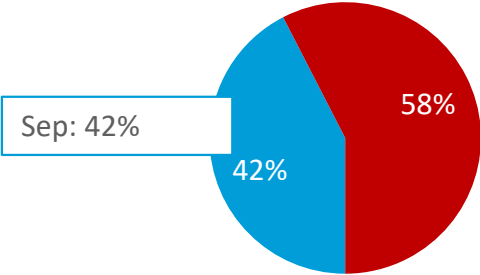

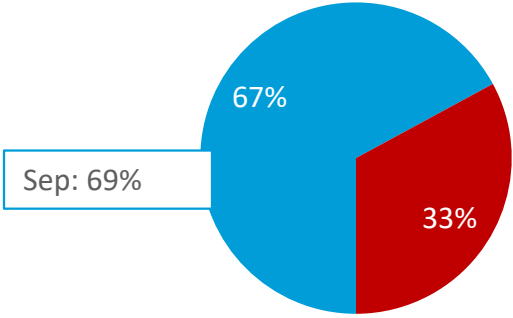

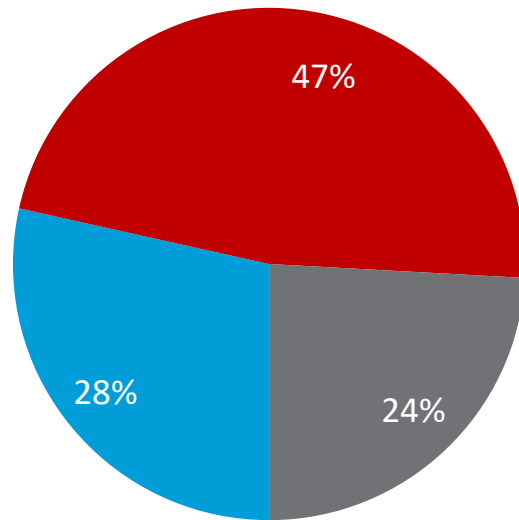

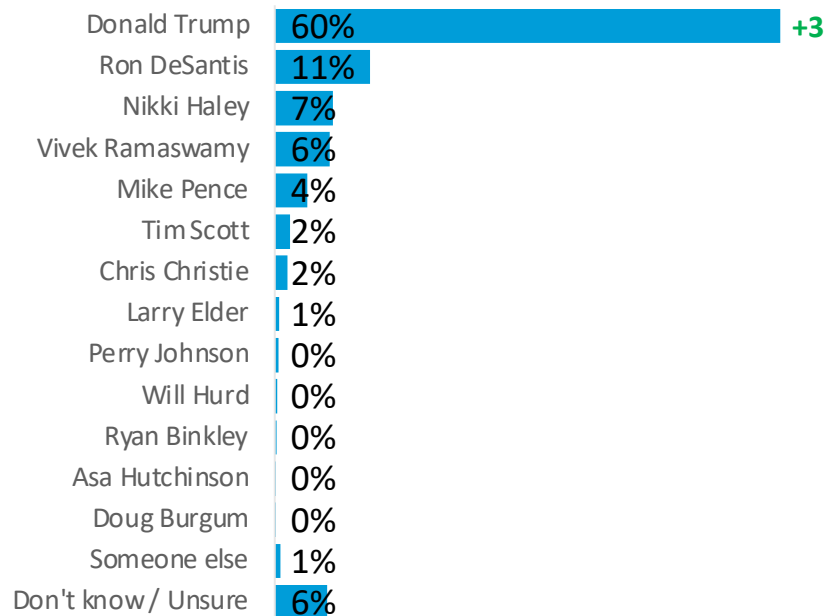

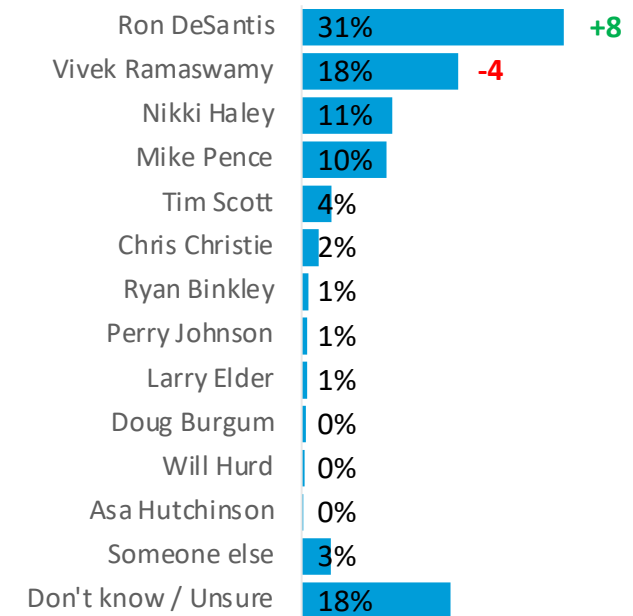
**If the Republican presidential primary for the 2024 election was held today, who would you vote for?**

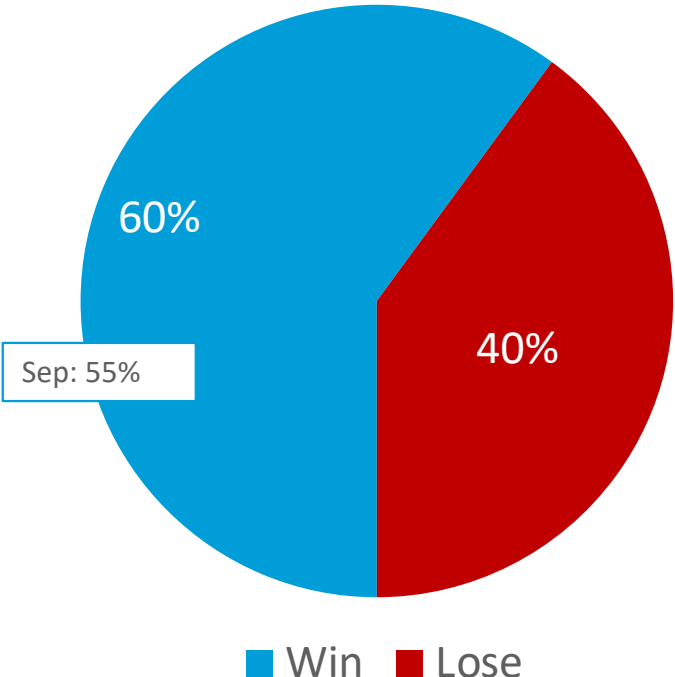

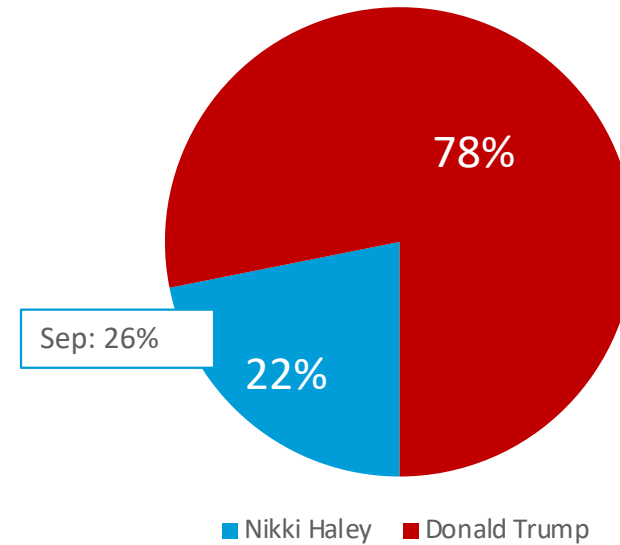
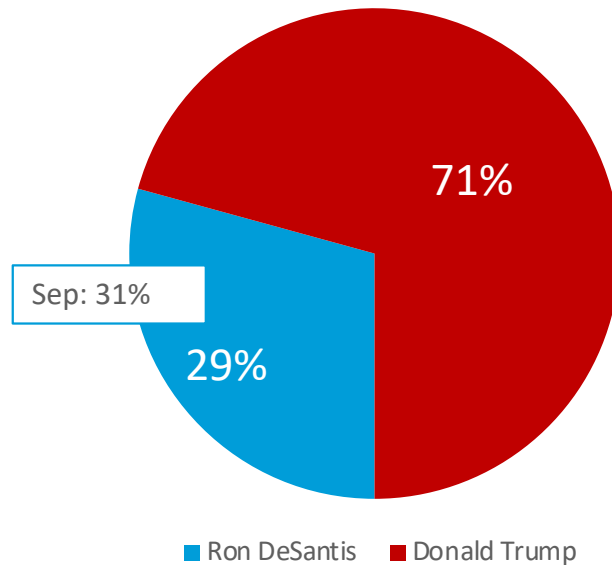

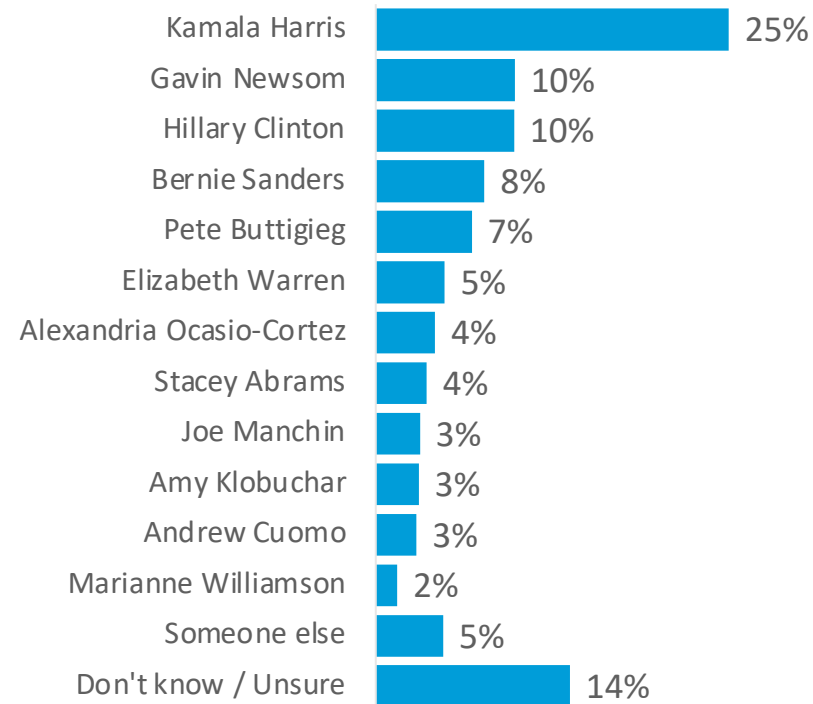

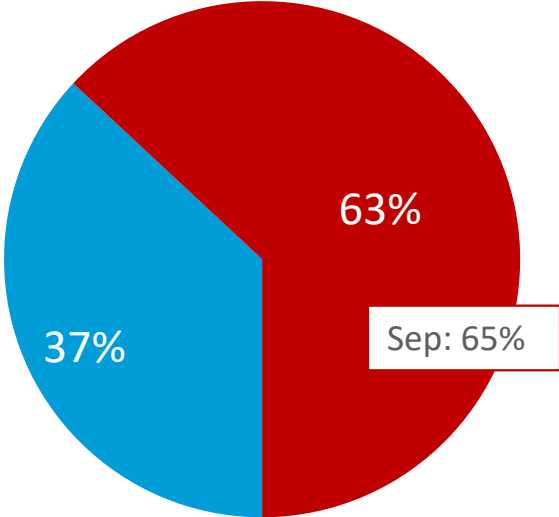

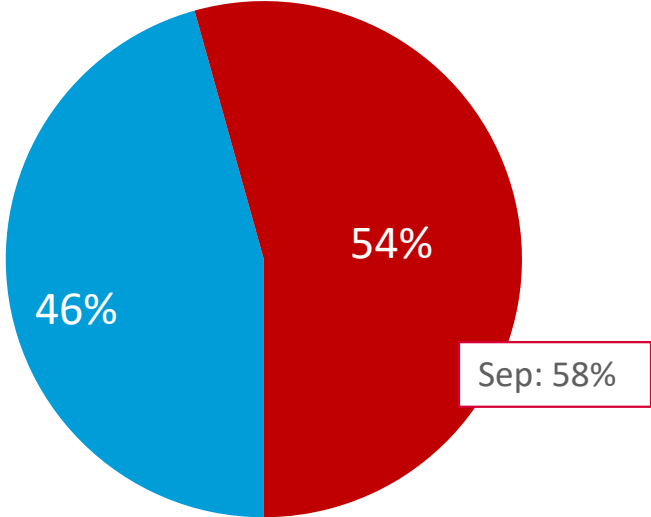

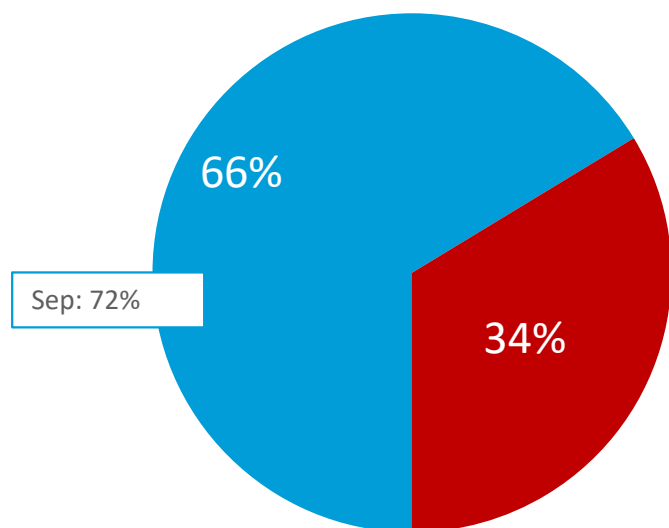

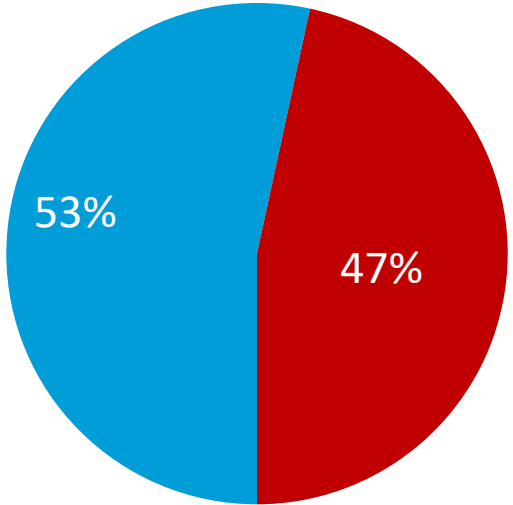

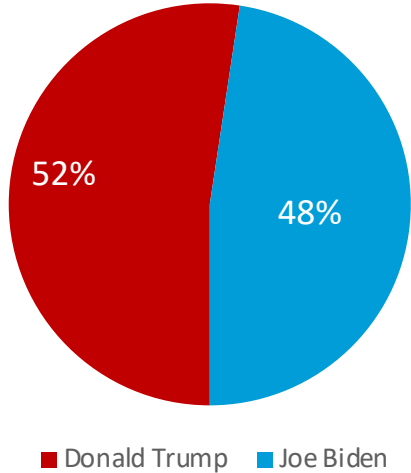

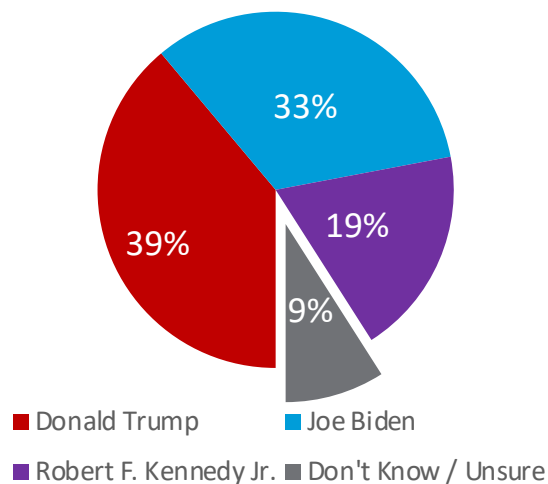

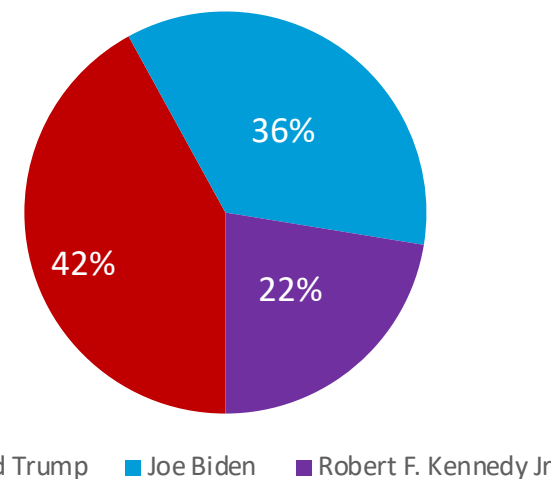

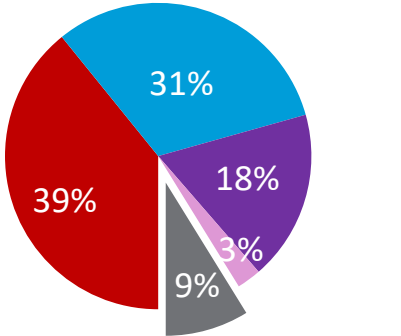

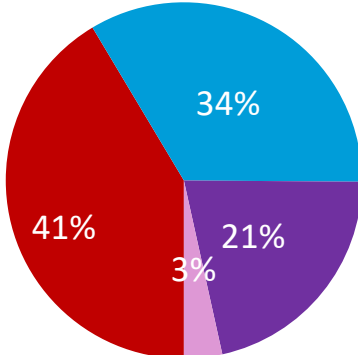

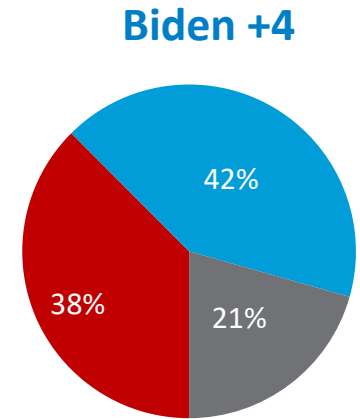

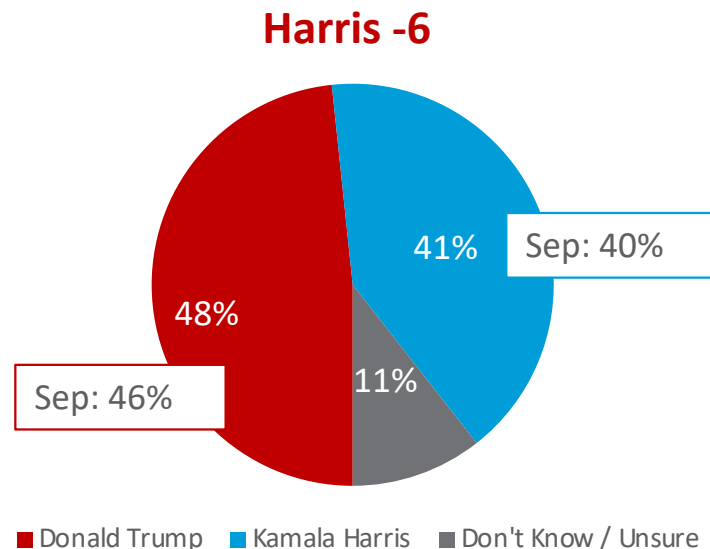

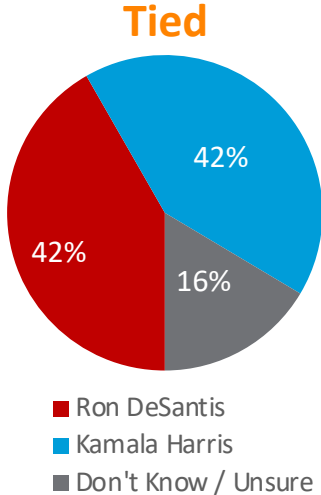

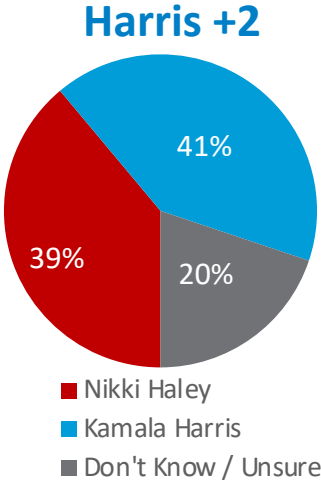

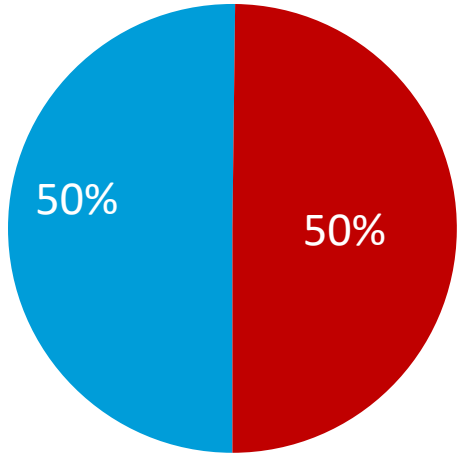

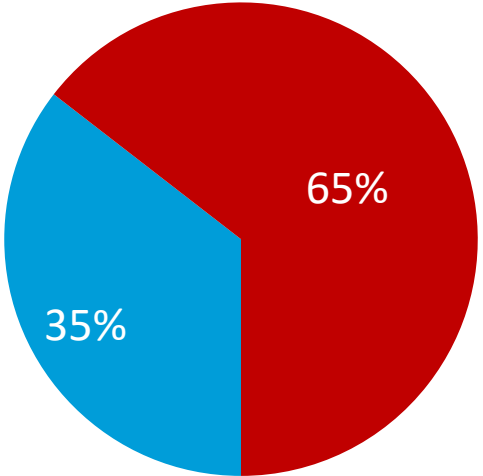

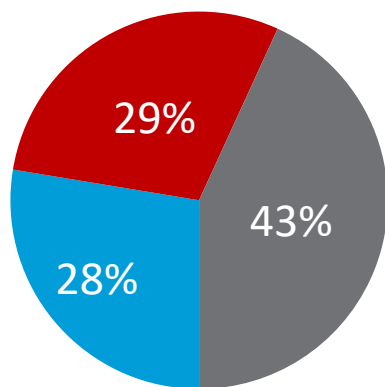

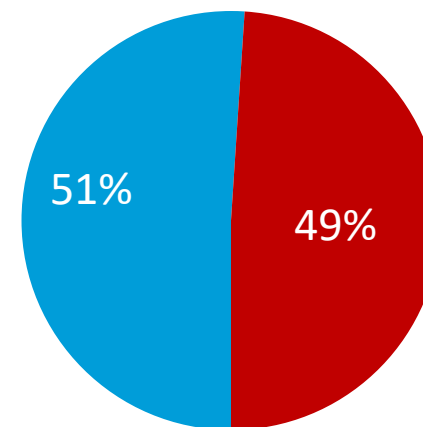

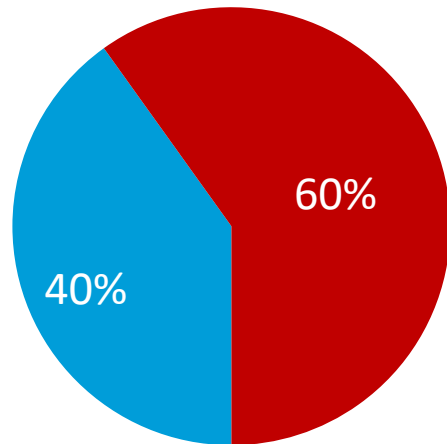

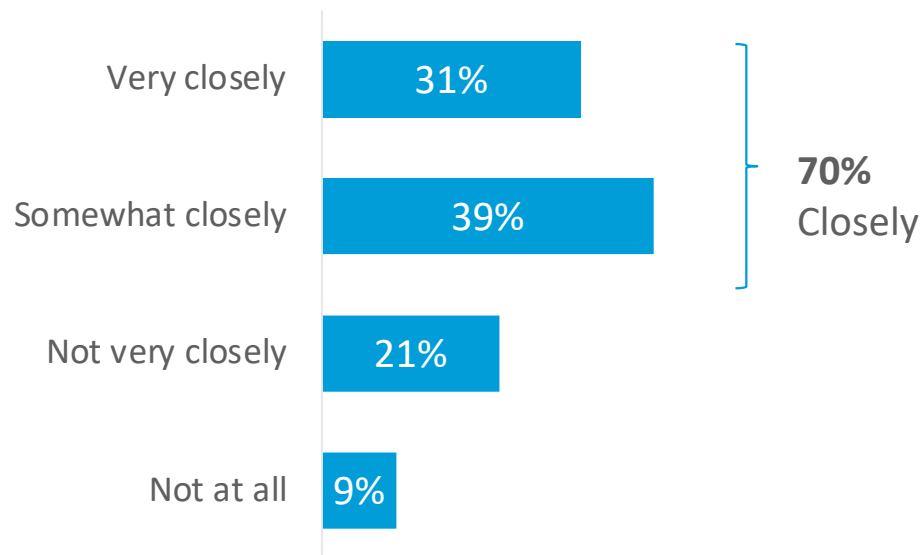

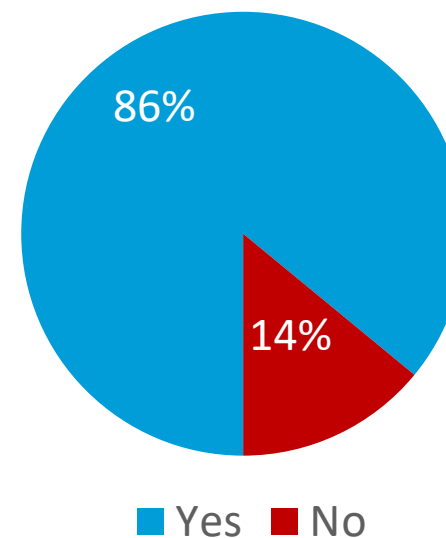

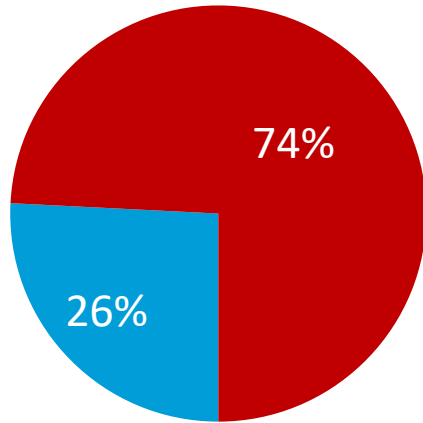

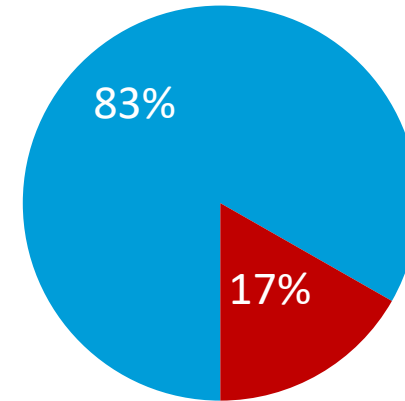

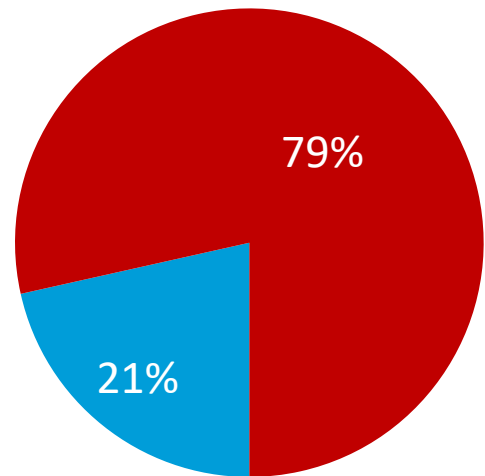

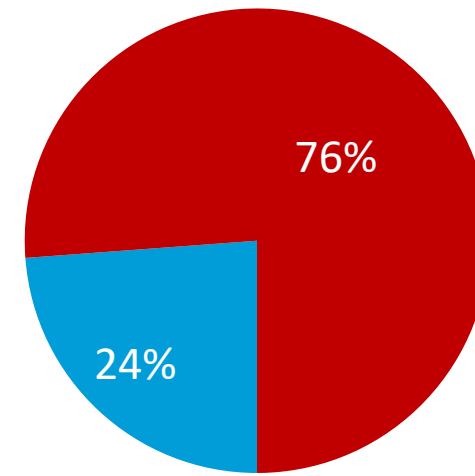

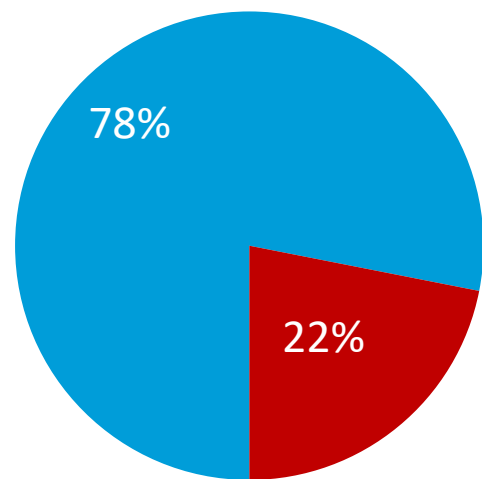

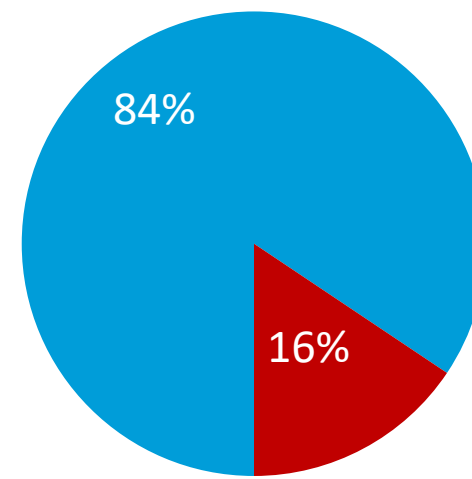

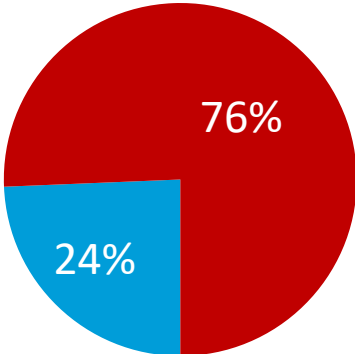

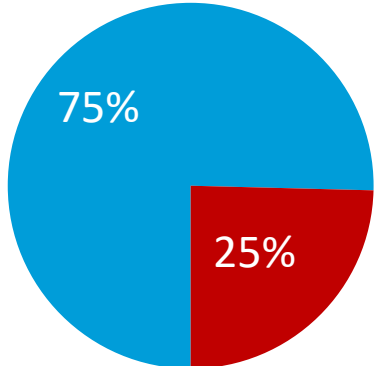

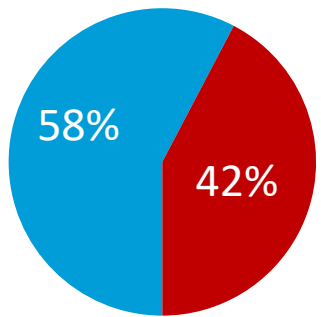

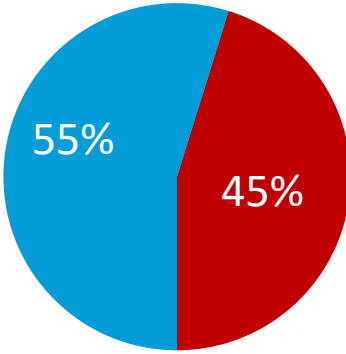

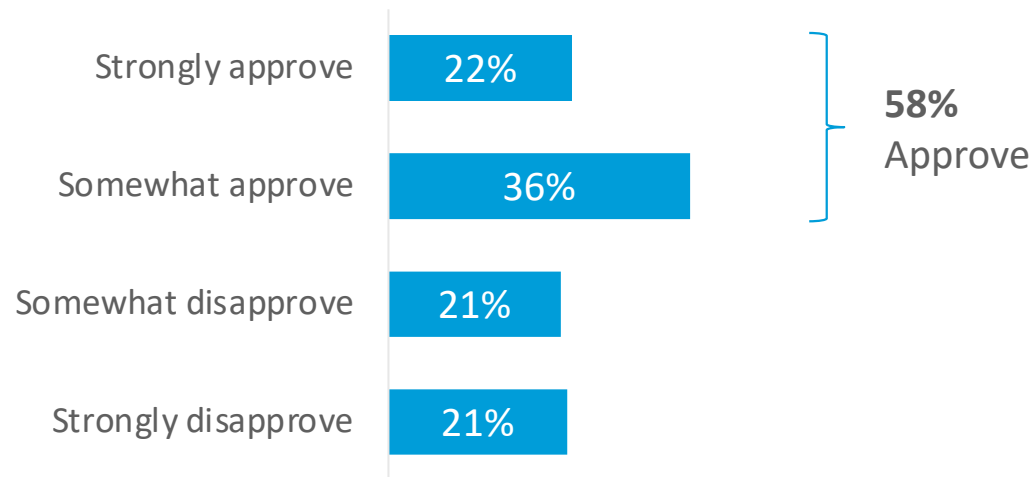

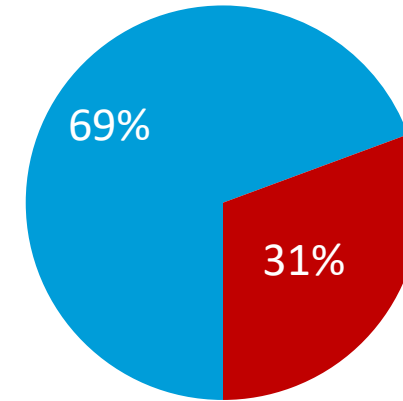

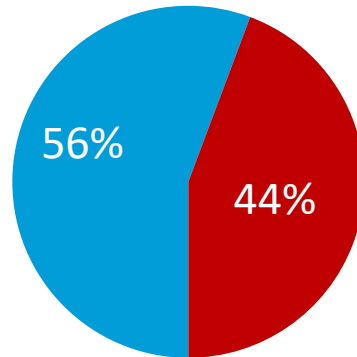

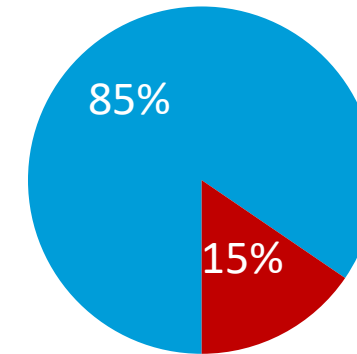

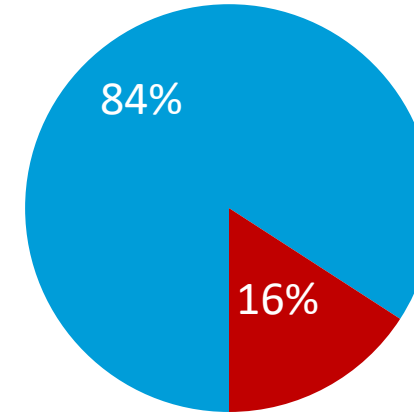

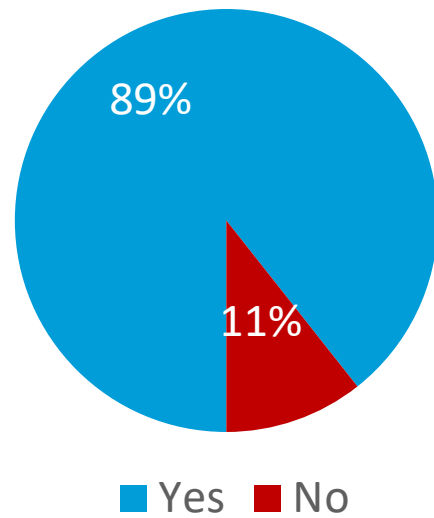

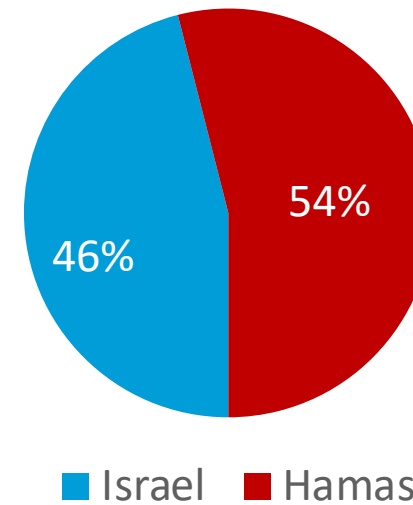

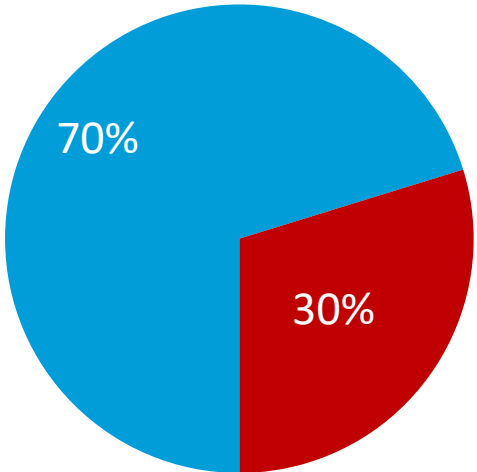

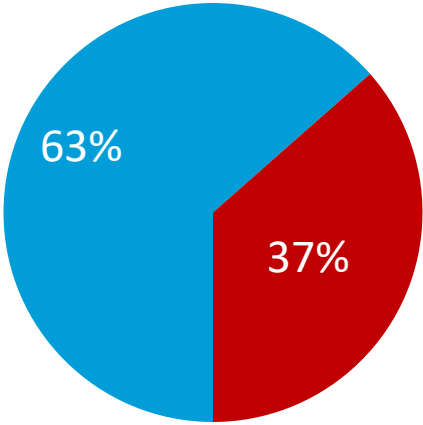

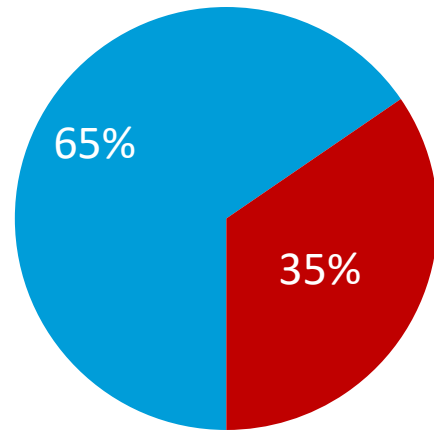

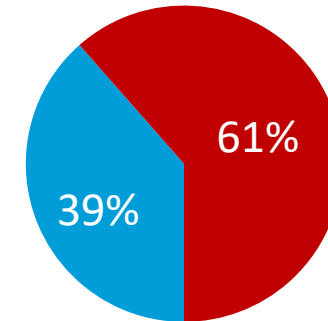

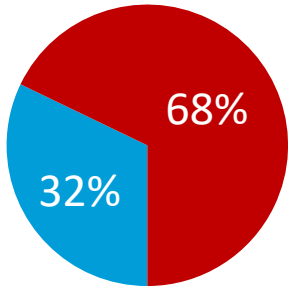

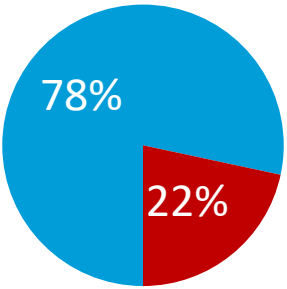

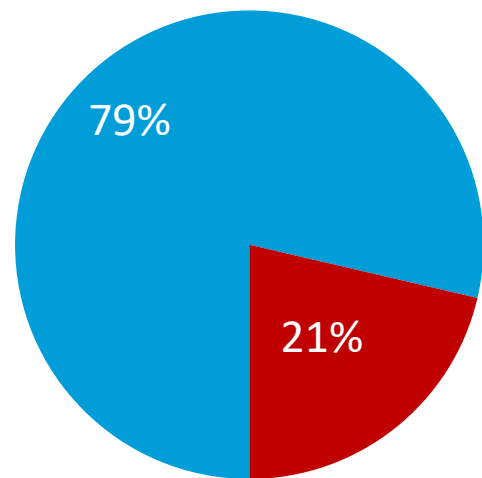

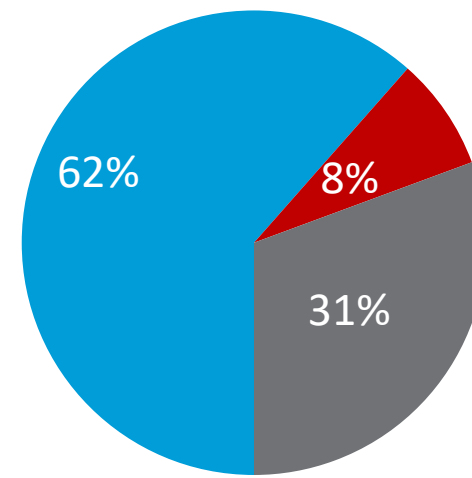

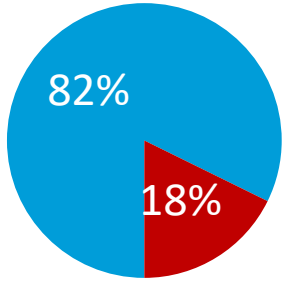

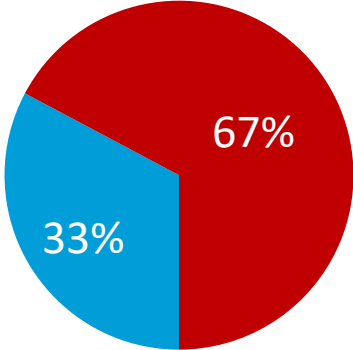

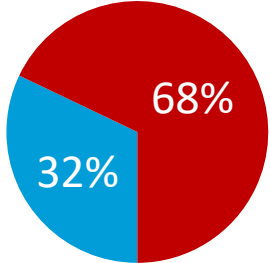

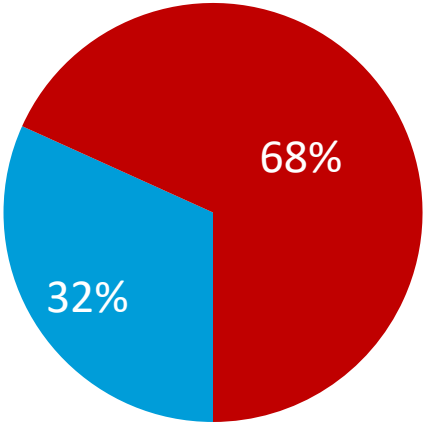

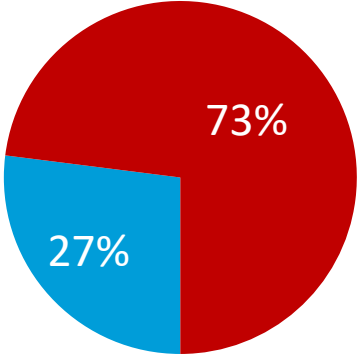

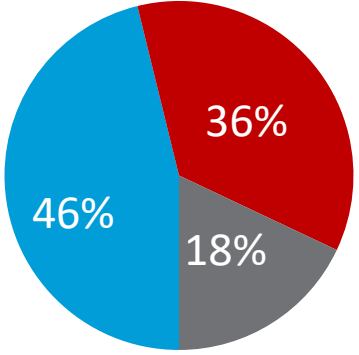

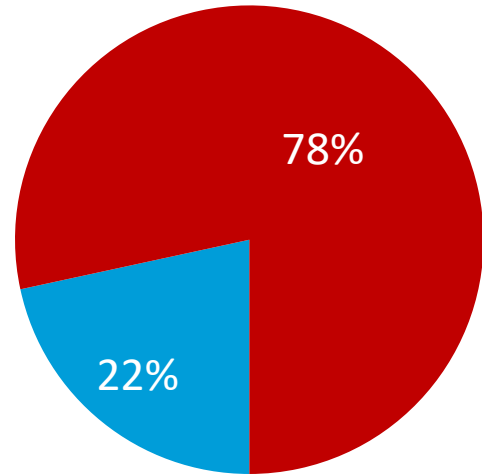

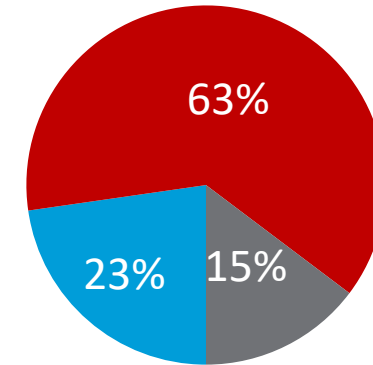

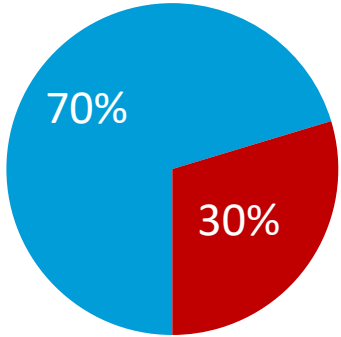

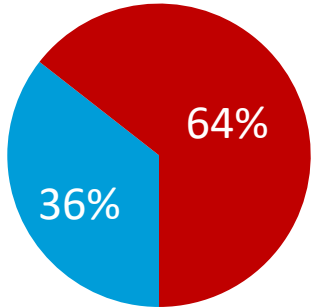

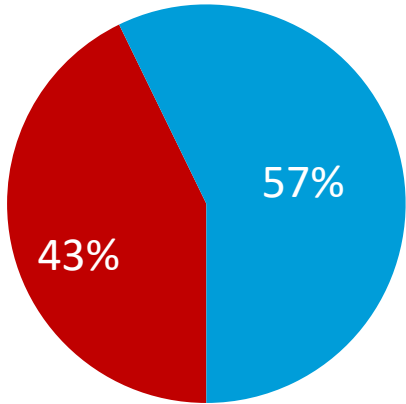

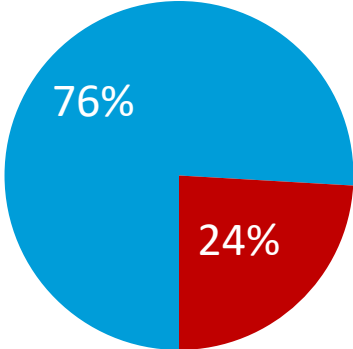

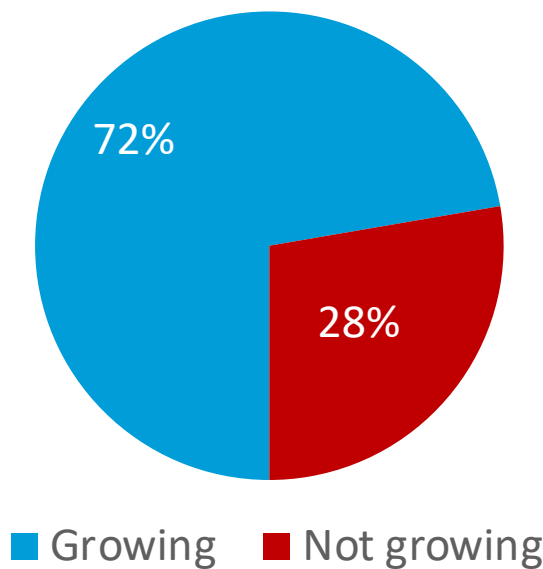

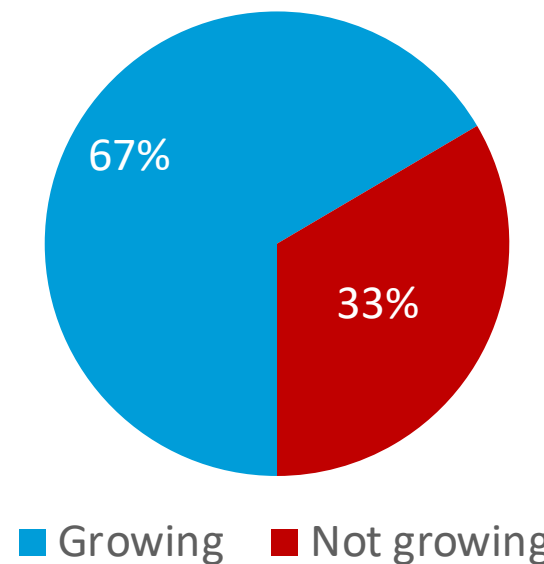

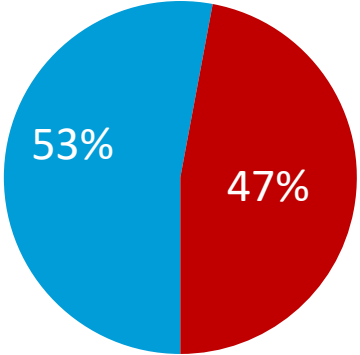

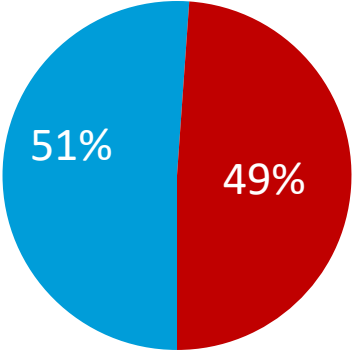

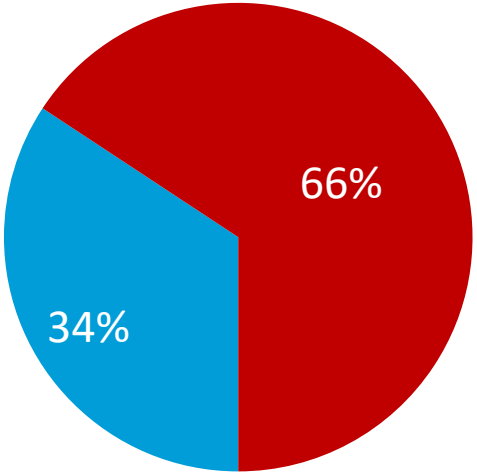
Do you think that the Biden administration should have traded releasing 6 hostages from Iran for \$6 billion or not made that deal?

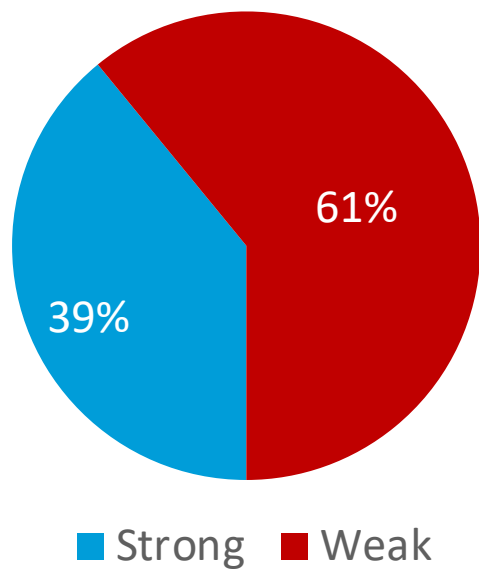
