
## HARVARD CAPS HARRIS







Field Dates: April 24-25, 2024



This survey was conducted online within the United States from April 24-25, 2024 among 1,961 registered voters by The Harris Poll and HarrisX.

Respondents for this poll are recruited through opt-in, web-panel recruitment sampling. Recruitment occurs though a broad variety of professional, validated respondent panels to expand the sampling frame as wide as possible and minimize the impact of any given panel on recruiting methods.

Results are weighted for age within gender, region, race/ethnicity, marital status, household size, income, employment, education, political party, and political ideology where necessary to align them with their actual proportions in the population. Propensity score weighting was also used to adjust for respondents' propensity to be online. The margin of error for the total sample is +/- 2%.










#### How strong do you think the U.S. economy is today?













## APPROVAL OF THE WAY CONGRESS IS DOING ITS JOB REMAINS LOW AT 32%




































Are President Biden's public lapses, if any, more or less frequent these days?



Do you think that Joe Biden helped and participated in Hunter Biden's business, or did he not participate or help his son's business dealings?








Do you think if convicted of tax evasion that Hunter Biden should serve jail time or should he not serve jail time?






Do you think Donald Trump has committed crimes for which he should be convicted, or has he not committed any crimes?





Do you think Donald Trump's legal cases make it impossible for him to be a viable candidate for president or is that not a blocker for Trump?






Do you think Donald Trump has committed crimes for which he will be convicted, or do you think he will not be convicted of any crimes?












Do you think this is a time in world affairs that enables the US to focus primarily on domestic issues or does the United States have to spend more on military and foreign affairs right now?













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




Do you favor or oppose NATO - the North Atlantic Treaty Organization - a defense grouping of 32 countries that counts among its ranks the United States?









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




Do you support or oppose formally inviting Ukraine to join NATO?







#### How closely are you paying attention to the Israel-Hamas war?























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


































