# HARVARD CAPS HARRIS







Field Dates: October 11-13, 2024

**SURVEY METHOD** 

This survey was conducted online within the United States from October 11-13, 2024 among **3,145 registered voters** by The Harris Poll and HarrisX. As part of the sample, 2,596 likely voters and 898 battleground state voters were also interviewed.

Respondents for this poll are recruited through opt-in, web-panel recruitment sampling. Recruitment occurs though a broad variety of professional, validated respondent panels to expand the sampling frame as wide as possible and minimize the impact of any given panel on recruiting methods.

Results are weighted for age within gender, region, race/ethnicity, marital status, household size, income, employment, education, political party, and political ideology where necessary to align them with their actual proportions in the population. Propensity score weighting was also used to adjust for respondents' propensity to be online. The margin of error for the total sample is +/- 1.8 pts on a 95% confidence level.




#### % Who Say "Right Track"






How strong do you think the U.S. economy is today?



Do you think your personal economics right now are excellent, good, fair or poor?












Do you approve or disapprove of the job Kamala Harris is doing as Vice President?































































































#### Who do you blame more for the escalating conflict in the Middle East: Israel or Iran?
















