

# HARVARD CAPS HARRIS POLL



Field Dates: October 11-13, 2024



## SURVEY METHOD

This survey was conducted online within the United States from **October 11-13, 2024** among **3,145 registered voters** by **The Harris Poll and HarrisX**. As part of the sample, 2,596 likely voters and 898 battleground state voters were also interviewed.

Respondents for this poll are recruited through opt-in, web-panel recruitment sampling. Recruitment occurs through a broad variety of professional, validated respondent panels to expand the sampling frame as wide as possible and minimize the impact of any given panel on recruiting methods.

Results are weighted for age within gender, region, race/ethnicity, marital status, household size, income, employment, education, political party, and political ideology where necessary to align them with their actual proportions in the population. Propensity score weighting was also used to adjust for respondents' propensity to be online. The margin of error for the total sample is +/- 1.8 pts on a 95% confidence level.


















Do you approve or disapprove of the job Kamala Harris is doing as Vice President?


















How likely or unlikely are you to vote in the upcoming 2024 elections in November?


If the congressional election were held today would you be more likely to vote for a...








































































































Do you think Donald Trump is ready to be commander in chief?

































Who do you blame more for the escalating conflict in the Middle East: Israel or Iran?






















