

Field Dates: April 9-10, 2025



This survey was conducted online within the United States on April 9-10, 2025, among **2,286 registered voters** by The Harris Poll and HarrisX.

Respondents for this poll are recruited through opt-in, web-panel recruitment sampling. Recruitment occurs though a broad variety of professional, validated respondent panels to expand the sampling frame as wide as possible and minimize the impact of any given panel on recruiting methods.

Results are weighted for age within gender, region, race/ethnicity, marital status, household size, income, employment, education, political party, and political ideology where necessary to align them with their actual proportions in the population. Propensity score weighting was also used to adjust for respondents' propensity to be online. The margin of error for the total sample is +/- 1.9 pts on a 95% confidence level.



IN A SLIGHT DIP FROM LAST MONTH, 39% OF VOTERS SAY THE COUNTRY IS ON THE RIGHT TRACK




% Who Say "Right Track"





PERCEPTIONS OF THE US ECONOMY HAVE HELD, WITH JUST OVER HALF SAYING IT IS WEAK TODAY




How strong do you think the U.S. economy is today?












Is Donald Trump doing better than you expected as president, worse or about what you expected?

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



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






In general, do you think federal judges are acting appropriately to hold up actions of the administration or are they over-stepping their authority in their actions?

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












Do you think tariffs are important to protect jobs in our country today or not?





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



MOST VOTERS OVERESTIMATE THE PERCENTAGE IMPORTS MAKES UP OF THE U.S. ECONOMY












Have the administration tariff policies affected you in any way? If so, how?




















































