

Field Dates: August 20-21, 2025



This survey was conducted online within the United States on August 20-21, 2025, among **2,025 registered voters** by The Harris Poll and HarrisX.

Respondents for this poll are recruited through opt-in, web-panel recruitment sampling. Recruitment occurs though a broad variety of professional, validated respondent panels to expand the sampling frame as wide as possible and minimize the impact of any given panel on recruiting methods.

Results are weighted for age within gender, region, race/ethnicity, marital status, household size, income, employment, education, political party, and political ideology where necessary to align them with their actual proportions in the population. Propensity score weighting was also used to adjust for respondents' propensity to be online. The margin of error for the total sample is +/- 2.2 pts on a 95% confidence level.







VOTERS ARE EVENLY SPLIT ON WHETHER THE U.S. ECONOMY IS STRONG TODAY OR NOT




How strong do you think the U.S. economy is today?

Would you say that your personal financial situation is improving or getting worse?









Do you approve or disapprove of the way Congress is doing its job?



Favorability of Political Figures










ACROSS THE PARTISAN SPECTRUM, INFLATION IS THE MOST IMPORTANT ISSUE TO VOTERS PERSONALLY



Which of these issues is most important to you personally?








Is Donald Trump doing better than you expected as president, worse or about what you expected?


MOST VOTERS REMAIN SATISFIED WITH THEIR 2024 PRESIDENTIAL CHOICE










Do you think President Trump is making good deals on behalf of the country or do you think he is making bad deals just to appear successful?






Do you think Trump will solve the Ukraine war or not?



Do you think Democrats should oppose everything that Trump is doing or should they take more of a wait and see attitude towards his actions?






Who do you trust more to manage the economy - the Trump administration and Republicans or Democrats in Congress?

Who is mostly responsible for the state of the economy today - Donald Trump or Joe Biden?






Do you think Donald Trump's policies are making the U.S. economy stronger or weaker?






Are Donald Trump's policies leading to more or less investment in the country?



Are Donald Trump's tariff policies boosting or harming the economy?






Do you think that the jobs numbers have been reliable or not reliable?






Do you approve or disapprove of President Donald Trump's decision to fire the head of the Bureau of Labor Statistics, the agency responsible for reporting job numbers?



How confident are you that Donald Trump's economic policies will lead to stronger economic growth?




Have you heard mostly positive or negative news stories about the economy over the last few weeks?






Would you say that crime in the United States is increasing, decreasing, or staying about the same?














Do you think President Trump's actions are justified and necessary to increase safety and reduce crime in Washington, D.C., or are they unjustified and not necessary?














How familiar or unfamiliar are you with the Jeffrey Epstein case?





How would you rate the following people's handling of the Jeffrey Epstein case investigation?










































Should the U.S. continue to take all actions necessary to prevent Iran from obtaining a nuclear weapon or not block Iran from such capability?








Do you support or oppose Donald Trump's efforts to end the war in Ukraine?






Do you think the meeting with Putin was successful in advancing peace or unsuccessful?






Do you agree or disagree that: Succeed or not Trump deserves a lot of credit for pulling off these meetings?






Do you think Russia's Vladimir Putin genuinely wants to end the war in Ukraine or is he playing games and stalling with the United States and the West?












