
# HARVARD CAPS HARRIS







Field Dates: October 1-2, 2025



This survey was conducted online within the United States on October 1-2, 2025, among **2,413 registered voters** by The Harris Poll and HarrisX.

Respondents for this poll are recruited through opt-in, web-panel recruitment sampling. Recruitment occurs though a broad variety of professional, validated respondent panels to expand the sampling frame as wide as possible and minimize the impact of any given panel on recruiting methods.

Results are weighted for age within gender, region, race/ethnicity, marital status, household size, income, employment, education, political party, and political ideology where necessary to align them with their actual proportions in the population. Propensity score weighting was also used to adjust for respondents' propensity to be online. The margin of error for the total sample is +/- 1.99 pts on a 95% confidence level.







### VOTERS ARE DIVIDED OVER WHETHER THE U.S. ECONOMY IS STRONG OR WEAK TODAY




#### How strong do you think the U.S. economy is today?

#### Would you say that your personal financial situation is improving or getting worse?







#### Do you approve or disapprove of the way Congress is doing its job?














### Is Donald Trump doing better than you expected as president, worse or about what you expected?












Do you think President Trump is making good deals on behalf of the country or do you think he is making bad deals just to appear successful?






#### Do you think Trump will solve the Ukraine war or not?
















#### Do you support or oppose the government shutdown?


### Who would you say is more to blame for the current government shutdown - Republicans or Democrats?



Does the government shutdown make you more likely to vote for the Democrats in the midterms, more likely to vote for the Republicans or does it not affect your vote?












Do you think Donald Trump's policies are making the U.S. economy stronger or weaker?






Are Donald Trump's policies leading to more or less investment in the country?














Do you believe that the rhetoric of our politicians has become too extreme or do you believe that today's political rhetoric is











Do you think America is hopelessly divided or that it could come together with leadership that tried harder to bring the country together?






#### For each of these public figures, when you heard about their assassinations, how did it make you feel?


















































