Field Dates: January 28-29, 2026



SURVEY METHOD

This survey was conducted online within the United States on **January 28-29, 2026**, among **2,000 registered voters** by The Harris Poll and HarrisX.

Respondents for this poll are recruited through opt-in, web-panel recruitment sampling. Recruitment occurs through a broad variety of professional, validated respondent panels to expand the sampling frame as wide as possible and minimize the impact of any given panel on recruiting methods.

Results are weighted for age within gender, region, race/ethnicity, marital status, household size, income, employment, education, political party, and political ideology where necessary to align them with their actual proportions in the population. Propensity score weighting was also used to adjust for respondents' propensity to be online. The margin of error for the total sample is +/- 1.99 pts on a 95% confidence level.

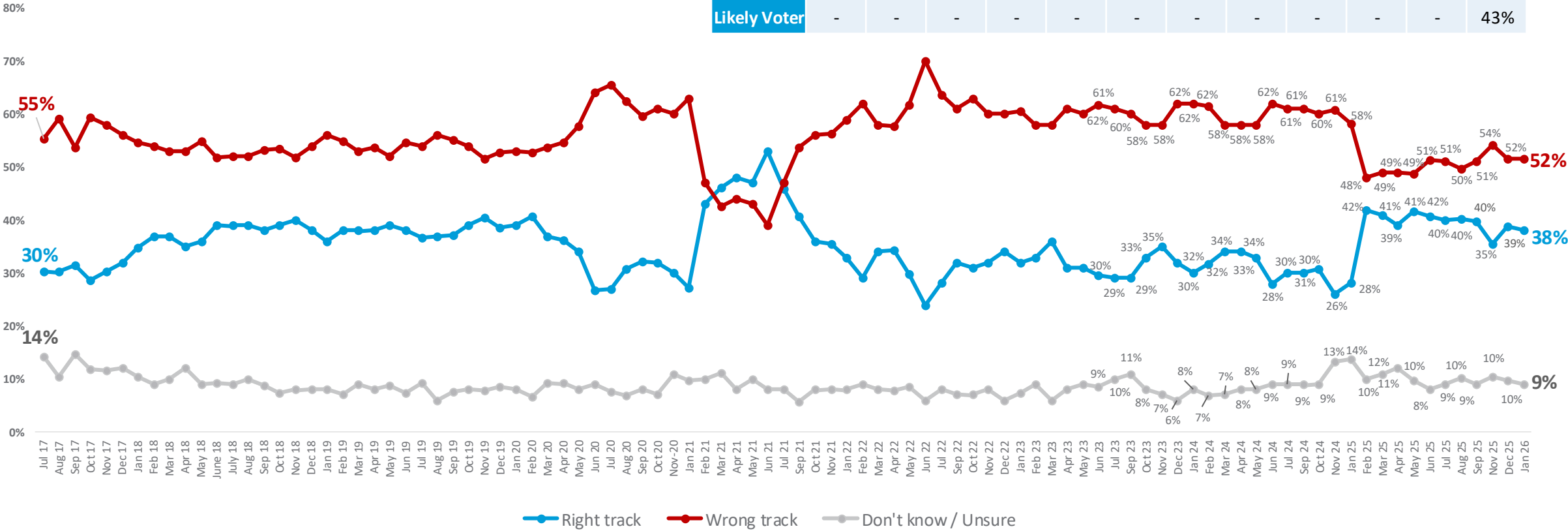

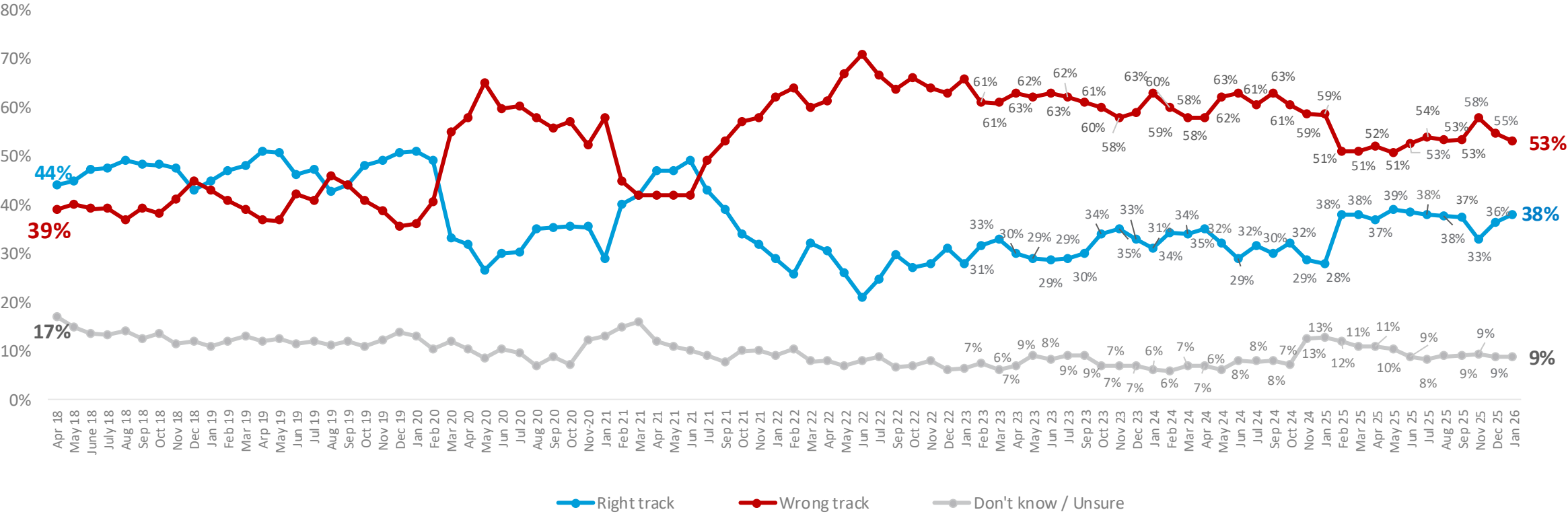
M1. In general, do you think the country is on the right track or is it off on the wrong track?

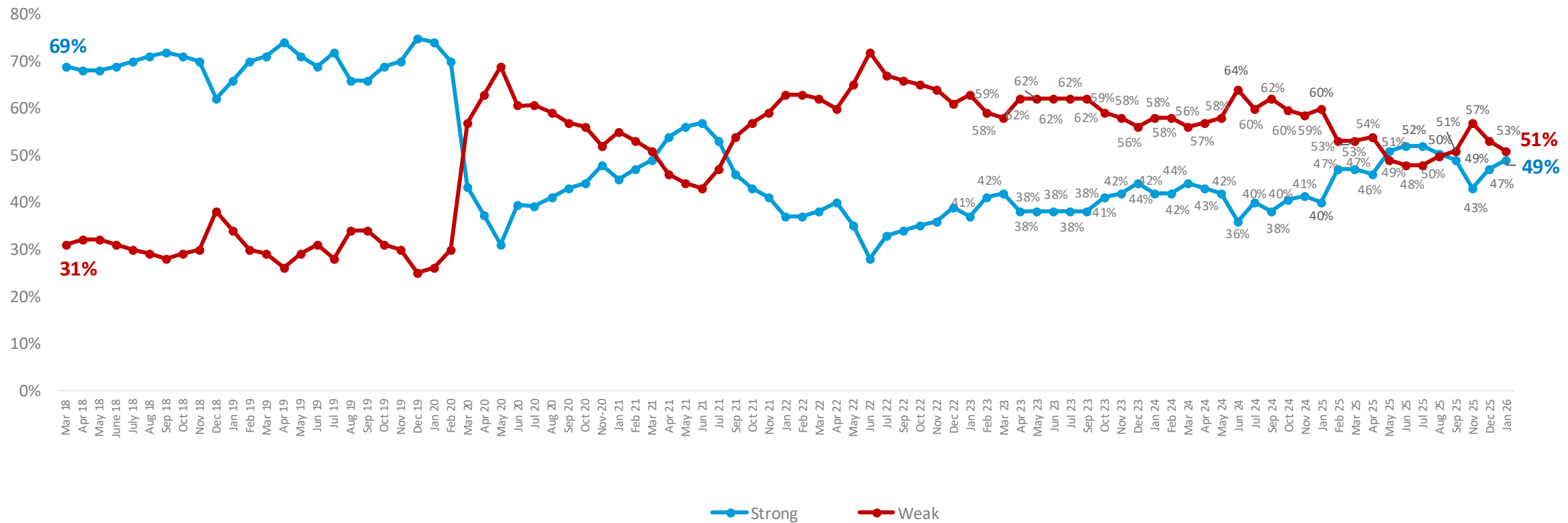

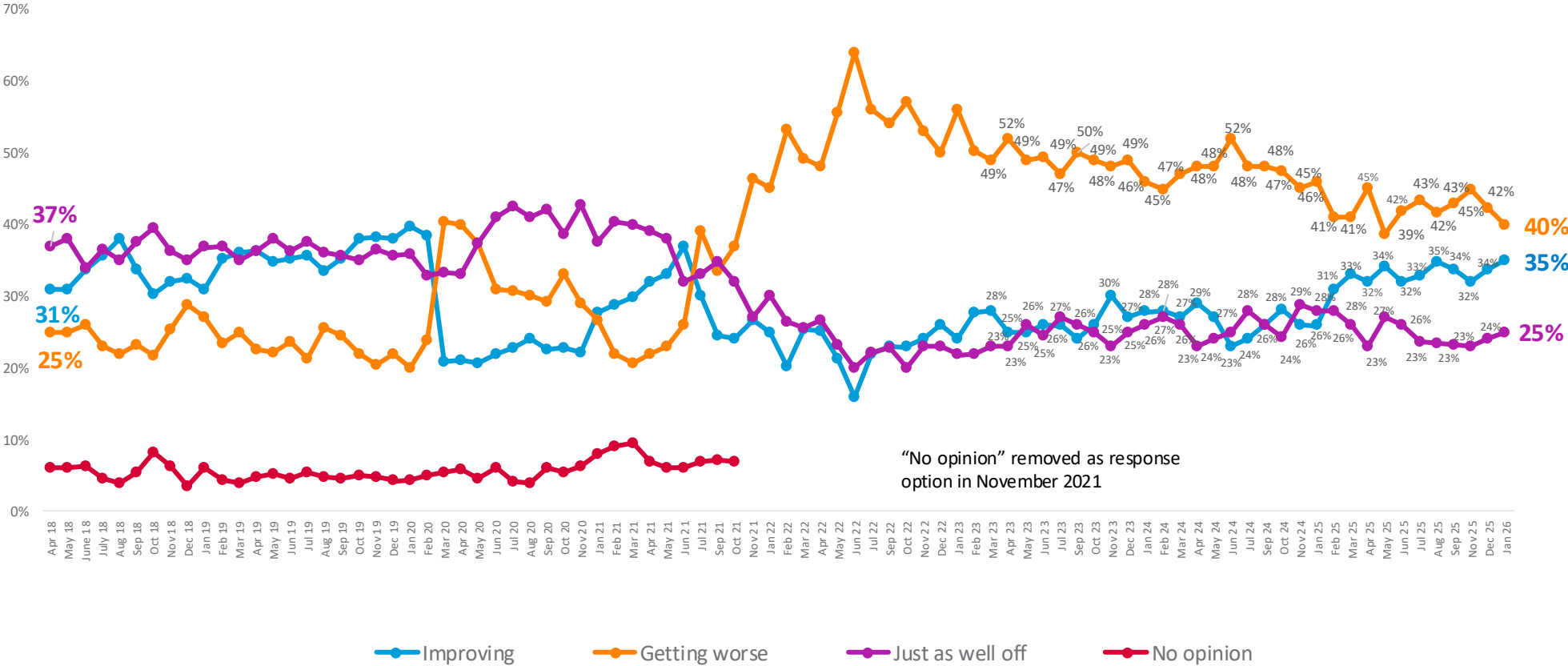
VOTERS ARE SPLIT ON WHETHER THE ECONOMY IS WEAK OR STRONG

Would you say that your personal financial situation is improving or getting worse?

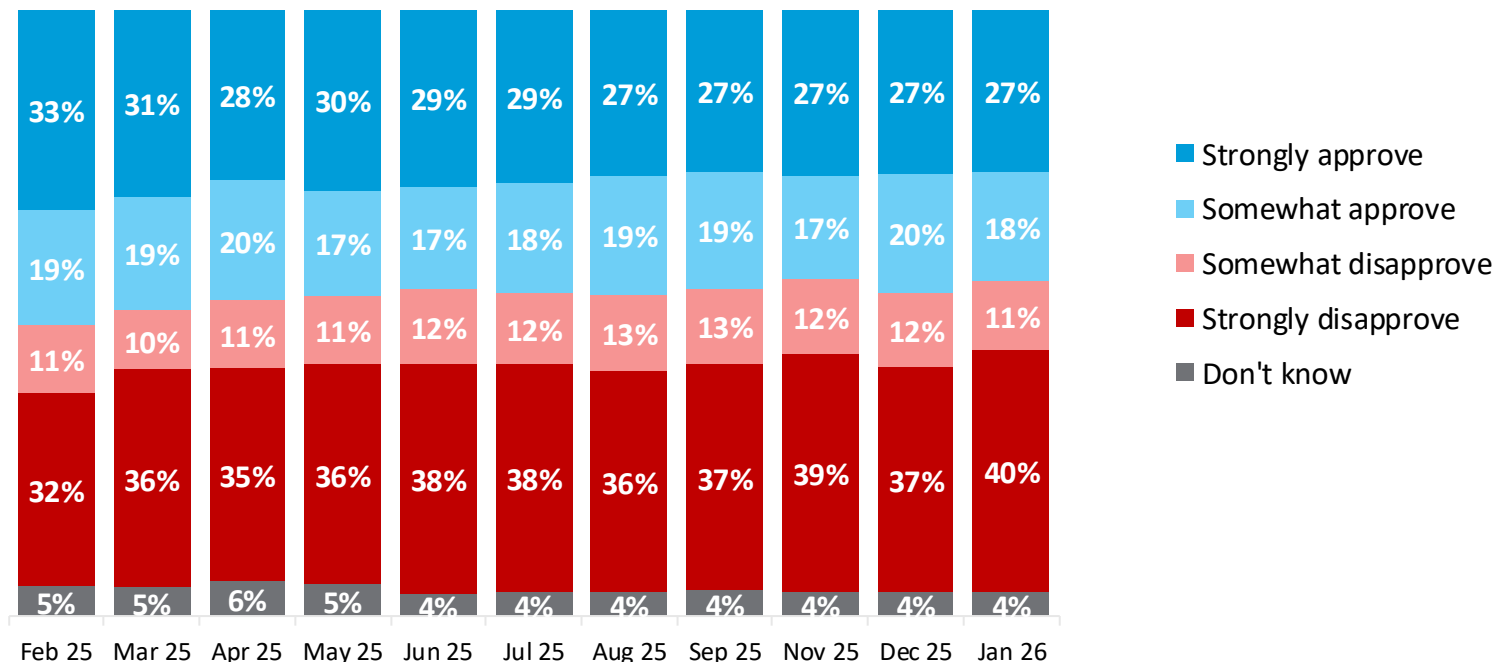

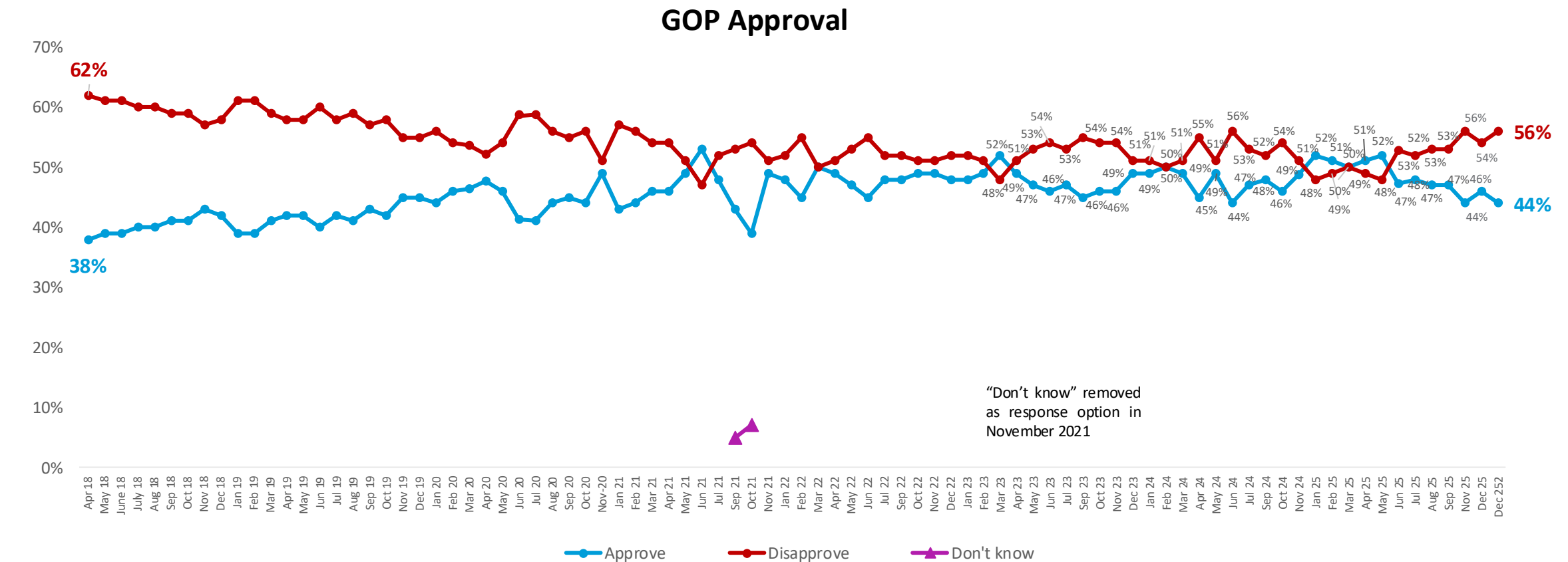

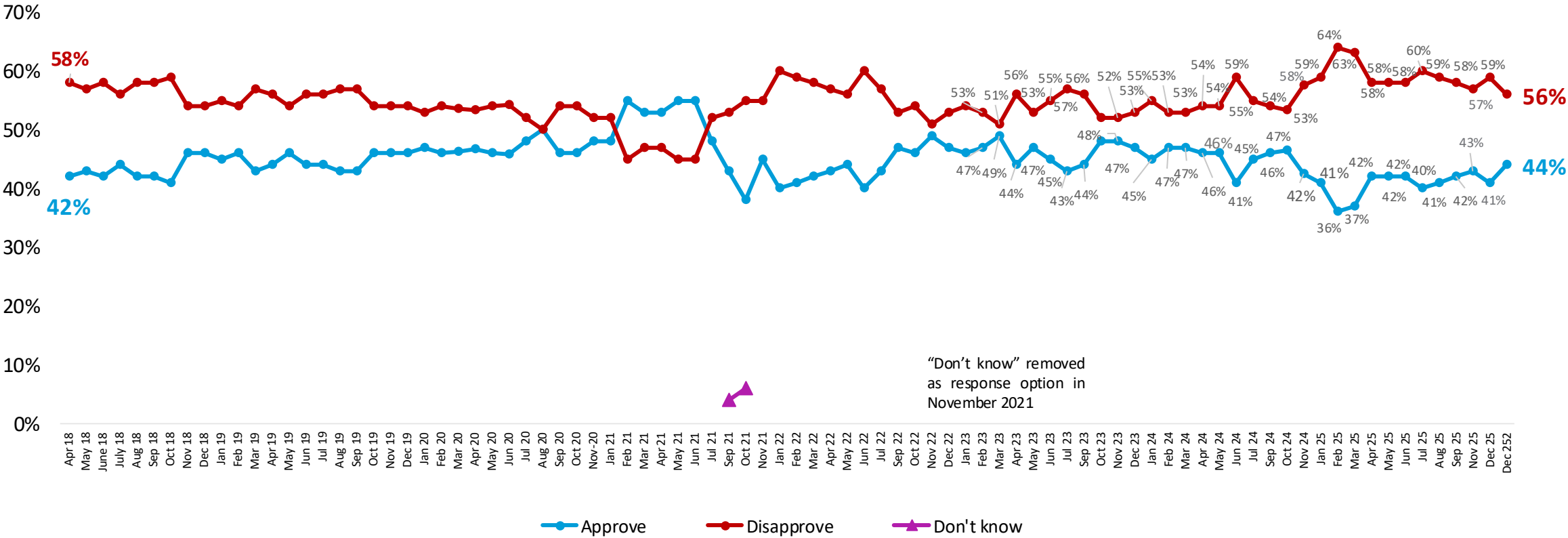

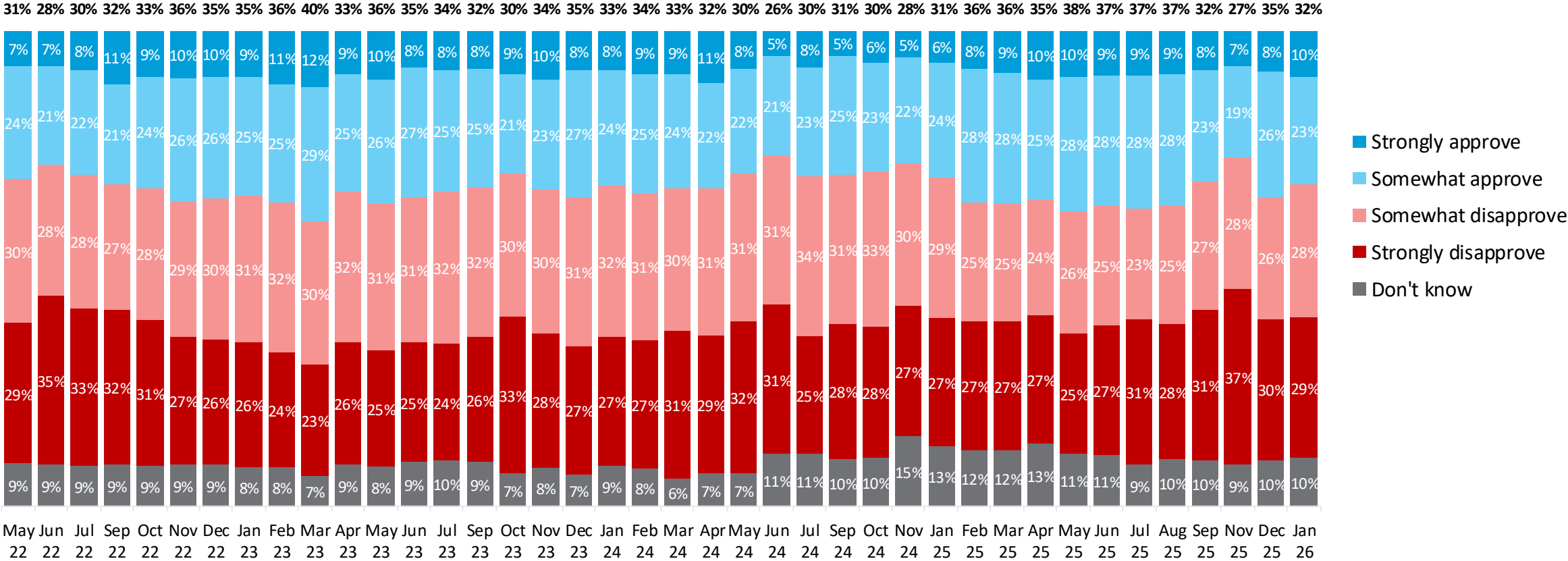

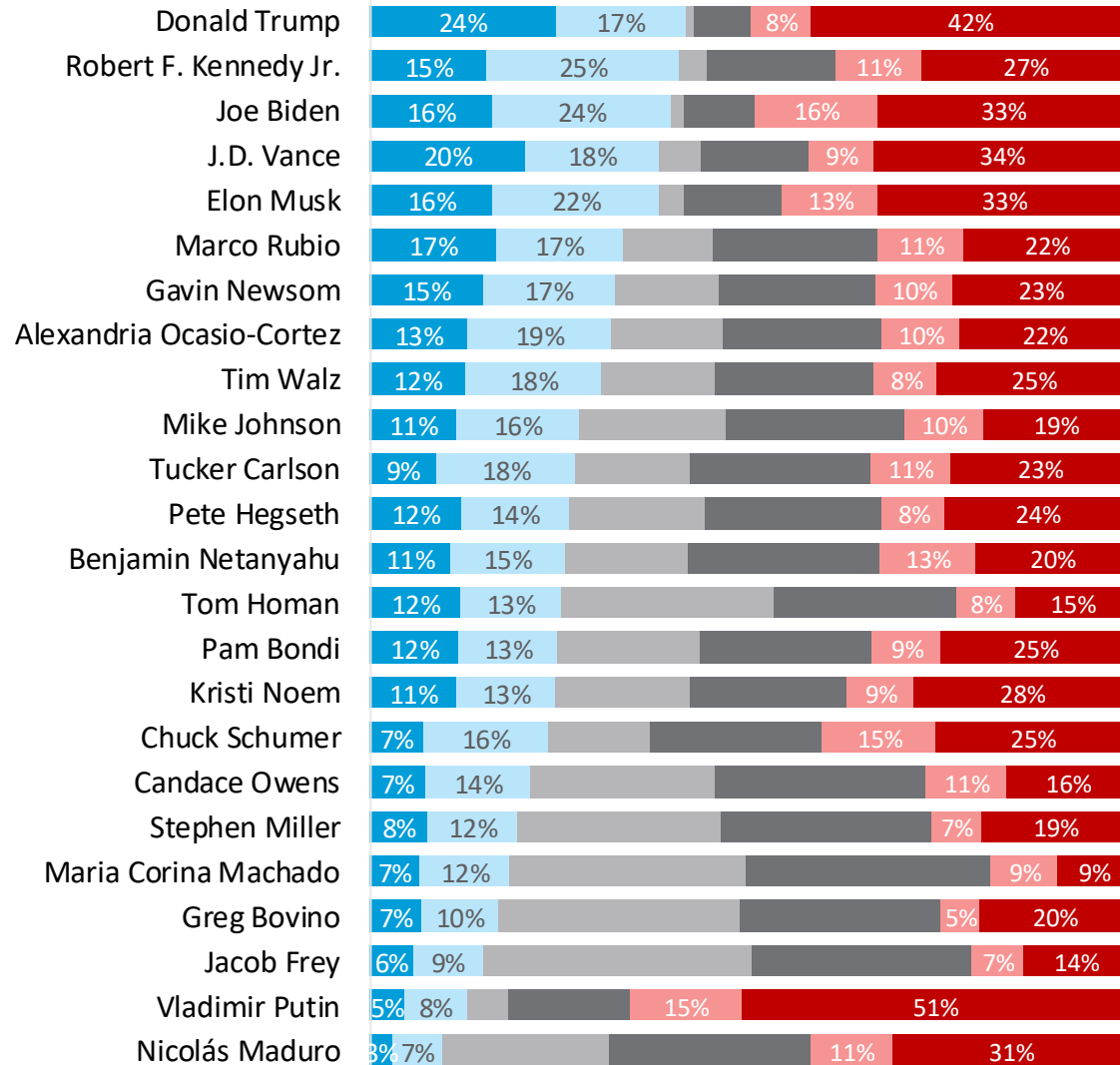
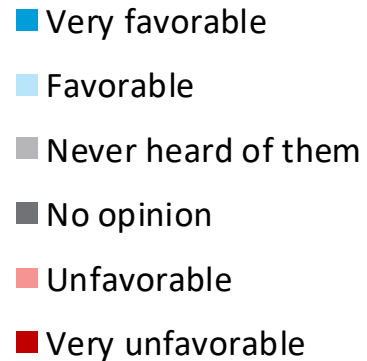
CONGRESSIONAL APPROVAL SLIPS TO 32%

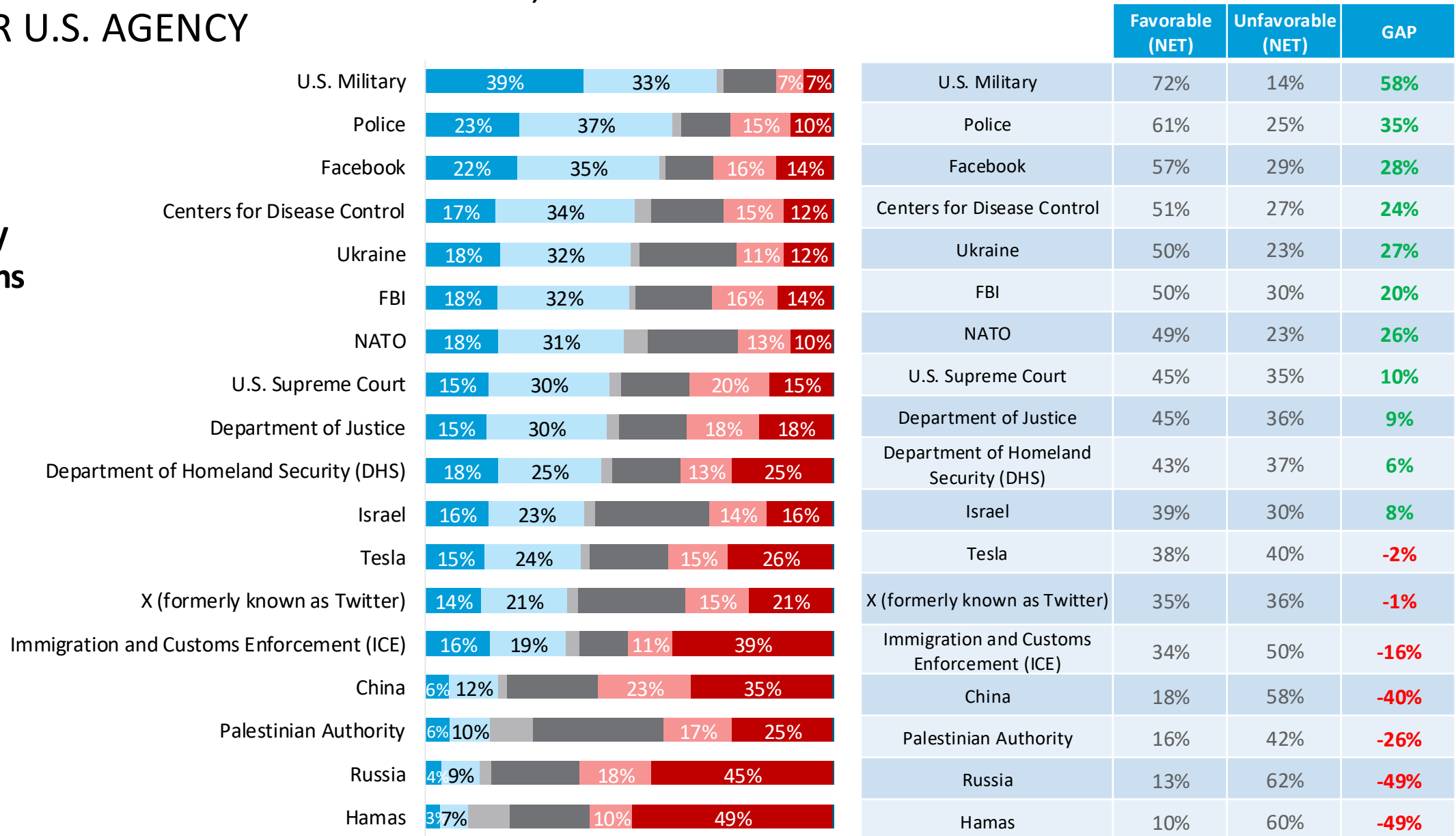

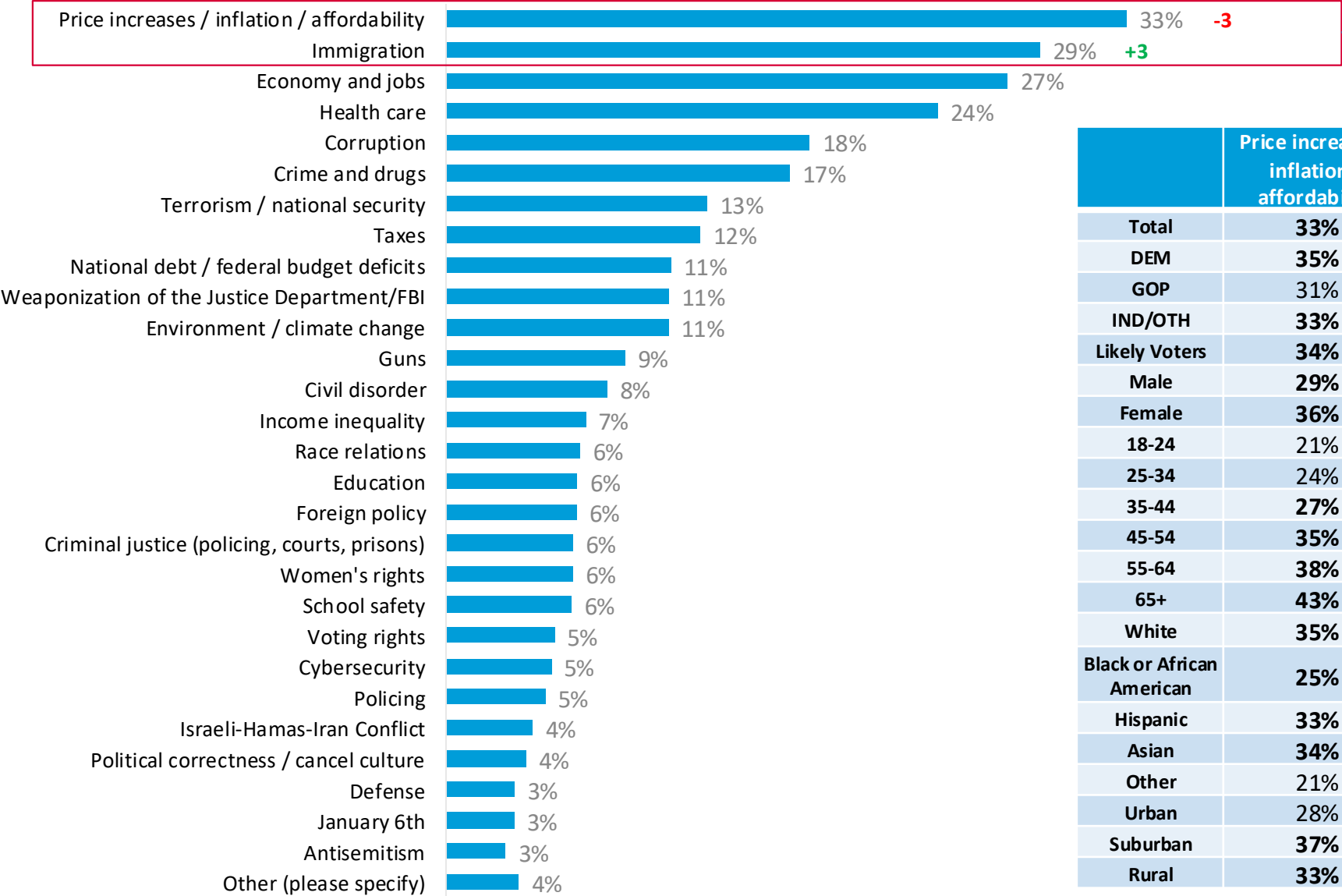

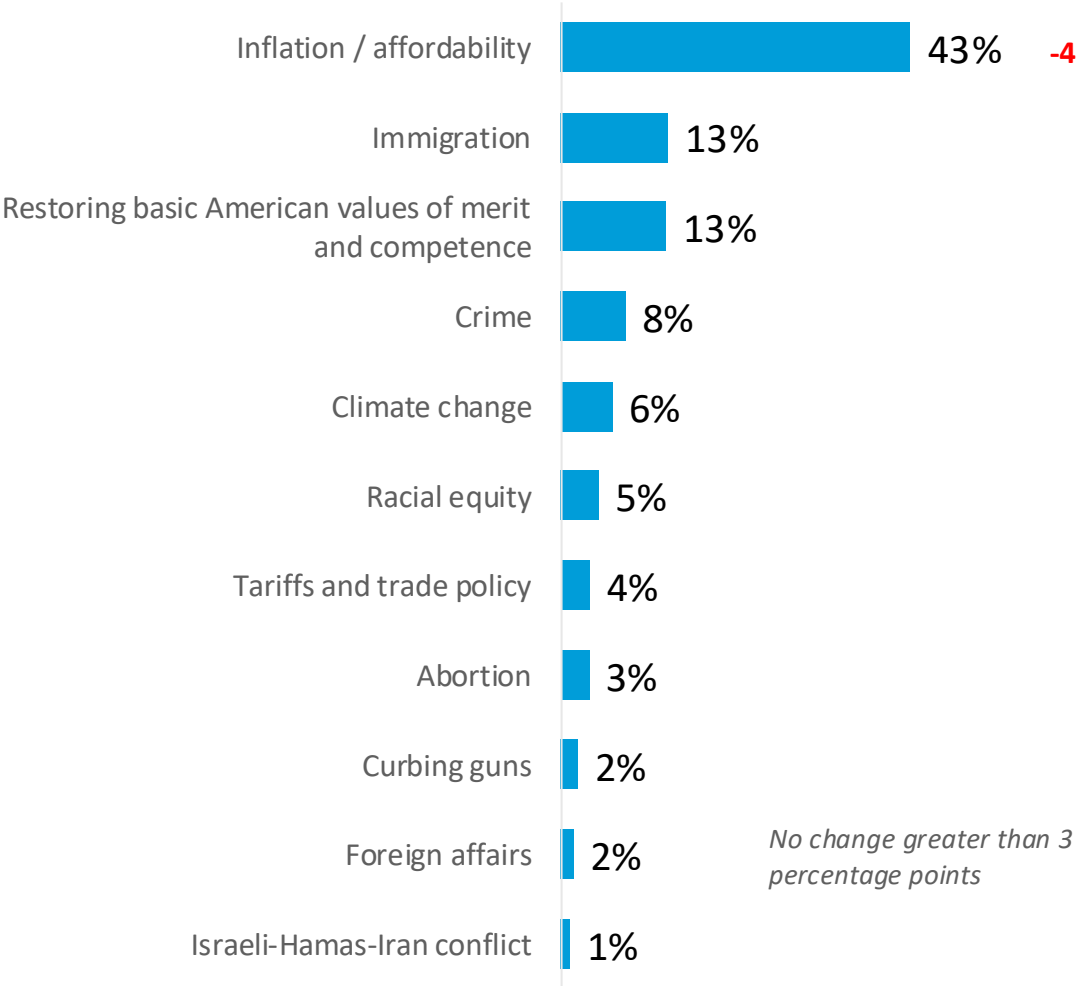

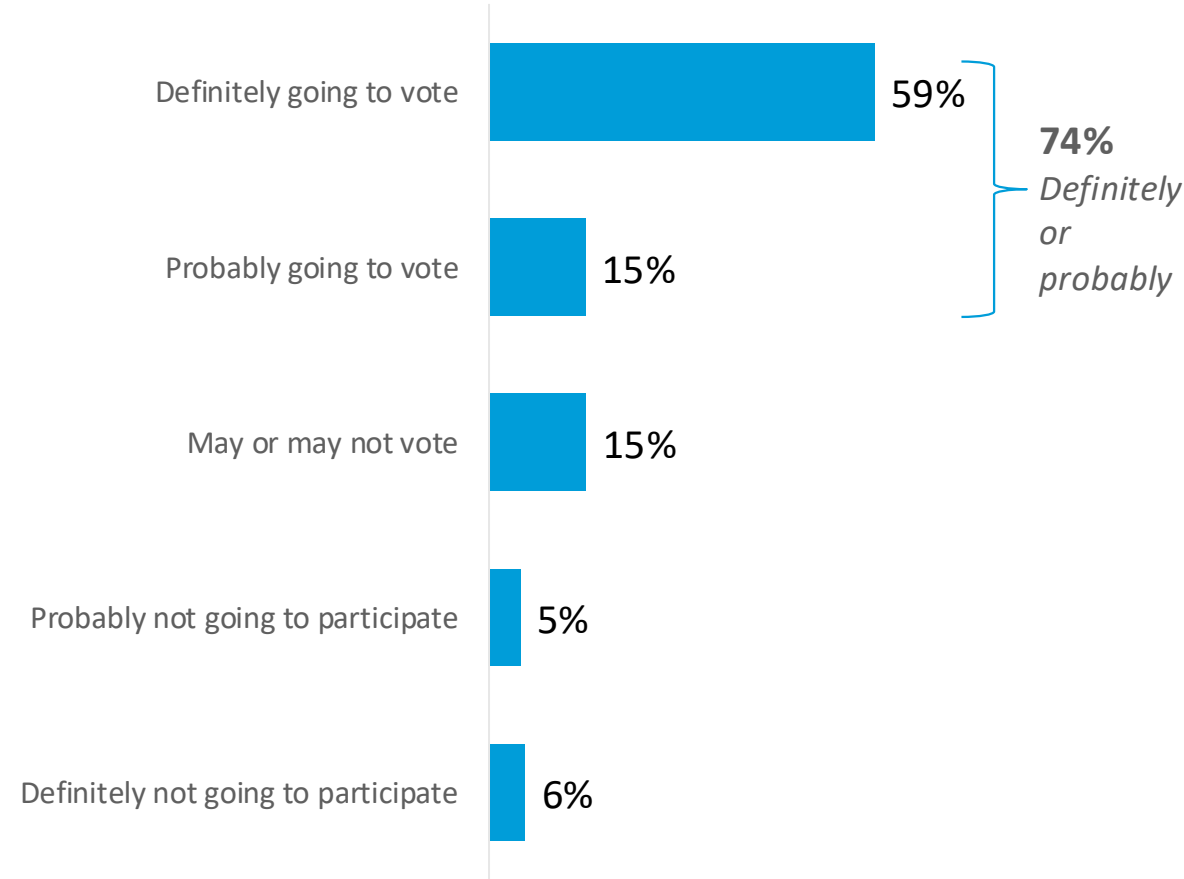

How likely or unlikely are you to vote in the upcoming 2026 Congressional midterm elections on November 3rd?

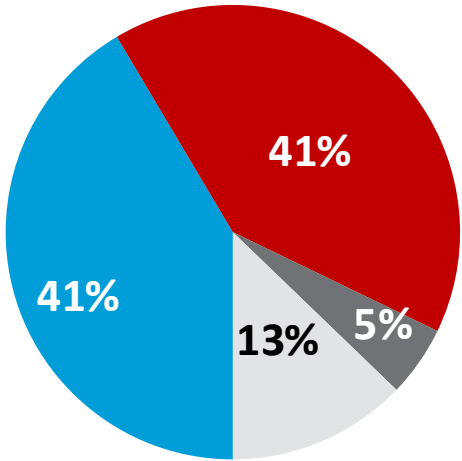

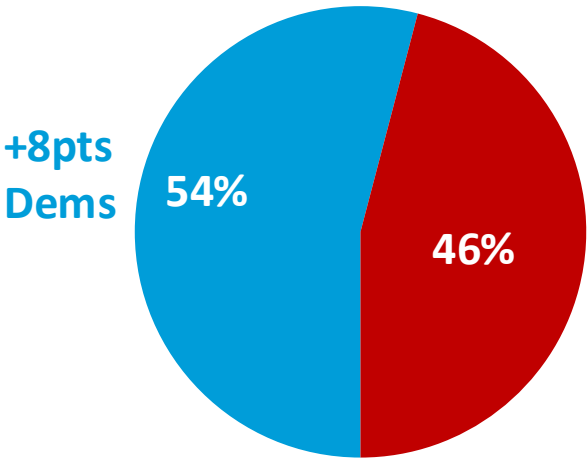

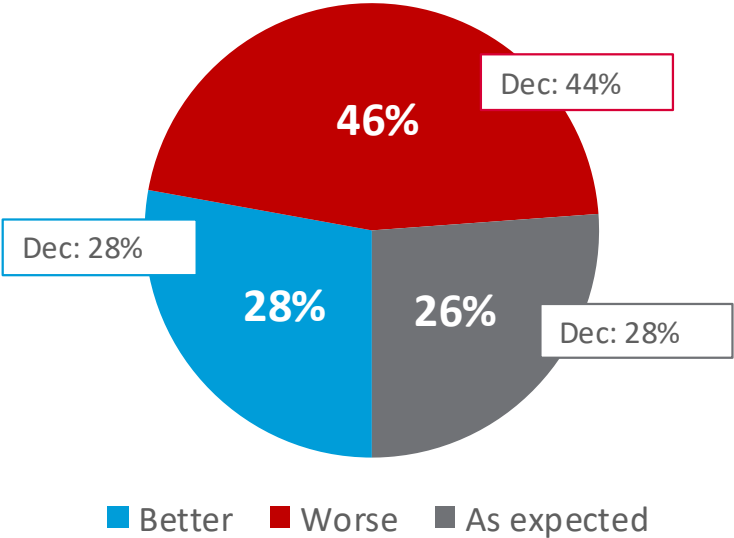

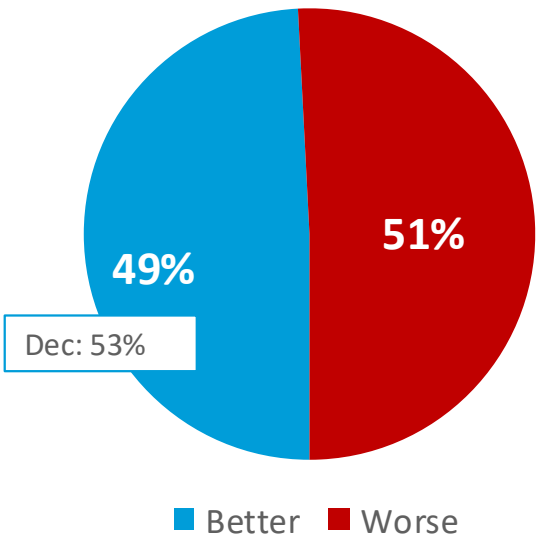

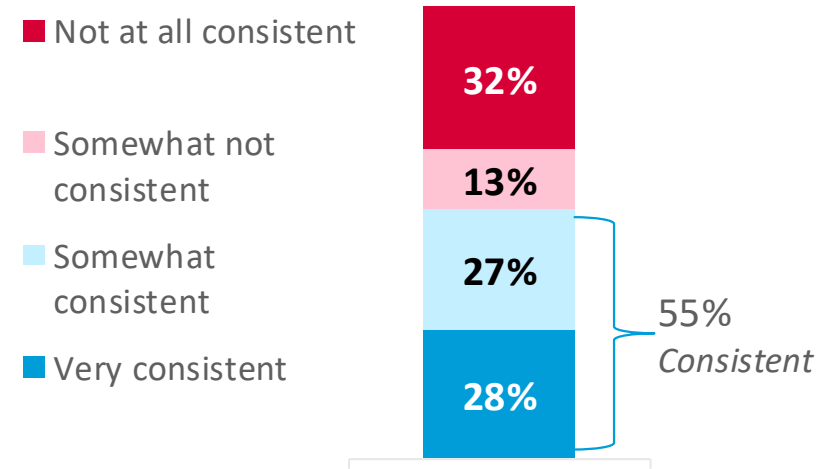

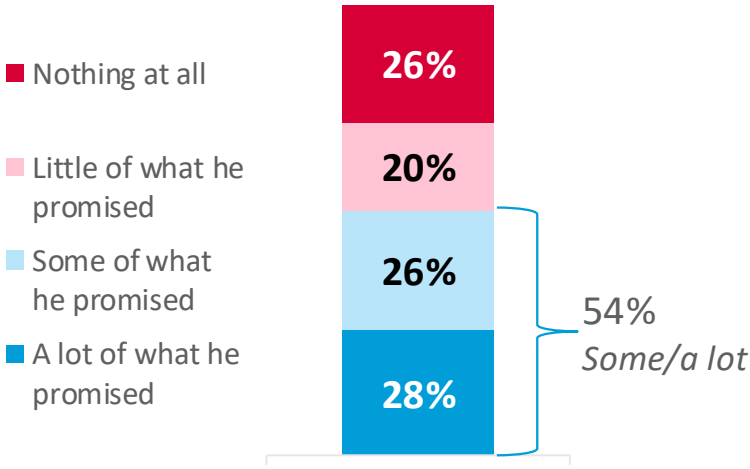

Do you think that Donald Trump's policies in his first year in office were consistent with his campaign promises or not?



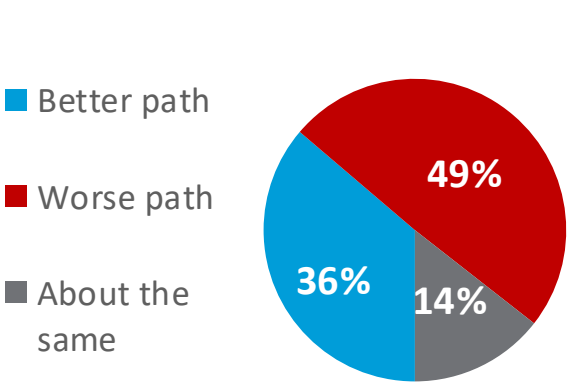

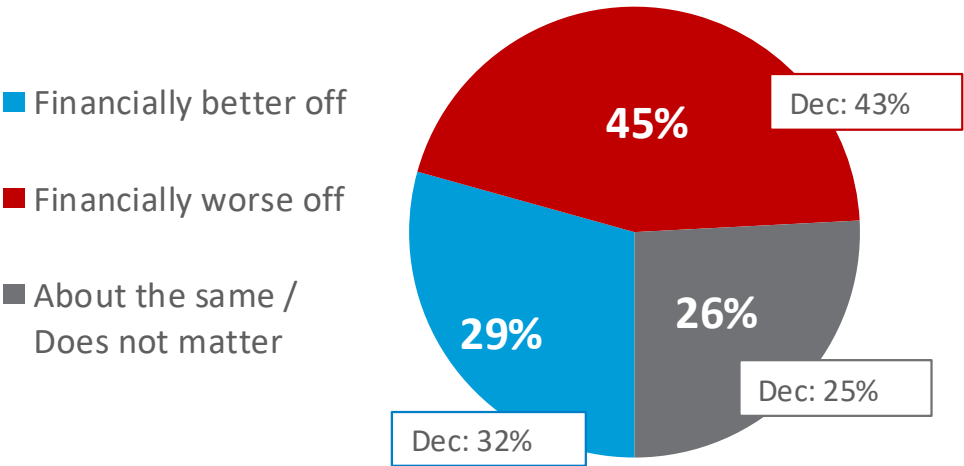

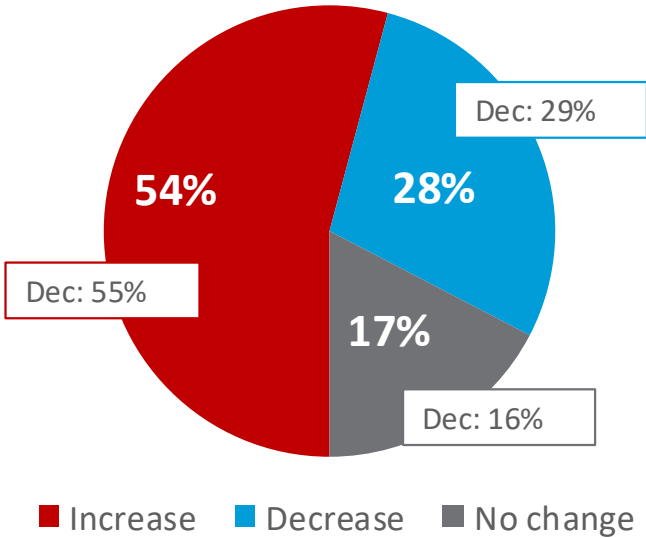

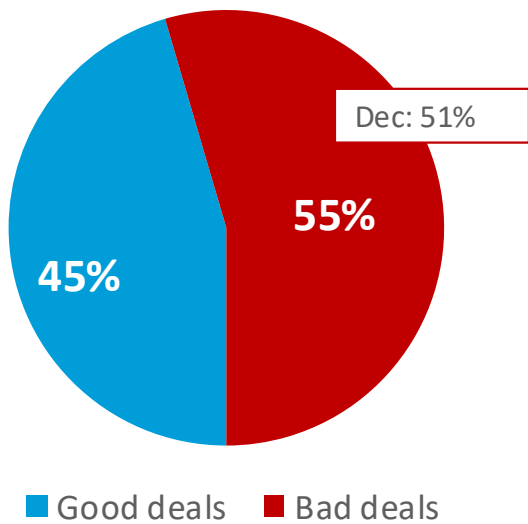

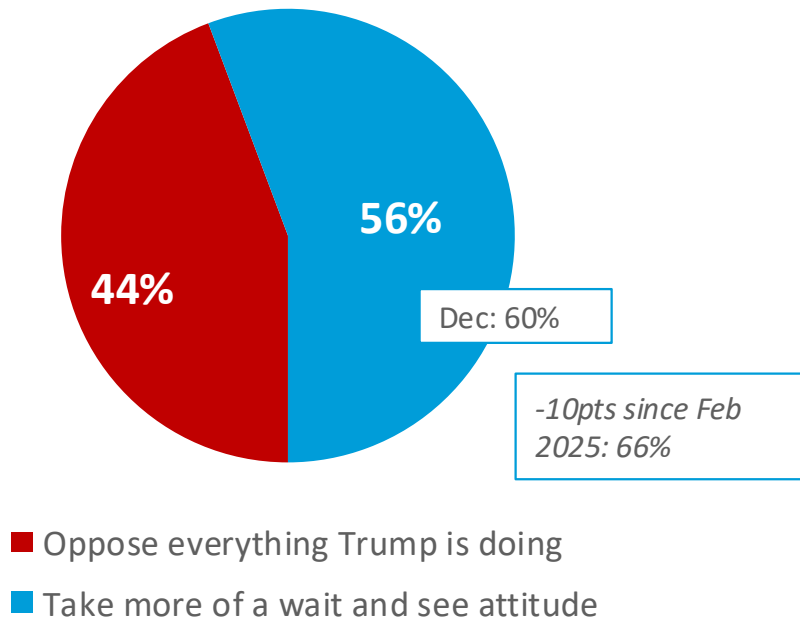

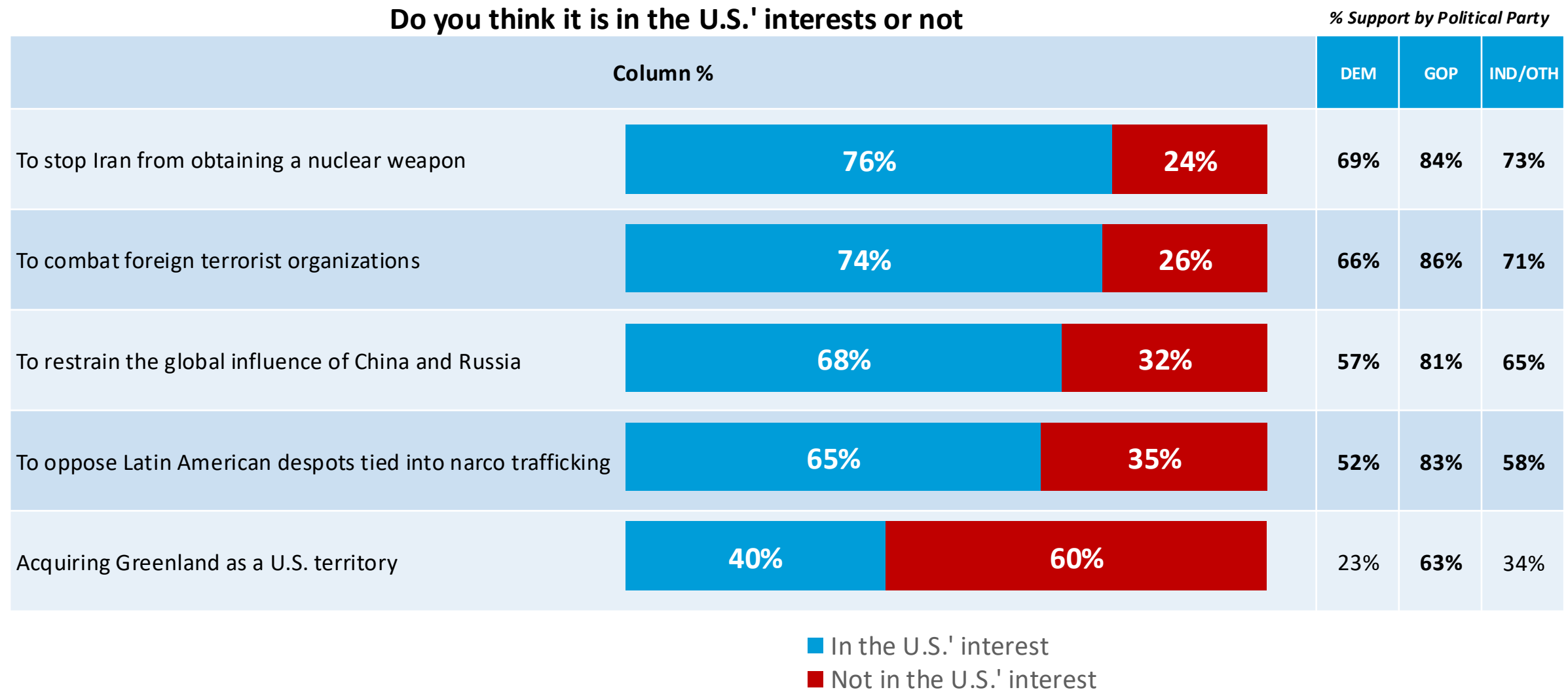

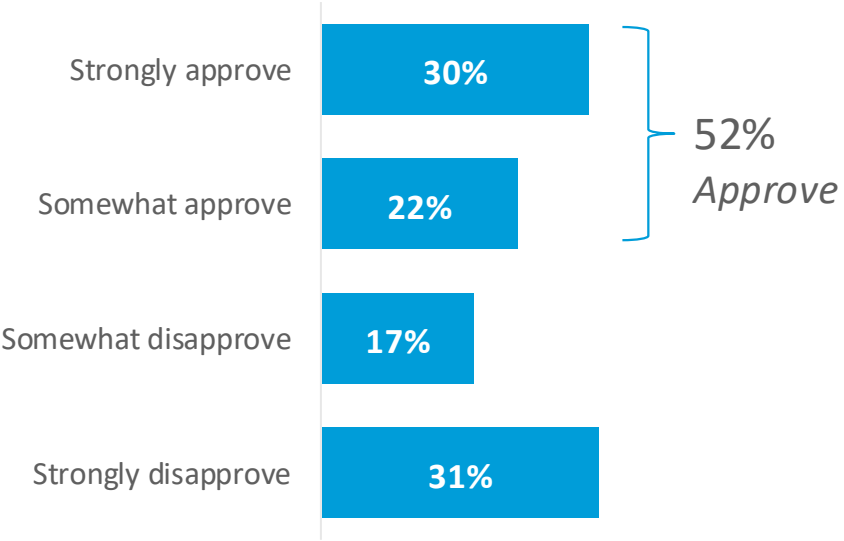

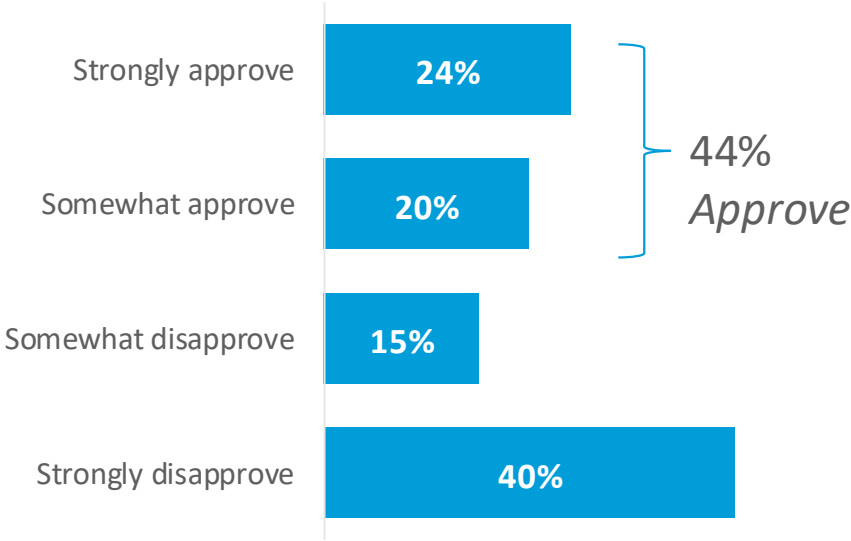

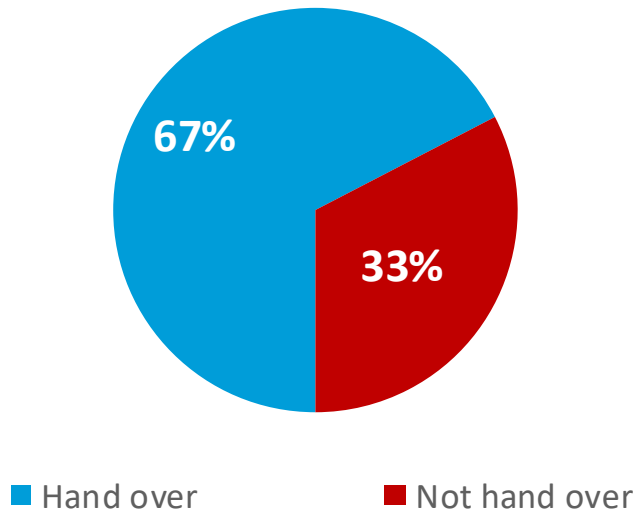

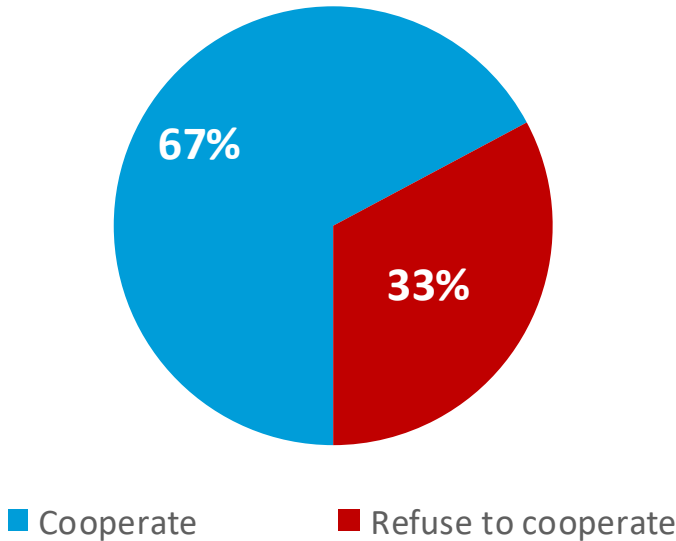

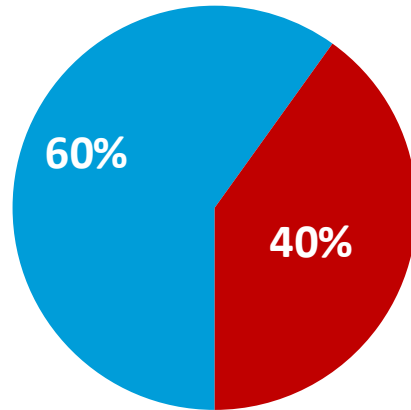

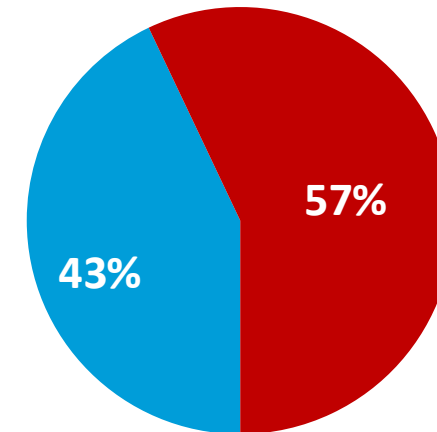

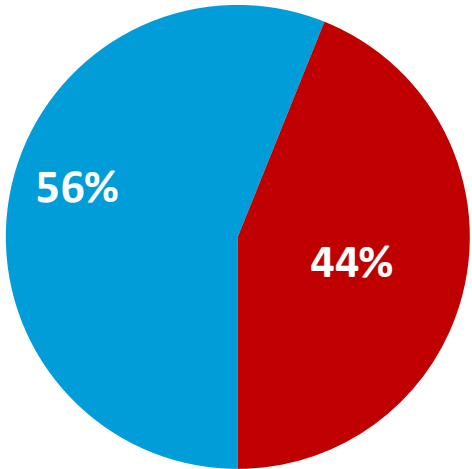

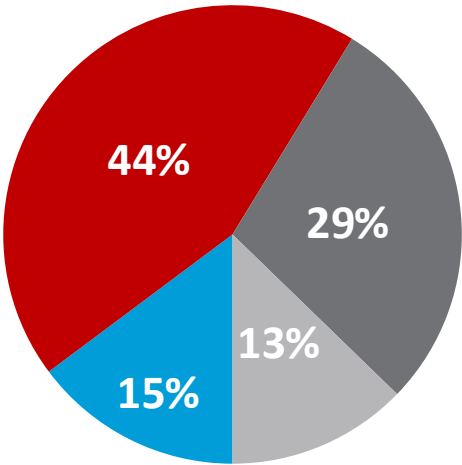

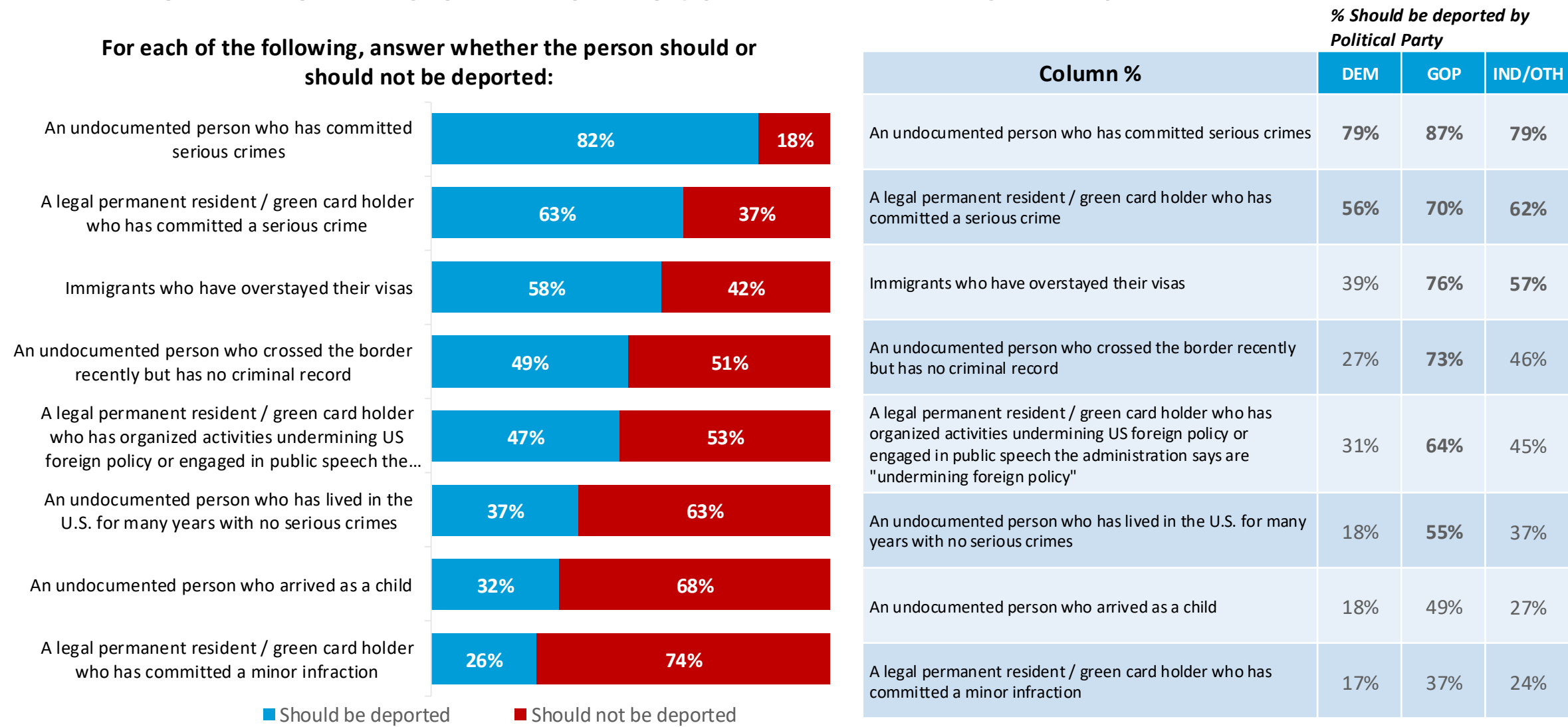

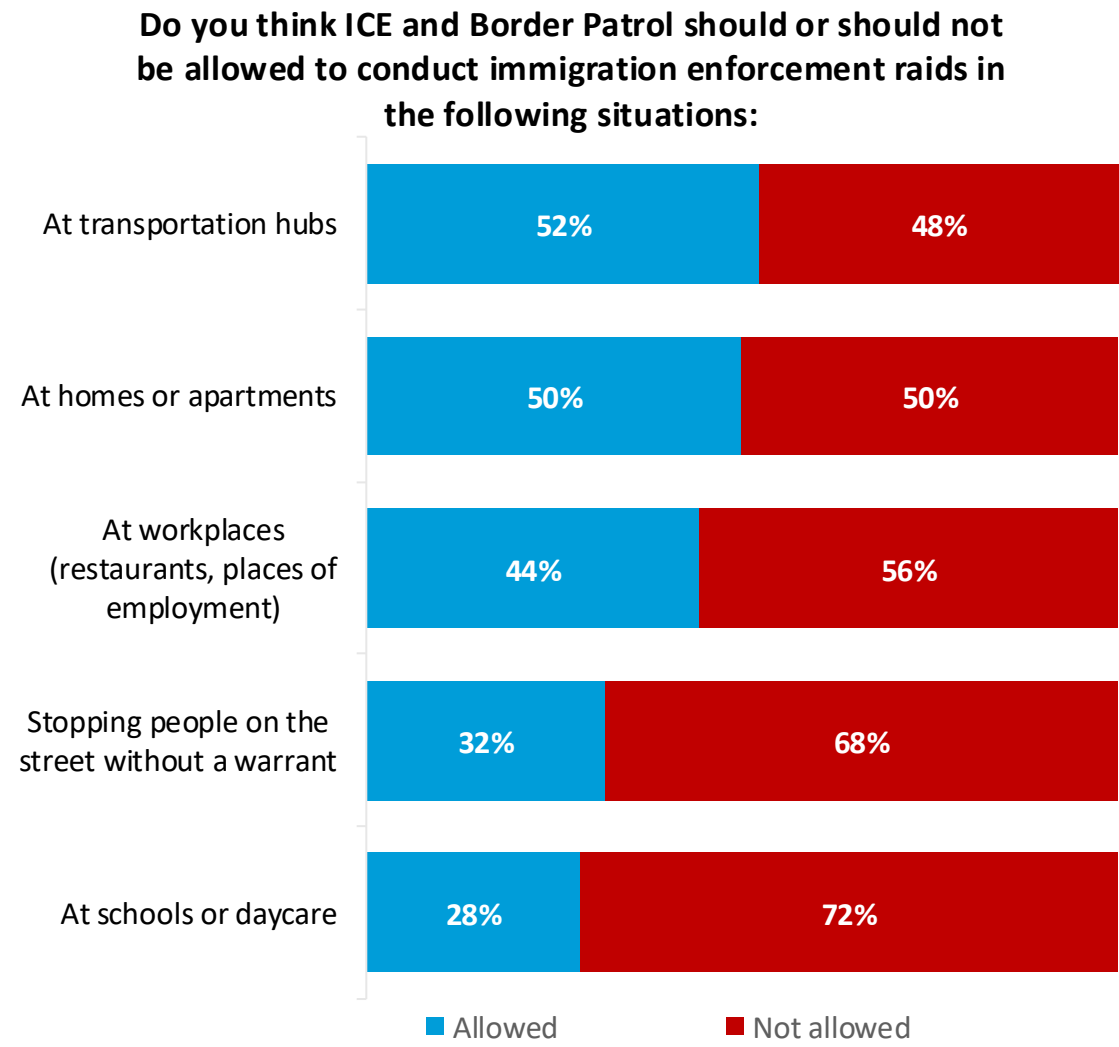

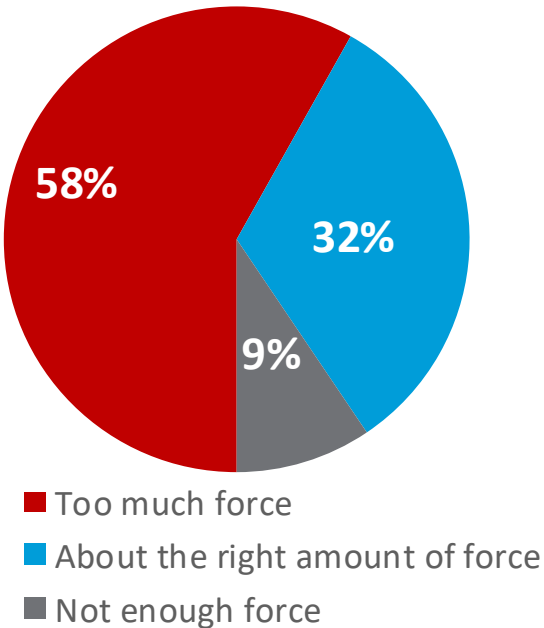

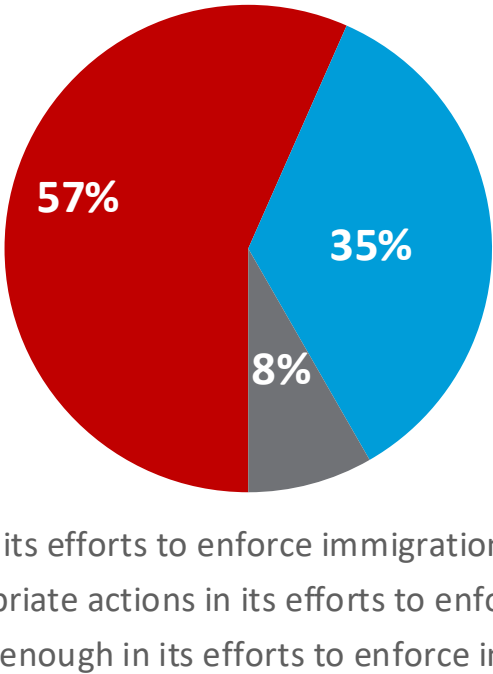

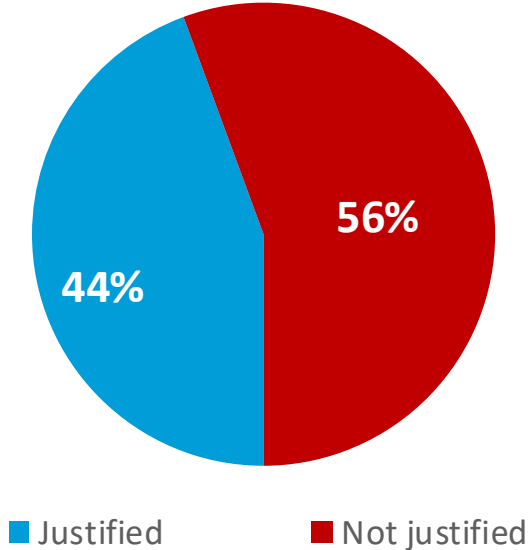

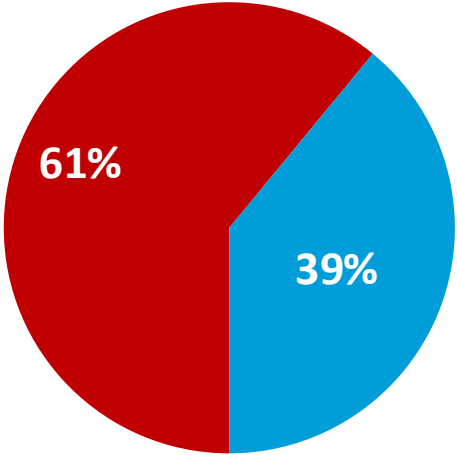

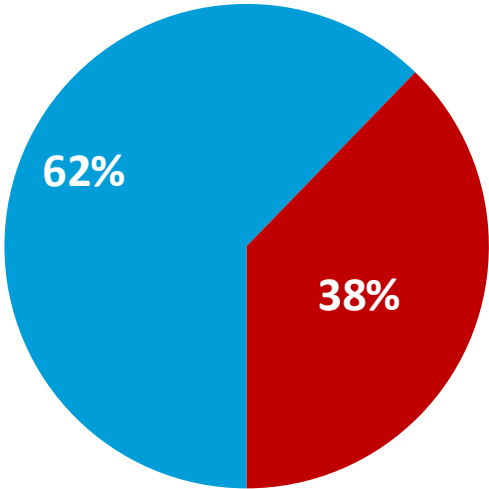

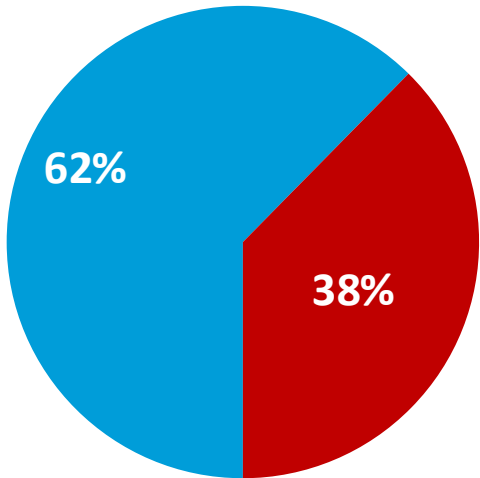

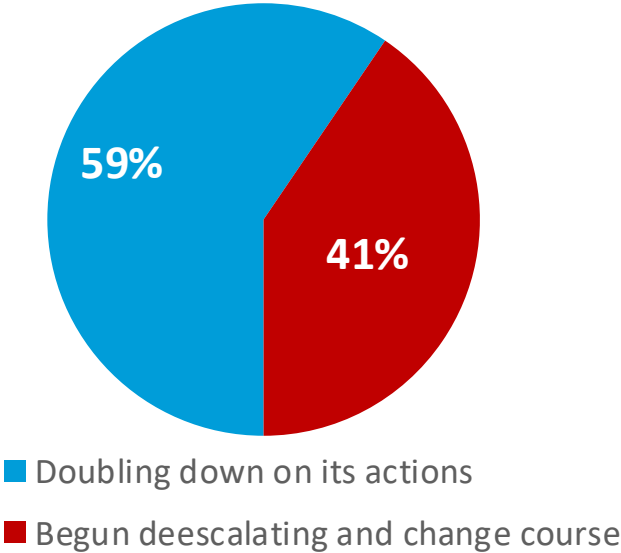

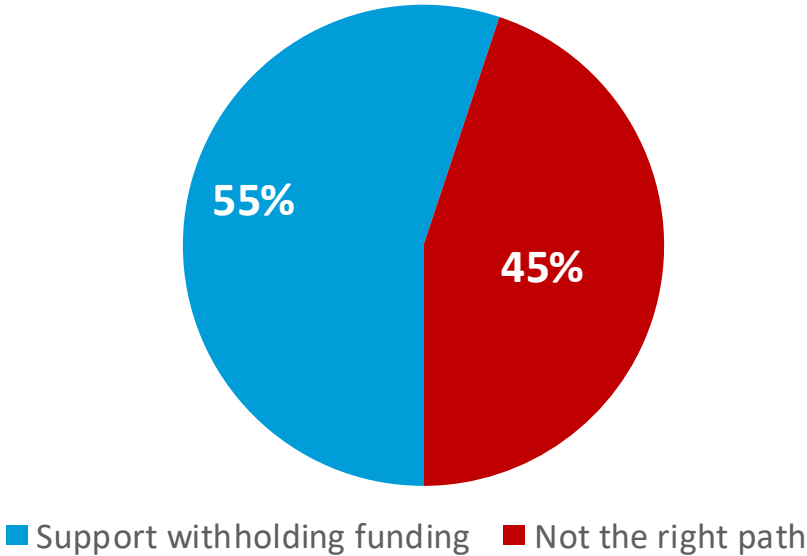

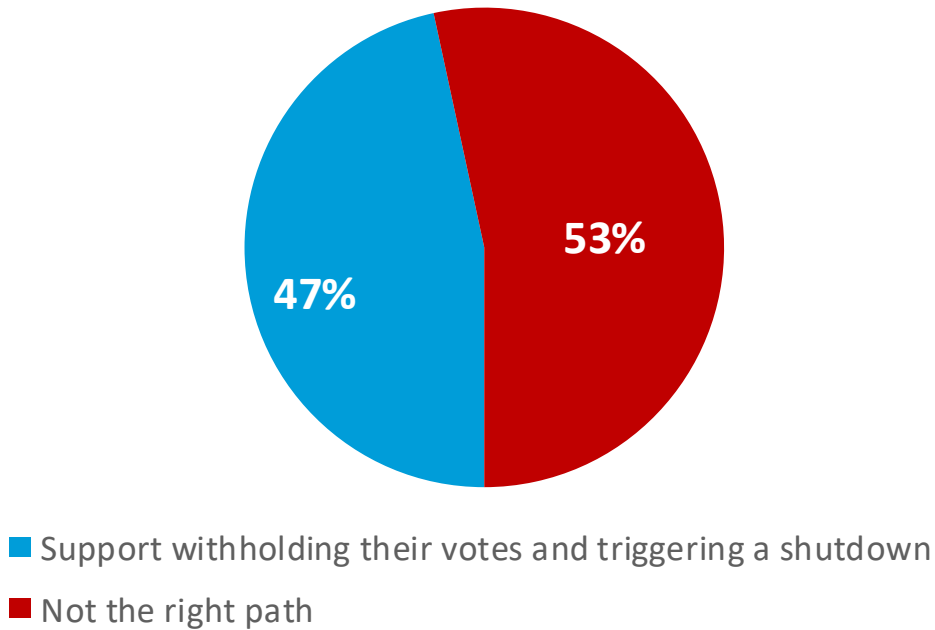

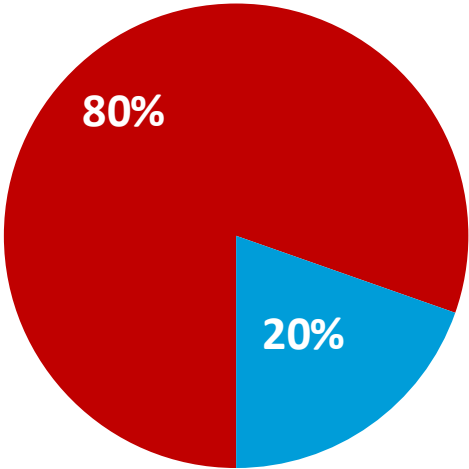

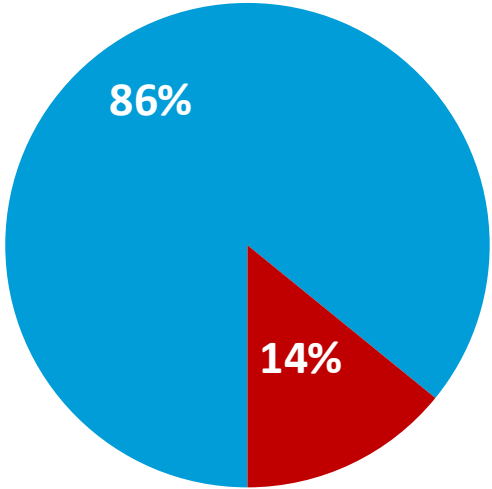

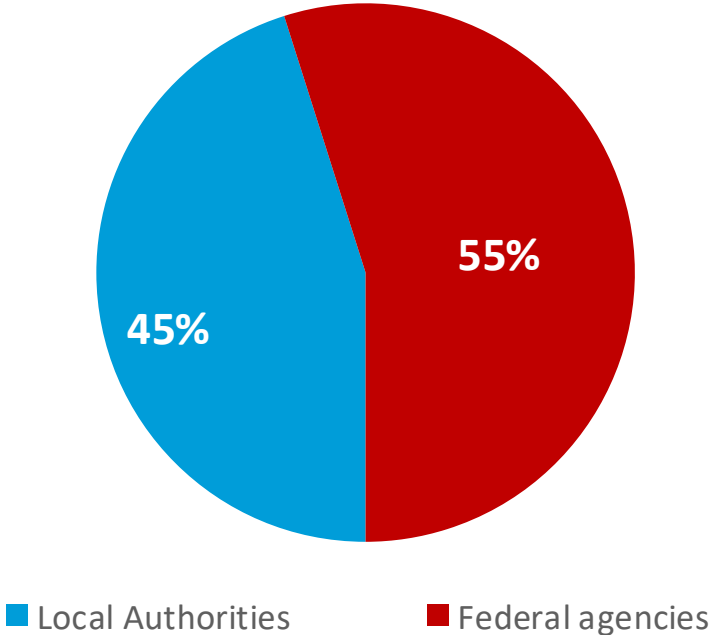

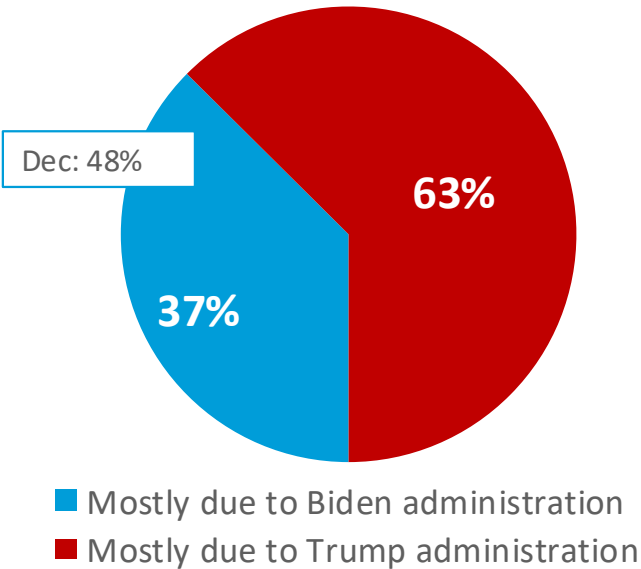

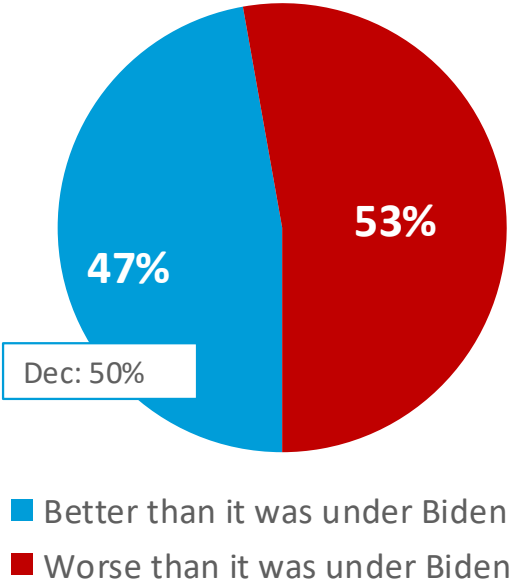

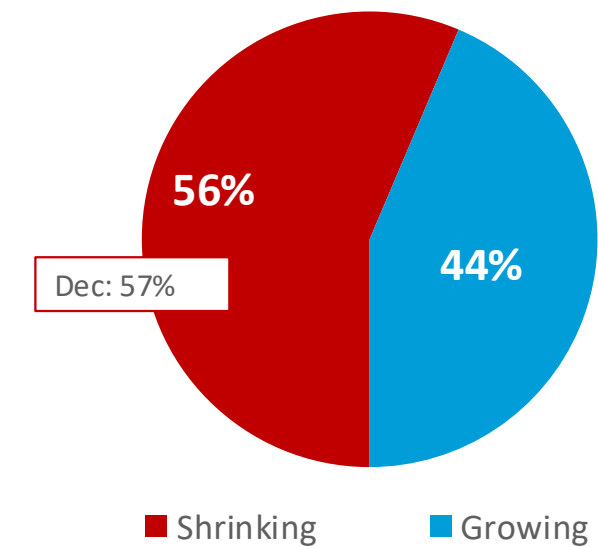

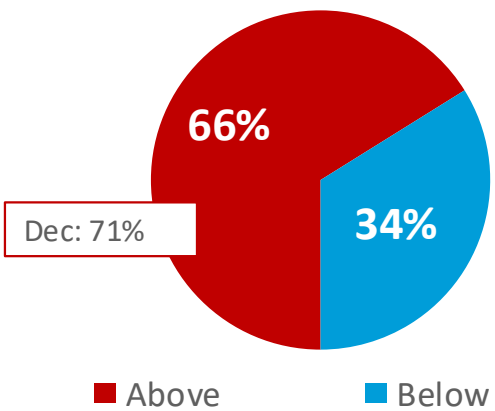

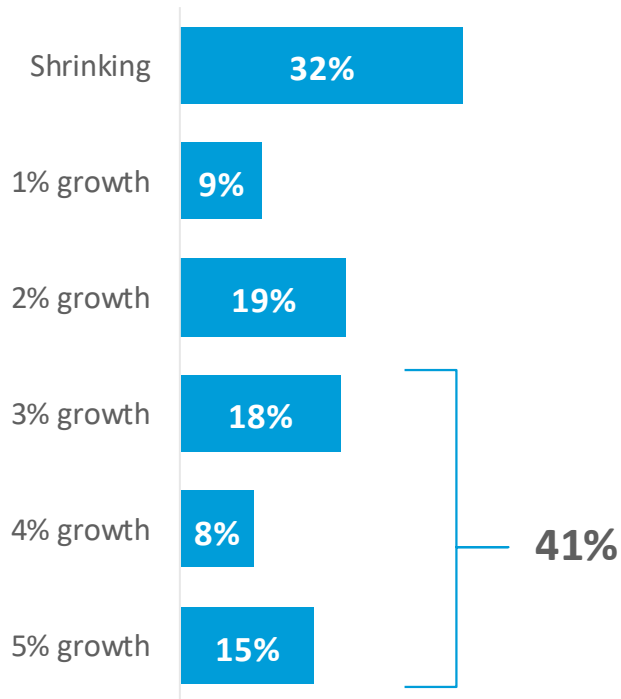

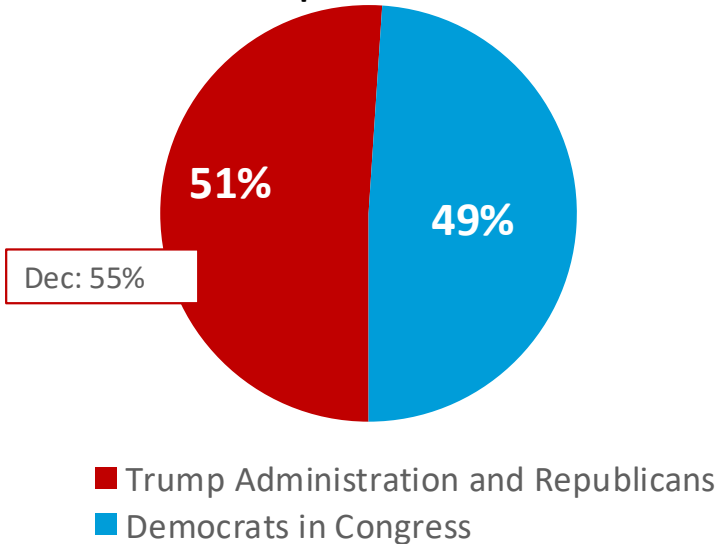

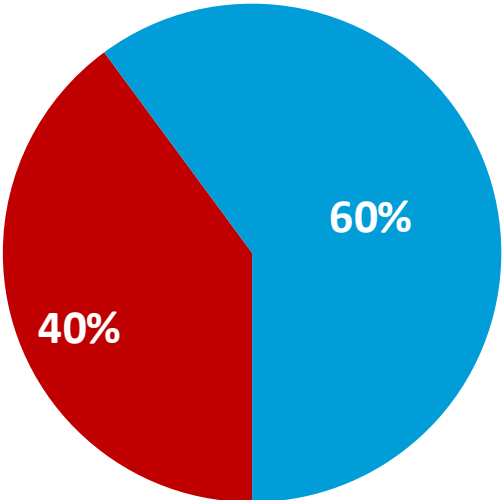

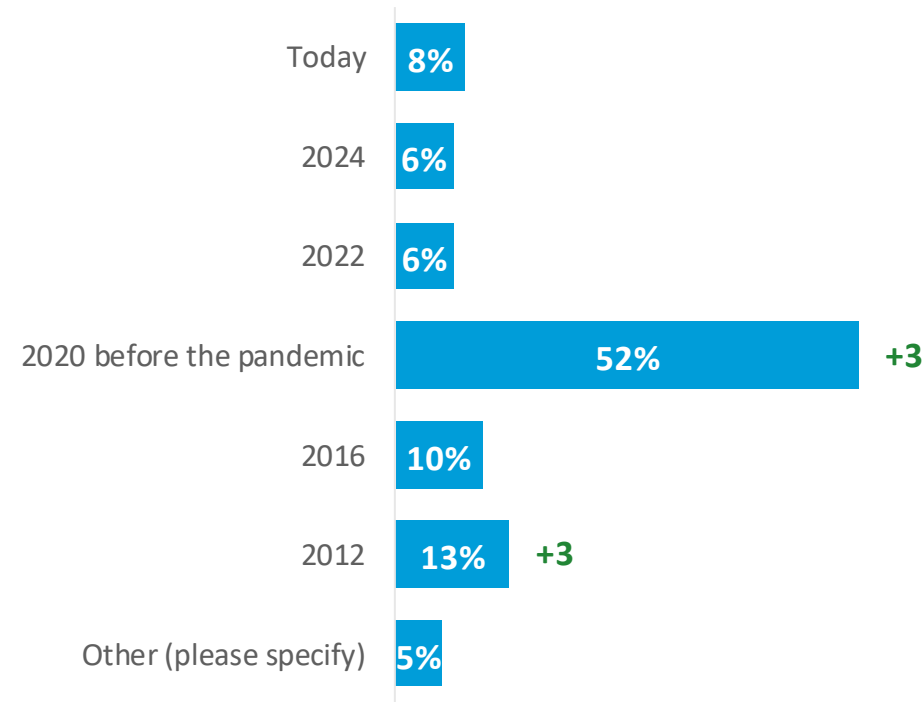

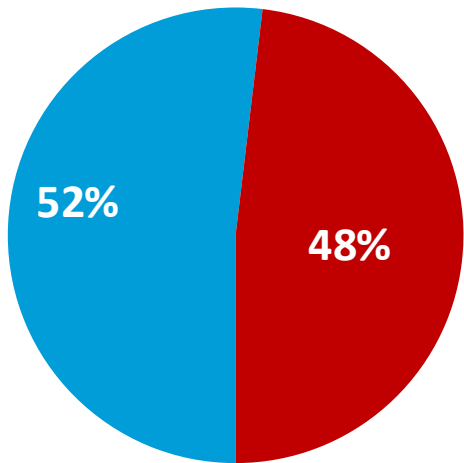

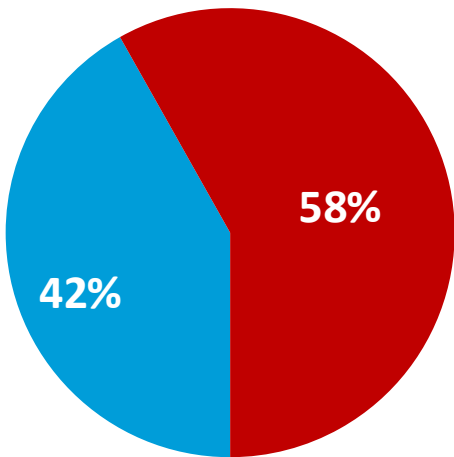

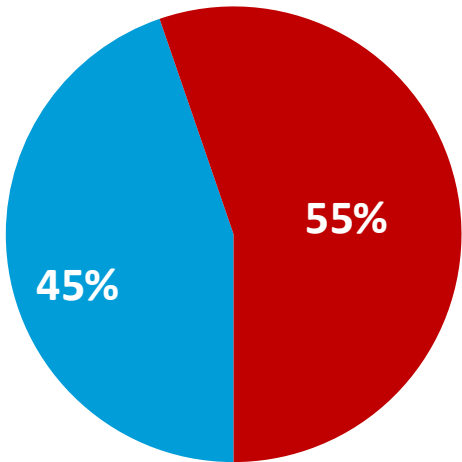

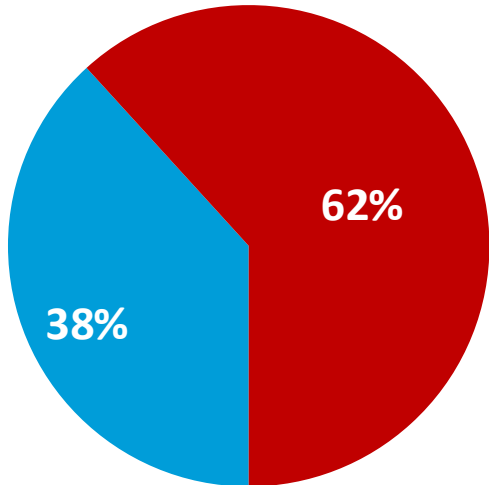

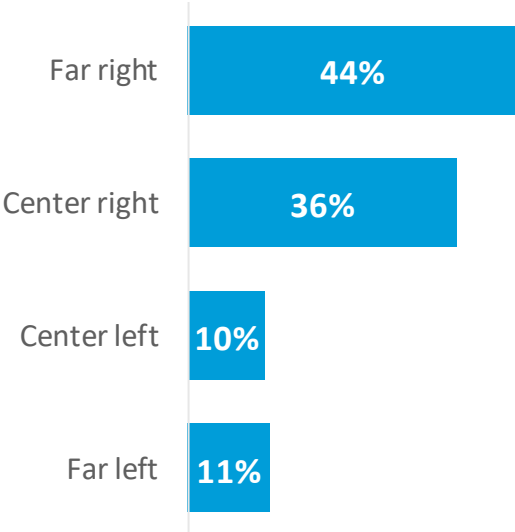

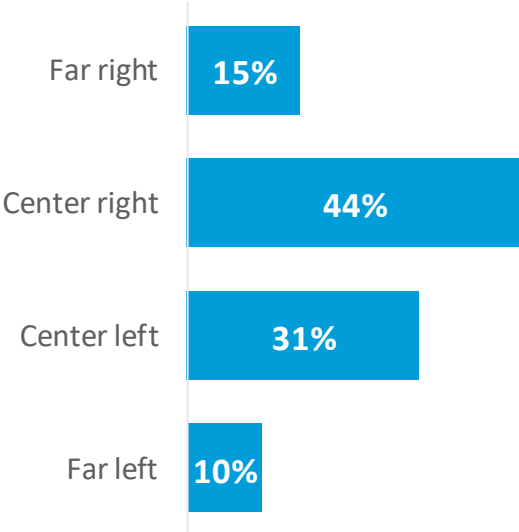

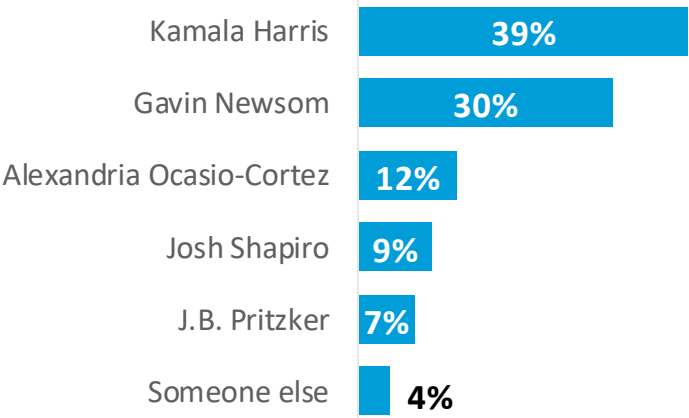

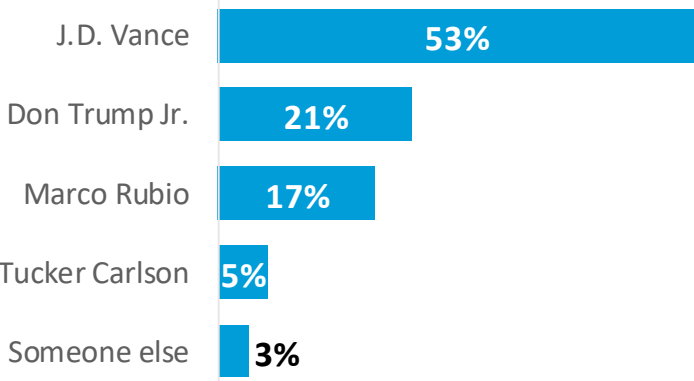

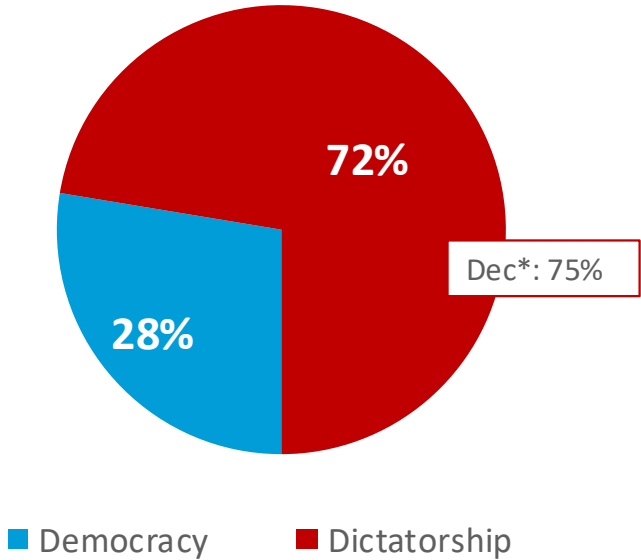

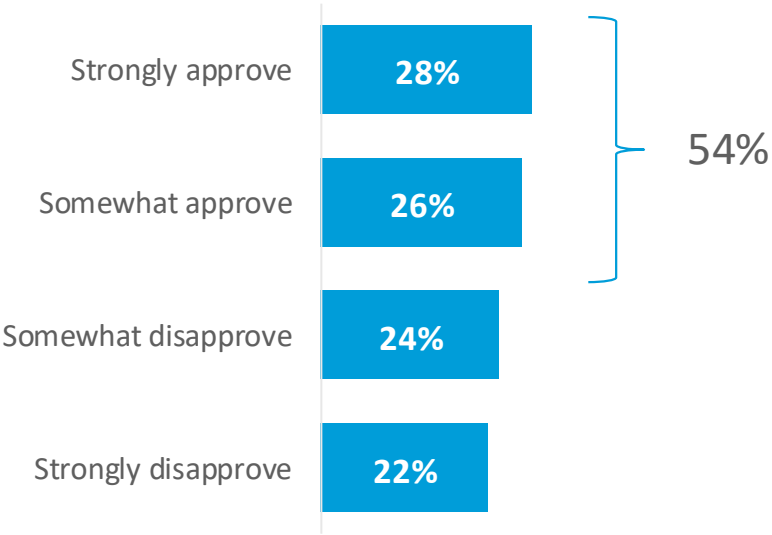

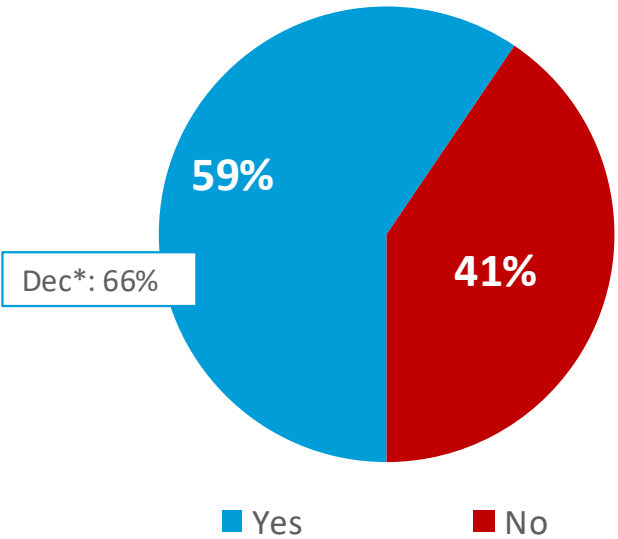

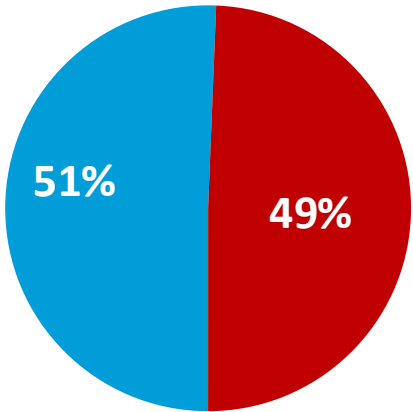

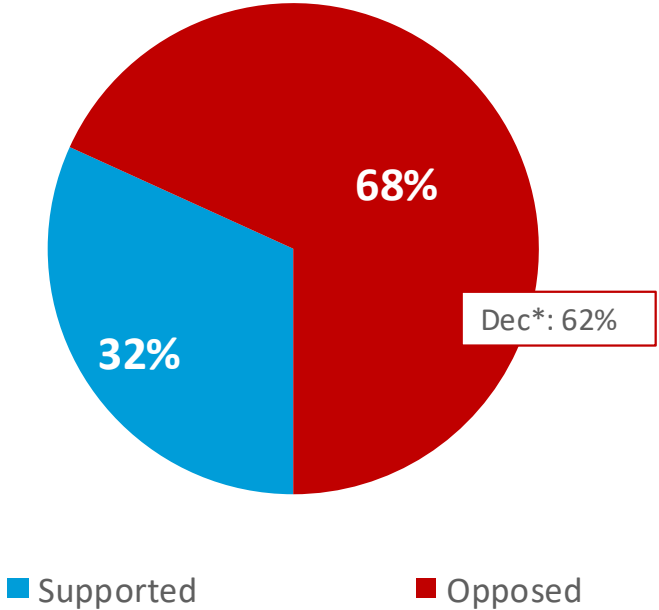

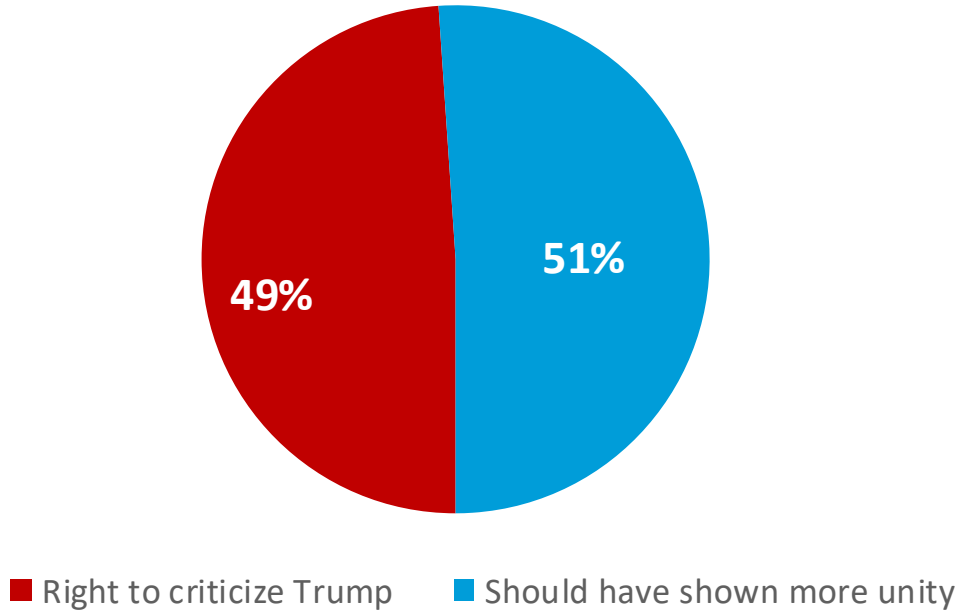

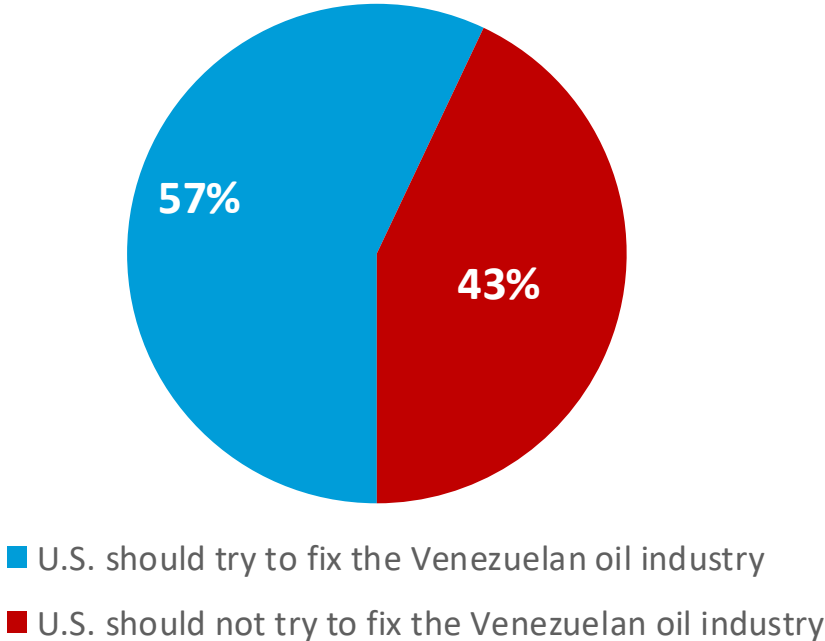

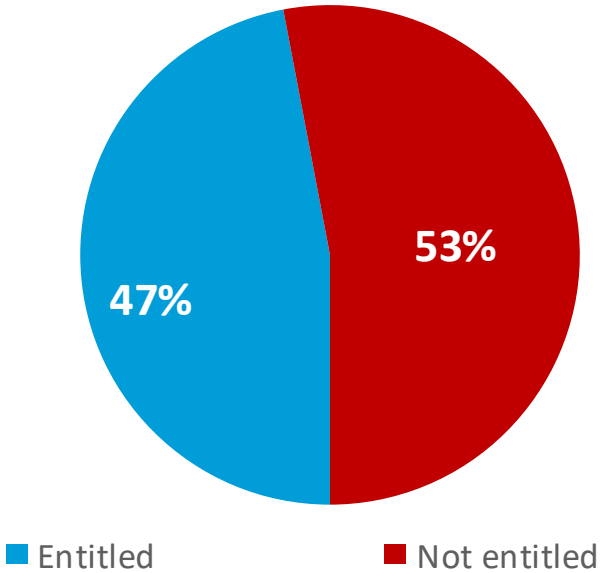

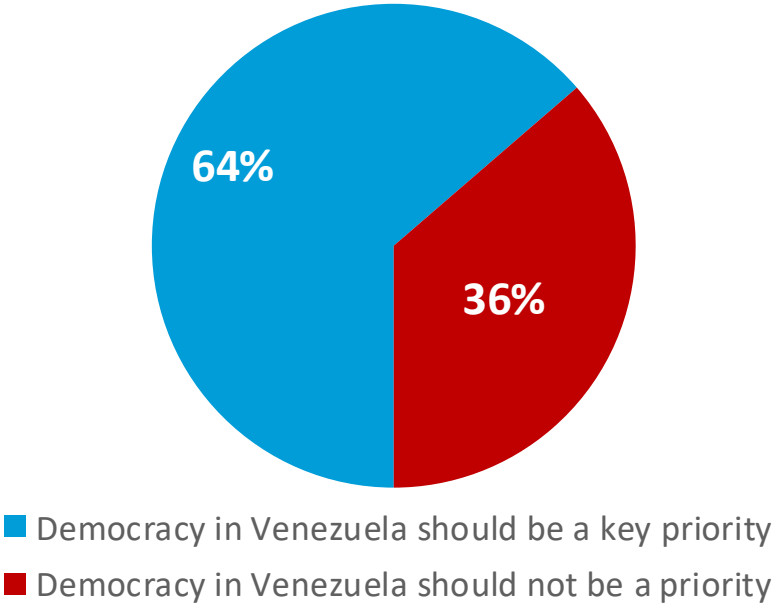

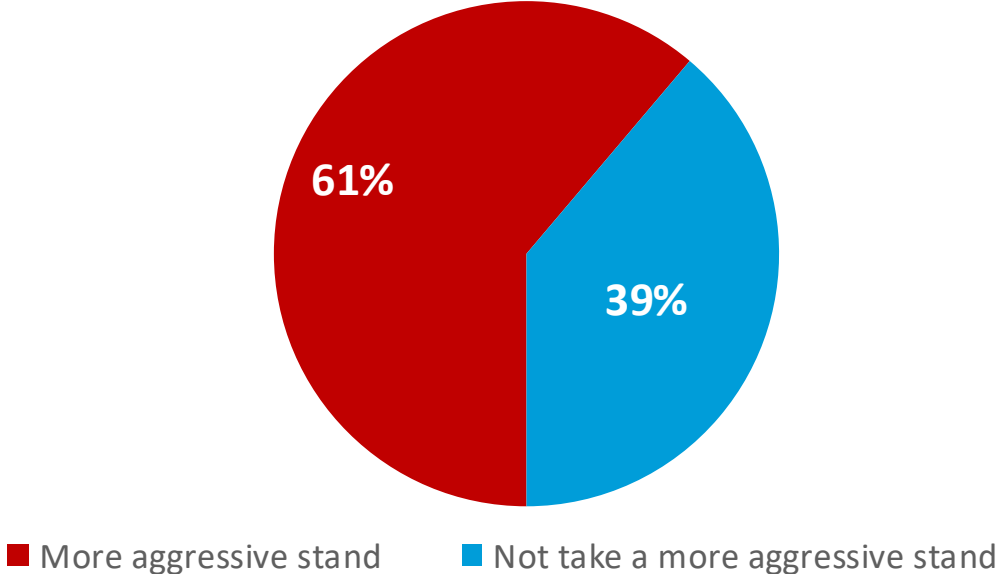

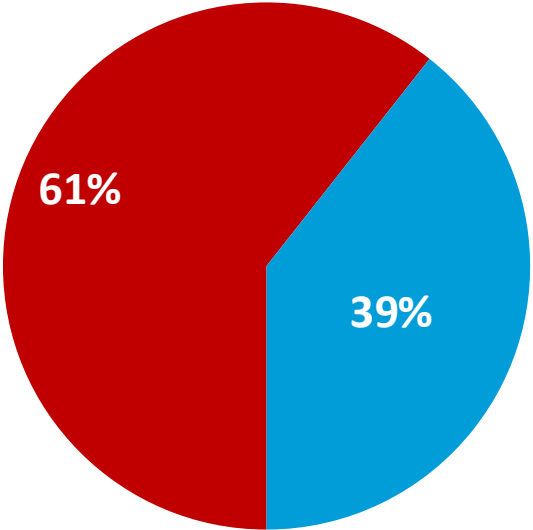

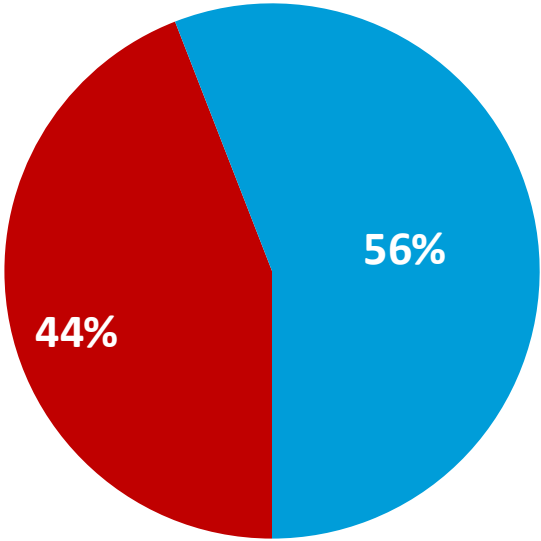

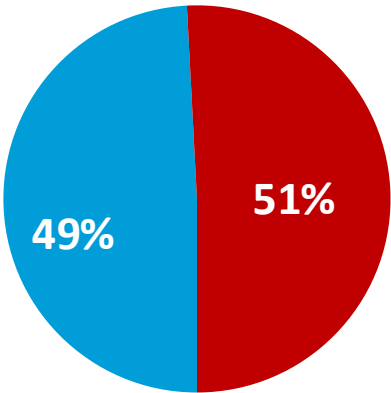

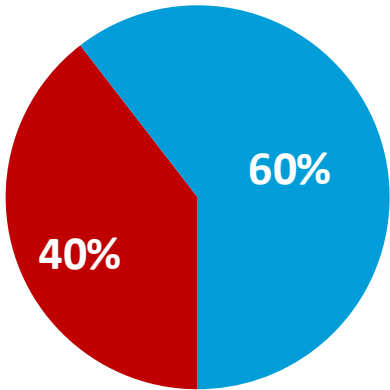

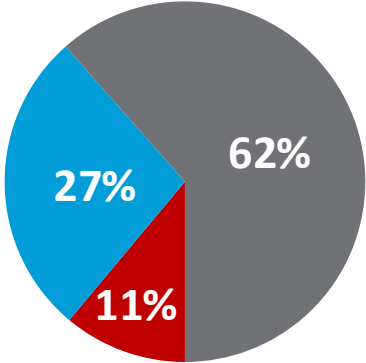

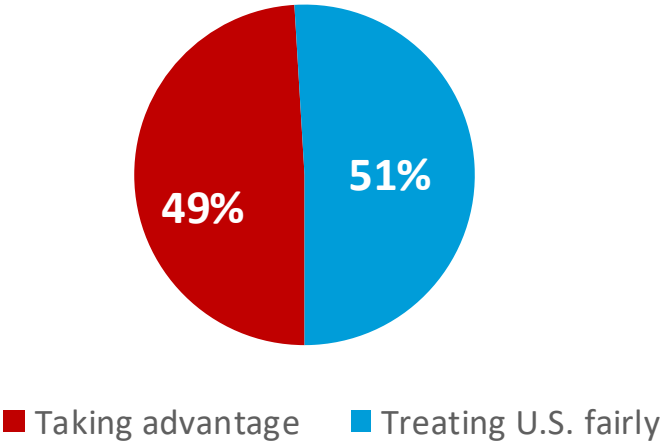

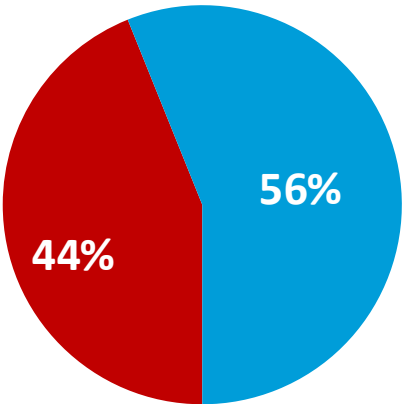

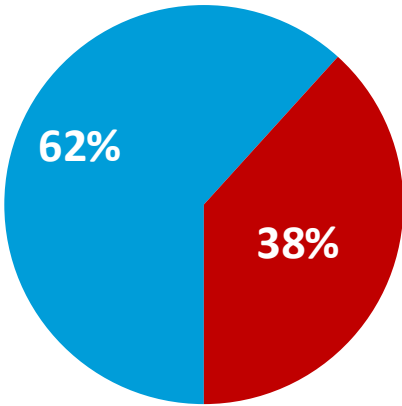

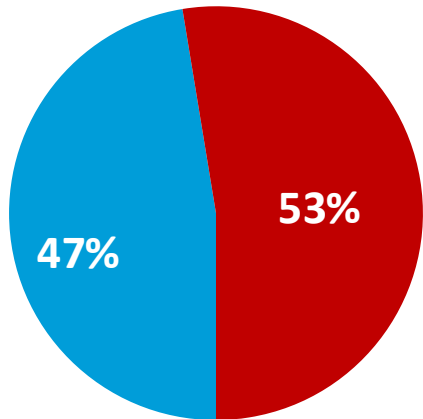

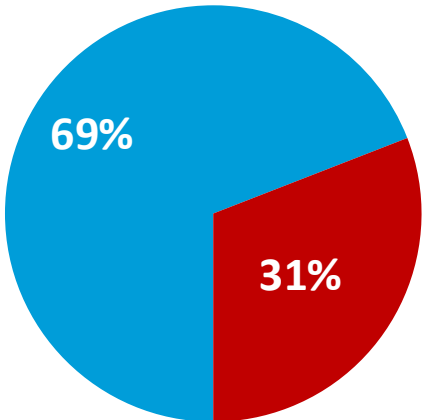

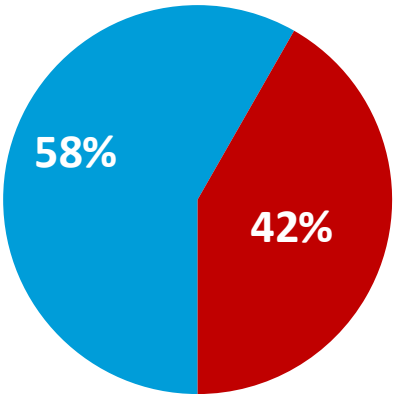

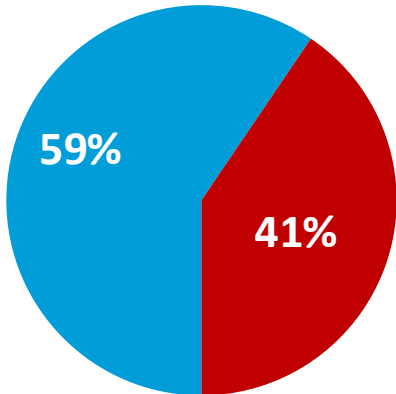

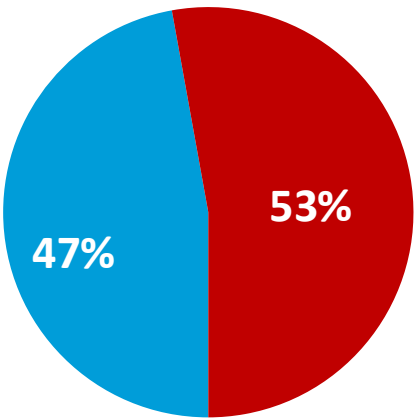

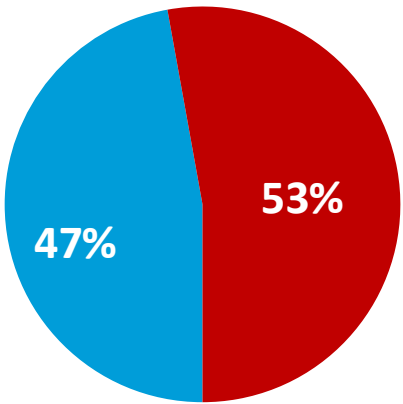

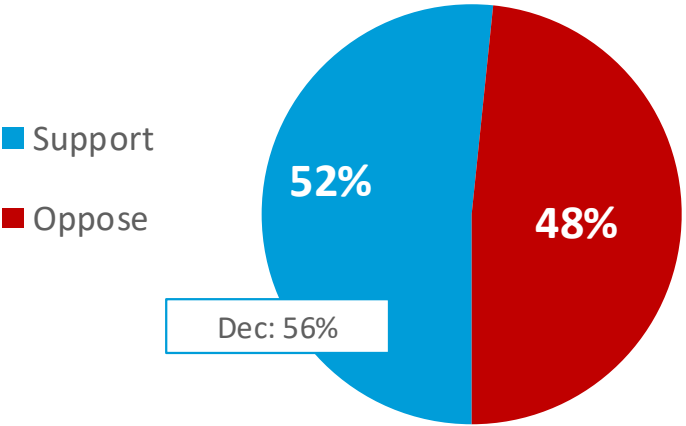

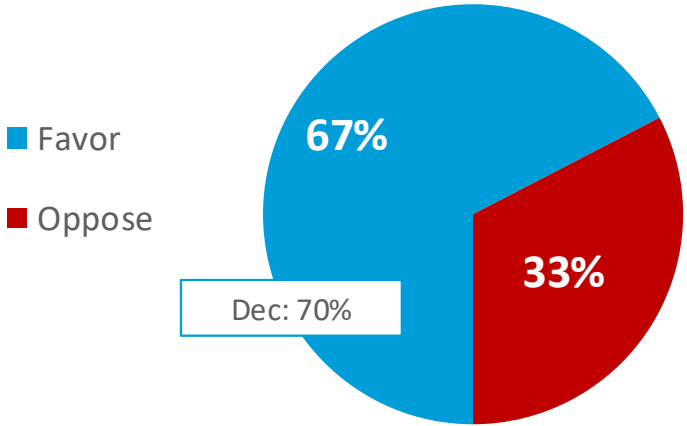

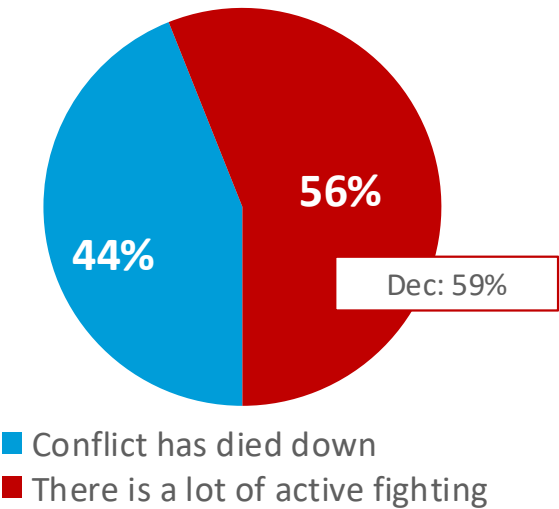

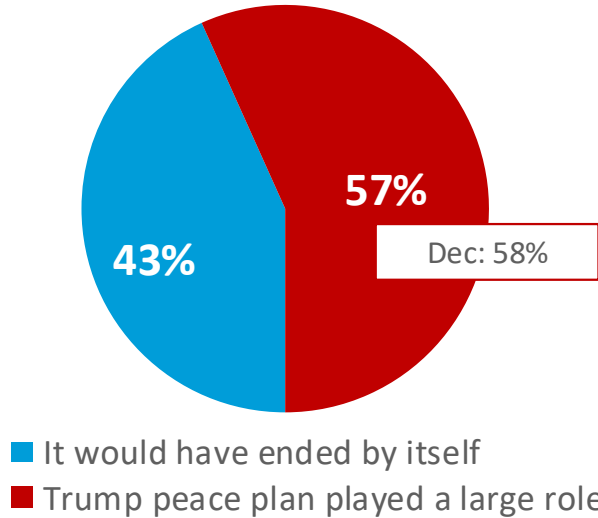

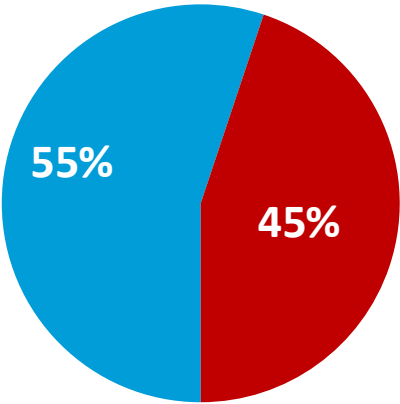

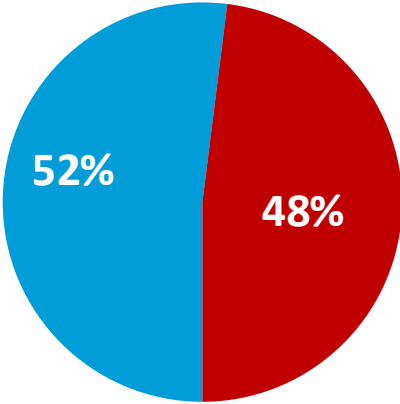

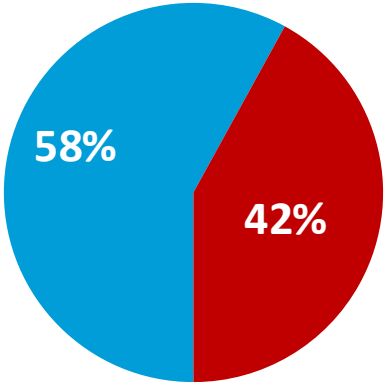

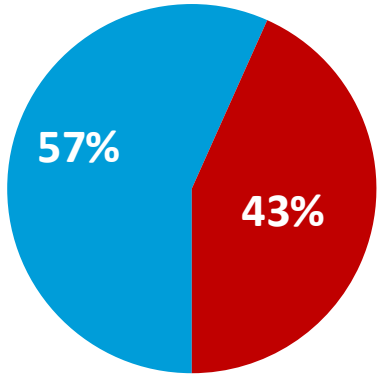

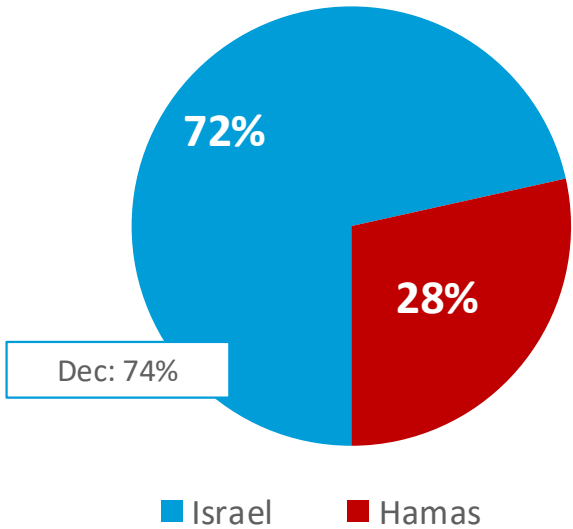

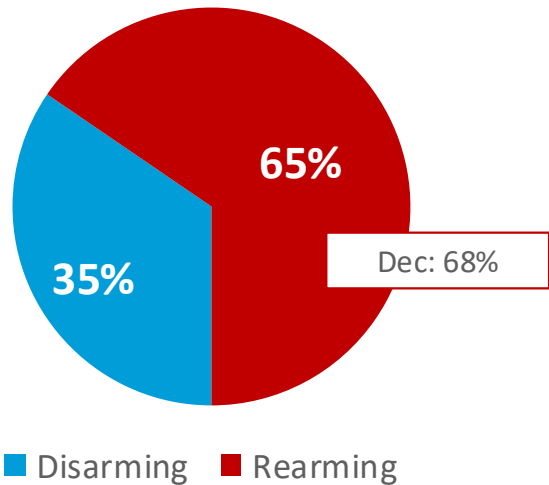

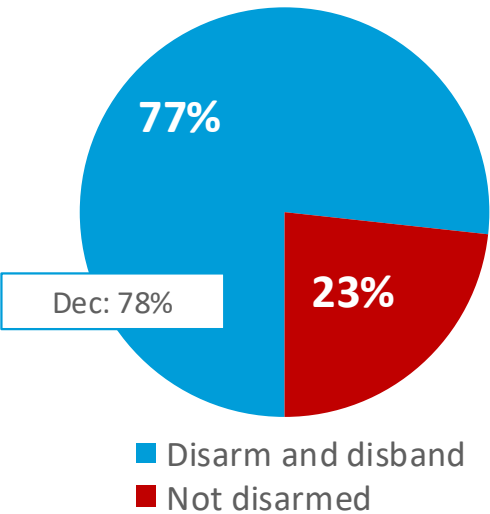

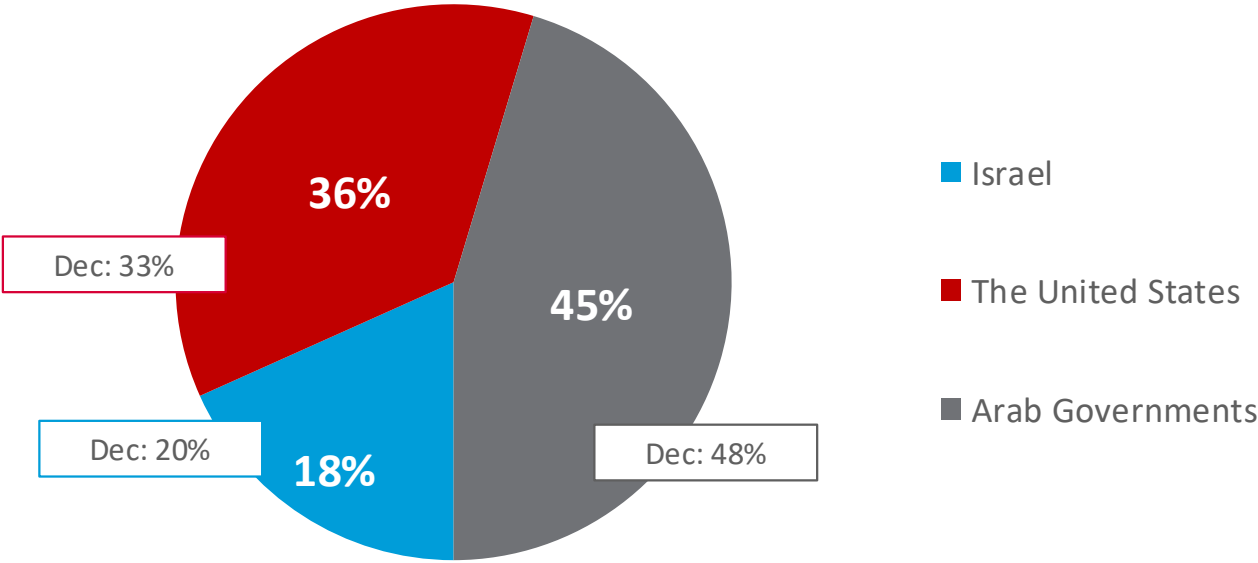

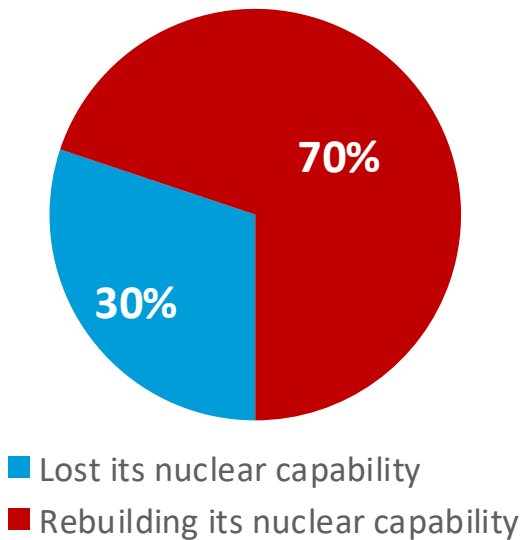

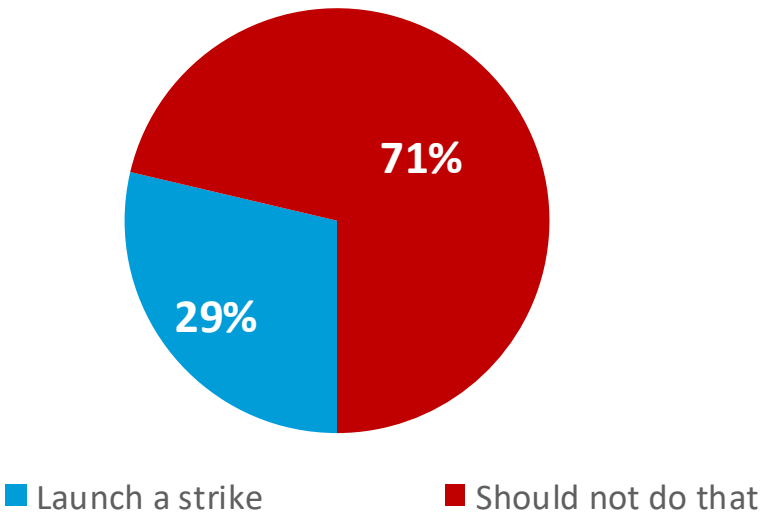

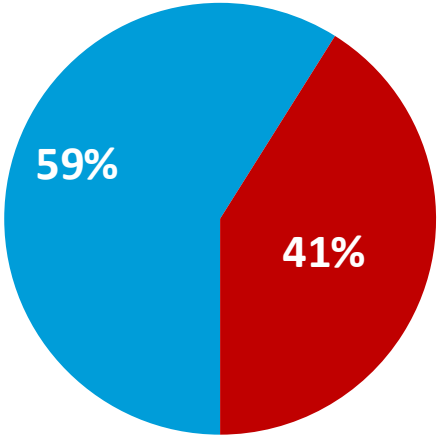

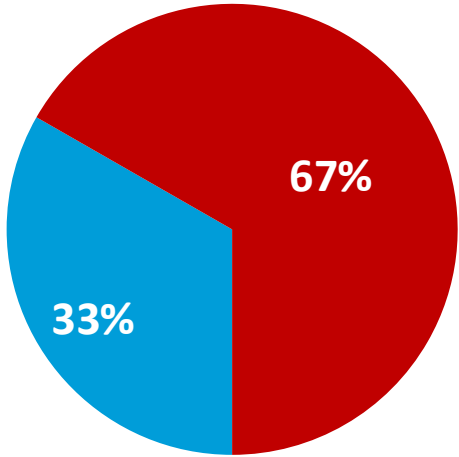

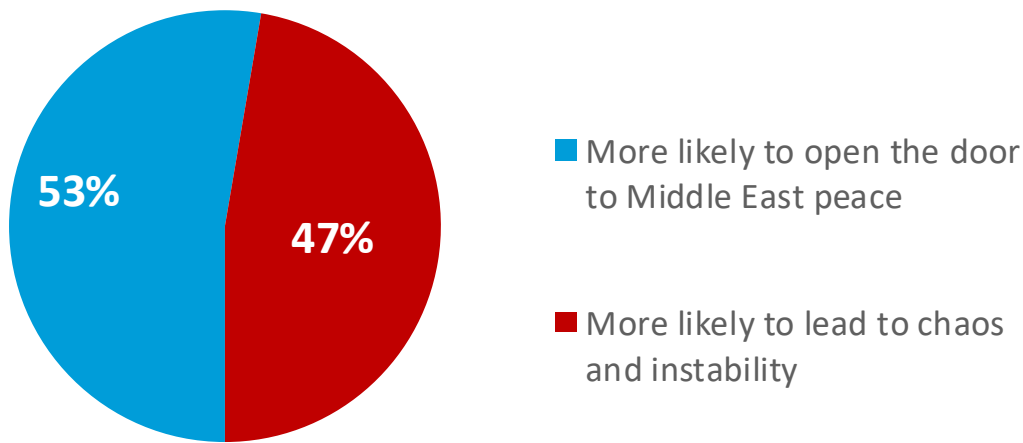

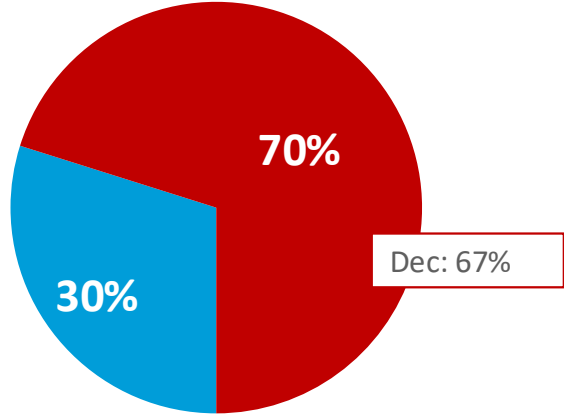

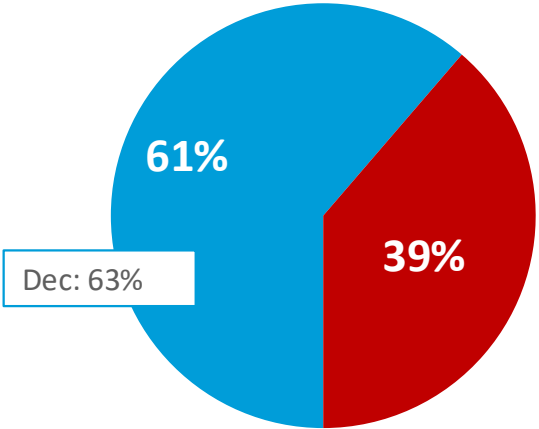

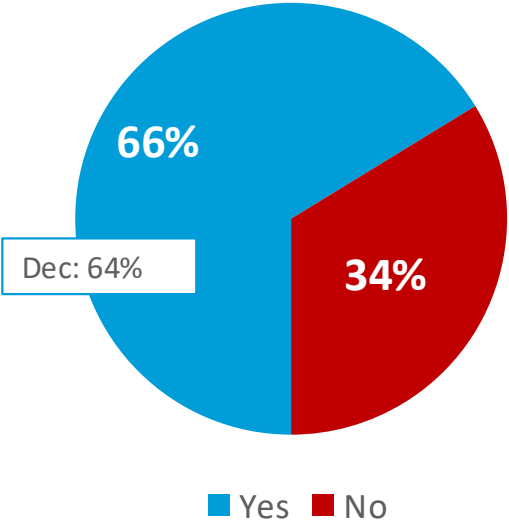

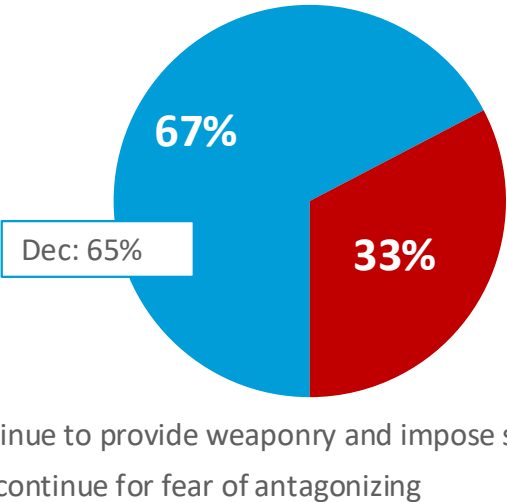

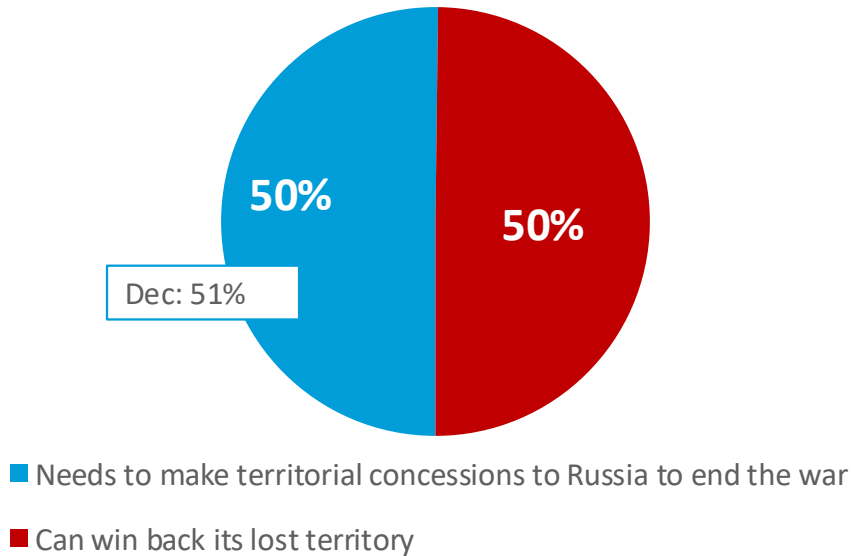

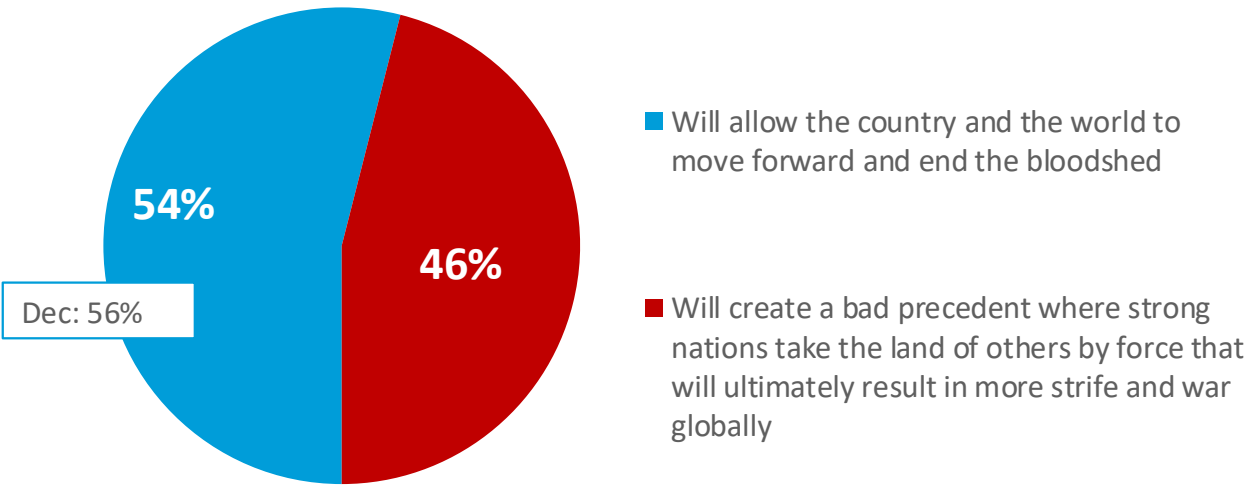
